**Under no circumstances, we will be liable or responsible for any incidental or consequential damages.**























All replacement products or parts will assume the remaining warranty of the original product. This warranty gives you specific legal rights. You may also have other rights, which vary from state to state.

2. We suggest that you take your time during installation to avoid bending the frame or pinching your fingers or hands while opening and closing the frame.
3. Avoid setting up your gazebo on steep inclines.
4. Do not use your gazebo for permanent shelter. It is designed for temporary use only.
5. Use precaution when using a BBQ or fire under the gazebo. Never allow fire flames to directly contact the gazebo.
6. Never leave your gazebo unattended.
7. Never store your gazebo when it is constantly wet or damp.
8. The frame MUST be staked or properly weighted down at all times.
9. When assembling and using this product, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of personal injury or damage to equipment. Please read all instructions before assembly and use.
10. Some parts may contain sharp edges. Wear protective gloves if necessary. Three or more people are recommended for safe assembly.
11. Keep all children and pets away from assembly area.
12. Begin assembly at least 9 feet from any obstruction such as fences, a garage, house, overhanging branches, laundry lines or electrical wires.
13. Please sweep or keep this unit out of snow deeper than 10 inches.

## SET UP THE GAZEBO

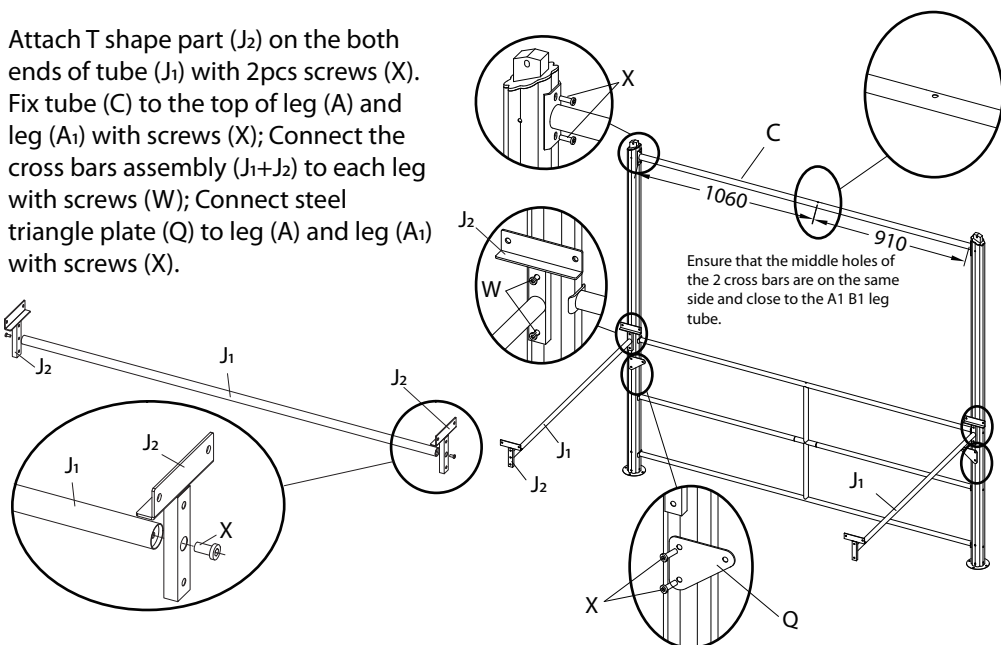
### Step 1

Attach foot pad (P) to Leg (A) using 4 pcs screws (Z<sub>2</sub>). Repeat the above steps for leg (A<sub>1</sub>). Insert tubes (O) into cross connector (I<sub>1</sub>). Connect the two of tube (F) into both ends of cross connector (I<sub>1</sub>), fix them with 2pcs screws (V). Connect tube assembly between leg (A) and leg (A<sub>1</sub>) with screws (S).



### Step 2

Attach T shape part (J<sub>2</sub>) on the both ends of tube (J<sub>1</sub>) with 2pcs screws (X). Fix tube (C) to the top of leg (A) and leg (A<sub>1</sub>) with screws (X); Connect the cross bars assembly (J<sub>1</sub>+J<sub>2</sub>) to each leg with screws (W); Connect steel triangle plate (Q) to leg (A) and leg (A<sub>1</sub>) with screws (X).



