

Thank you for your purchase of our special hand-blown glass chandelier which is uniquely designed.

Be careful when opening the packages with a blade not to cut any wires.

Glass should be handled gently and with care.

Installation to be done by licensed electrician.

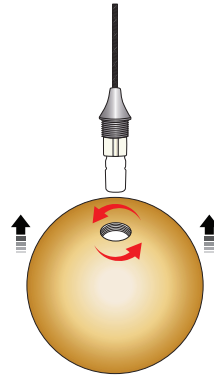
WARNING: When installing the glass make sure it does not collide together with the other glass pieces installed.

Attach glass to sockets by screwing them on gently. Do not put pressure or squeeze the glass.

Bulbs: Bulbs are supplied with chandelier. Make sure you use G9 / LED / DIM / 2700K – 3000K bulbs. Halogen bulbs up to 40 Watts each can be used in the chandelier.

Your chandelier is built to work with both LED & Halogen bulbs up to 40 watts per bulb. The bulbs installed are G9 / LED / DIMMABLE and can be found in online stores like Amazon, Home Depot, Lowes & many other lighting stores.

Dimming: Chandelier is supplied with LED dimmable bulbs which dim up to 25%. Bulbs work with most Triac 120V dimmers. The dimmers that the bulbs were tested on are the Lutron Maestro LED + CFL dimmers & Skylark dimmer. The dimmers were trimmed on the low-end side until flickering stabled. Some LED bulbs require a higher low-end trim than others. This feature will eliminate flickering and strobing when the dimmer is turned ON to its lowest settings. DO NOT USE ELV DIMMERS (will cause the circuits in the LED bulbs to fail)



Glass

The glass on your chandelier is hand-blown by our talented artisans. All the pieces are unique as they are not made by mold.

Colored glass is made by fire and when the clear glass and colors melt together, air is then blown into it by mouth, which stretches the glass with the color. This is not film but the natural texture of the glass with the color stretched.

It is Hand made so each glass will have a different texture with the colors. This glass cannot be made by machine which will give you an identical pattern.

Cleaning:

Simple dusting is enough for the day-to-day upkeep of your chandelier. Do not use any chemicals or sprays to clean your Glass Chandelier as this may damage the glass. Do not use a dishwasher to clean the glass.

To clean the glass it is best if you use a dry clean micro fiber cloth for the outside.

For the inside you can use a cotton tip type of wire rod. The cotton tip bristles are just to wipe off like a finger smear on the glass.

Changing the light bulb:

1. Unthread the glass shade from the socket assembly while holding the socket stationary. Do not allow the socket assembly to twist. Pull out the bulb while holding the socket.

2. Replace the light bulb in the threaded socket by pushing the bulb upwards to click into position.

3. Re-install the glass shade by threading it onto the socket.
