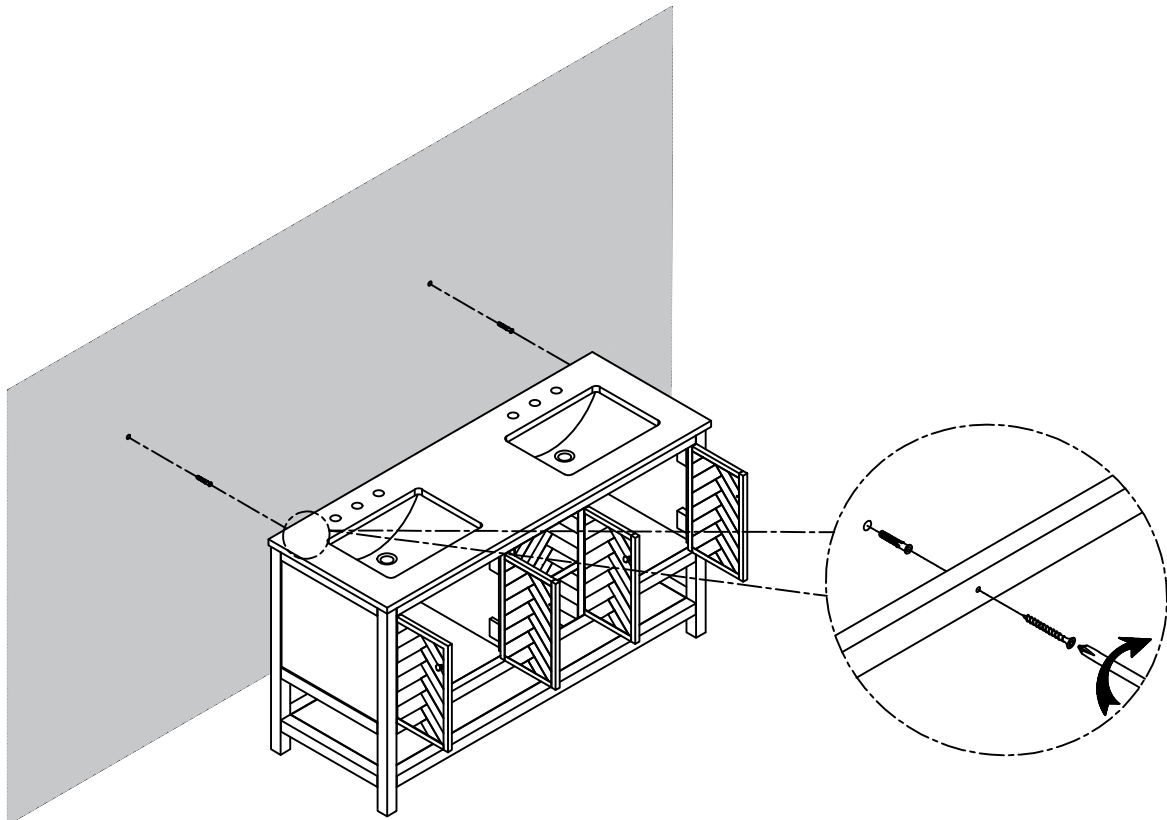
# Assembly Instructions

**Step 1. Adjust the vanity's height by rotating the adjustable leveler.**



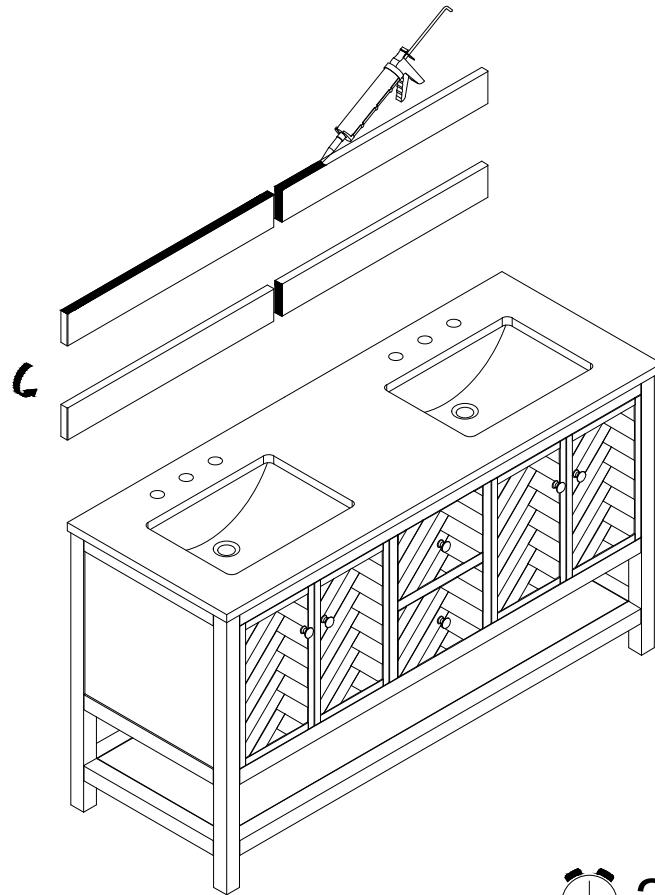
**Step 2. Mount the vanity to the wall (hardware not included in the package)**

