Observe all local plumbing and building codes.

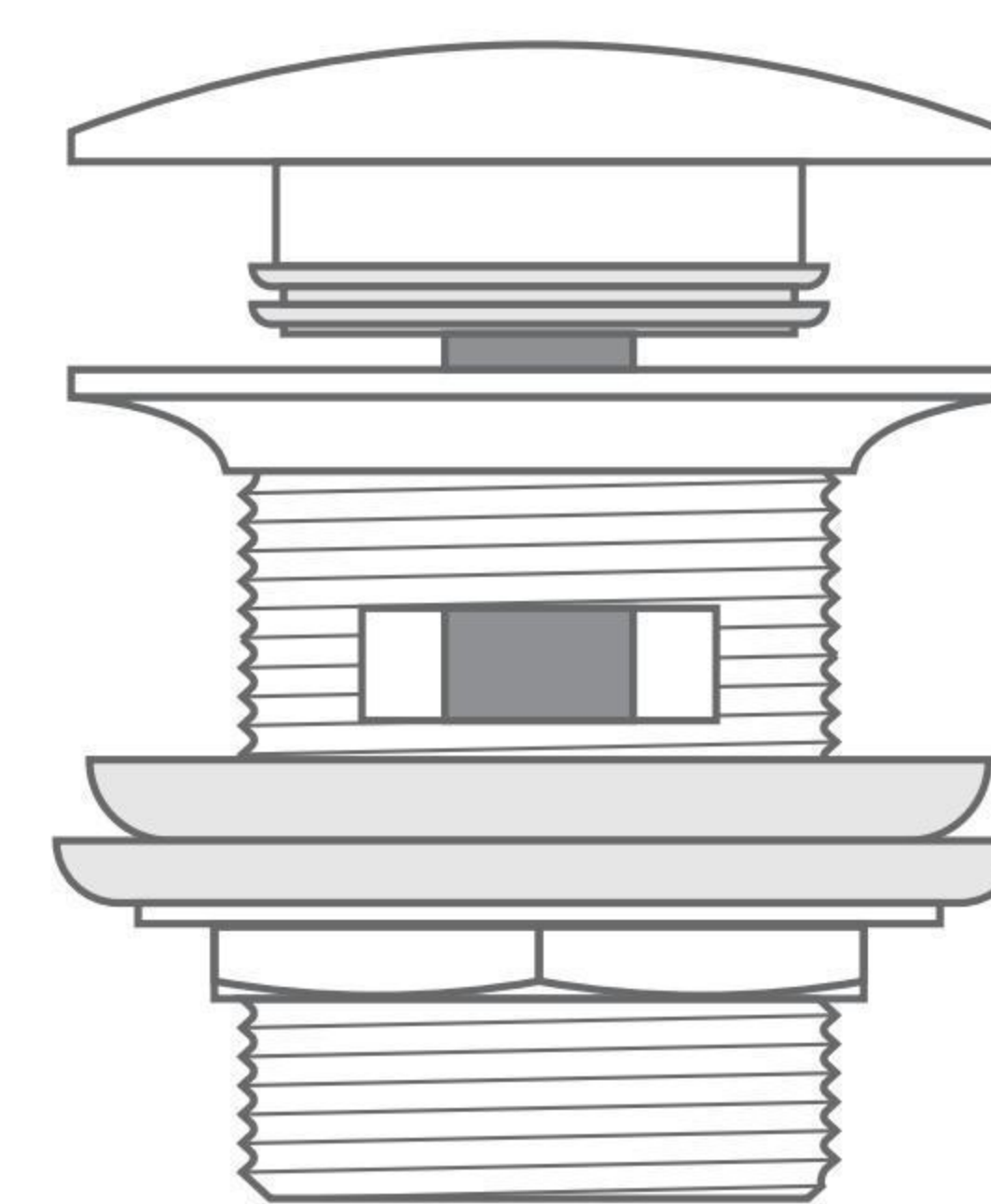

This products must be installed by a fully insured and licensed plumber only.

