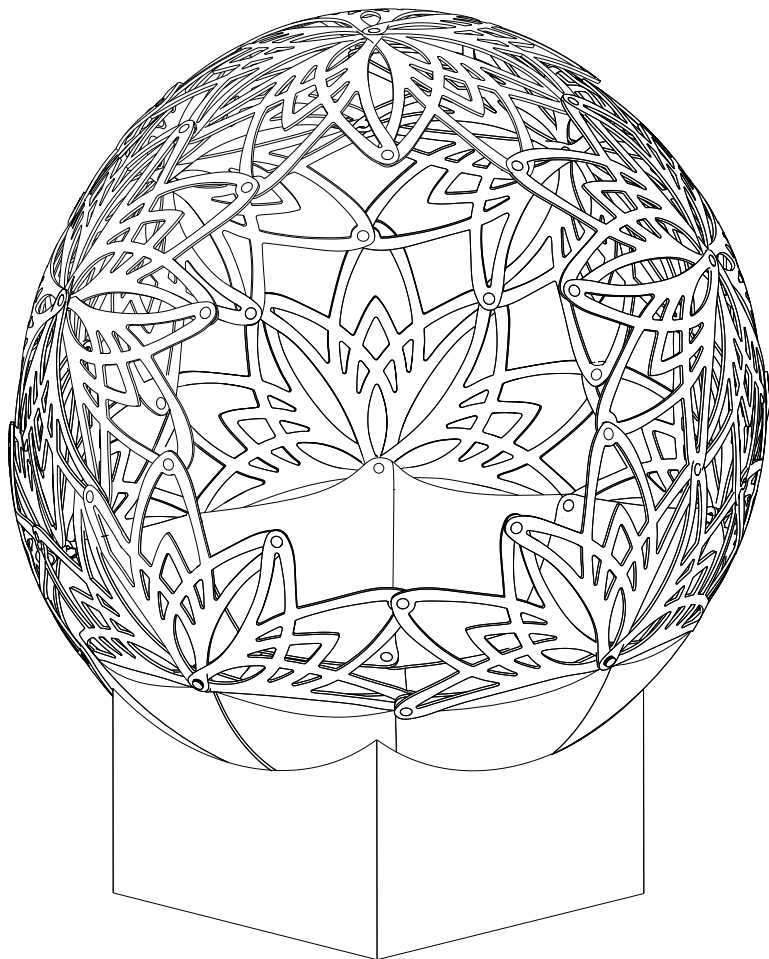

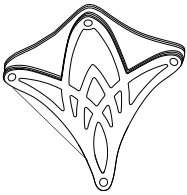

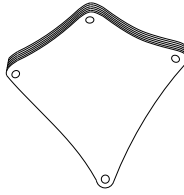
- Become familiar with the operation of this product.

Using Bolts

Bolt heads must always face outside the fire pit during assembly.

Each tip must be connected in a specific way.

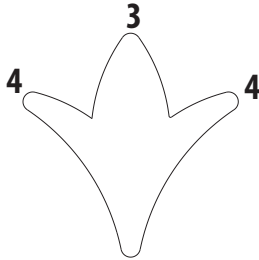
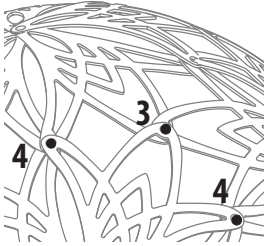

Remember this Golden Rule!



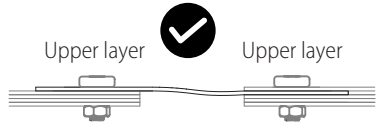
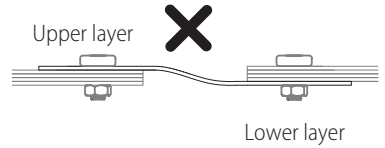
DO NOT TIGHTEN



Key

- 4 = Pointed Side tips have 4 connection layers.
- 3 = Round Center tips have 3 connections layers.

NOTE: Connect adjacent Face Layers with adjacent Face Layers (upper with upper and lower with lower).

