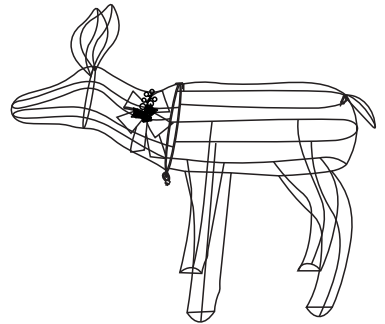

- Do not use this item in a way inconsistent with the manufacturer's instructions as this could void the product warranty.

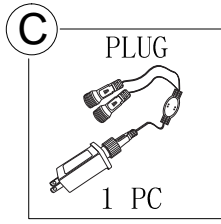
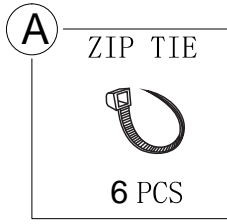
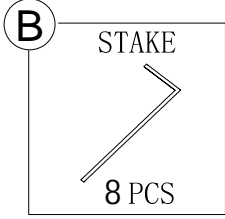
## WARNINGS!

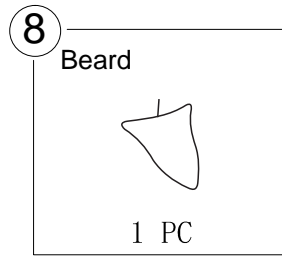
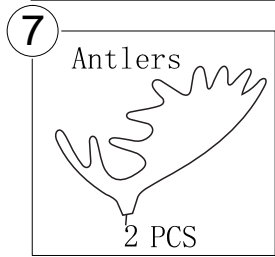
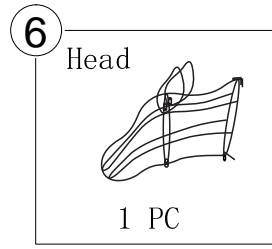
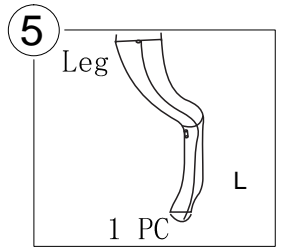
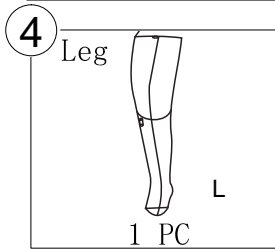
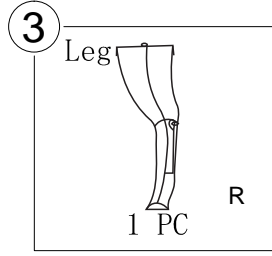
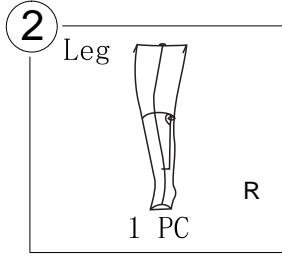
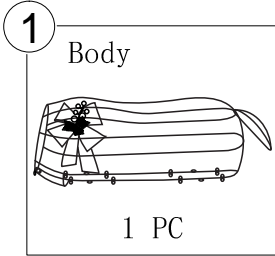
PROBLEM	REASON	SOLUTION
One section does not light	Broken or loose bulb	Inspect bulbs individually and replace broken bulbs
Lights do not work	Not plugged in	Firmly plug into wall outlet
	Extension cord does not have power	Plug in/turn on extension cord
	Broken or loose bulb	Inspect bulbs individually and replace broken bulbs
	Blown fuse	Replace fuse on plug

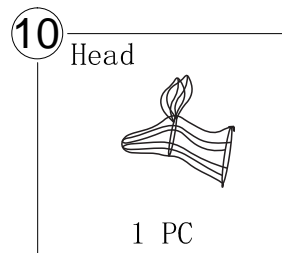
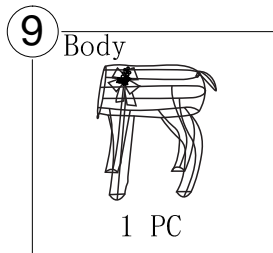

