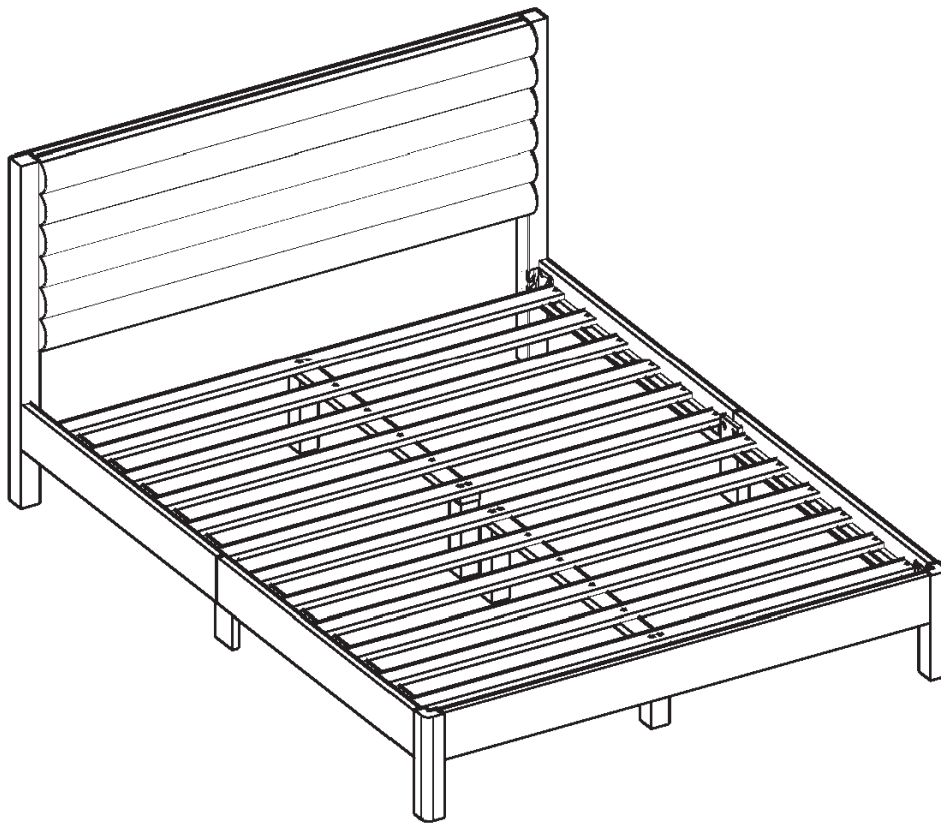
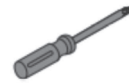

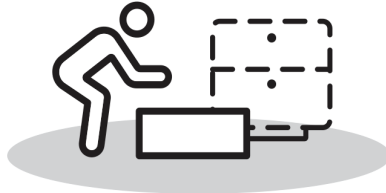
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent to prevent scratches and damages.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

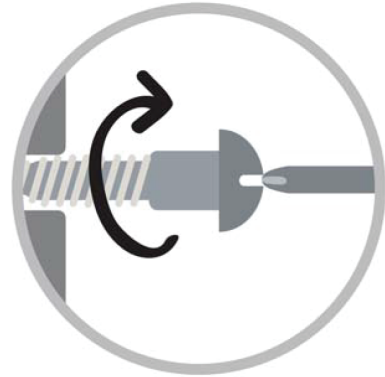
ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE

Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
their respective holes.



Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
to do so.



Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.

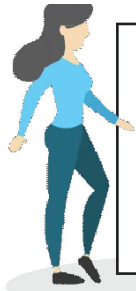
Use the appropriate hand tools
or power tools for assembly.
Select steps, such as tightening
screws and/or bolts, may require
hand tools to avoid causing
damage during assembly.



