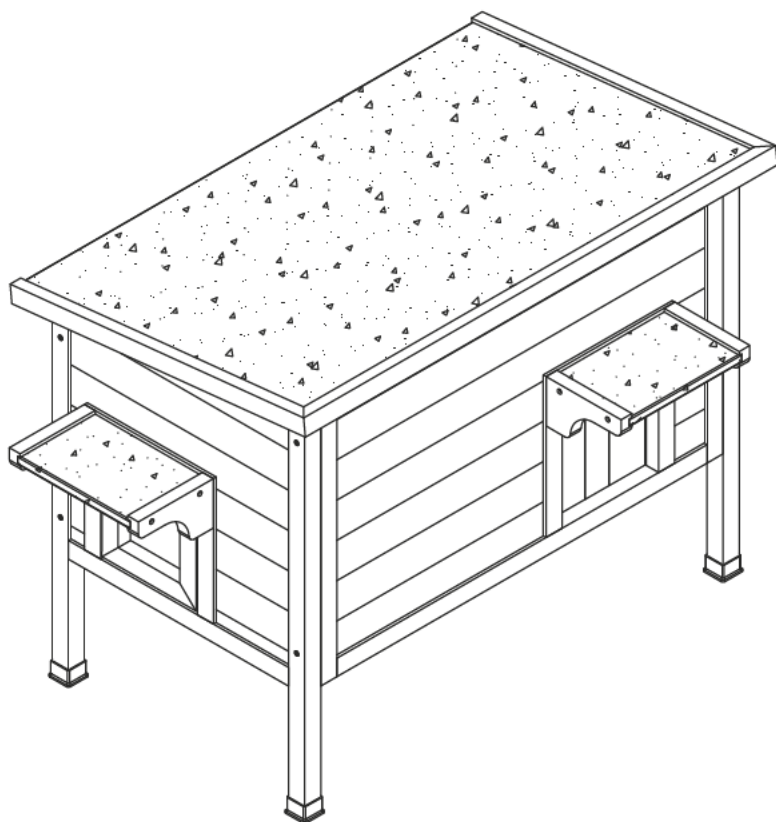


HEATED OUTDOOR CAT HOUSE

- Item identification: For ease of identification, all parts are labeled to correspond to the step number in which the part is used.

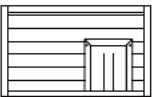
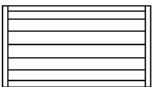
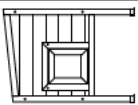
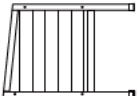

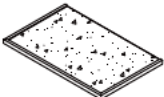
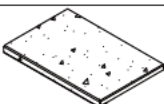
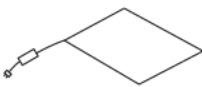
- Please read following instructions carefully before using the cat house.
- Be aware that some parts are heavy and have sharp edges.
- Do not overtighten screws (Insert all screws before tighten screws).
- Firmly secure all bolts, screws and nuts before use.
- Please do not exceed the weight limitations of this item.
- Reconfirm that all bolts, screws, and nuts are secure every 90 days.

CARE & SAFETY

- **Regular Inspection:** Regularly inspect the cat house to ensure it remains in good condition. Check for any signs of damage, wear, or deterioration that could compromise the cat's safety or comfort. Make any necessary repairs promptly.
- **Cleanliness:** Keep the cat house clean to maintain a healthy environment. Remove any debris, leaves, or dirt that may accumulate inside or around the structure. Regularly clean the bedding to prevent the buildup of dirt, parasites, or bacteria.