## Male Deer



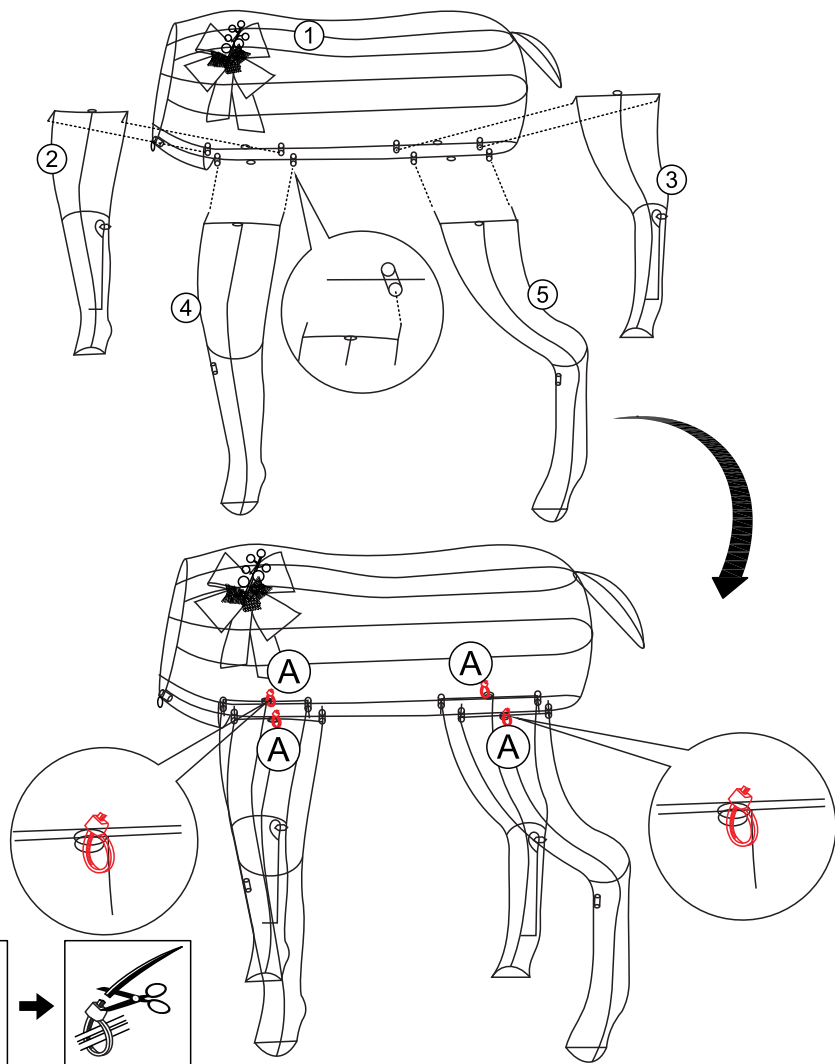

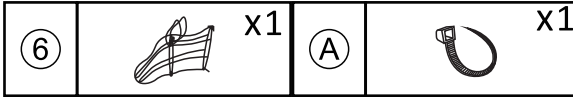
# Male Deer

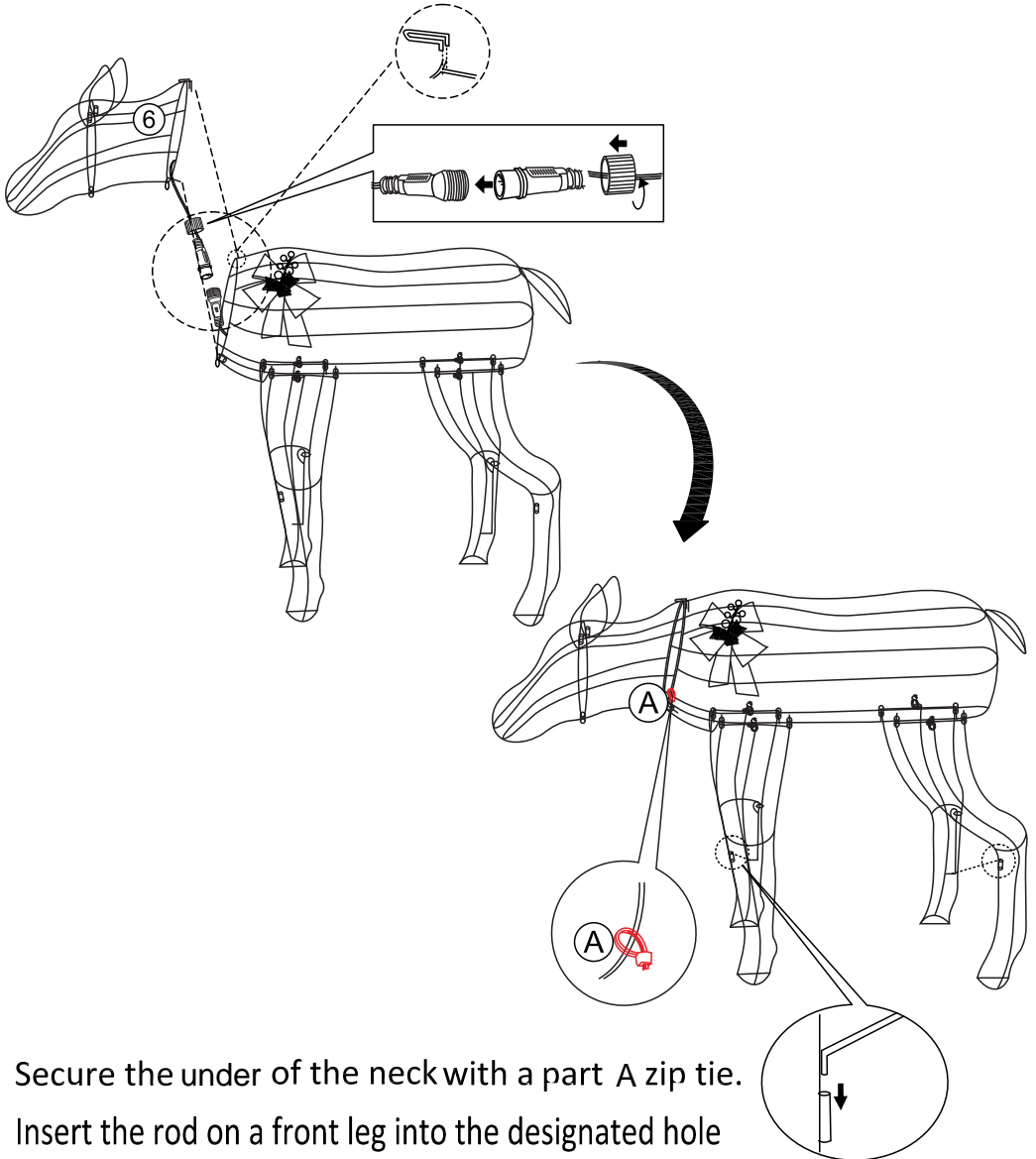
Carefully remove protective wrap. Do not use a knife to avoid damaging parts or light bulbs.

Insert the part(2)(3)(4)(5)legs into the designated holes on the part (1)body. Secure the four legs with a part A zip tie.

