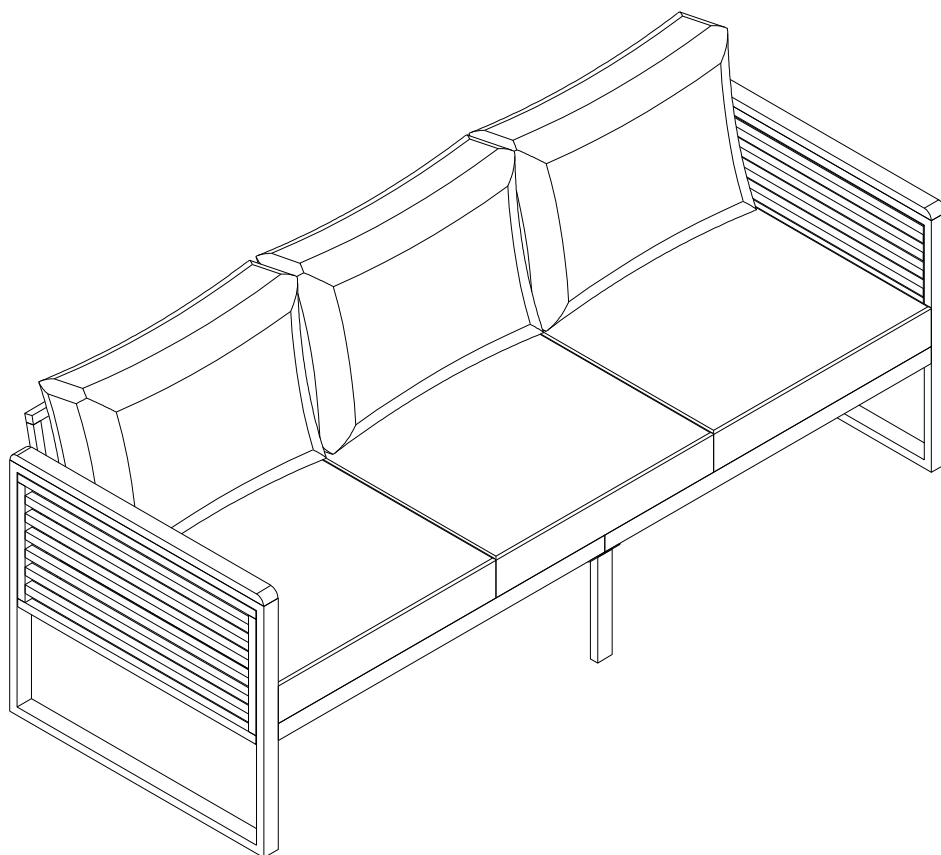

Care & Maintenance

- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  • Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

