4-TIER LARGE CAPACITY BLACK METAL BOOT & SHOE STORAGE RACK

Safety Precautions & Guidelines

- Read all instructions carefully before starting the assembly process.
- Ensure all small parts and hardware are kept away from children during assembly.
- Place the rack on a flat, even floor surface to guarantee structural stability.
- Do not exceed the weight capacity of individual shelves or top boot organizers.

Step-by-Step Assembly Instructions

Step 1: Install Leveling Feet

Screw the four adjustable leveling feet **(G)** into the bottom holes of both side frames **(A)**. Hand-tighten them until secure. These can be adjusted later if your floor surface is uneven.

Step 2: Assemble the Bottom and Middle Mesh Shelves

Align the mesh wire shelf panels **(B)** with the pre-drilled holes on the lower tiers of the side frames **(A)**. Secure the shelves using the provided assembly screws **(F)** and hand-tighten halfway using the hex wrench.

Step 3: Attach the Top Crossbars

Position the two top crossbars **(C)** horizontally on the uppermost slot of the side frames **(A)**. Fasten them securely using screws **(F)**. Ensure that the pre-drilled vertical holes on the crossbars are facing upwards.

Step 4: Install the Tall and Short Boot Hanging Rods

Locate the pre-drilled holes on top of the crossbars. Screw the 4 long boot rods **(D - 16.53")** into the rear row of holes. Next, screw the 4 short boot rods **(E - 13.77")** into the front row of holes. Tighten them clockwise until fully locked into position.

Step 5: Final Inspection and Tightening

Ensure the entire rack structure is perfectly aligned and flat on the ground. Fully tighten all screws and hardware completely. Your 4-tier boot organizer is now fully assembled and ready for use.

Usage & Layout Advice

- **Top Tier (Boot Storage):** Designed for 4 pairs of tall boots. Place over-the-knee or riding boots on the taller rear rods (16.53") and mid-calf or ankle boots on the front rods (13.77") upside down to maintain shape.
- **Lower Tiers:** Store heels, flats, athletic sneakers, and dress shoes with up to 7.08 inches of vertical space available per tier.
