Acacia Furniture

When properly maintained, your acacia furniture will maintain its beautiful appearance and last for decades to come.

Caring for your acacia furniture: A little TLC goes a long way.

- **Protection:** Use coasters, trivets, or other protective items to use for preventing watermarks or stains.
- **Protection:** Placing the table away from direct sunlight and away from heating vents or radiators will help maintain the color for years to come.
- **Spills:** Inevitably it does happen. Wipe clean immediately with a soft damp cloth, wiping in the direction of the wood grain, and dry with a soft dry cloth.
- **Chemicals:** Avoid cleaning products with ammonia, bleach, and lemon, these products can harm the wood finish.
- **Routine Preventative Care:** Wipe the wood with a dry soft cloth once a week to prevent dust from accumulating. Adding a protective furniture wax using a soft, clean cloth is optional.

From tree to furniture, no two pieces will be identical. Acacia wood has proven to be extremely durable, heavy, strong, and resistant to wear and tear. Its density and hardness make it a desirable material for furniture pieces.