Insert the part(6)head. Connect the power connector between the head and the body.



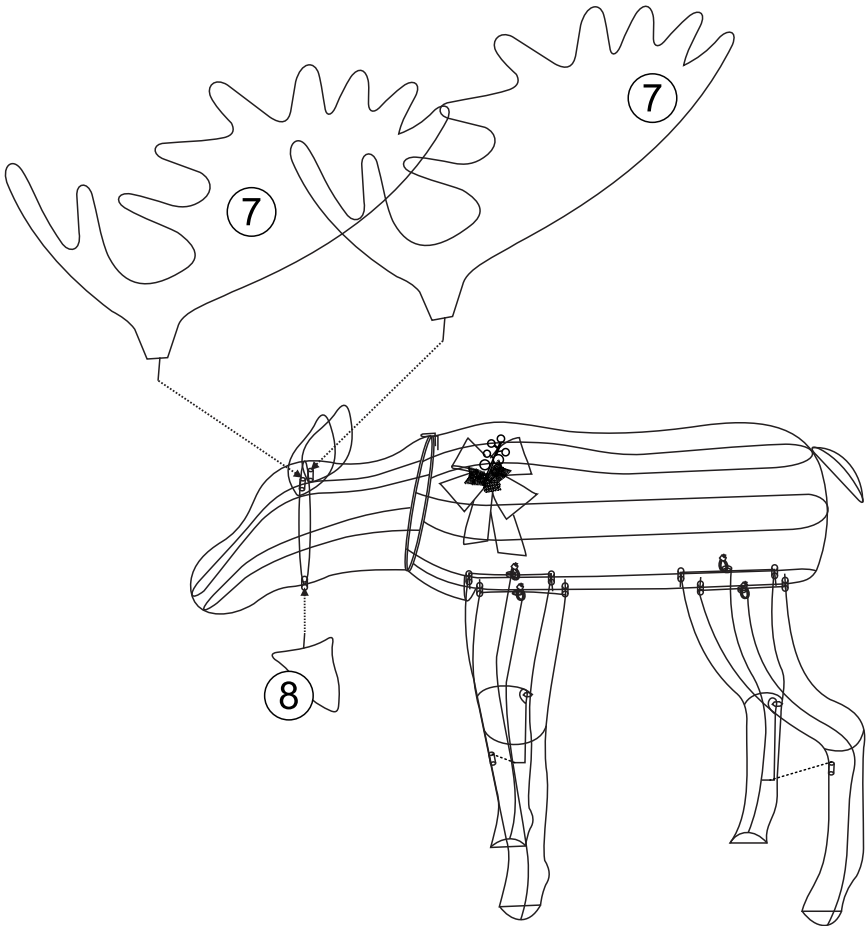
Secure the under of the neck with a part A zip tie.  
Insert the rod on a front leg into the designated hole  
on the other front leg. Repeat on the back legs.

