

MANUAL

Assembly:

The furniture is delivered disassembled, in packages, for self-assembly. Assembly should be carried out according to the enclosed assembly instructions. Use the appropriate tools for assembly. If in any doubt, please contact your retailer.

Safety:

The furniture must be fixed to the wall to avoid the risk of the furniture tipping over or the hanging element falling. Use screws suitable for the substrate. If you do not know which ones, contact a specialist. Before fixing the furniture, it must be levelled. Do not leave moving parts of the furniture (doors, drawers) open (protruding), as this may damage the furniture and endanger your safety. Special care should be taken with lighting sources or other electrical equipment. In particular, they should not be allowed to come into contact with liquids, should be touched without being disconnected from the mains, should be childproof and the connection to the mains should comply with the relevant standards. The connections of the furniture components should be checked periodically. Any looseness detected should be rectified immediately by tightening the appropriate fasteners and screws. Glass elements must be used with particular care, in particular they must not be overloaded.

Rules of use:

The furniture should be used in dry, closed rooms and protected from harmful atmospheric influences and direct sunlight. Do not overload the furniture as this may cause permanent damage. Do not place hot dishes on the surfaces and avoid contact of furniture elements with solvents, alcohol. Do not allow large amounts of liquid to be spilled. If this happens, remove the liquid immediately and dry the spill area with a soft cloth. The furniture should be vacuumed systematically, several times a week, with a slightly damp, soft and clean cloth and then wiped dry. In the event of heavier soiling, mild detergents designed for furniture cleaning can be used. The furniture has a durability limited by its usual purpose. In particular, the furniture is not resistant to scratches from sharp clothing items or pet claws.

Colours:

The colours of the furniture shown in the photographs may differ slightly from the actual appearance. This is primarily due to differences in lighting conditions, as well as individual monitor/screen settings. The features of the furniture (intensity of colouring) may change during use.
