



## **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### I. Preparing the Fixture

1. Secure the mounting plate to the electrical box with two mounting plate screws. **Note:** For single light fixture, mounting plate studs must face horizontally.

#### II. Wiring the Fixture

- 1. Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits to ensure there's no electricity running through the wiring.
- 2. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate, which the ground wire should be tightly wrapped around, or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
- 3. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
  - a) White fixture wire to neutral power line wire
  - b) Black fixture wire to hot power line wire
- 4. Align, then place the fixture base onto the mounting plate studs and secure it with the two ball nuts.
- 5. Place the shade and spacer onto the shade base and secure them in place by installing and tightly screwing the shade collar nut onto the socket; repeat for all shades.
- 6. Screw the lamps into the sockets to complete installation.
