Well, the wonderful show comes from the **BUMMULO**, an ancient jar that contained water or wine and which today, thanks to Artefice Atelier, also lives on as a design object.

Colorful, original, cheerful, it certainly winks at the so-called "utilitarian" collectors, that is, the collector who seeks beauty in everyday life and who appreciates the practical and domestic objects necessary for everyday life. The utilitarian perceives the pure simplicity of function and form. This is the case of the **BUMMULO** signed by Artefice Atelier: appreciating its quality design, we also understand the charm of the useful and the everyday.

Group them in close proximity in your kitchen, where you can admire the material and the richness of the decorations (strictly handmade). The collection thus becomes a short treatise on the art of Sicilian ceramics and the Bummolos thus exhibited bring us back to the love for simple objects, as witnesses of rediscovered artisan skills.