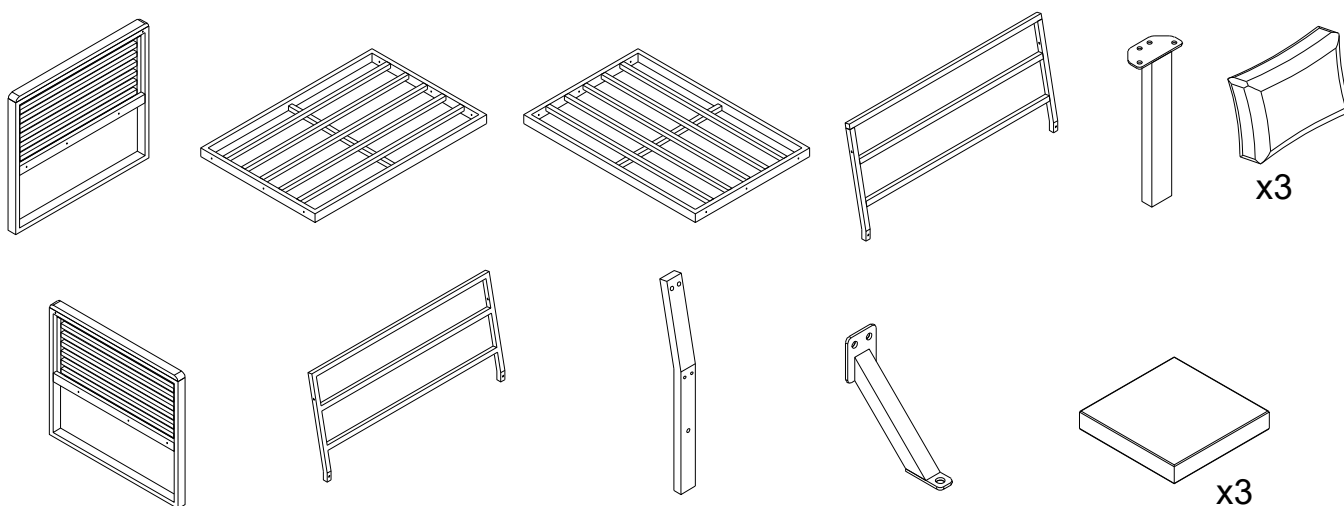
Assembly Steps

OVERVIEW



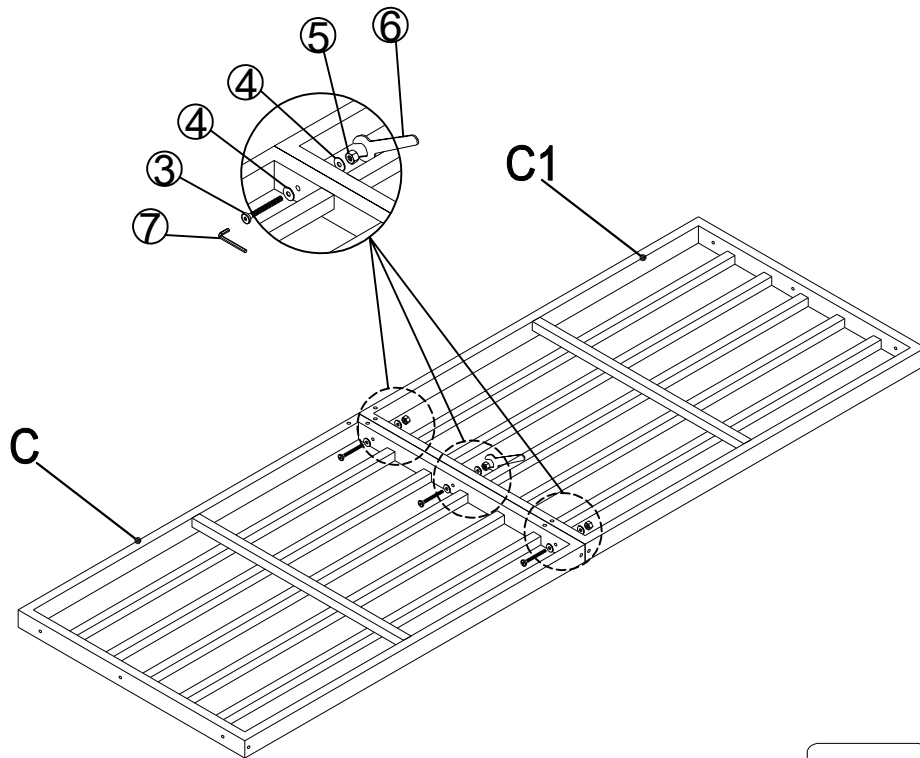
This Bench has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Bench parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non -marring surface.

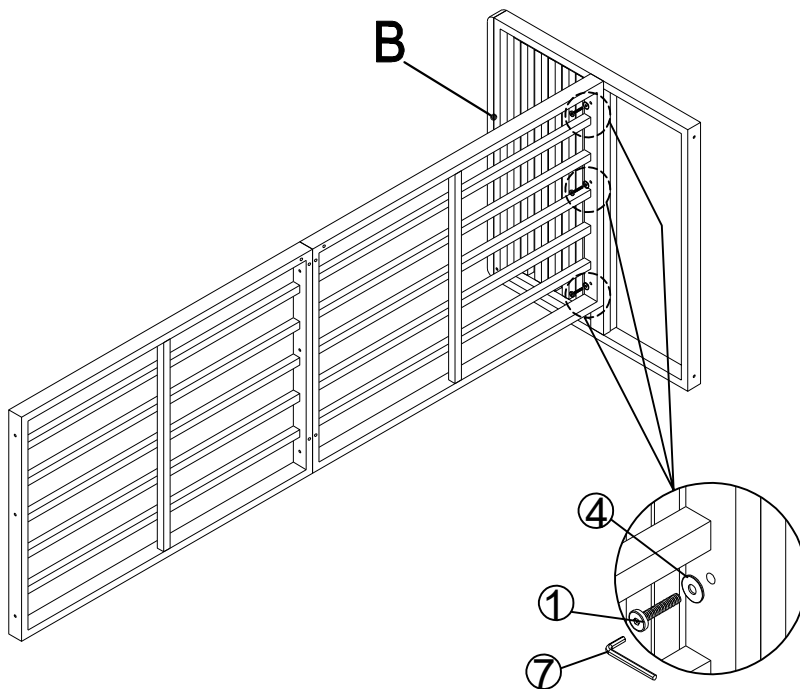
Step 2



With assistance from your adult partner, place both Left Seat Panel (C) onto a clean, non marring surface, then align Right Seat Panel (C1) together. Attach both Seat Panels together by using the Bolts (③), Washers (④), Nut (⑤) Wrench (⑥) and the Allen Wrench (⑦).

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

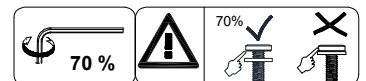
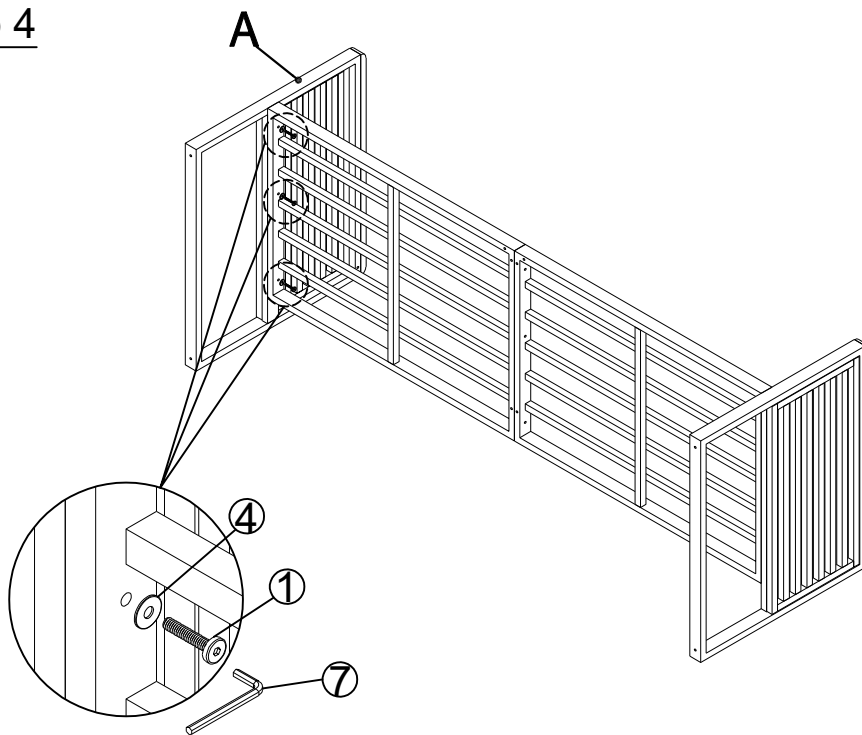
Step 3