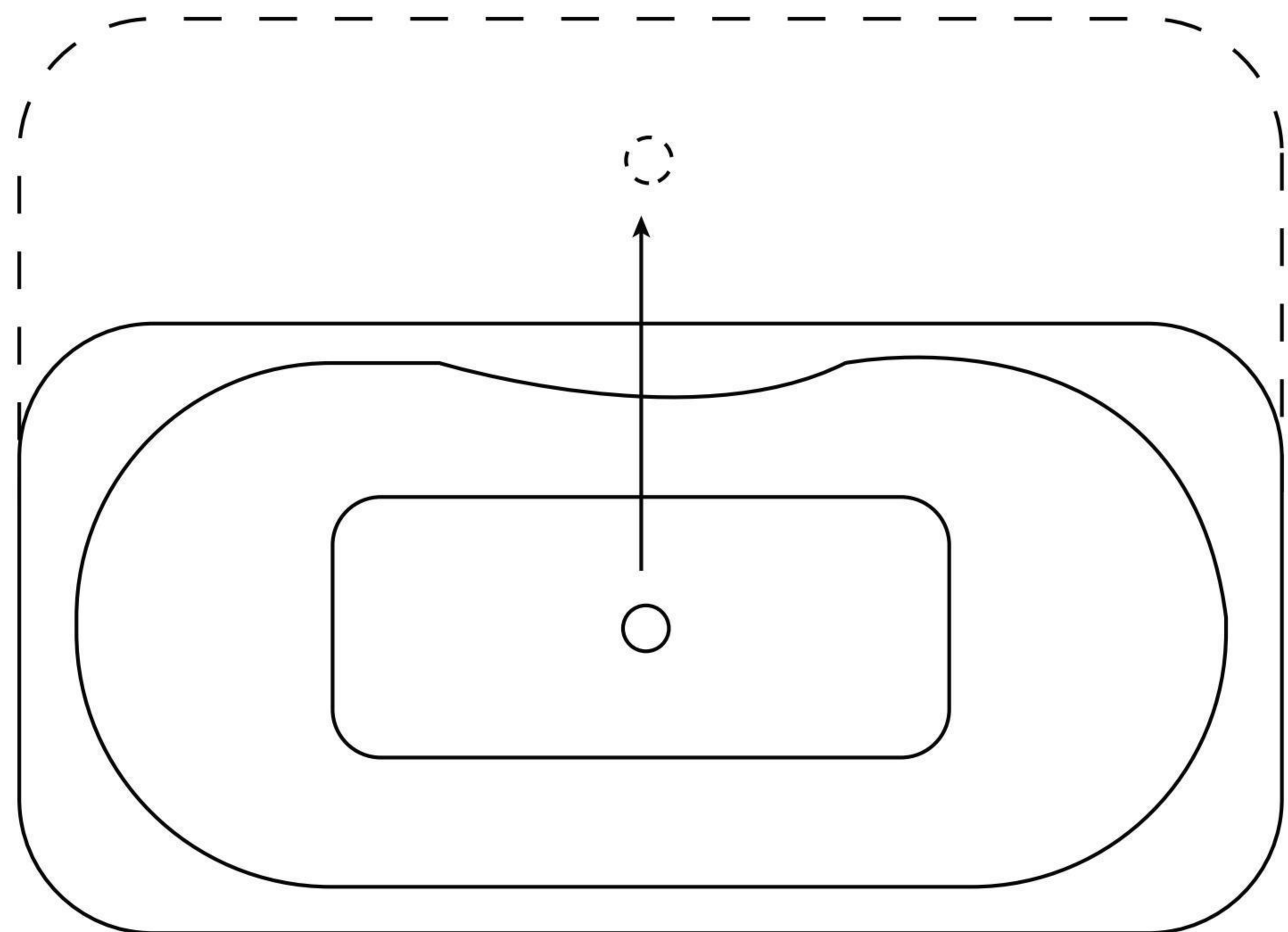
PLANNING ASSEMBLY

Check the bathtub for damage before installation. If any part of the cabinet is missing or damaged contact the Customer Service Team at 206.809.0093.

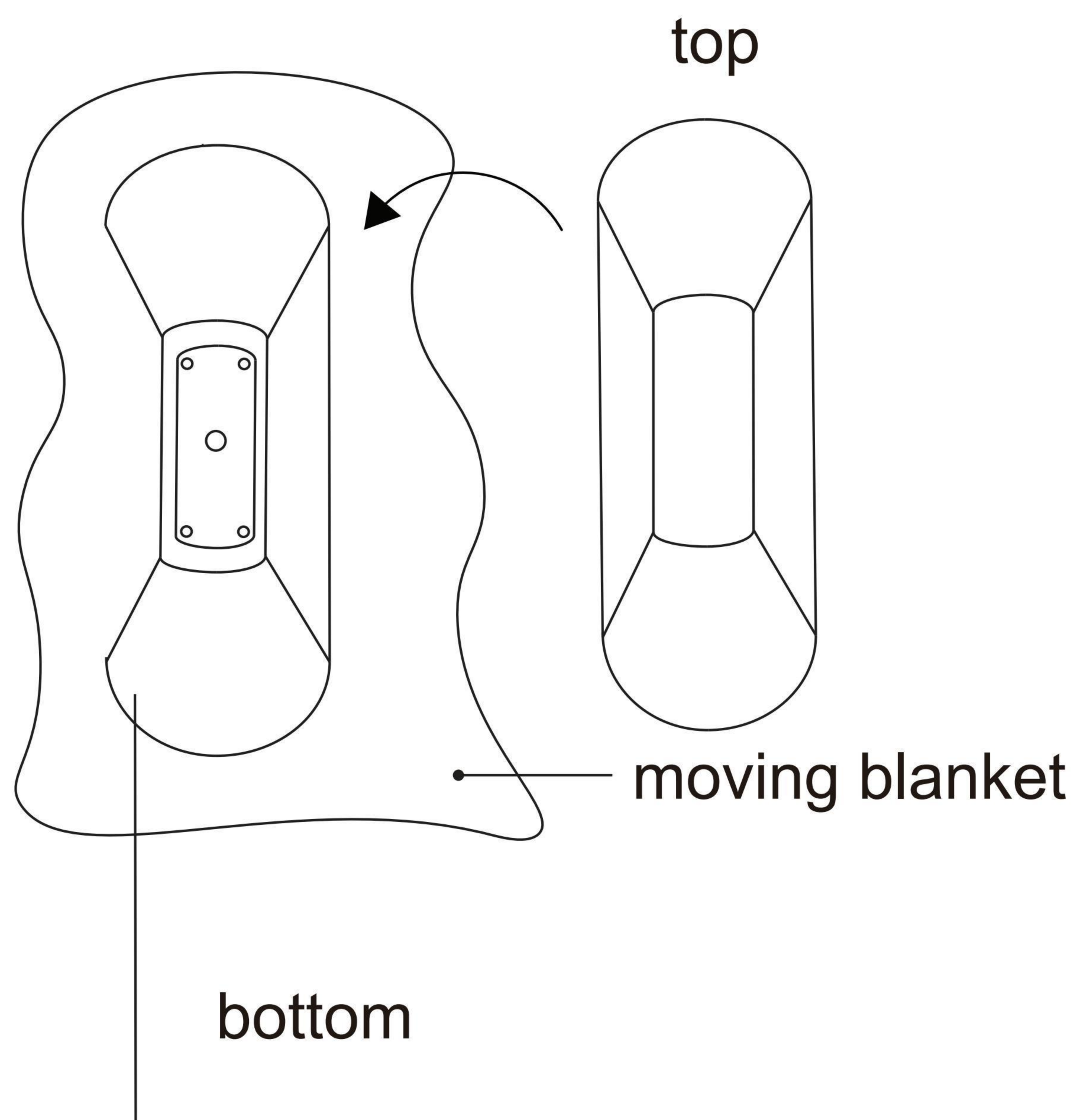
Ensure that the bathtub location is accessible to water supply and drain lines. Ensure that your bathroom floor is adequately supported, and the finished floor is level.