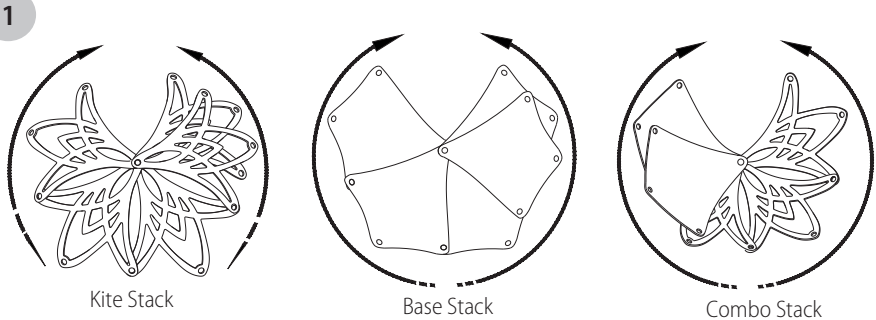


This will make for a smoother sphere shape when assembled.

Assembly

Each Kite tip must be connected in a specific way.

Spread each of the **STACKS** open to prepare them for assembly as shown.



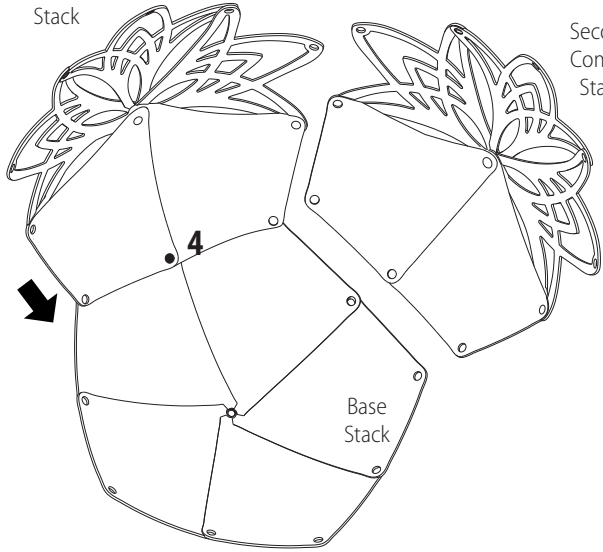
- 2 Expand the **BASE STACK** and assemble the **COMBO STACK** shown to form the Base I.



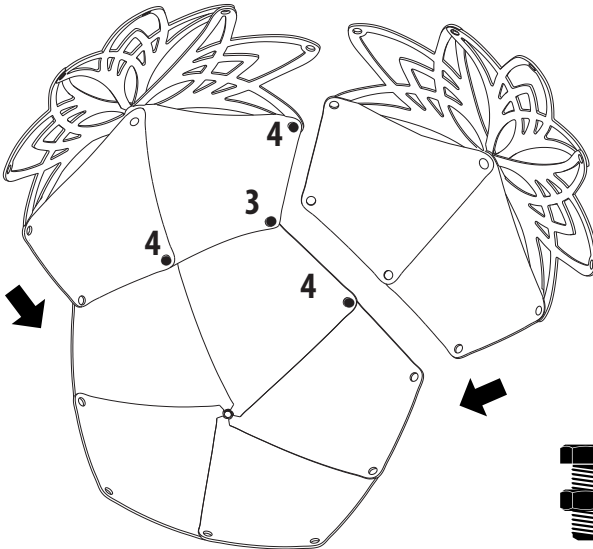
NOTE:
As you assemble, insert nuts and bolts but **DO NOT TIGHTEN** until all stacks have been attached.

