- Burning must be inside the metal bowl. Never burn firewood on the faux stone fire pit body, otherwise it would destroy the appliance.
- 29. Do NOT put any hot part of the fire pit onto combustible surfaces such as grass, wooden deck or furniture.
- All above must be exactly followed.





Do NOT use oven cleaner or abrasive cleaners as they will damage this product. Do NOT clean any part of this outdoor fire pit in a self-cleaning oven as it may damage the finish. Wipe exterior surfaces of the metal parts with

- a mild dishwashing detergent or baking soda. For stubborn surfaces on the metal parts, use a citrus based degreaser and a nylon
- scrubbing brush. Rinse clean on the metal with water. Use a soft dry brush to wipe away the dust on the faux stone fire pit body. Never use

water or other liquids to clean the faux stone