INSTALLATION WITH UNDERFLOOR ACCESS

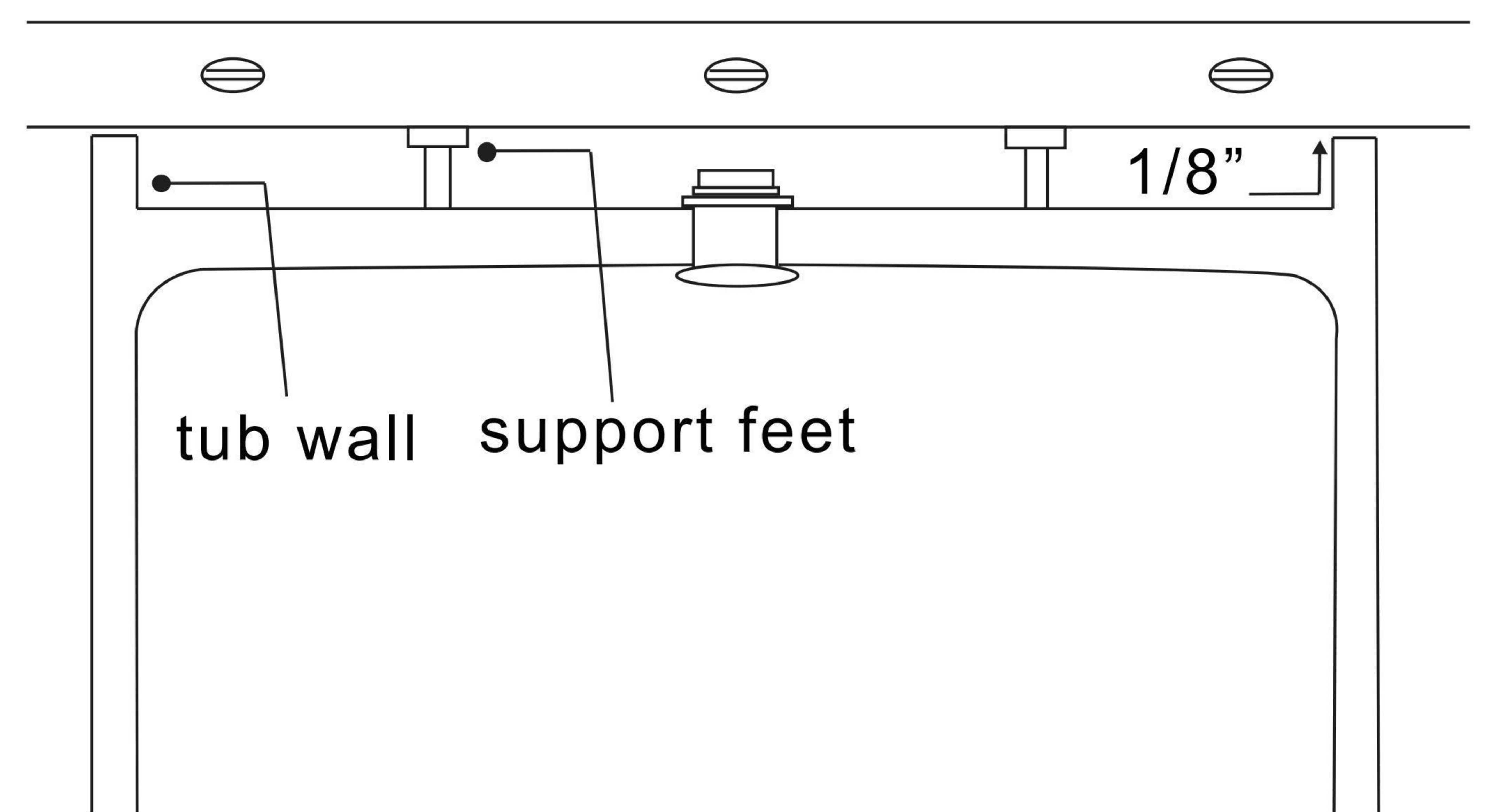
1. Set the tub in the desired location and mark the drain hole location on the floor. Then, move the tub away from the desired installation location so that the plumbing can be installed.



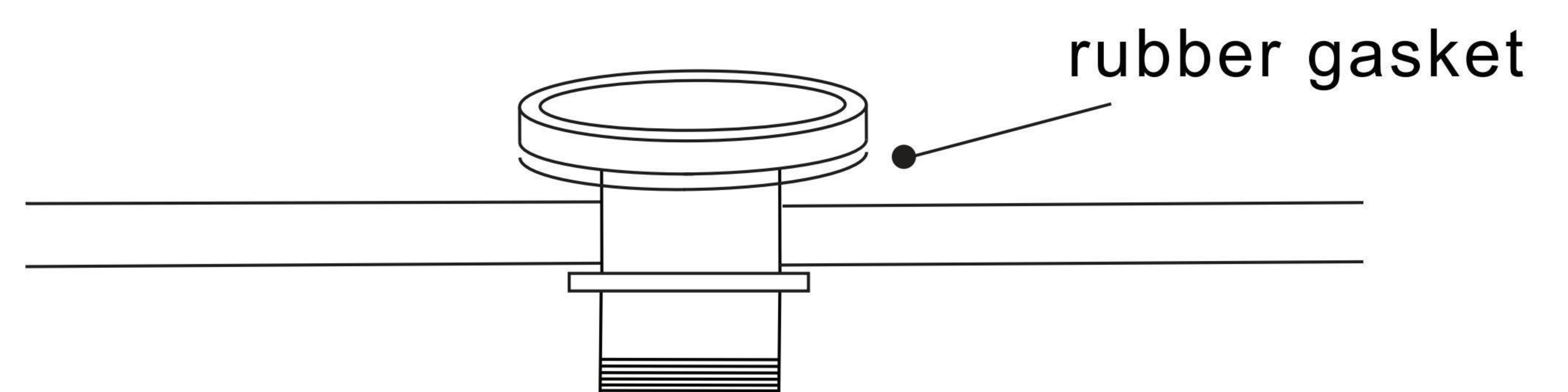
2. Turn bathtub upside down and rest it on a moving blanket, cardboard, or other soft surface to prevent scratching the rim. Use caution when turning the bathtub upside down, as the product may be heavy and may require assistance to rotate.



