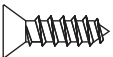
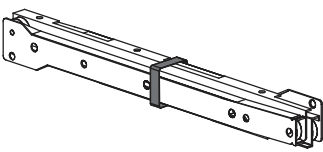
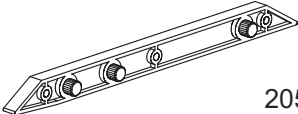
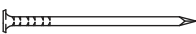
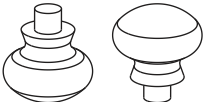
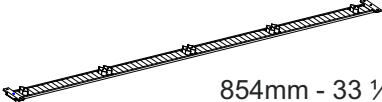
Assembly Tips
