

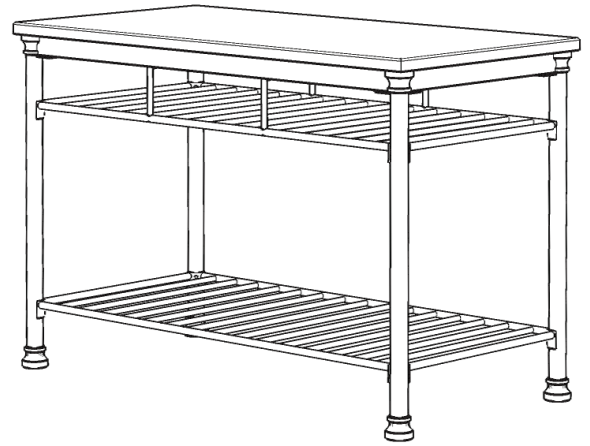

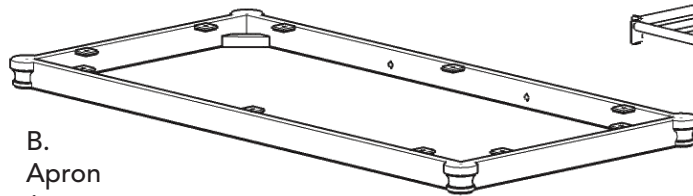
Carefully remove all the parts from the carton and place them individually on a soft cloth to prevent scratches or other damage.

Carefully and strictly follow these assembly instructions to ensure a completed product as designed.

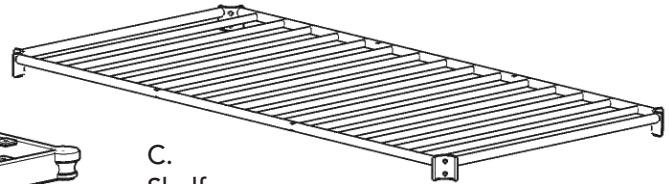
Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.



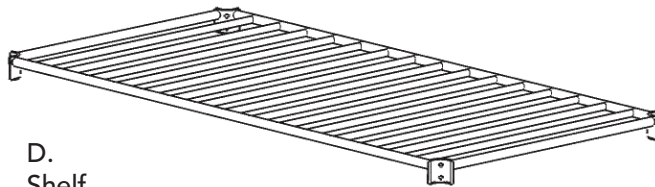

Assembly Instructions 2/3

IMPORTANT

- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.
- Do not tighten all the bolts until each part is properly assembled.
- The unit must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.
- Keep Hex Wrench in a safe place as the bolts may need to be tightened up in the future.

STEP 1

Place Top (A) upside down on a soft cloth.

Attach Apron (B) to Top (A) with Flat Washers, Spring Washers and Head Cap Bolts, tightening bolts only half way. (See Figure 1)

Tighten all Head Cap Bolts used in this step.

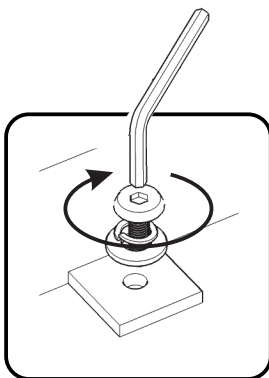
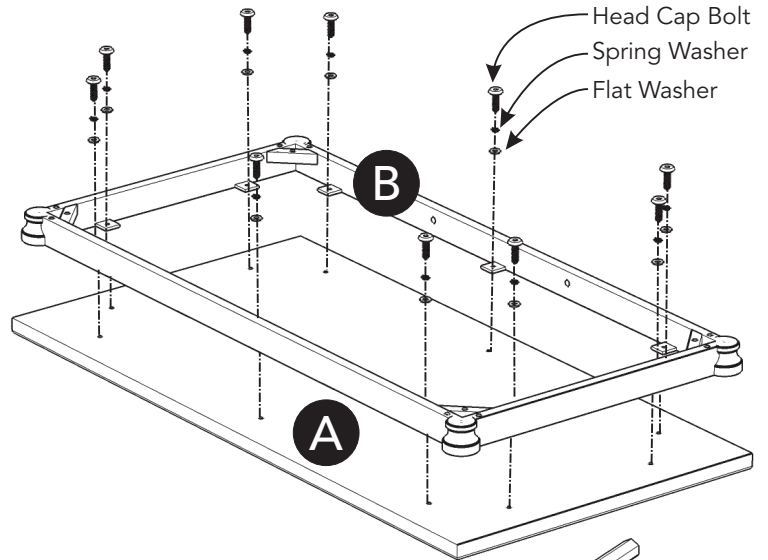

STEP 2

Attach Supports (E) to unit with Flat Washers, Spring Washers and Head Cap Bolts, tightening bolts only half way. (See Figure 2)