3. Place a level across the bottom of the tub to represent floor level. Raise adjustable leveling supports to touch level. Then, raise the support an additional 1/8" to ensure the bathtub is supported by the support feet and not by the tub walls.

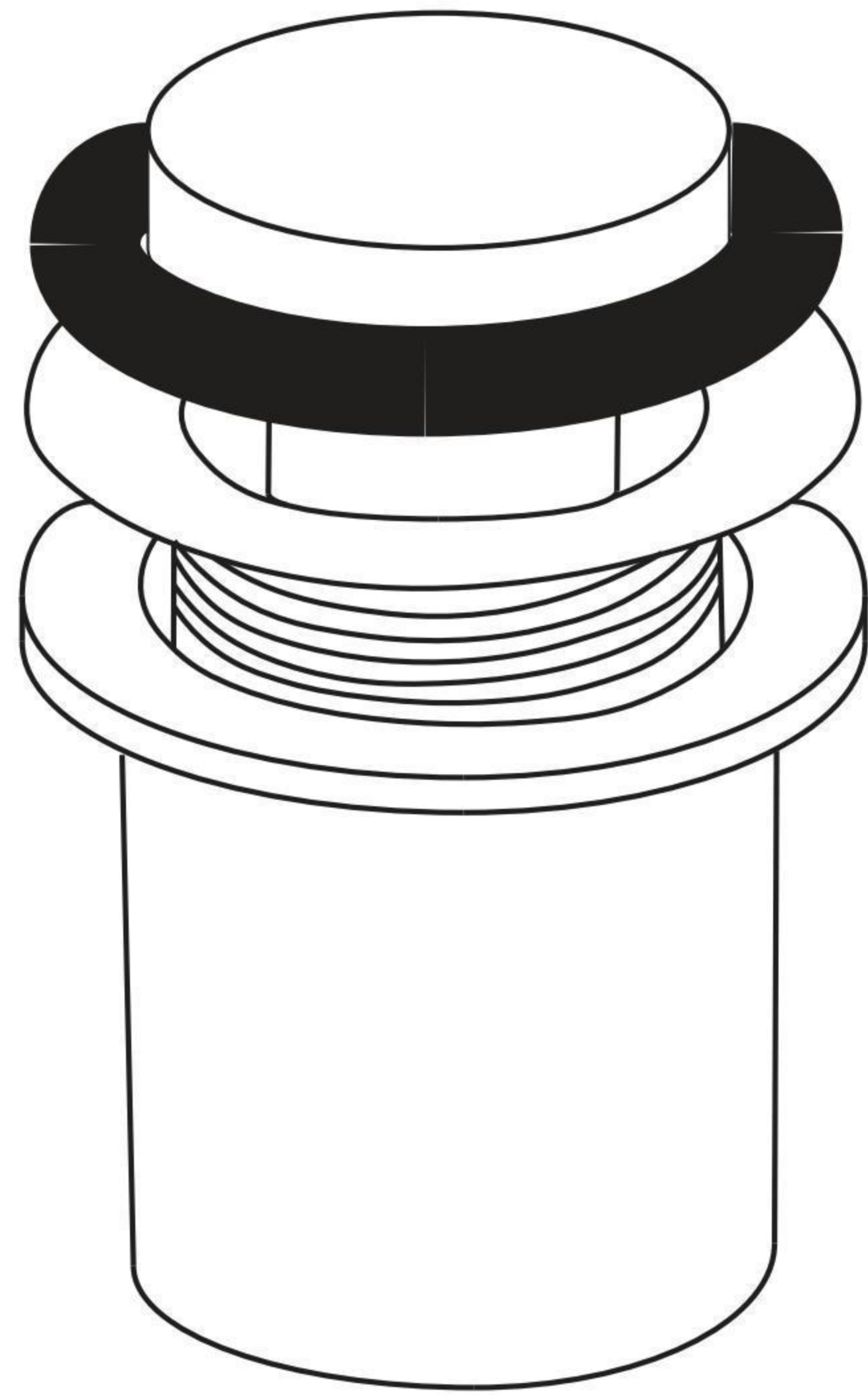

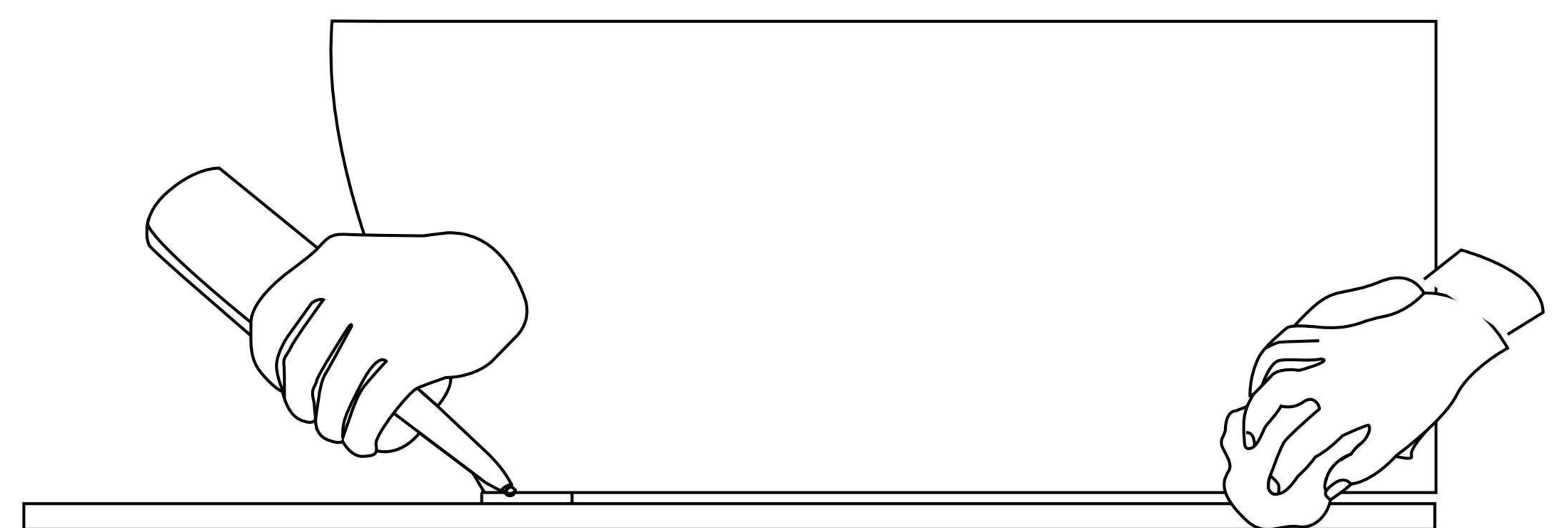
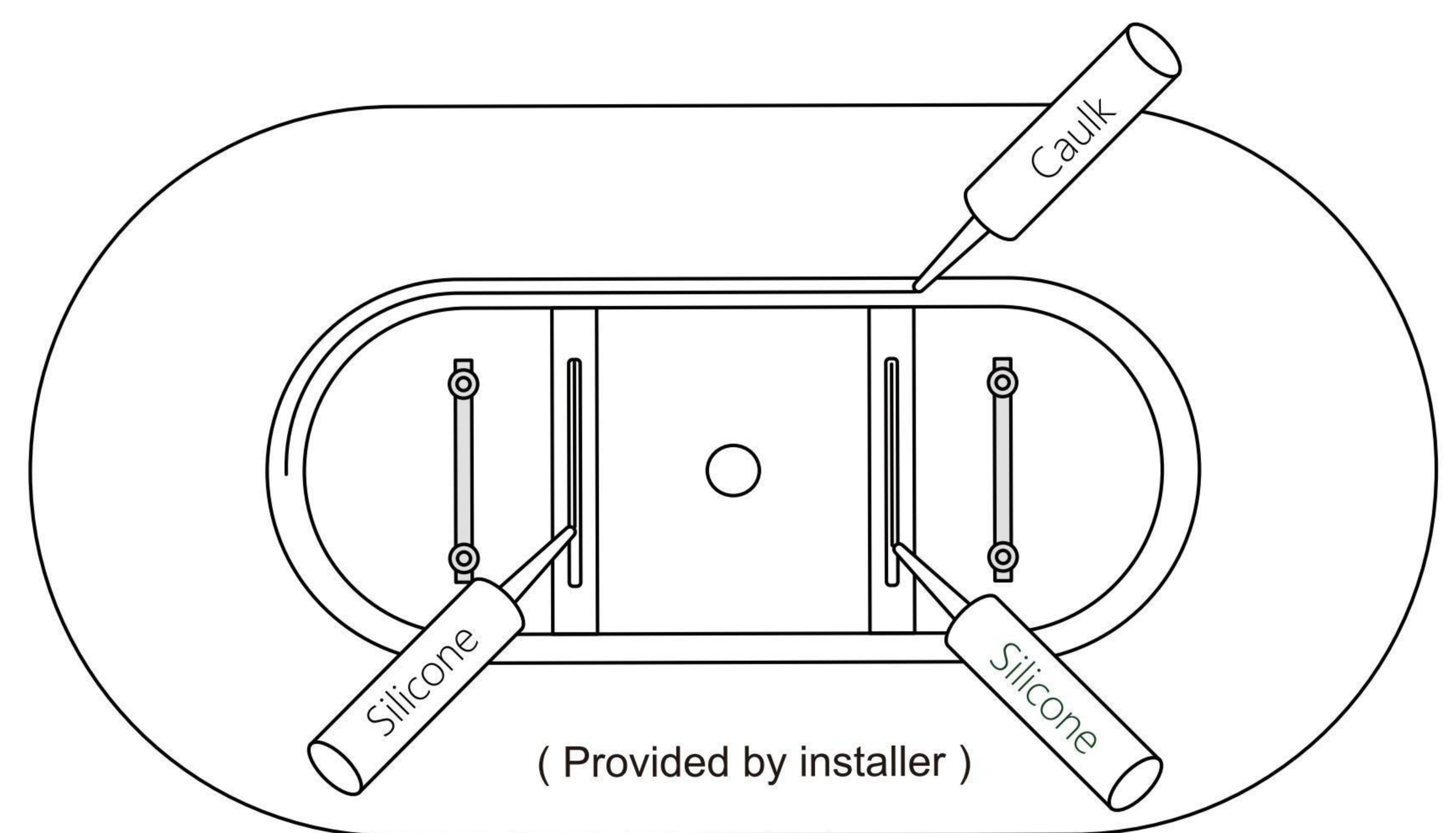
6. Make connection under floor from tub drain to p-trap.



