Buying a mattress can be a very stressful experience, but what can be even more stressful is when you have purchased the mattress and you can't position it in the correct place due to tight corners, small doorways or tight corridors. A vacuum packed mattress could be the answer.

The vacuum packed mattress (or roll up mattress) is a completely ordinary mattress, just that it comes delivered to you in a roll. How this works is in the factory, the mattress is packed into a plastic wrapper, and all of the air is completely extracted.

The mattress is then rolled up and packed again to keep it into shape. The benefits of this type of mattress is that not only is a vacuum packed mattress easy to transport, it also arrives to you in a 100% hygienic condition which is great news for allergy sufferers.

Vacuum packed mattresses are also extremely comfortable and are in many respects just as good as, if not better than a standard mattress. Sareer Matrah vacuum packed mattresses include Memory Foam, Latex, Reflex Foam, Gel, Cool Blue Memory Foam, Air Stream Memory Wool and even pocket springs to give you maximum comfort throughout the night. The mattress is also ready to sleep on within hours. Simply take the mattress into the room of your choice, unpack the mattress and let it unfold to maximum size (Note: Can take up to 72 Hours).

Vacuum packed mattresses also come in all sizes and are designed to fit onto any standard divan bed or bed frame, so everyone can enjoy them.

UNPACKING YOUR MATTRESS:

If your mattress is vacuum packed and/or boxed. (This process requires 2 people)

- Remove the packed mattress from the box or bag
- 2. Carefully pierce the outer wrapping of the mattress, and gently pull the plastic away from the mattress
- 3. Place the mattress on to the bed where it will be located. The zipped edge of the mattress cover will be at the bottom of the mattress so please ensure it is the correct way up
- 4. If your mattress has a zip in the middle then please ensure you place the mattress with the label on top
- 5. Remove the bag from the mattress
- 6. Your mattress will take a few hours (Maximum 72) to fully recover. Your mattress is now ready for use!

Cut the outer bag along the seams with scissors making sure not to cut the plastic bag inside. Do not use a knife. Roll out the compress mattress onto a clean flat surface.



Carefully cut the plastic bag along the edges and removeyour mattress will slowly expand.