Insert the part(7) antlers and (8)beard .

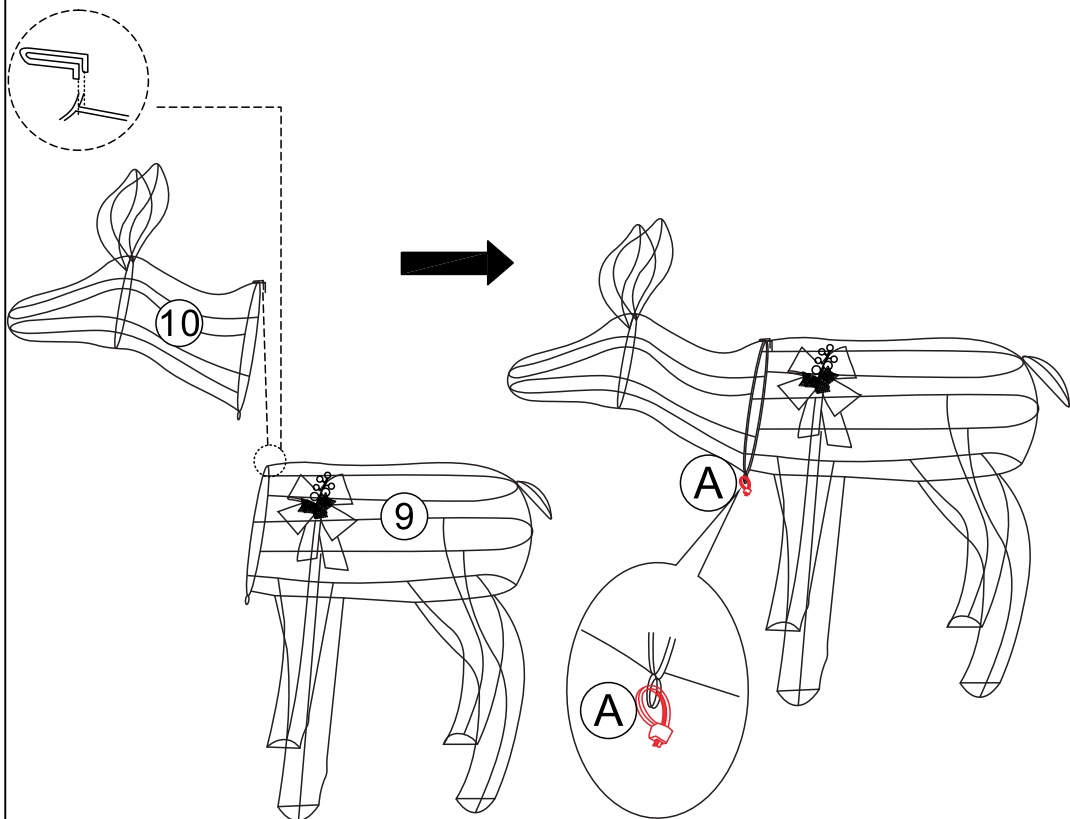
