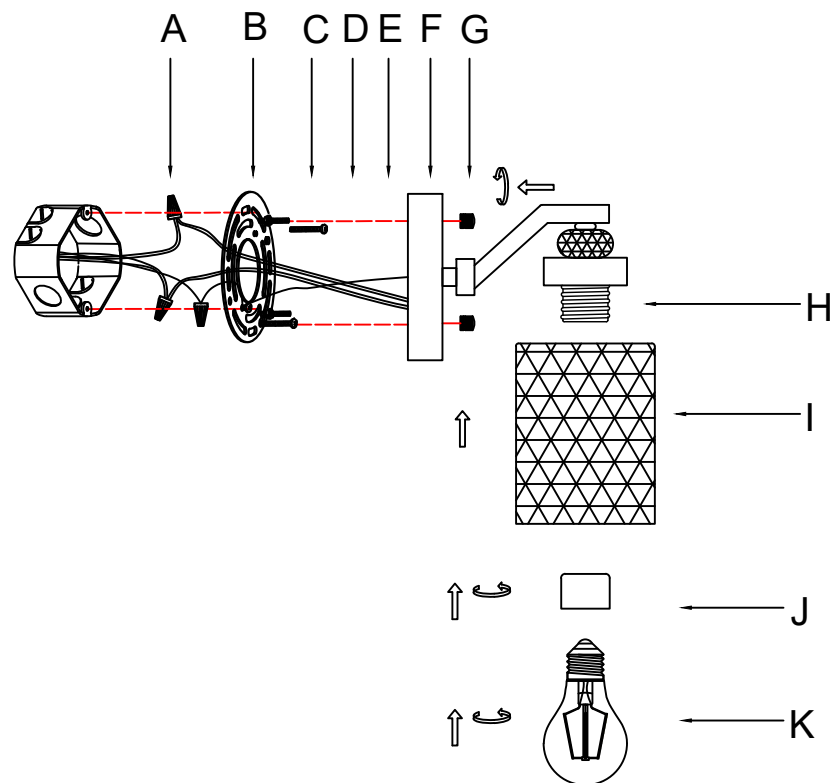
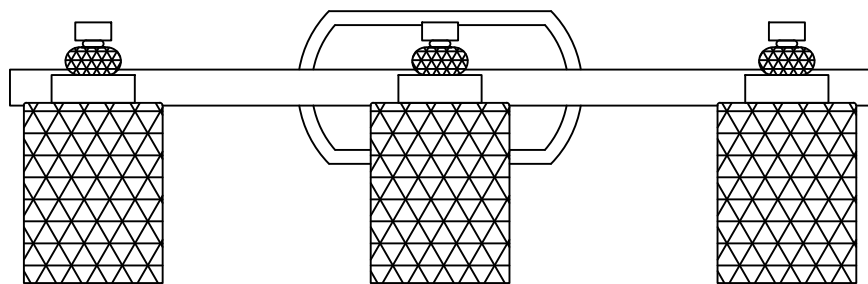


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Turn off the power at the circuit breaker.
 2. Secure the mounting bracket (B) to the junction box using the screws (C).
 3. Connect the fixture wires (D) to the house wires using wire nuts (A): Line (Hot) to Line (Hot), Neutral to Neutral. Secure the fixture ground wire (E) to the bracket with the green grounding screw, then connect it to the house ground wire using a wire nut (A).
 4. Secure the fixture backplate (F) to the mounting bracket (B) using the finial (G).
 5. Secure the lampshade (I) onto the socket (H) using the retaining ring (J).
 6. Install the bulb (K) into the socket (H) (bulb not included).
 7. Restore power and test the fixture.
- Installation complete.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