With assistance from your adult partner, attach the Right Leg Panel (B) to Seat Panel (C) by using Bolts (①), Washers (④) with Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown above

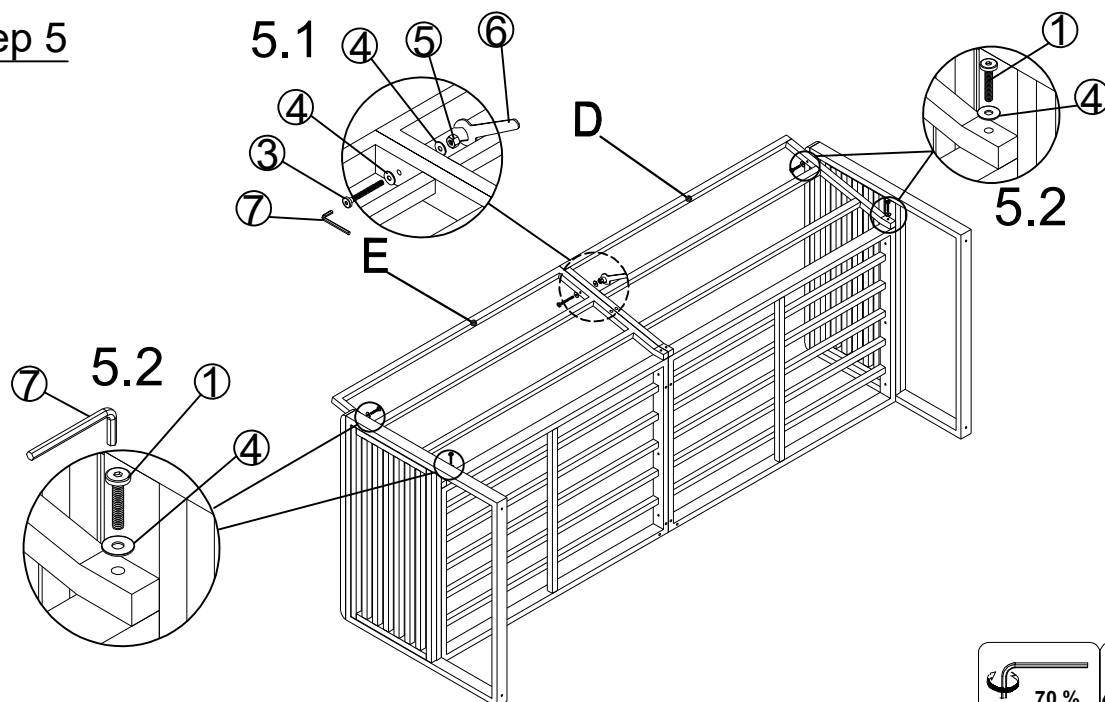
DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 4



With assistance from your adult partner, attach the Left Leg Panel (A) to Seat Panel (C)) by using Bolts (①), Washers (④) with Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown above.
DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 5



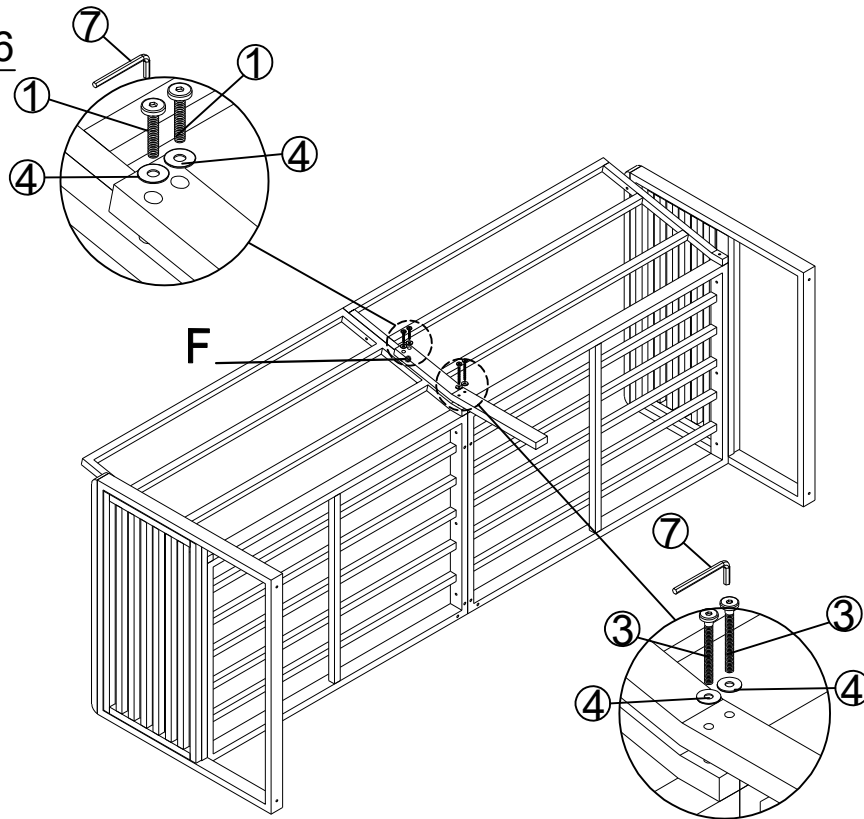
With assistance from your adult partner, attach the Left Backrest Panel (D) and Right Backrest Panel (E) to Seat Panel (C) and both Leg Panels then:

4.1: secure Left Backrest Panel (C) to Right Backrest Panel (D) by using Bolts (③) Washers (④), Nut (⑤) Wrench (⑥) and the Allen Wrench (⑦).