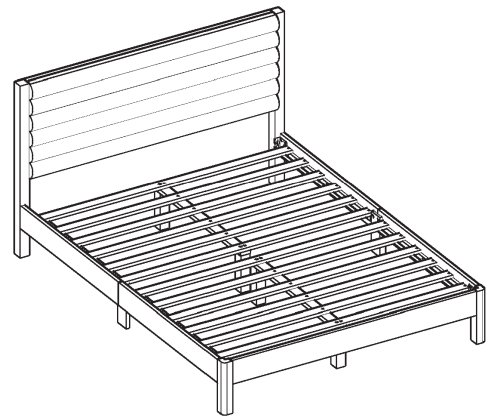
After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

- I. Attach the Headboard Legs (#2R, 2L) to Headboard (#1) using Bolt (#D) with Spring Washer (#G) and Flat Washer (#F).
- II. Align the Footboard Legs (#3R, 3L) with the Footboard (#6), ensuring the arrow points upward (see diagram). First, interlock with Wood Dowels (#H). Then secure with Bolt (#E) and Spring Washer (#G).

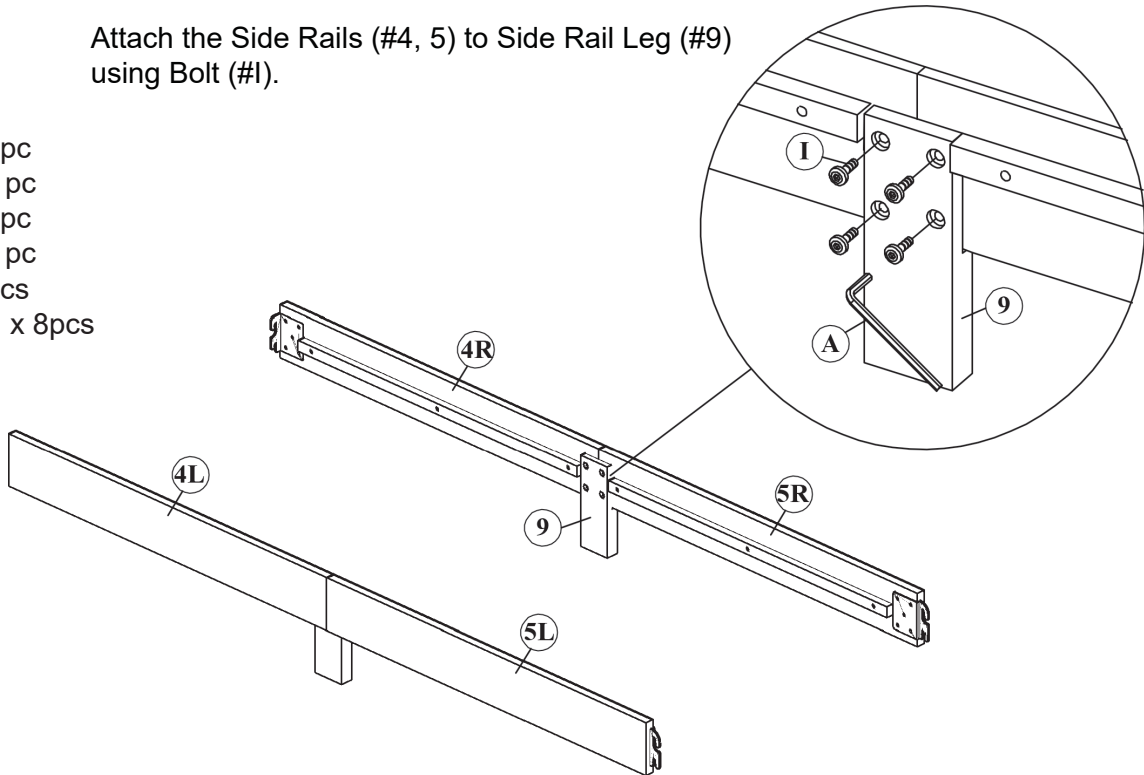

Attach the Side Rails (#4, 5) to Side Rail Leg (#9) using Bolt (#I).