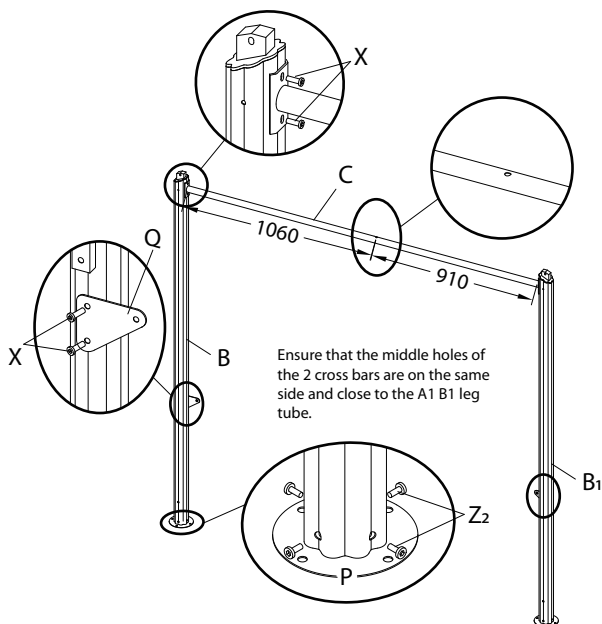
## SET UP THE GAZEBO

### Step 3

Attach foot pad (P) on leg (B) and with 4 pcs screws (Z<sub>2</sub>), Repeat the above steps for leg (B<sub>1</sub>).

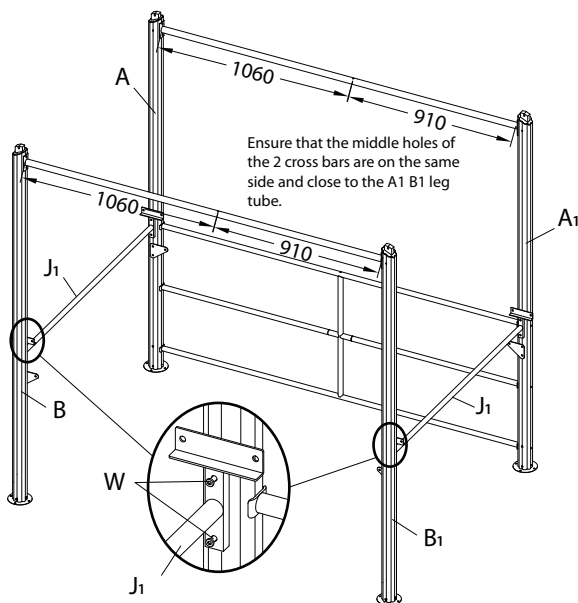
Fix tube (C) with screws (X) at the top of leg (B) and leg (B<sub>1</sub>);

Use screws (X) to connect steel triangle plate (Q) to legs (B) and (B<sub>1</sub>).



### Step 4

Connect Leg Assembly A and A<sub>1</sub> to Leg Assembly B and B<sub>1</sub> using cross bars J<sub>1</sub> using screws (W).