Attach Shelf (C) to unit with Head Cap Bolts (long), tightening bolts only half way. (See Figure 3)

Assembly Instructions 3/3

STEP 3

Attach Posts (F) to unit with Head Cap Bolts (short), tightening bolts only half way. (See Figures 4 and 5)

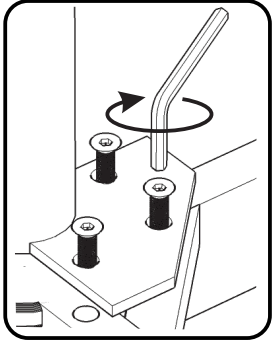

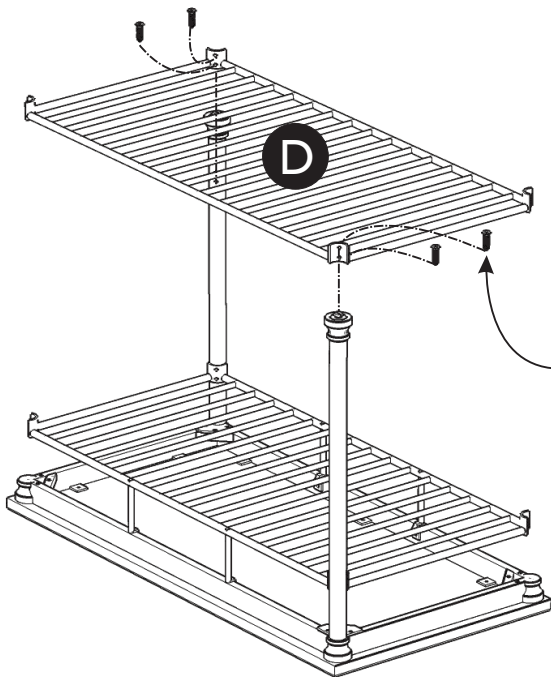
Head Cap Bolt (short)

STEP 4

Attach Shelf (D) to unit with Head Cap Bolts (short), tightening bolts only half way.

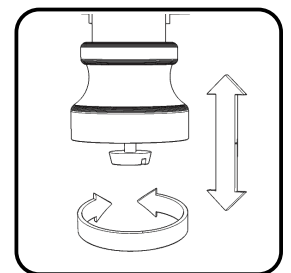

STEP 5

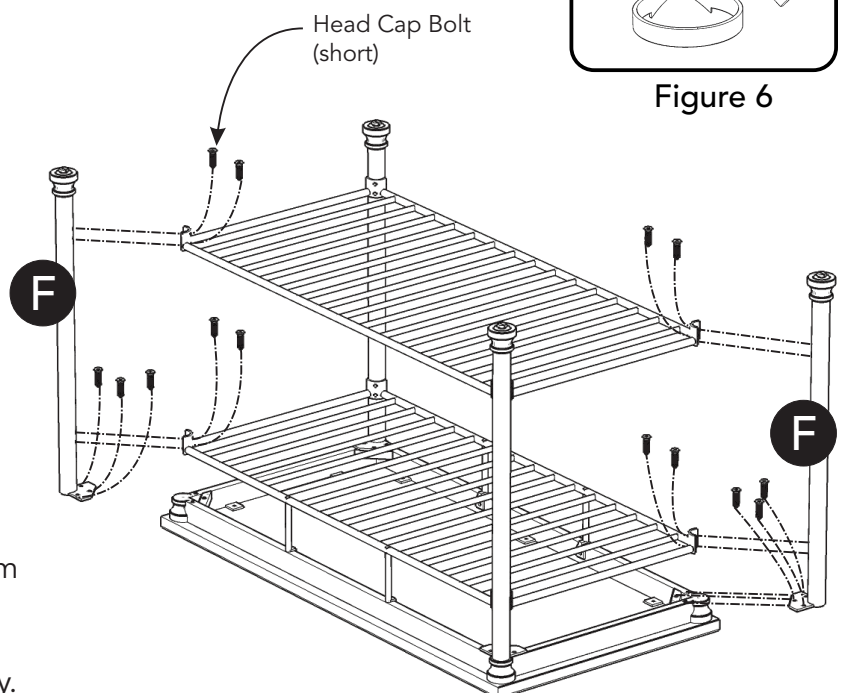
Attach Posts (F) to unit with Head Cap Bolts (short), tightening bolts only half way.

Tighten all Head Cap Bolts used in Steps 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Turn unit over to its' upright position.

Level unit by adjusting levelers on bottom of unit. (See Figure 6)

Note: Unit must be level to work properly.

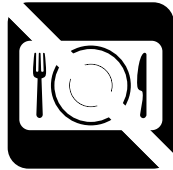