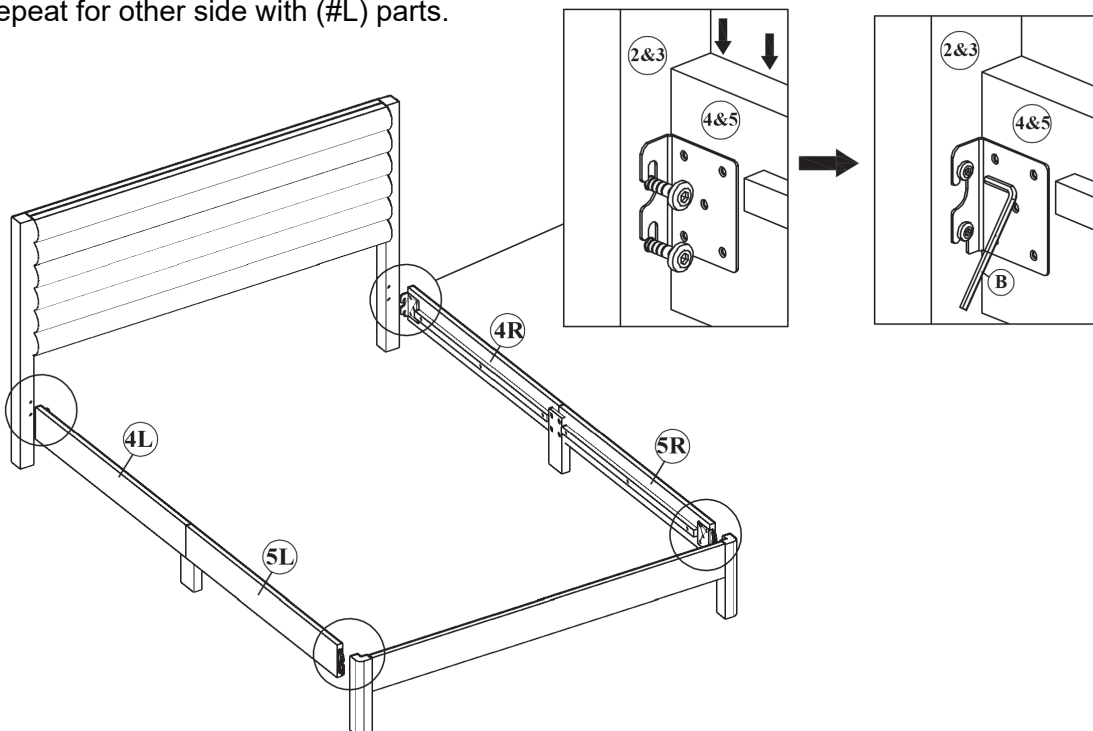

Align Side Rail (#4R) with Headboard Leg (#2R) and hook pre-attached bracket onto the protruding bolts. Align Side Rail (#5R) with Footboard Leg (#3R) and hook pre-attached bracket onto the protruding bolts. Tighten bolts with provided Allen Wrench (#B).

Repeat for other side with (#L) parts.