If there are drawers on both sides of your vanity, remove the drawers by following the instructions in the **To remove the drawer** section before mounting the vanity on the wall.

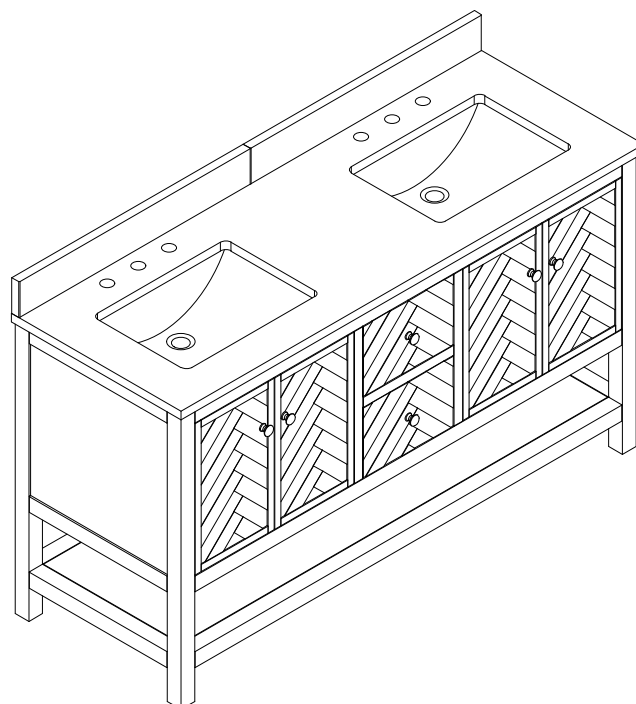

**Step 3. Secure the backsplash.**



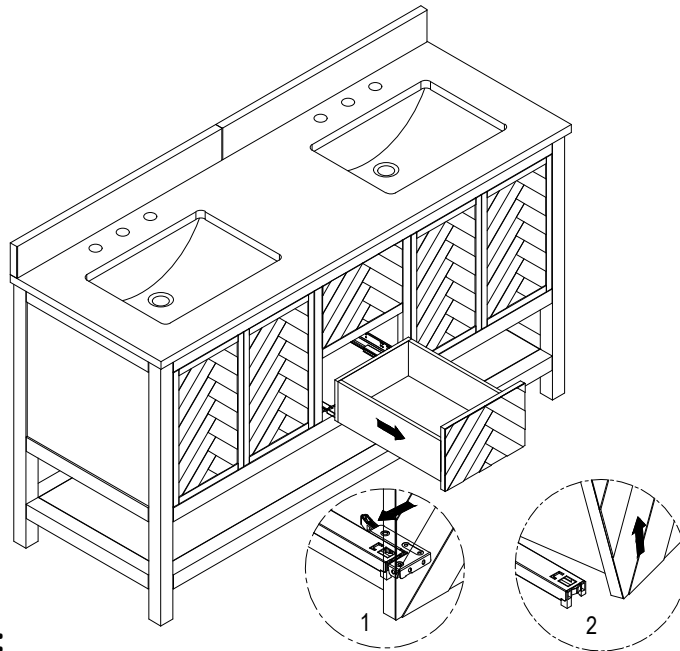

# Assembly Instructions

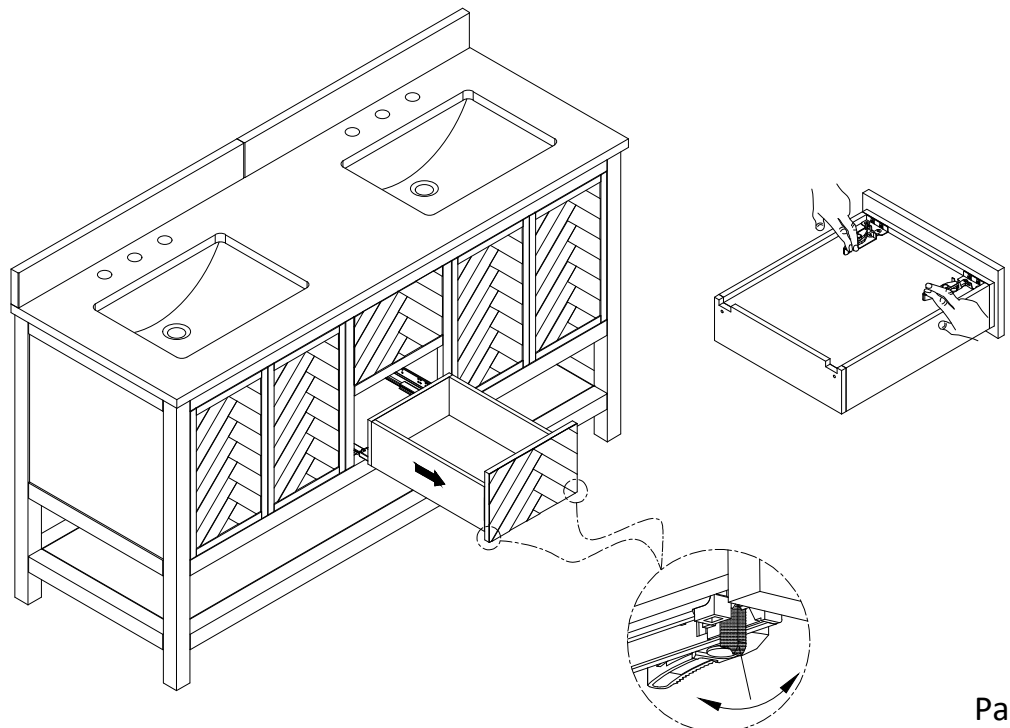
## To remove the drawer:

- Find the plastic clips on the left and right slides under the drawer.
- Press both clips at the same time, then lift the drawer upward slowly.
- Slide the drawer fully out to separate it from the metal slides.



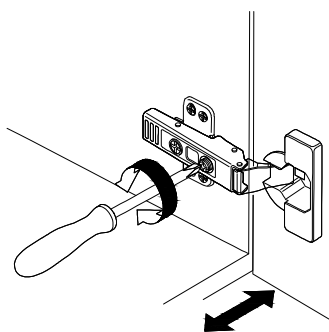
## To insert the drawer:

- Pull the drawer slides all the way out.
- Align the drawer with the hooks at the rear of the slides and set it in place carefully.
- Set the drawer down onto the fully extended slides.
- Push the drawer inward until it closes completely.

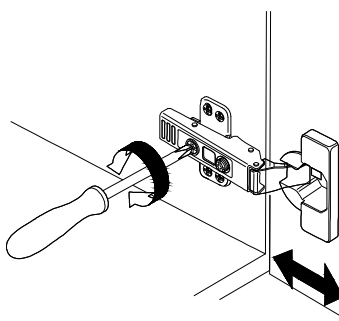

**To adjust the door:**

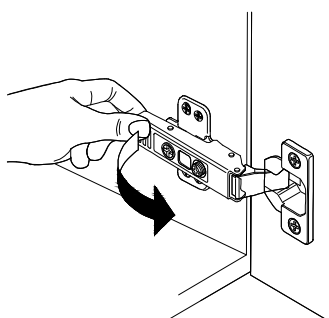


Adjust laterally

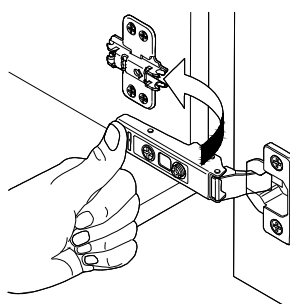


Adjust depth

# Vanity Care & Maintenance Guide

## Cabinet Care

- Wipe dust regularly with soft lint-free cloth. Use mild non-abrasive wood cleaner for painted surfaces, dry immediately after cleaning.
- Never use acetone, bleach, ammonia, vinegar or abrasive cleaners, which cause discoloration and paint peeling.
- Keep cabinet away from direct sunlight to avoid fading. Ventilate bathroom fully to reduce humidity and prevent wood warping.
- Clean spills instantly to stop moisture seeping into wood. Keep hot styling tools away from cabinet surface.

## Stone Countertop Care

- Blot all spills right away, especially oil & acidic drinks (coffee, juice). Do not leave liquid overnight.
- Clean only with neutral soap water or stone-specific cleaner. Avoid acid, lemon, vinegar, bleach and rough scrubbers.
- Always use coasters/mats under toiletries. Do not place hot hair tools directly on stone. Do not stand or sit on countertop to avoid cracks.

## General Tips

- Maintain good bathroom ventilation to lower moisture.
- Wipe all chemical residues from soap, facial cleansers completely after use.
- Contact local stone shop for irreversible stone damage.