7. Fill the tub with water to check for any leaks from the connections. Verify that the drain is working properly.



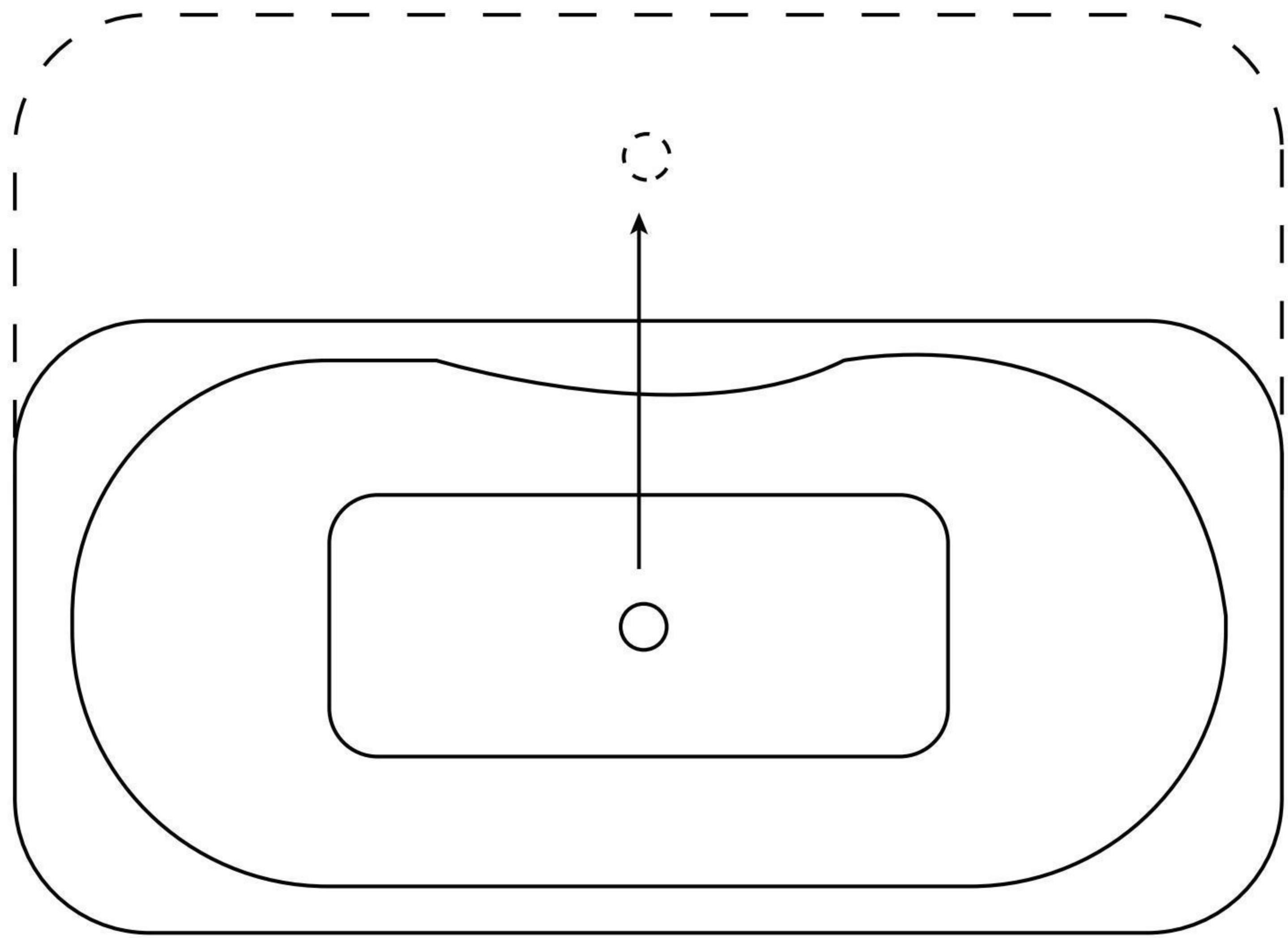
8. Finish your installation by running a bead of neutral cure silicone sealant around the base of the tub where it meets the floor. Wipe away any excess sealant with a damp cloth.



