Proper care of our products

For daily care, we recommend the use of a simple damp cloth.

Please follow these care instructions to optimise the serviceable life of your furniture.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Wood is a living material, it can expand and contract due to varying degrees of humidity. Humidity
 levels in your home are very important. Furniture stored in rooms that are either too humid or
 too dry may crack. We recommend that you keep a humidity level between 40 and 60%. During the
 winter months, heating your home can help keeping humidity levels down.
- We recommend that you keep the furniture base on floors or tiling.
- Keep your furniture away from heat sources and don't place it directly into sunlight.
- Keep your furniture away from air conditioning/humidifier or any climate modifying device.
- When moving your furniture, make sure it is emptied first. You should always be with another person when moving your furniture, to avoid injuries and damages to your home. Displacement of furniture can cause damages to your floors and your furniture.
- To avoid staining your furniture, we recommend the use of placemats and coasters.
- For any liquid spill, we recommend that you immediately clean the surface with a cloth until it is completely dry.
- To avoid local discoloration, you should move items resting on your furniture, especially during the first year after purchase,.
- To avoid damaging your floors, we recommend that you use felt pads at the bottom/on the legs of your furniture.
- New furniture can sometimes emit odors during 1-2 weeks after purchase. You can attenuate this process by opening windows to ventilate the room.
- Our furniture is not conceived for outdoor or commercial use. Any such use will void your warranty.
