

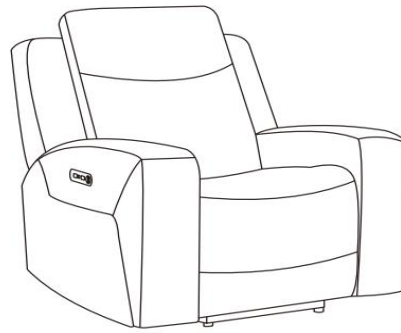

Power Recliner with Power Headrest

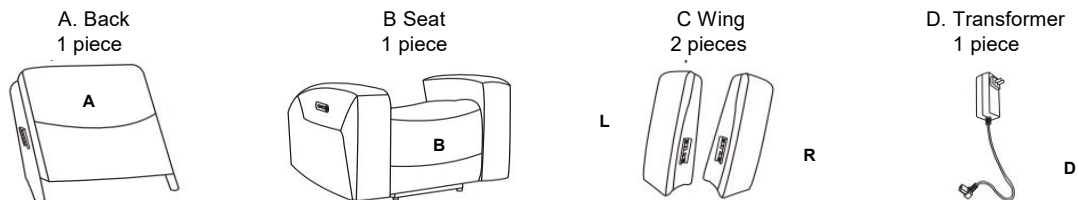
IMPORTANT NOTE

Read these instructions carefully, and familiarize yourself with each procedure before assembling the furniture. Check that you have all the component parts, and familiarize yourself with each part before proceeding.

Take all the fittings out of the plastic bag and separate them into groups. Ensure you have enough space to lay out all the parts before assembly. To prevent damage to the parts, we recommend that you assemble the unit on a soft, level surface.

Assembly Instructions

STEP 1

Detach the transformer (D) from the bottom of the Seat (B) and the wings (L/R) from the bottom of the armrests (See Figure 1)

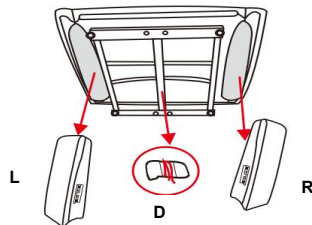

STEP 2

Attach the Back (A) to the Seat (B). Then attach the Wings (L/R) to Back (A). Ensure the latches fit well. (See Figure 2)

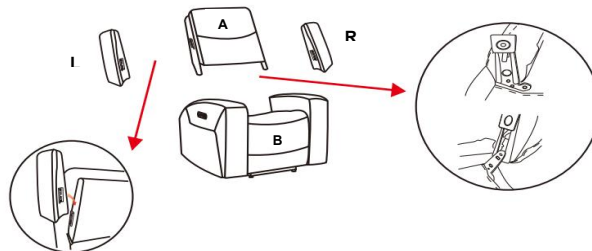

STEP 3

Zip the black fabric on bottom of Back (A) with back of Seat (B). (See Figure 3)

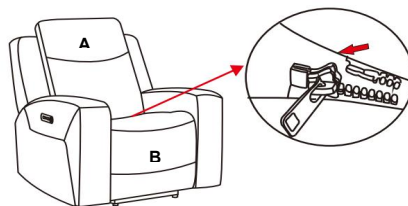

STEP 4

Flip up the back flap, connect the headrest cable to the power button control cable and place them behind the flap. (See Figure 4)

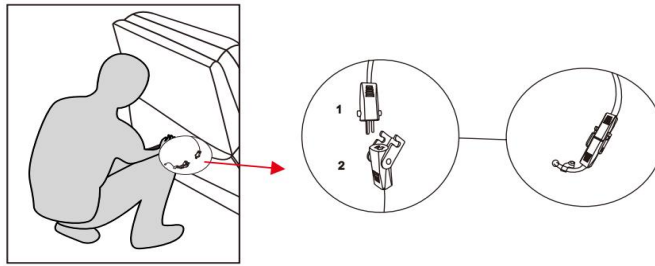

STEP 5

Connect the transformer (D) into the power port on the back of the piece, then plug it into a nearby outlet, still making sure it is clear of the metal base. (See Figure 5)

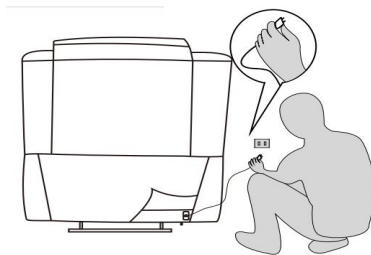

STEP 6

Fasten the back flaps to the bottom of the furniture. (See Figure 6)

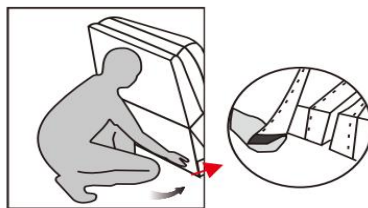

Disassemble Back (A)

Pull up the spring leaf in bracket, then lift Back (A) up. (See figure 7)

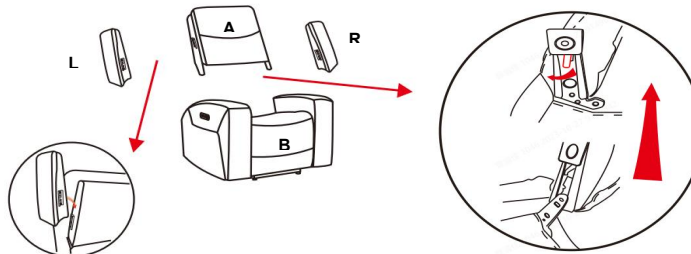