4.2: secure Left Backrest Panel (C) and Right Backrest Panel (D) to Leg Panels by using Bolts (①), Washers (④) with Allen Wrench (⑦)

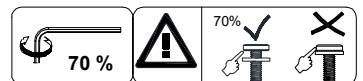
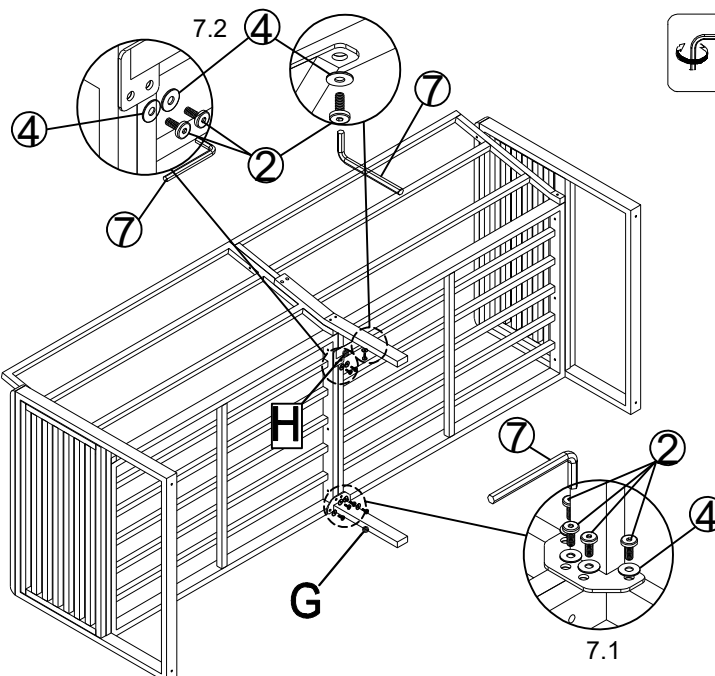
DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 6



With assistance from your adult partner, attach the Back Leg (F) to Backrest Panels by using Bolts (①), Washers (④) with Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown above
DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 7



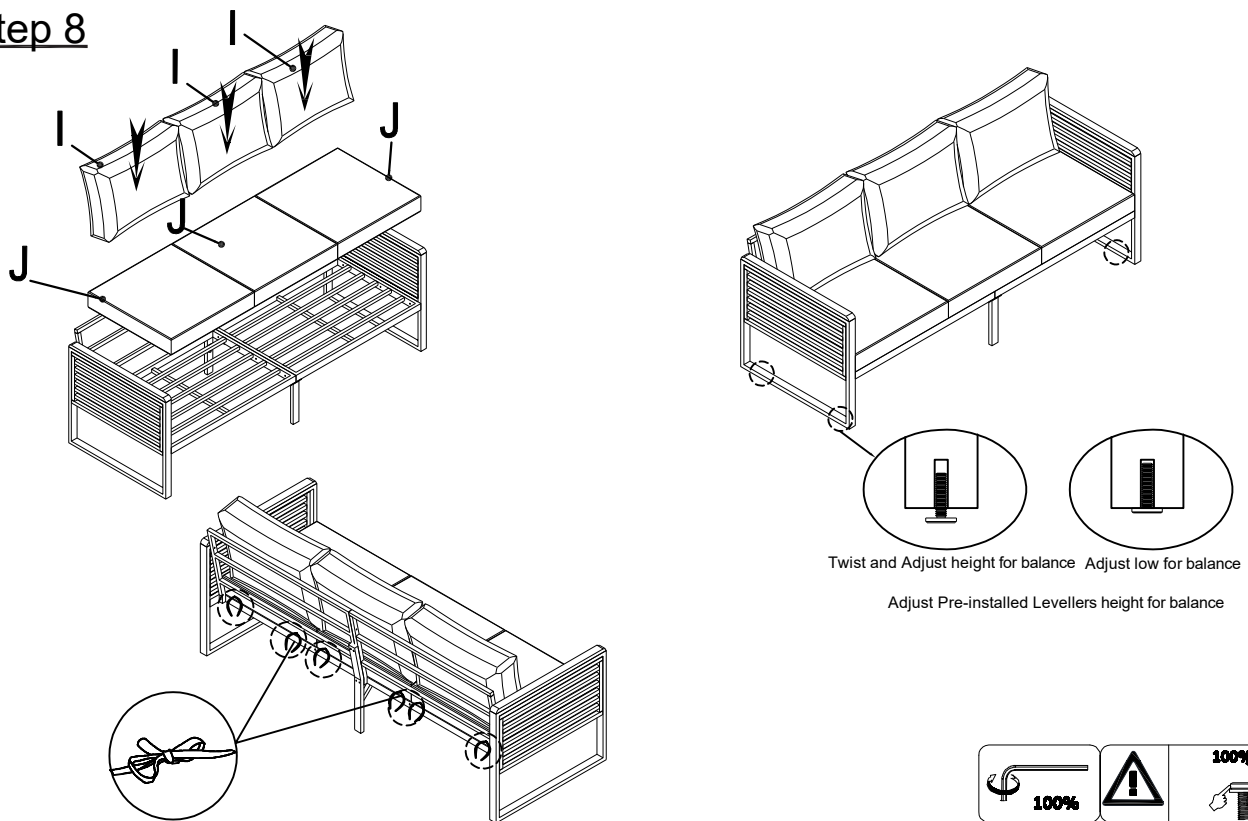
With assistance from your adult partner:

6.1 attach the Front Leg (G) to Seat Panel (C) by using Bolts (②), Washers (④) with Allen Wrench (⑦)

6.2: attach Support Bar (H) to Seat Panel (C) and Back Leg (D) by using Bolts (②), Washers (④) with Allen Wrench (⑦)

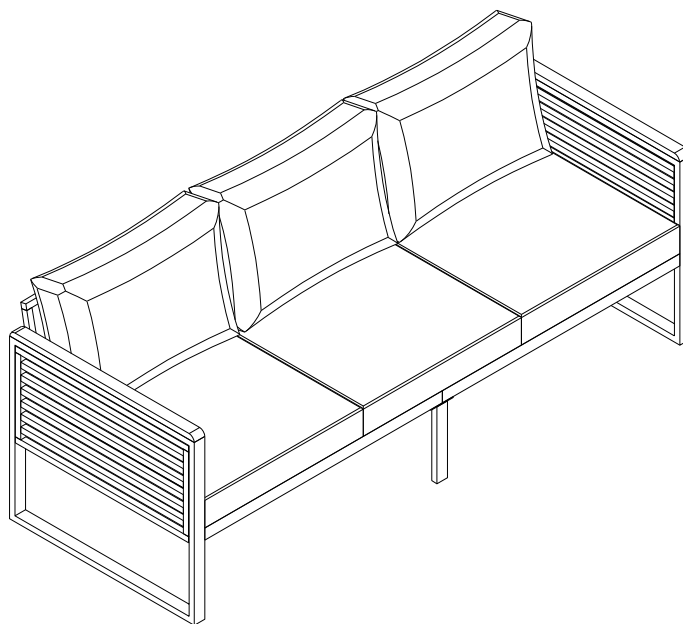
DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 8



With assistance from your adult partners, turn the Chair back to normal flat ground.
Place the Seat Cushion (J) and the Backrest Pillow (I) onto the Chair as shown above.
Place the Bench on a LEVEL surface.
Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.
Gently and gracefully, sit onto the Bench. This pressure will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.
Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface. If no wobbles are found, proceed to tighten the Bolts in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.
Adjust the Levelers until the Bench is level with the ground.
To adjust the Levelers, get assistance from an adult partner to lift/lean and hold the Bench while you are working.

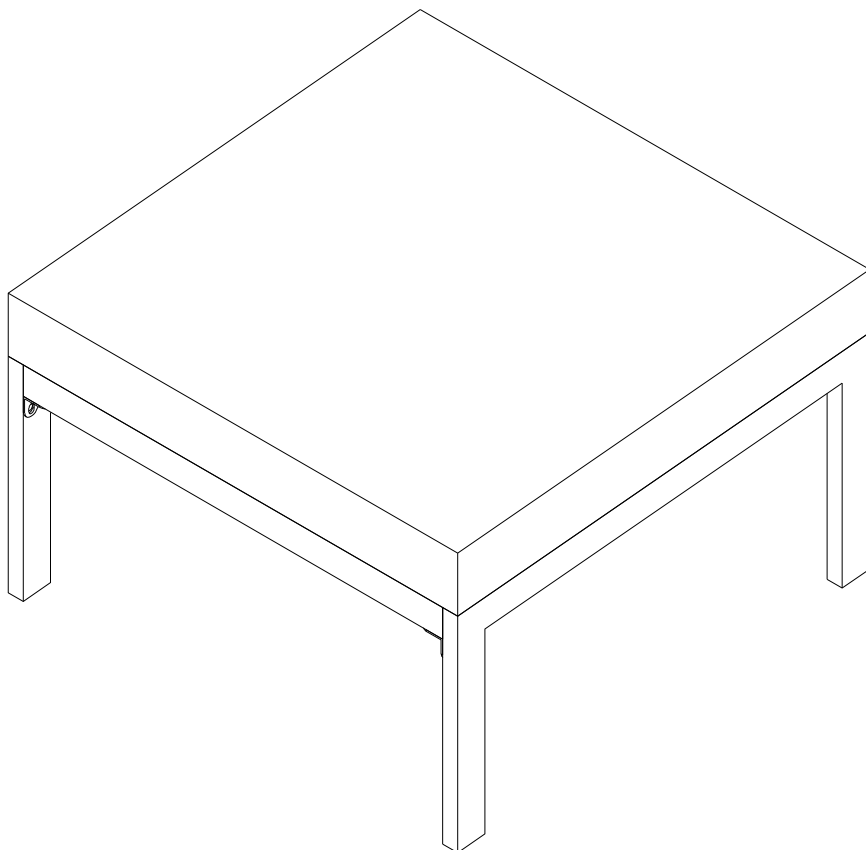
Step 9

This sofa-bench can only be used on a flat, level surface.