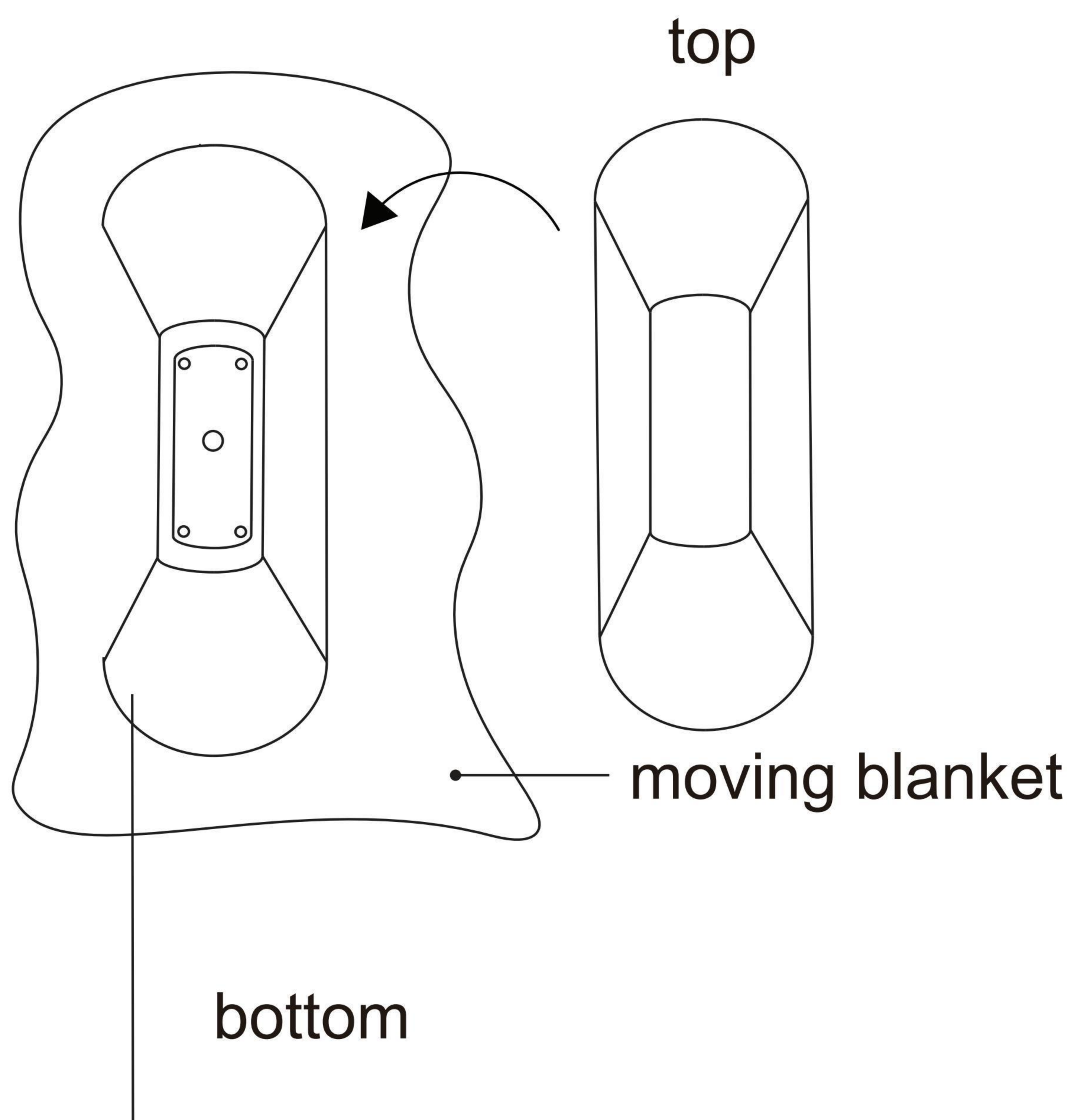
INSTALLATION WITHOUT UNDERFLOOR ACCESS / SLAB FLOOR INSTALLATION

7. You may need to trim 1½" PVC drain pipe extending from the floor to the appropriate length.



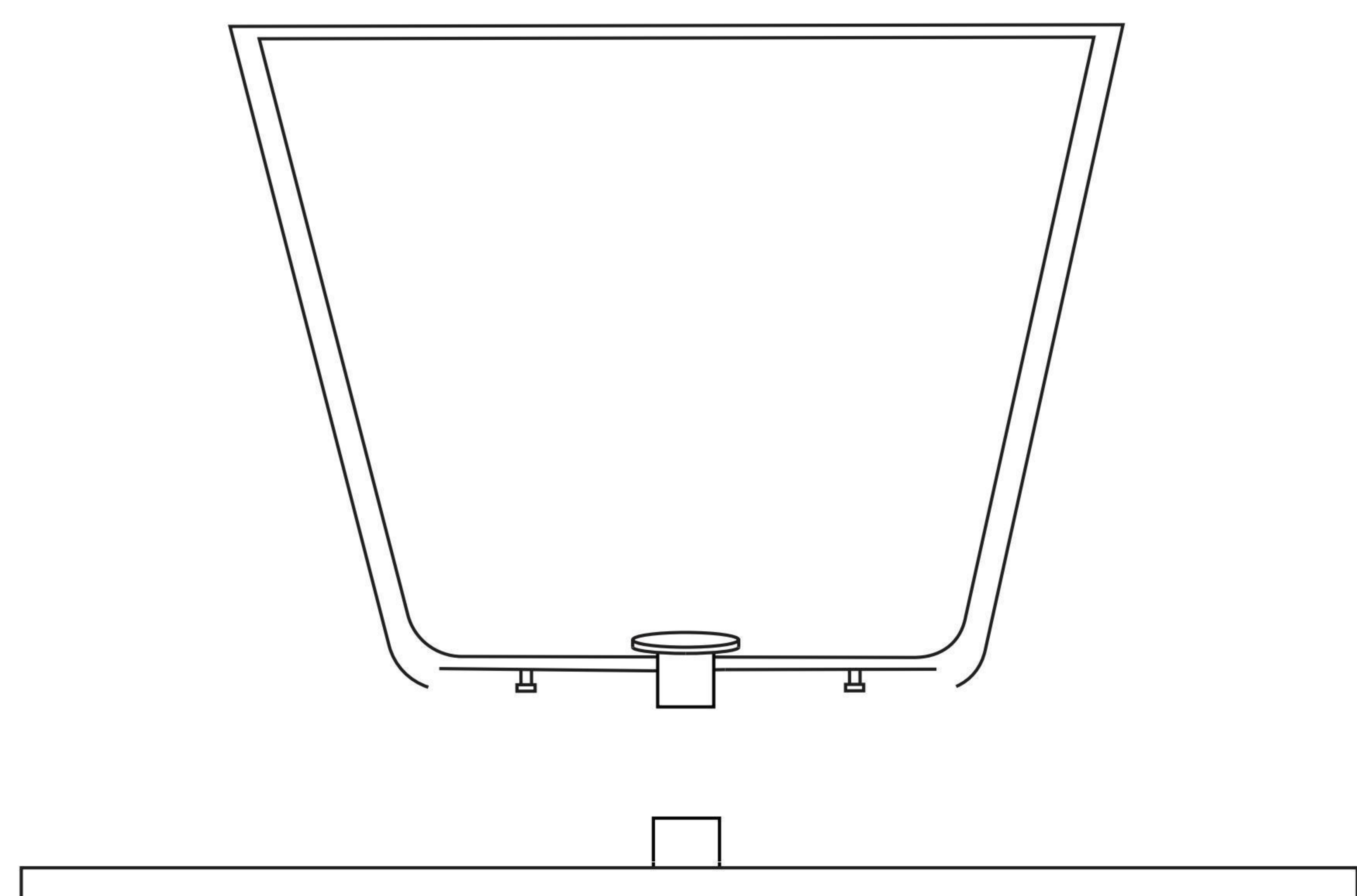
8. Turn the tub to upright position. Prepare the drain to be connected to the male PVC pipe rough-in above floor level.



