

Cat Palm Care Guide





Can tolerate low and medium light conditions, but thrives in bright indirect light. Direct sunlight may burn the leaves.



Water & Humidity

Keep soil consistently moist year round. Make sure to remove any water that has accumulated in the saucer. Can tolerate average household humidity, but prefers higher humidity. It will benefit from misting or placing a humidifier nearby.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 70-80°F



Food

Feed once during the spring and summer with a slow release fertilizer.



Toxicity

Non-toxic to humans and pets.



Growers Tips

Tap water sometimes contains fluoride, chlorine, or other chemicals that damage palms, so it's a good idea to use distilled or rainwater to water your palm. Always use room temperature water when watering your tropical house plants because cold water is a shock to them.
