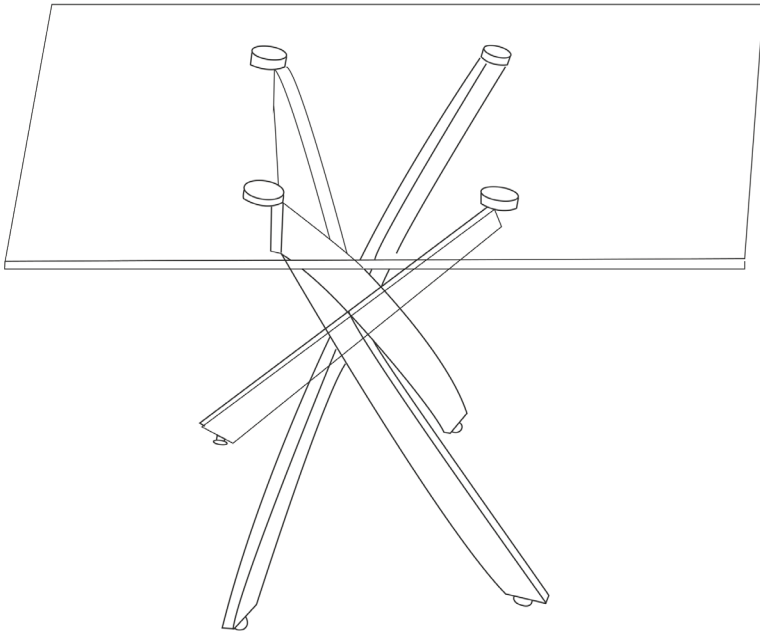


# ASSEMBLY GUIDE

### **NO POWER TOOLS**

#### **SAFETY AND CARE ADVICE**

- Check you have all the components and tools listed.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- We do not recommend the use of power drills/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers and Allen keys.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could cause choking if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Do not overtighten the nuts to avoid causing damage to the threads.
- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre

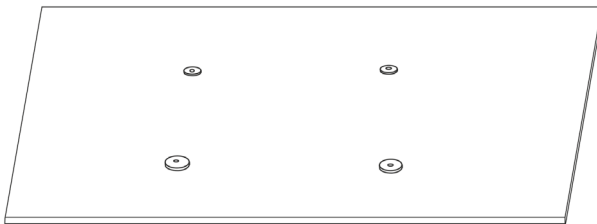

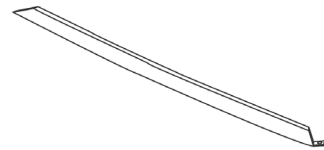







TableTop

TableLegs

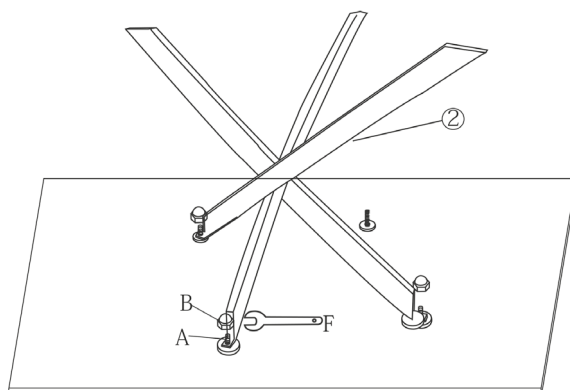
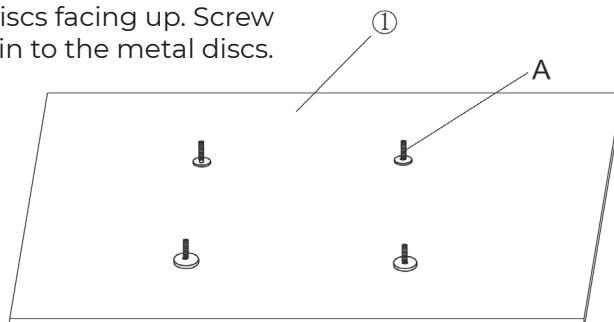

**NOTE:** The quantities above are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.

## STEP 1

Use a clear, flat, soft surface to avoid bumps or scratches. Place the table top on the floor with the metal discs facing up. Screw 4 x rods [A] in to the metal discs.



## STEP 2

Place the table legs over the rods on to the metal discs.

Use 4 x nuts [B] to secure table legs to table top.

Repeat for all 4 table legs.

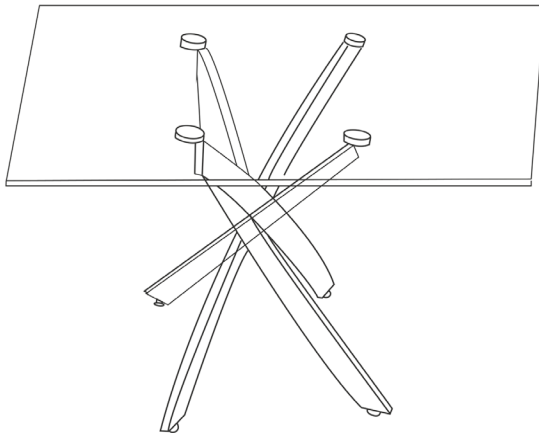
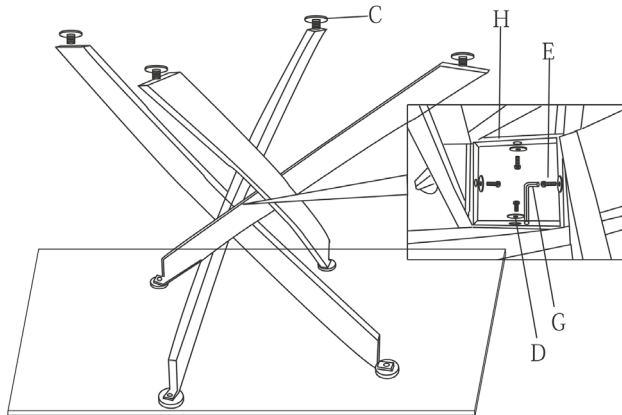
**ATTENTION:** Be careful not to fully tighten fixings yet.

### STEP 3

Add feet [C] to bottoms of table legs.

Connect all four legs together in the middle using the connecting piece [H], washers [D] screws [E]. Tighten with Allen key [G].

Once connecting piece [H] is secured, you can then tighten all the table legs to the table top with wrench [F].



### STEP 4

**ATTENTION:** With help carefully, and with help, turn your completed table over so it's now the correct way up. Ensure stability.
