**Assembling frame** 

Insert the chair back 1 into the right 3 and left leg 2.

Screw bar 4 into place with A , E and D . Use Allen key

Place the seat pad upside down on a flat raised surface ie. Kitchen top.

seat pad 5 and screw down into the seat pad to secure. Only tighten to

90% at all stages,

Assembling seat pad





Proceed to tighten all bolts to finish assembly. Get someone to sit on the chair to make all
