

# Use & Care Guide

The below use and care instructions are meant as a guide to extend the life of your table.

## **Use Instructions for your MgO Table:**

Place the table on flat ground or surface. It is better if the table's base is not exposed directly to continuous moisture.

## **Special consideration for tables crafted from magnesium oxide material:**

- It is best if the table is protected from rain and snow. Either place it in a covered area or place a tarp over the table during rainy or snowy weather. It is also best if the table is not left in standing water or snow for long periods.
- During extreme winter conditions, we recommend moving your table to a sheltered, dry location to help prevent damage to it.

## **Care Instructions for your Care:**

### **Items you need:**

Water, soft wash cloth

If temperatures are near or below freezing, do not attempt to clean the table. Magnesium oxide absorbs moisture and may crack while it expands.

Start by gently rinsing the table with a sprayer nozzle attached to a garden hose.

Do not use a power washer. The forceful spray may damage the table, especially if it is small or painted.

Once you have rinsed off the largest debris and grime, use a soft cloth to wipe off any residue or dirt. Gently rinse the table and either wipe dry with a soft, dry cloth or allow to air dry.

The outdoors can be a harsh place for outdoor furniture, especially in some locations and seasons. Therefore, special precautions should be taken to protect the patio's focal points and extend their pristine appearance as long as possible.

**Special note:** It is best to place in an area with the least amount of contact with water.

Using a water sealer designed for concrete or masonry on tables that will be placed outside is a good idea. This can be done once a year for all tables.

Following directions when applying a water sealer to tables is very important. Sunny days offer the best weather conditions for drying the table once it has been sealed with the water sealer. Moreover, it is essential to wash the table before sealing to remove any particles of dust, dirt, or grime.

Because magnesium oxide (MgO) is a porous material, it makes a versatile material that can withstand most extreme weather conditions.

**Special note:** Excluding long periods of rain, snow, or freezing temperatures

However, to extend the life of your table, we recommend taking additional care during the winter and rainy seasons. The table may erode if left too long in the snow or standing water.

It is recommended that the MgO tables should be placed on a paving stone, concrete block, or concrete pavement to protect them from the harsher elements of the soil and ground. Our tables are durable, but a bit of help from human hands cannot hurt.