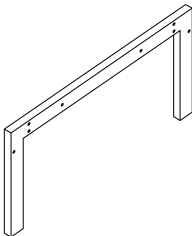
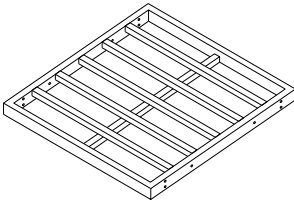
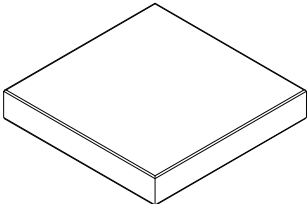
SOFA - STOOL

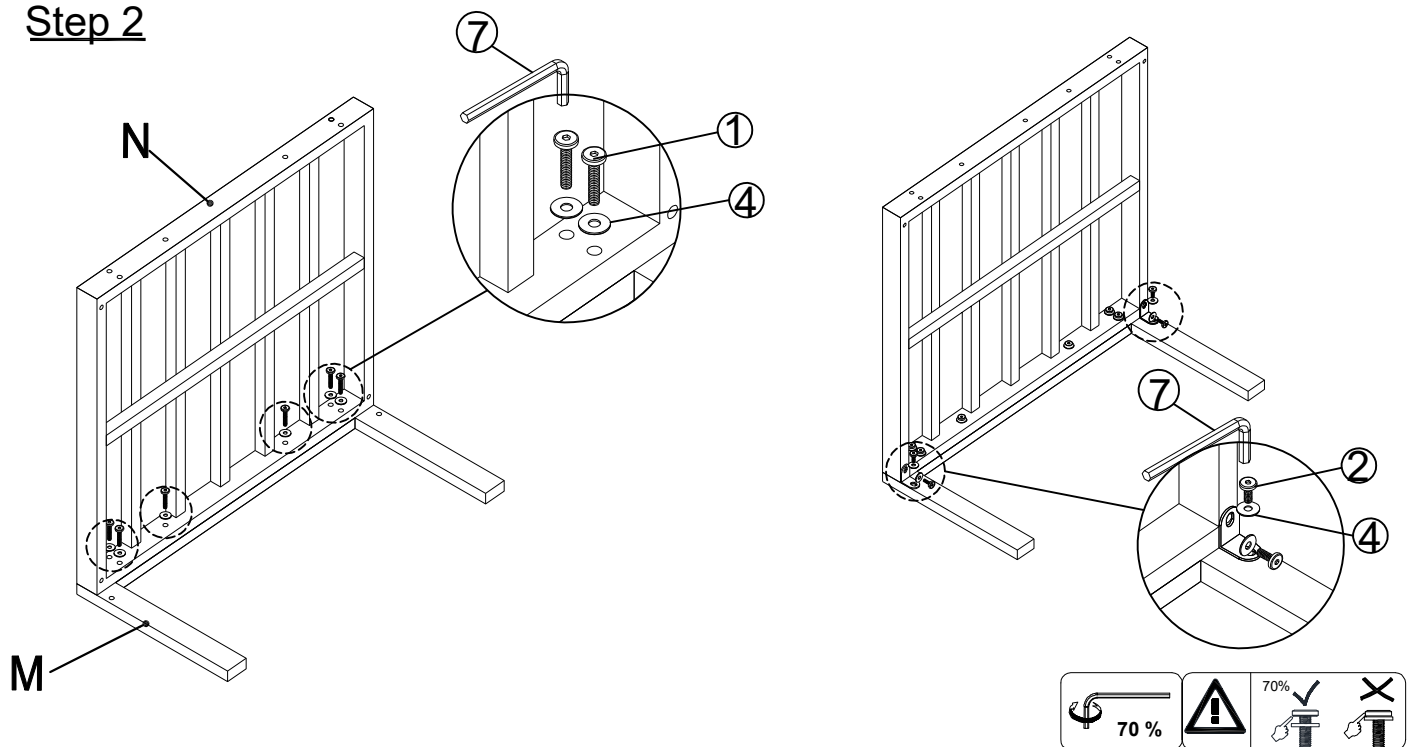
This Stool has multiple parts and may require up to some 15 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Stool parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non -marring surface.

Step 2



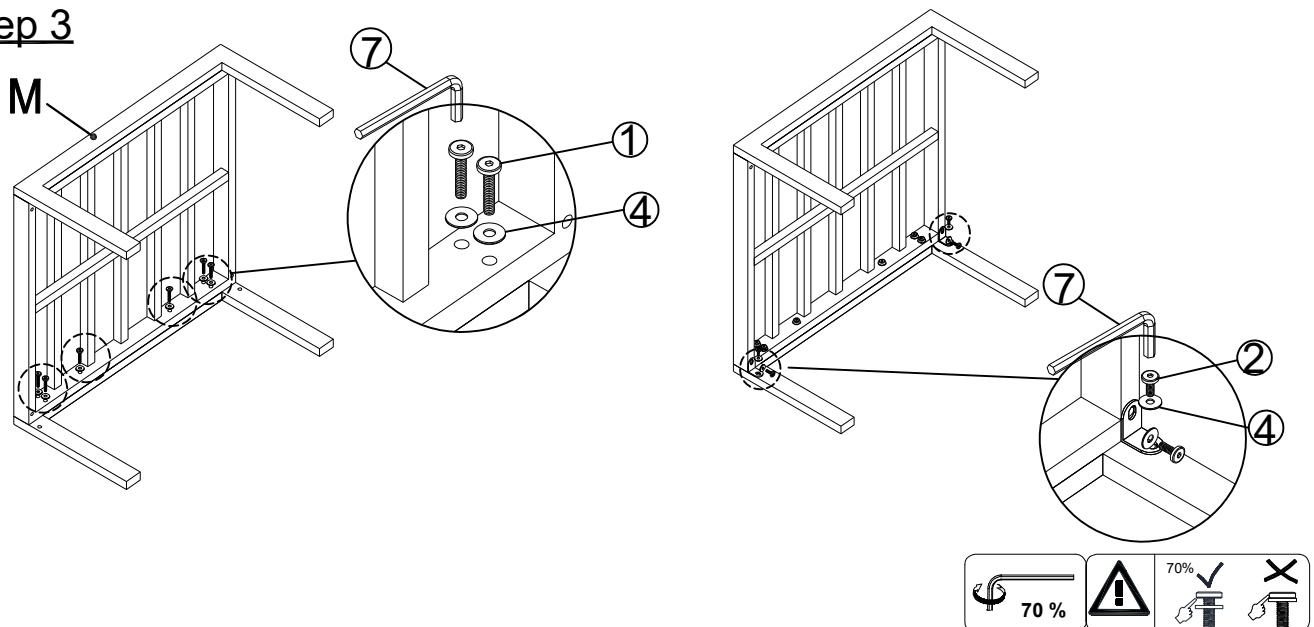
With assistance from your adult partner, place Leg Panels (M) onto a clean, non marring surface, then

