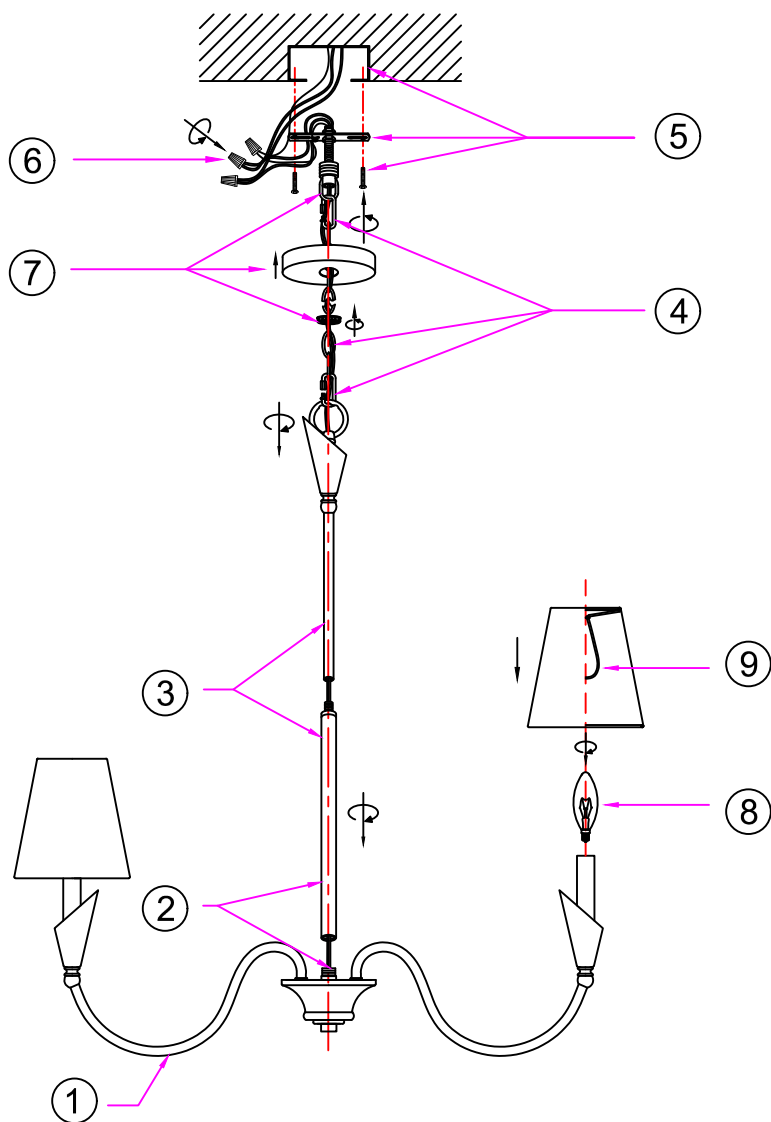


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Adjust the curved pipes to evenly spaced angles.
 2. Secure the central tube to the lamp fitting.
 3. Attach the suspension assembly to the central tube of the lamp body.
 4. Loosen the swivel connector to adjust the suspension chain length, matching the desired wire length.
 5. Use mounting screws to fix the mounting plate to the electrical box.
 6. Connect incoming and outgoing wires with wire caps. (Note: Connect positive to positive (live), negative to negative (neutral), and ground to the grounding terminal. Avoid exposed wires during connection.)
 7. Use the crystal lamp head ring to secure the ceiling plate to the mounting plate.
 8. Screw the bulb into the lamp fitting.
 9. Clamp the bulb with the spring clip inside the lampshade.
 10. Turn on the power to test the bulb.
- Installation is complete.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