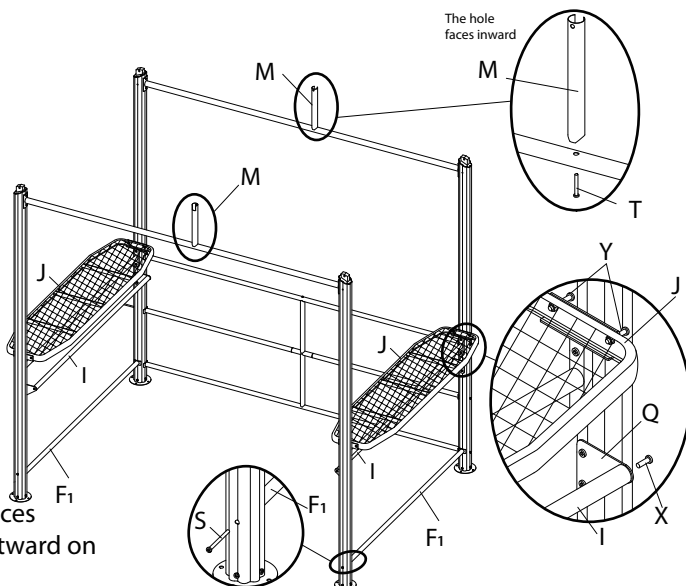


## SET UP THE GAZEBO

### Step 5

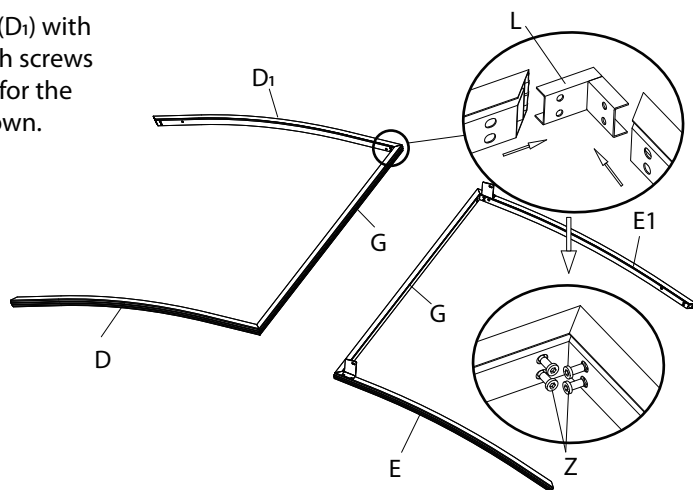
Attach tube (F<sub>1</sub>) between the bottom of legs (A) and leg (B) with screw (S). Attach tube (I) to triangle plate (Q) on legs A and B with screw (X). Place mesh bar (J) above the crossbar (J<sub>1</sub>) and secure with screw (Y).

Repeat process on legs (A<sub>1</sub>) and leg (B<sub>1</sub>). Install (M) on cross bars (C), fix it with screw (T), ensure the hole faces inward and the gap faces outward on both bars.



### Step 6

Connect tubes (D), (G), and (D<sub>1</sub>) with L-shaped connectors (L) with screws (Z). Repeat the above steps for the tubes (E), (G), and (E<sub>1</sub>) as shown.

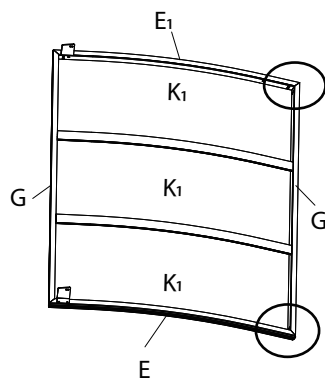
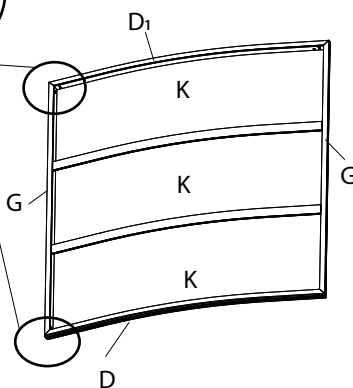
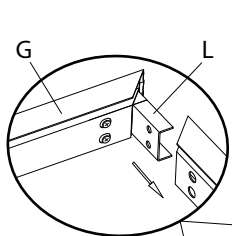
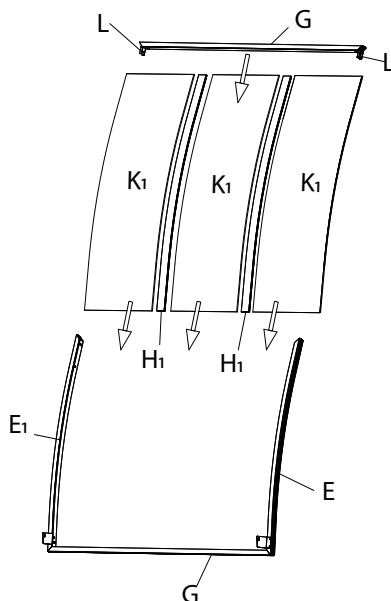
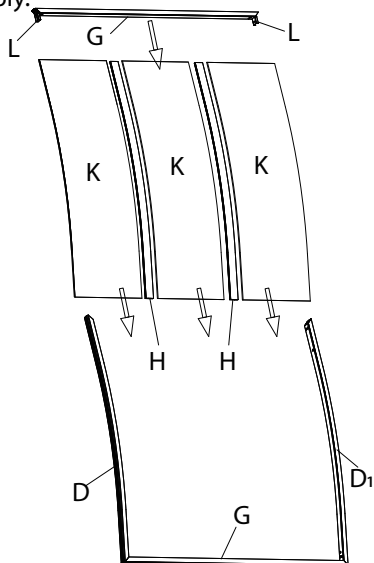




