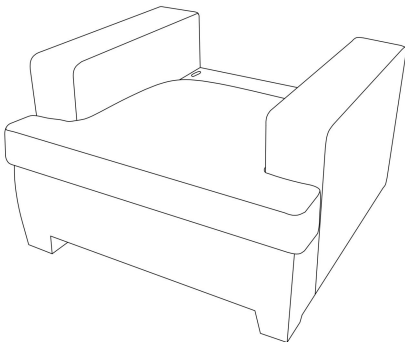
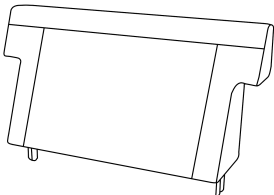
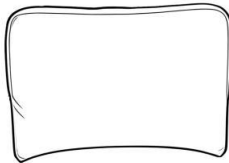
CHAIR

Please take it out for assembly.



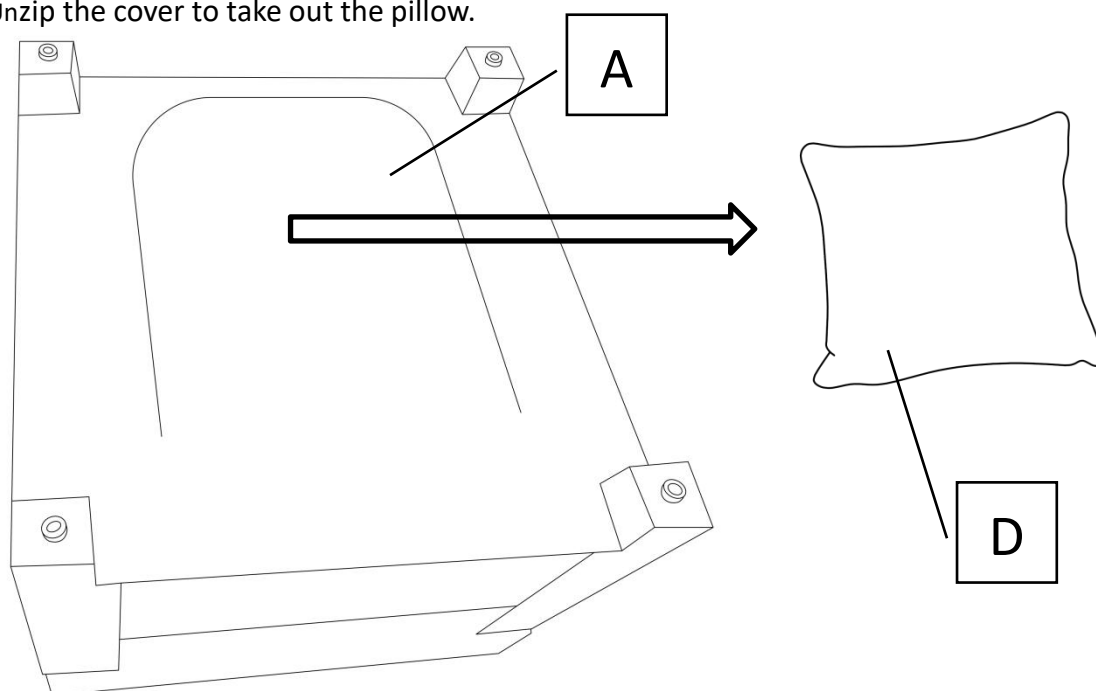

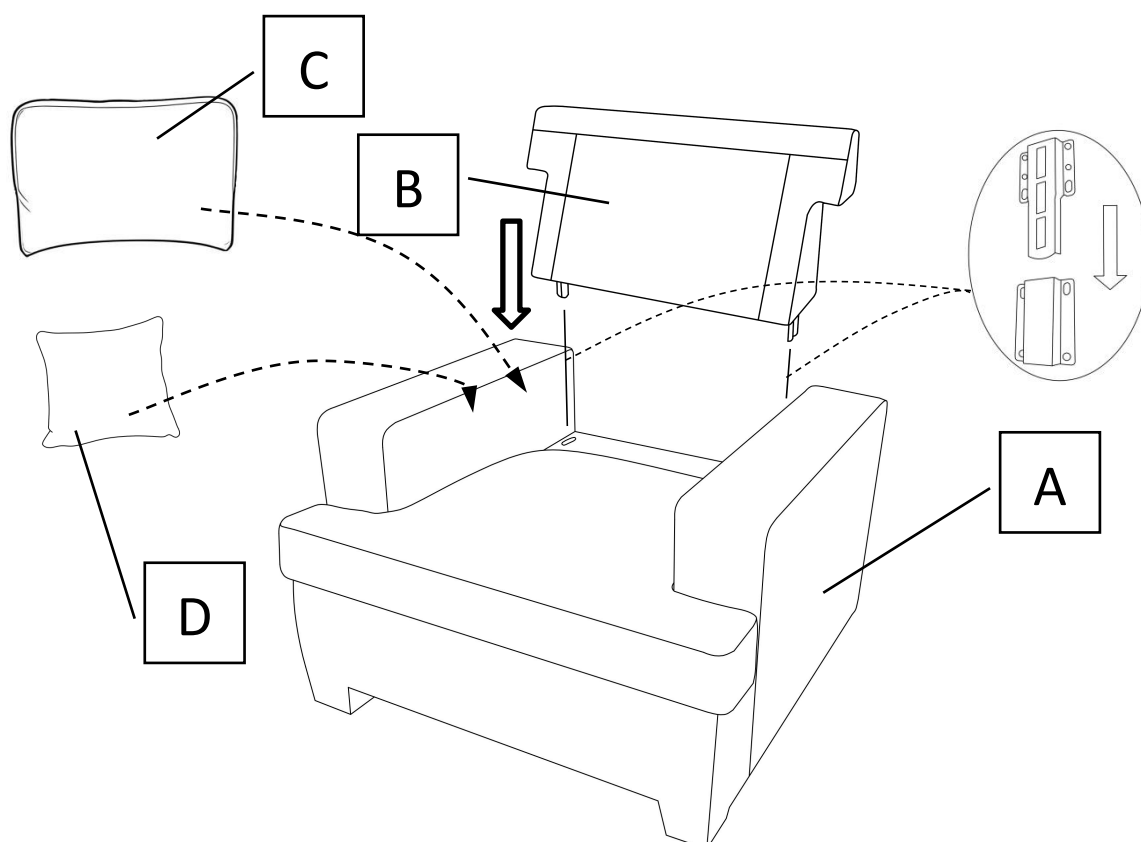

Care Instructions for Chenille Furniture:

To maintain the original appearance of your chenille furniture, please follow these simple care procedures:

- Avoid direct exposing furniture directly to sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets. Prolonged exposure to sunlight and/or heating and air conditioning outlets will cause chenille to fade or deteriorate.
- Regularly vacuum or dust with a soft cloth to maintain the fabric's texture and remove debris.
- Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connections are tight. Re-tighten if necessary.



For items used on wooden floor, hard surfaces or carpets, it is recommended to install protective pads under all legs and supports to prevent damage/scratches and discoloration.

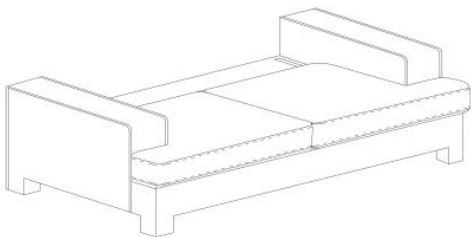
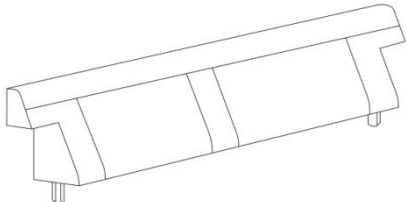
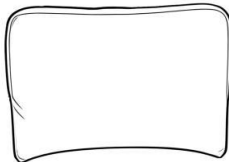
LOVESEAT
