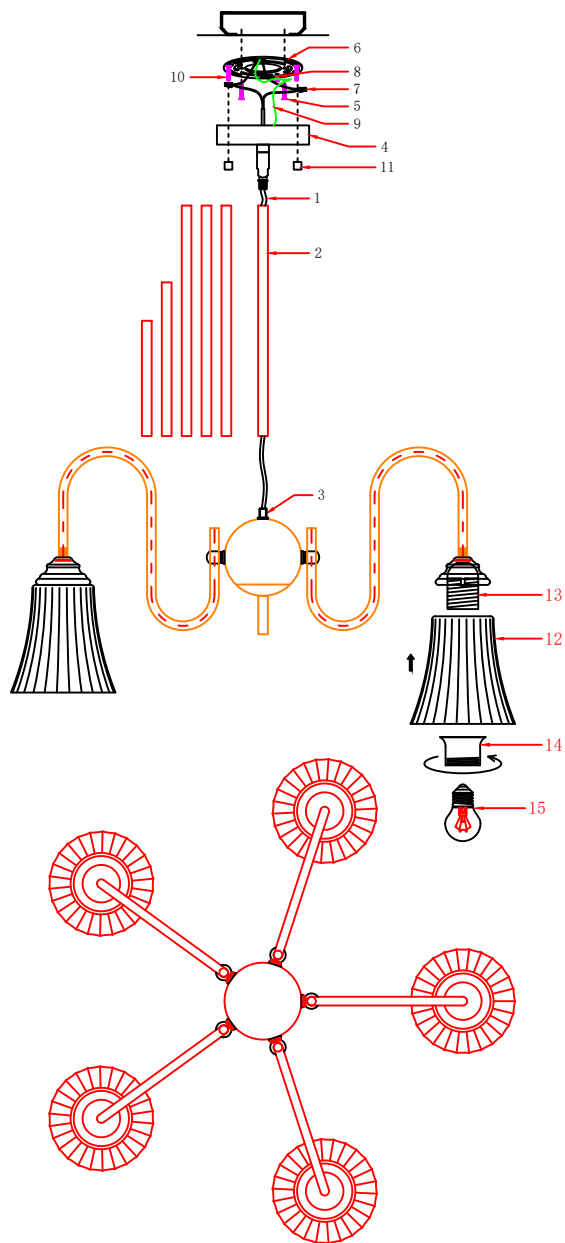


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Thread the main cord (1) through the required number of metal tubes (2) for height adjustment. Connect the assembly to the main body (3), then thread the cord through the canopy (4) and secure it to the threaded nipple (2).
2. Secure the mounting bracket (6) to the junction box using the junction box screws (5).
3. Wiring Connections
 - Use wire connectors (7) to connect the fixture's positive wire, negative wire to the corresponding wires from the junction box.
 - Secure the fixture ground wire (9) and supply ground wire to the mounting bracket (6) using the green grounding screw (8).
 - Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
4. Place the canopy (4) over the mounting bracket, passing the mounting studs (10) through its holes. Secure the canopy by tightening the decorative nuts (11).
5. Position the glass shade (12) over the socket (13) and secure it by tightening the locking ring (14).
6. Install the light bulb (15) into the socket (13) (bulb not included). Do not exceed maximum wattage.
7. Restore power and test operation.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