## SET UP THE GAZEBO

### Step 7

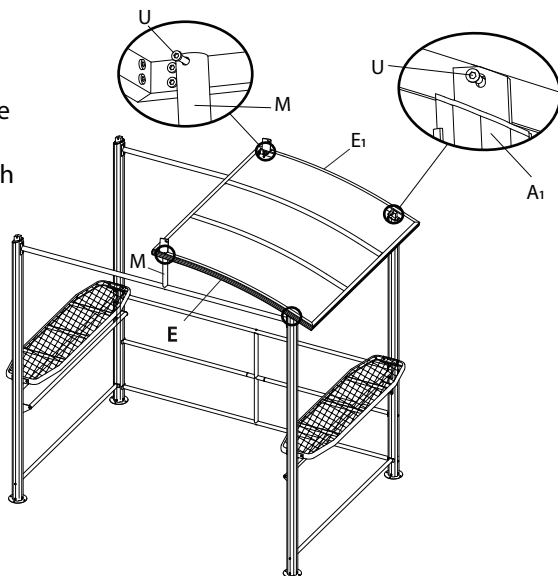
Slide PC board (K) into the (D), (D<sub>1</sub>), and (G) frame assembly. Attach tube (G) using brackets (L) to complete the frame. Repeat the above steps to (E), (E<sub>1</sub>), and (G) frame assembly.



## SET UP THE GAZEBO

### Step 8

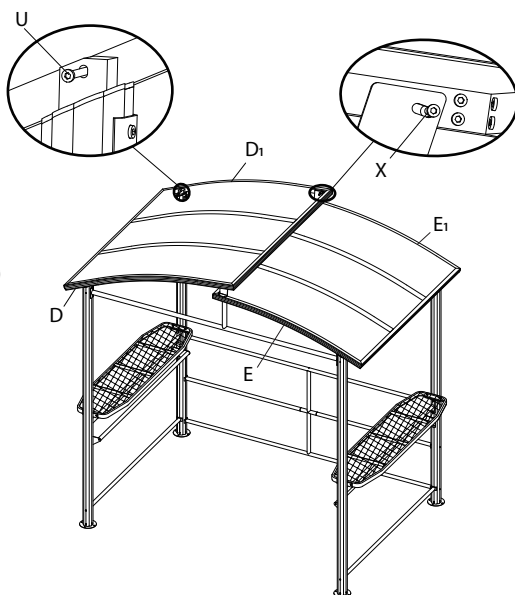
Place the (E) roof assembly on the tube as pictured. Use screw (U) to connect tube (E)/(E1) to legs (A1) and (B1). Attach the roof assembly to legs with (M) bracket with screws (U).



### Step 9

Place the (D) roof assembly on the tube as pictured. Use screw (U) to connect tube (D)/(D1) to legs (A) and (B). Attach roof assembly (D) to roof assembly (E) at the center with screws.

Place assembled roof board assembly on the top as pictured. Use screw (U) to connect tube (D)/(D1) with the leg, then connect (D) and (E), (D1) and (E1) with screw (X).



## SET UP THE GAZEBO

### Step 10

Secure the gazebo to soft ground by inserting a stake (Z3) through the foot of each leg. The gazebo may be anchored to concrete using suitable concrete anchors (not included).
