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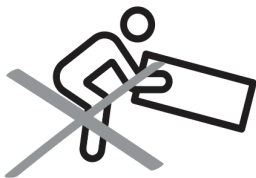
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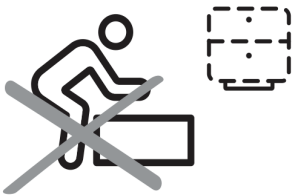
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Avoid Scratches

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

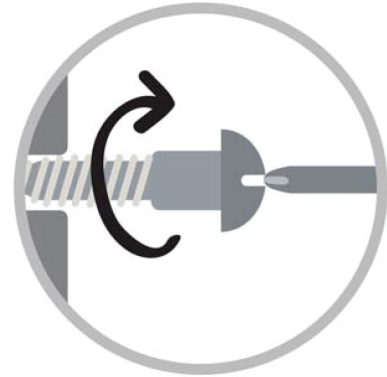

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Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes.



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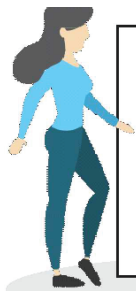
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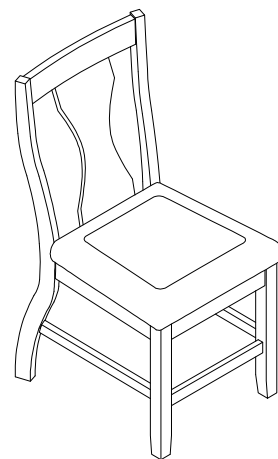

1. Prepare 4 bolt assemblies by first inserting a lock washer (D) onto the bolt (A) then a flat washer (E) onto that same bolt (A).

Prepare 2 bolt assemblies by first inserting a lock washer (D) onto the bolt (C) then a flat washer (E) onto that same bolt (C).



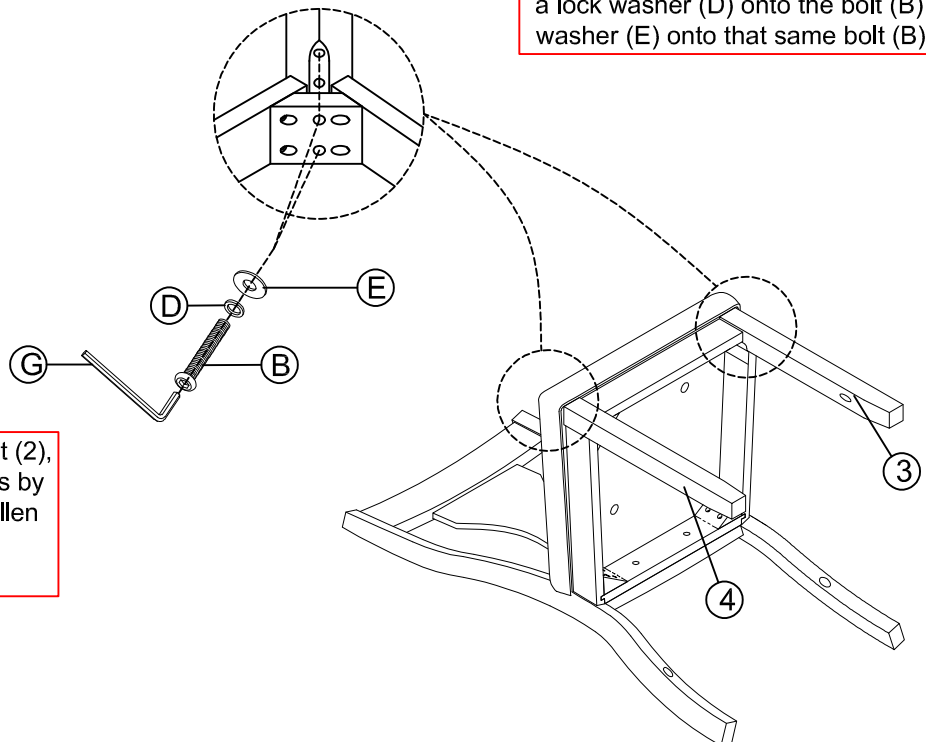
3. Assemble the seat and the back chair by bolt (A) with washer (D),(E) using Allen wrench (G)
* Do not tighten the bolts

2. Align wooden dowel of the seat (2) to the back chair (1), then assemble the seat and the back chair by bolt (C) with washer (D),(E) using Allen wrench (G)
* Do not tighten the bolts

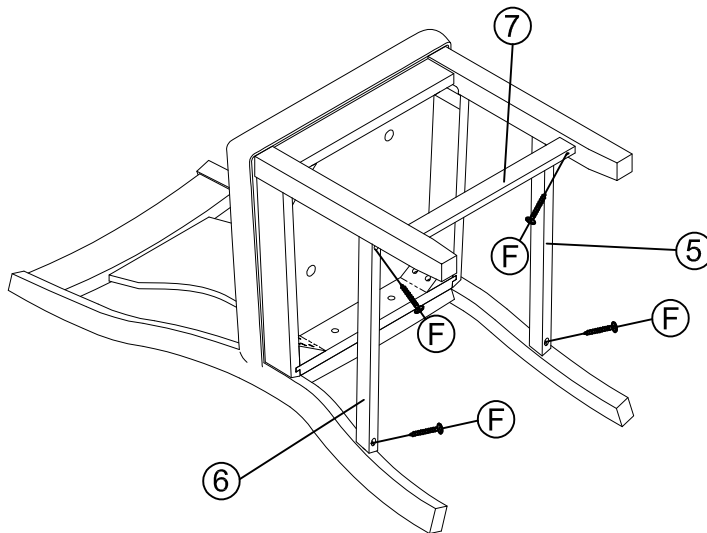

* Do not tighten the bolts

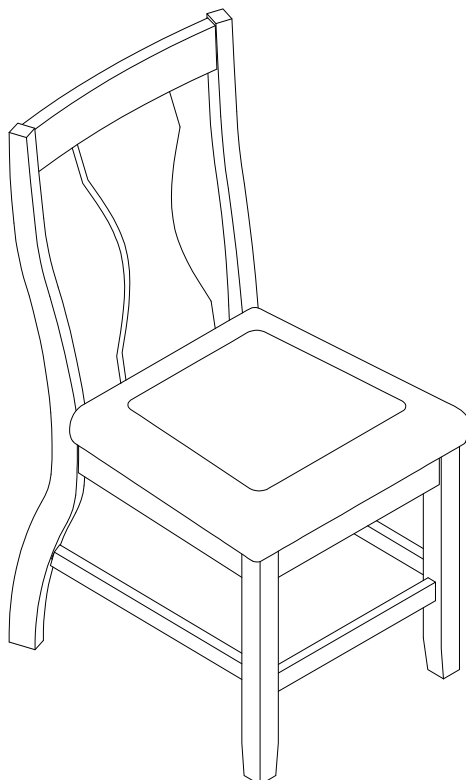

- Hardware ① x 6pcs

1. Prepare 6 screw (F)
2. Place right, left stretcher (5), (6) to middle the back legs and front leg, front stretcher (7) to middle the front legs, then assemble the stretchers and the legs by screw (F) using screwdriver.
* Do not tighten the screw

- To level the chair, stand the chair up on a flat surface and tighten all the bolts by using Allen Wrench (G) and tighten all the screws by using a screwdriver.