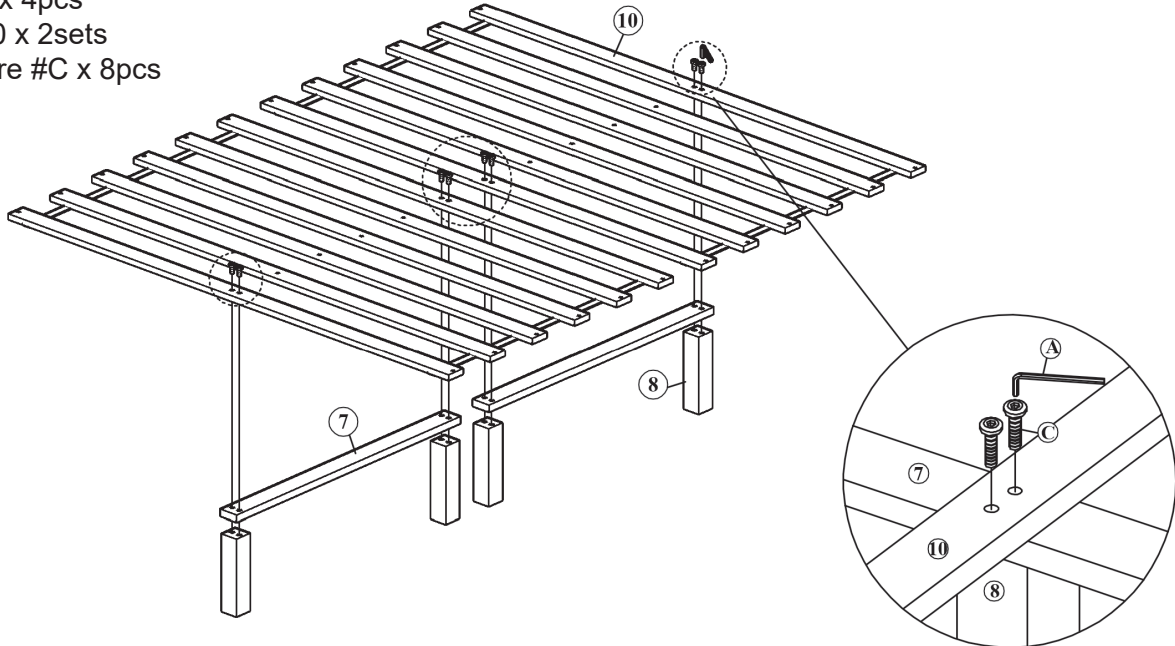

Align one Center Rail (#7) atop two Center Legs (#8). Place 1 set of Slats (#10) on top and secure the first and last slats with Bolt (#C). Repeat for other set.