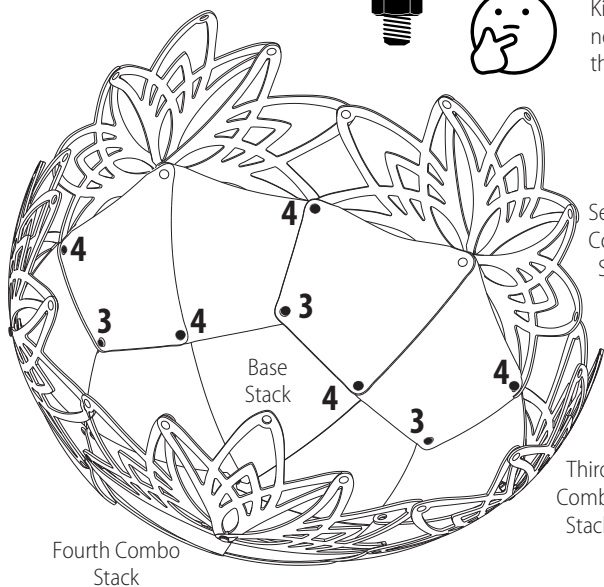


"4...3...4" **NOTE:**

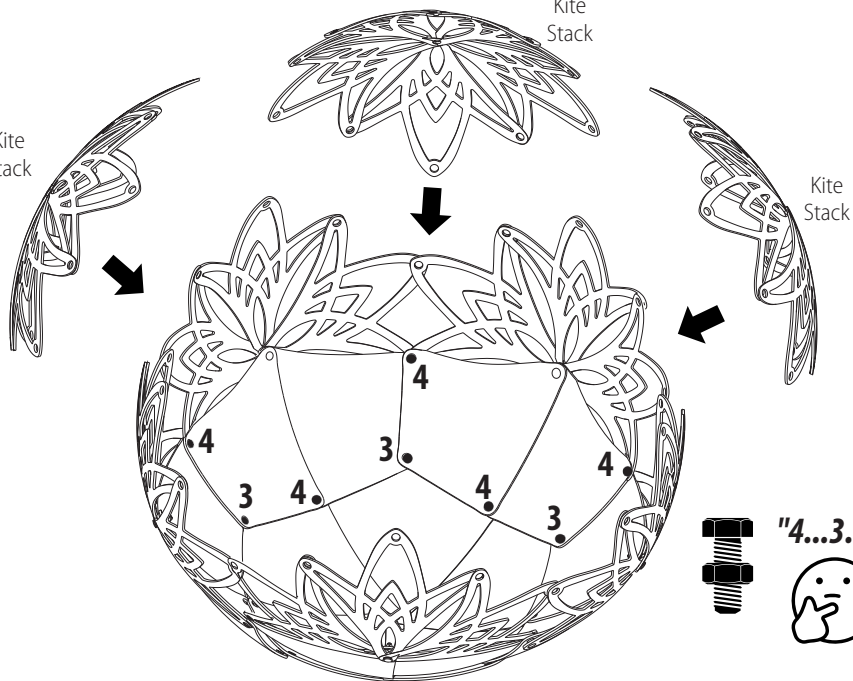

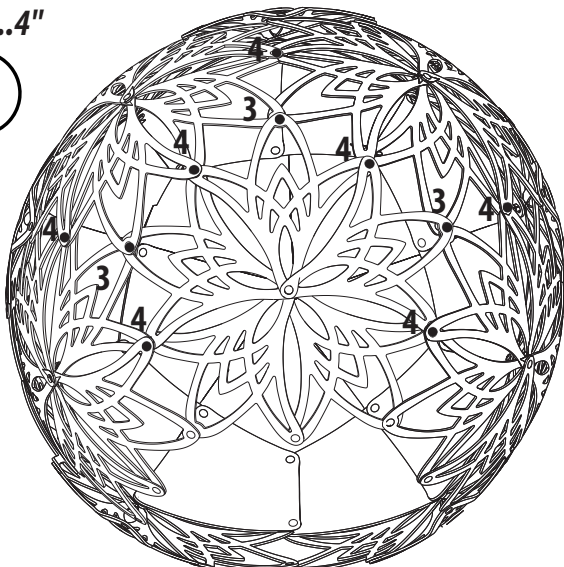

TOP VIEW

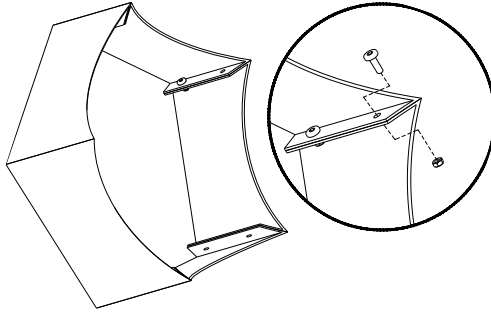
- 7 Continue to connect the **KITE STACKS** together, leaving an opening on one side of the (this opening allow logs to be inserted inside).

- 8 **TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS**

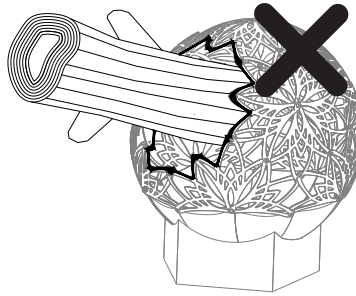
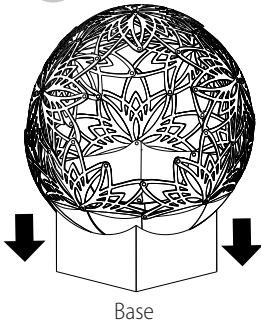


FRONT VIEW

- 9 Assemble the **BASE WALLS** into a pentagon shape using the Nuts and Bolts.



- 10 Place the sphere portion to the base.
