



Shelf Brackets

Installation Instructions for Glass Shelves.

Tools Needed:

Pencil, Level, Screwdriver, (possibly drill).

1. Determine the location of the glass shelf on your wall. To insure proper installation, it is important to choose the correct fastener for your wall type (wood, masonry, drywall, or tile, etc.)
WE RECOMMEND FASTENING BRACKETS OR CLAMPS TO STUDS.
IF THIS IS NOT POSSIBLE IT IS IMPORTANT TO USE PROPER FASTENERS.
I.E. TOGGLE BOLTS, MOLLY TYPE WALL ANCHORS, ETC.
(NOT INCLUDED)
2. Using pencil and level, locate the Shelf Brackets or Clamps mounting locations.
3. To open Shelf brackets loosen screw on bottom of bracket, this will open bracket and expose where you screw bracket to wall.
4. Fasten the brackets or clamps securely to the wall.
5. Hold the shelf in place on the opened Shelf bracket; use a screwdriver to carefully tighten the screw located on the bottom of bracket.
6. For Shelf clamps as featured below, numbers 3 and 5 are not applicable.
- **IF SCREWS TO ATTACH BRACKETS OR CLAMPS TO WALL ARE INCLUDED, THEY MAY NOT BE THE PROPER FASTENER FOR YOUR INSTALLATION.**