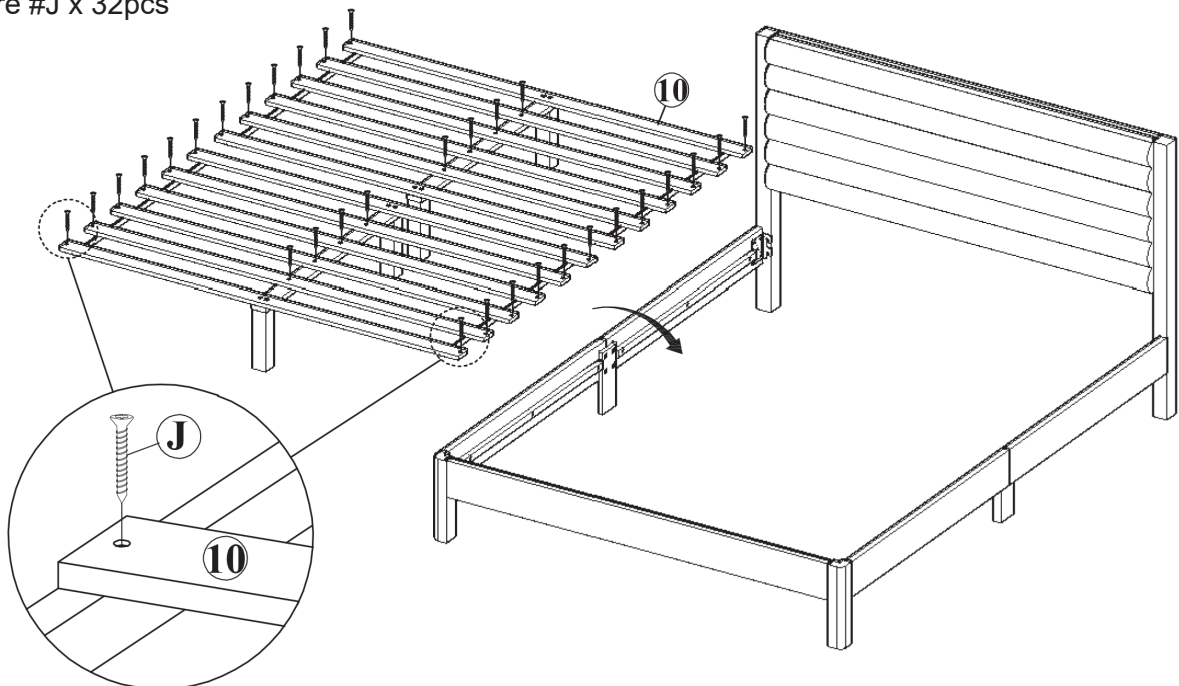

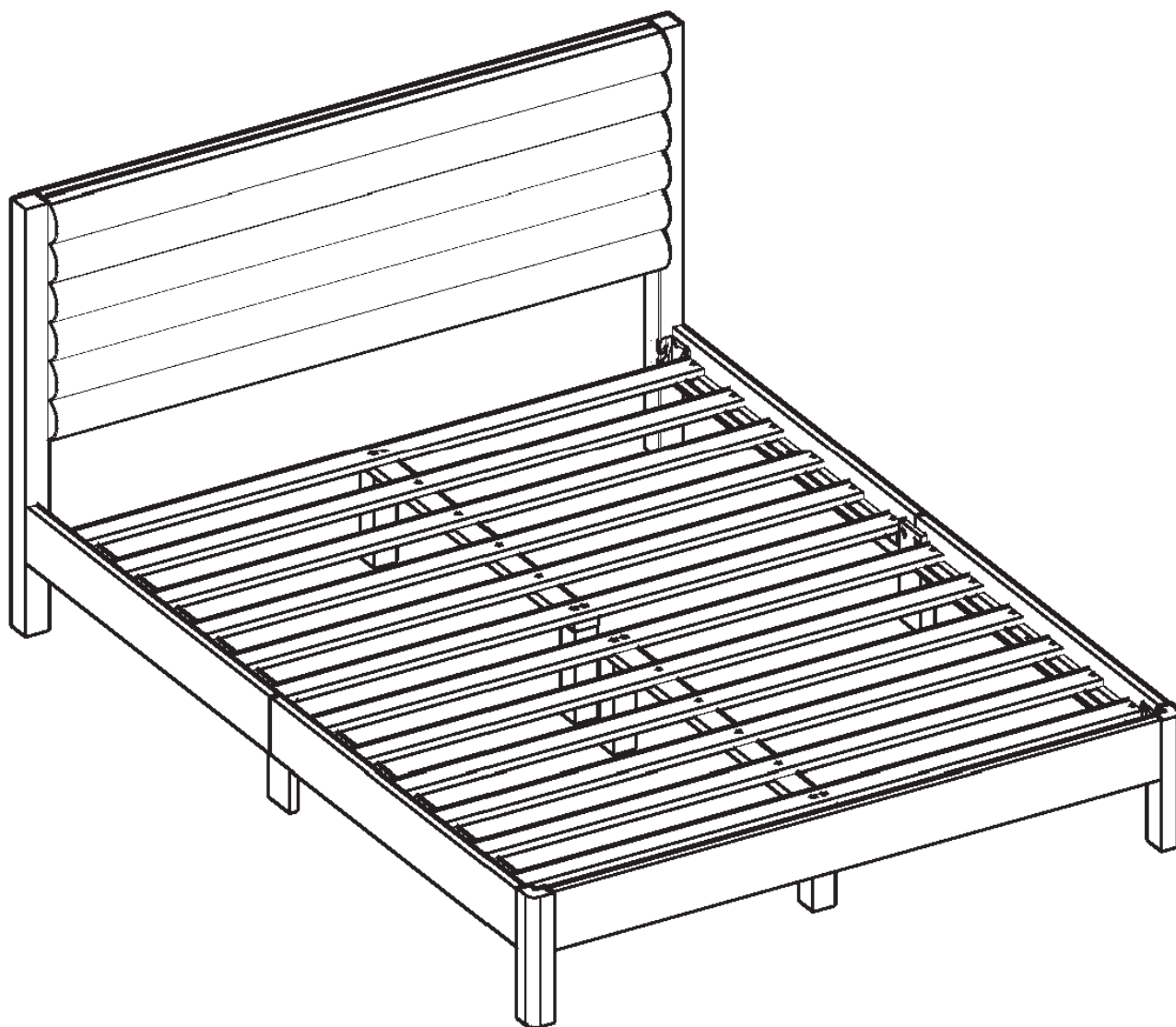

Place assembled Slats over the Side Rails. Secure every outer end of an individual slat to the Side Rails with Wood Screws (#J). Secure the center of each inner slat to the Center Rail (#7) with Wood Screws (#J).
