The designers behind the Sentrum side table have studied product design together at the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar in Germany. Their shared theoretical background shows in the side table, which follows the principle of simplicity as it has been stripped from all unnecessary elements.

The S-shaped construction creates two spaces for storage on both sides to enhance to usability of the side table. The objective for Schmahl + Schnippering is to create objects that are designed to integrate and interact with people as a part of their daily life.
