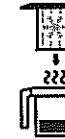

Directions



1. Pour up to 16 oz. of liquid (max fill line) into the Coldwave pitcher.



2. Remove Insert from freezer and place into the pitcher.



3. Chill beverage until cold, pour and enjoy!

Exact cooling times vary depending on initial temperature.

FAQs

Q. How many times can I use the Coldwave before it needs to be refrozen?

A. It all depends on the incoming beverage temperature, so use these guidelines:

Hot: Two 16 oz. coolings

Warm: Eight 16 oz. coolings

Q. How long can I leave the Coldwave out before it no longer works?

A. The Coldwave's cooling ability decreases with time. After 10 min, there is no noticeable effect. After 4 hrs, the Coldwave will not cool.

Q. Can the Coldwave cool carbonated drinks?

A. YES! For best results, chill 16 oz. of cold water for 10 sec. to take the initial cooling off the Coldwave.