2.1 attach the Seat Panel (N) to Leg Panels (M) by using Bolts (1), Washers (4) with Allen Wrench (7) as shown above.

2.2 secure Leg Panels (M) and Seat Panel (N) by using L bracket 8, Bolt (2), Washers (4) with Allen Wrench (7) as shown above.

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 3



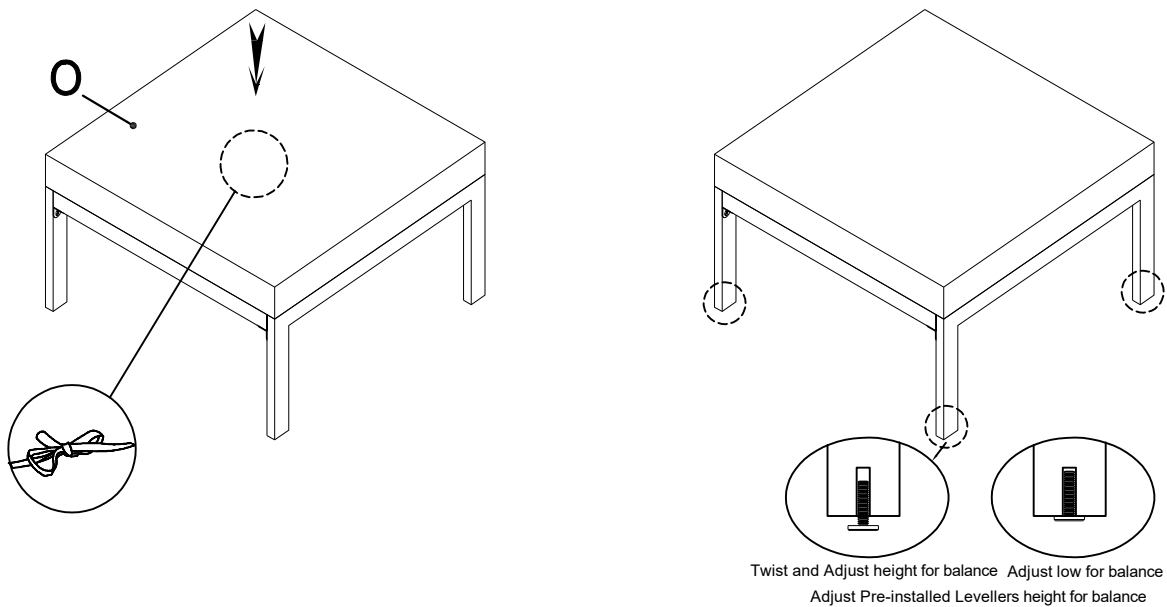
With assistance from your adult partner:

3.1 attach the assembled frame in step 2 to Leg Panel (M) by using Bolts (1), Washers (4) with Allen Wrench (7) as shown above.

2.2 secure Leg Panels (M) and Seat Panel (N) by using L bracket 8, Bolt (2), Washers (4) with Allen Wrench (7) as shown above.

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

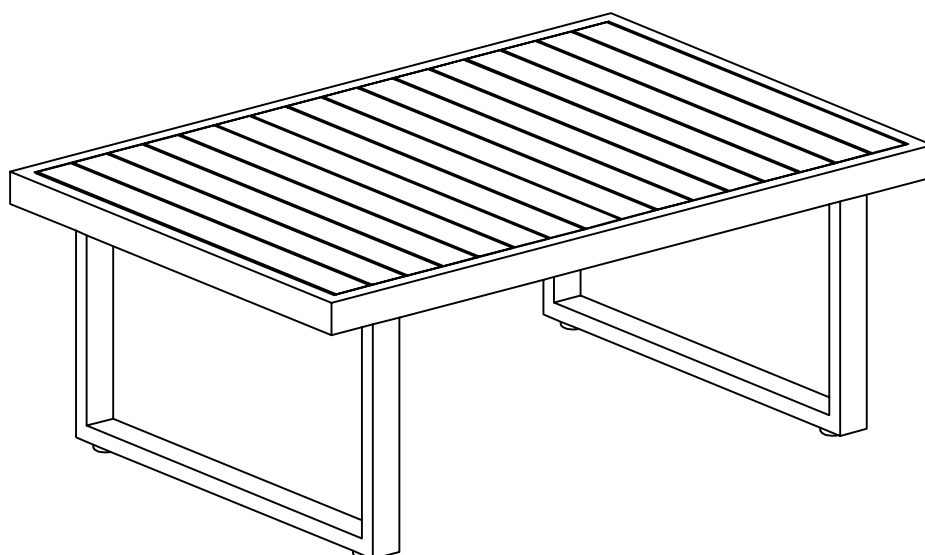
Step 4



Place the Seat Cushion (O) onto the Stool as shown above.
Place the Stool on a LEVEL surface.
Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.
Gently and gracefully, sit onto the Stool. This pressure will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.
Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface. If no wobbles are found, proceed to tighten the Bolts in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.
Adjust the Levelers until the Chair is level with the ground.
To adjust the Levelers, get assistance from an adult partner to lift/lean and hold the Chair while you are working

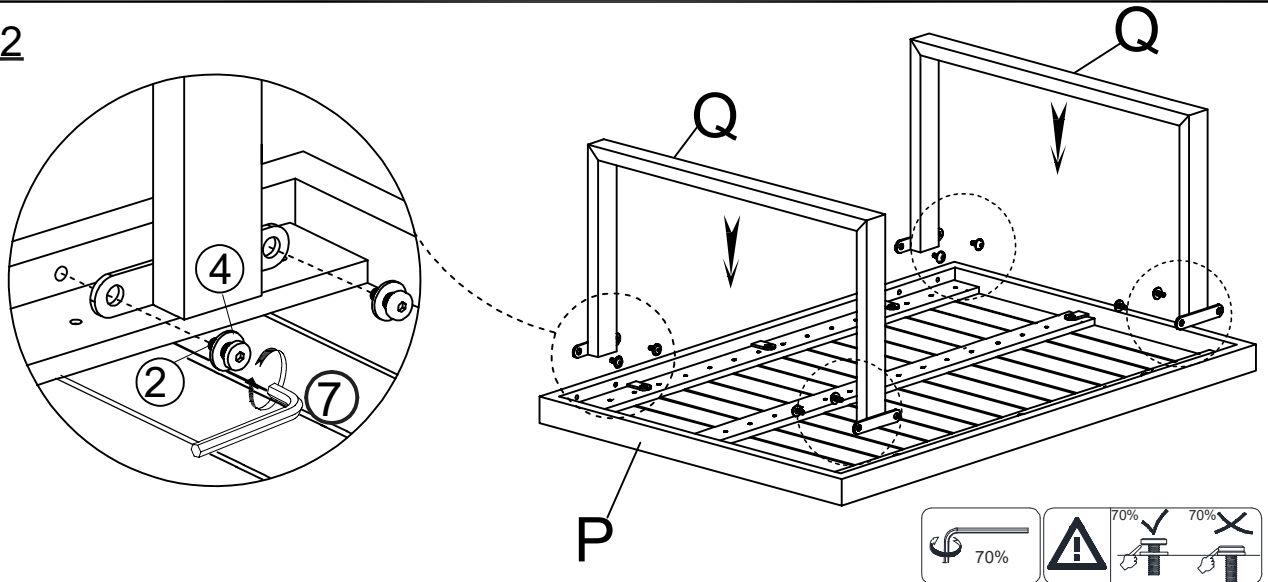
This Table has multiple parts and may require up to some 10 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



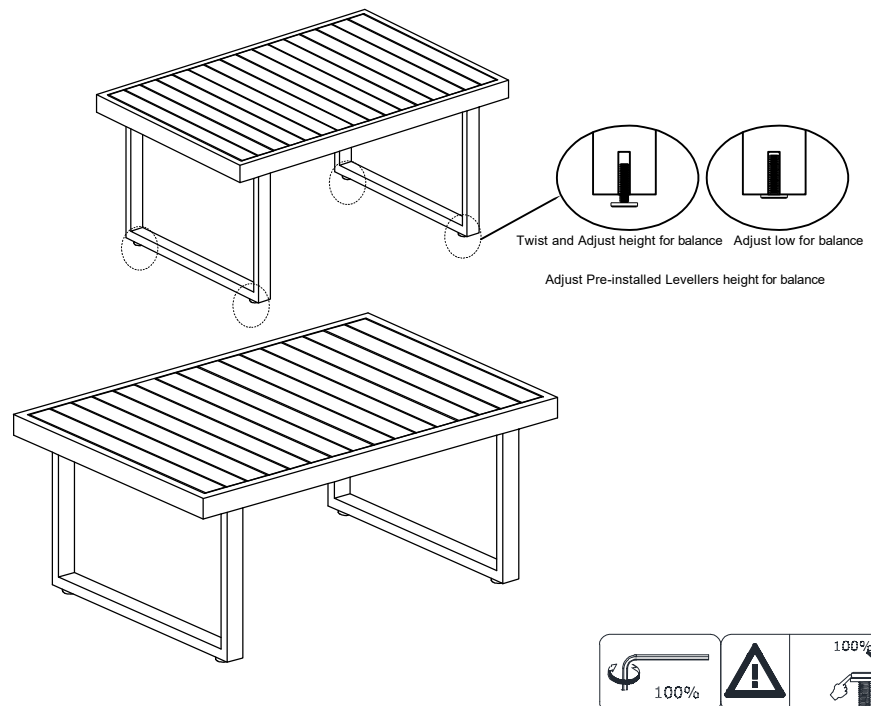
Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non -marring surface.

Step 2



With assistance from your adult partner, place the Table Top (P) facedown onto a clean, nonmarring surface, attach Leg Panel (Q) to Table top (P) by using the Bolt ②, Washers (④) with Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown above. Repeat the same process with the remaining leg. **DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.**

Step 3



Turn the Table right side up.

Place the table onto a flat level surface.

Then Exert pressure onto the table with both hands follow floorwards, this pressure will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.

Check for wobbles on a Level surface.

If no wobbles are found, in a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Bolts at all joints until evenly secured.

Inspect the table and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Your table is ready for use.

This table can only be used on a flat, level surface.