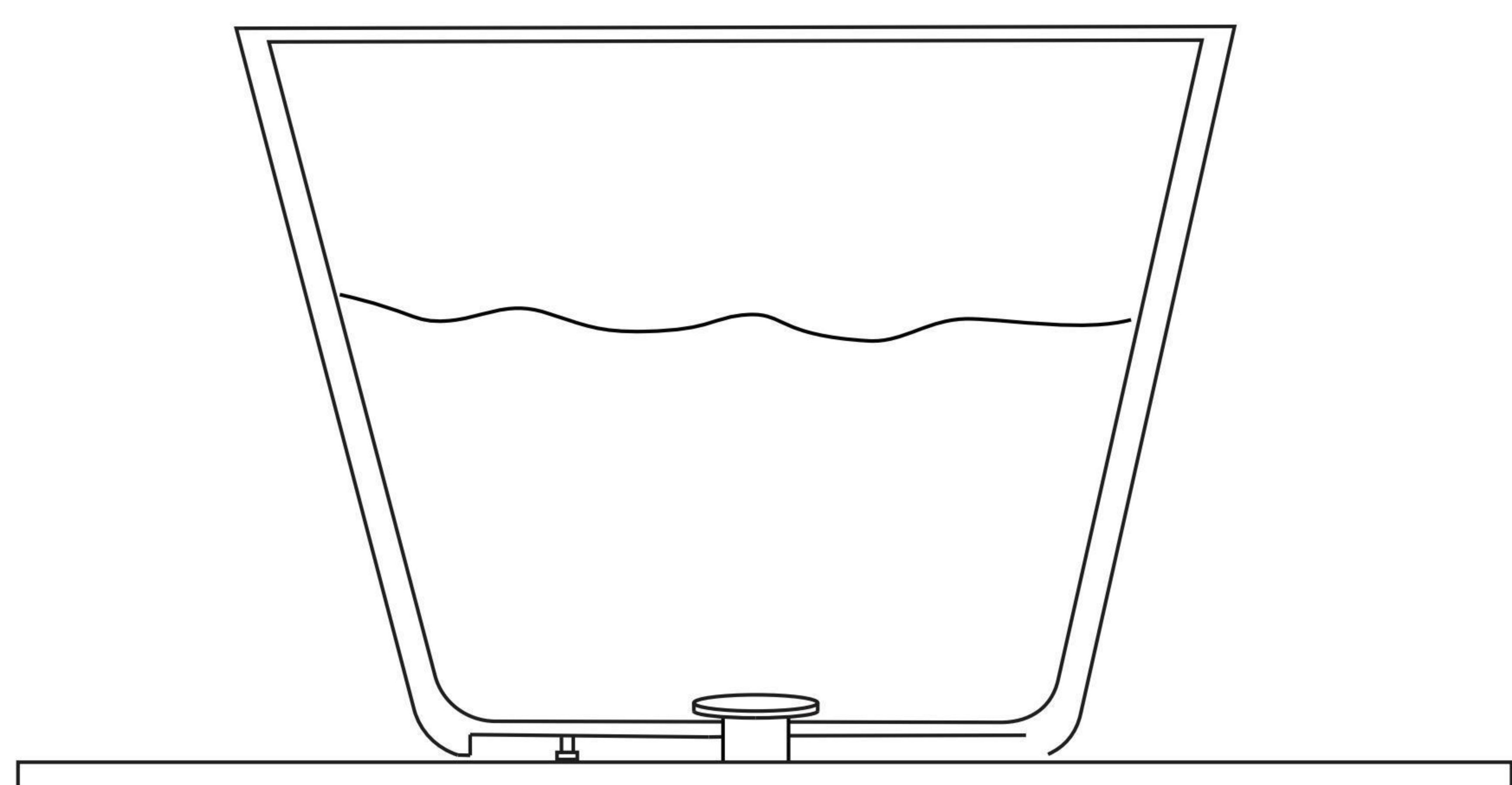

9. Center tub directly over PVC rough-in, adhere tub onto PVC pipe.

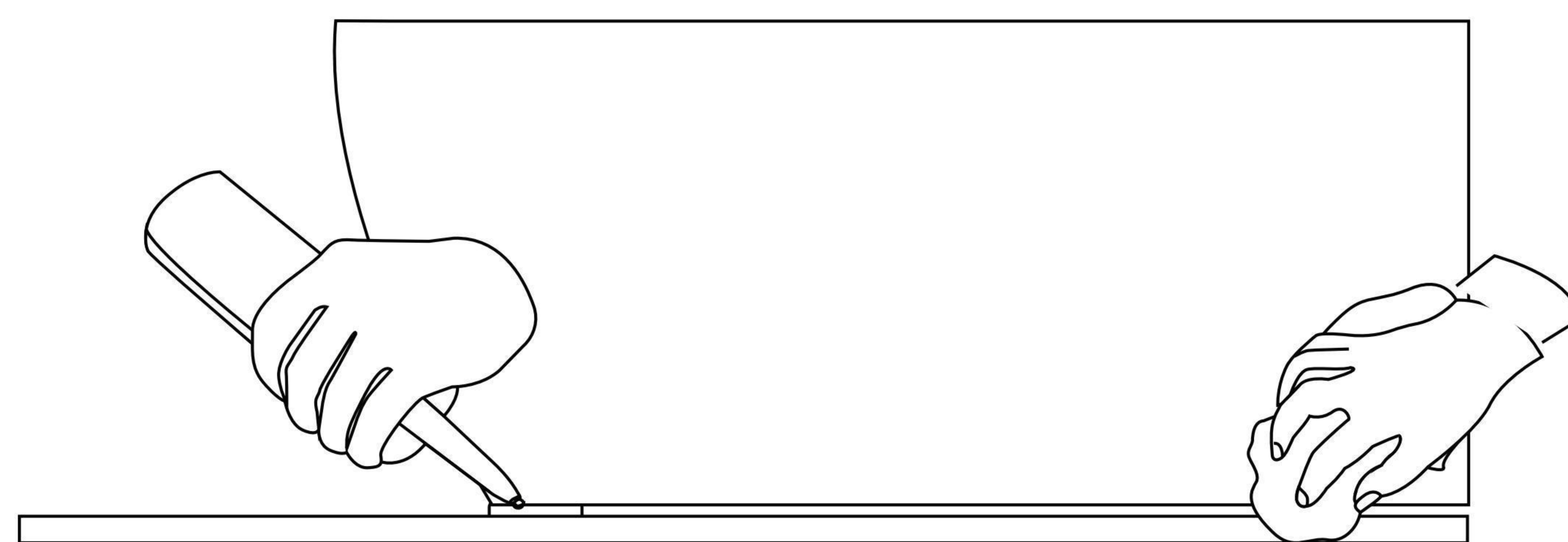
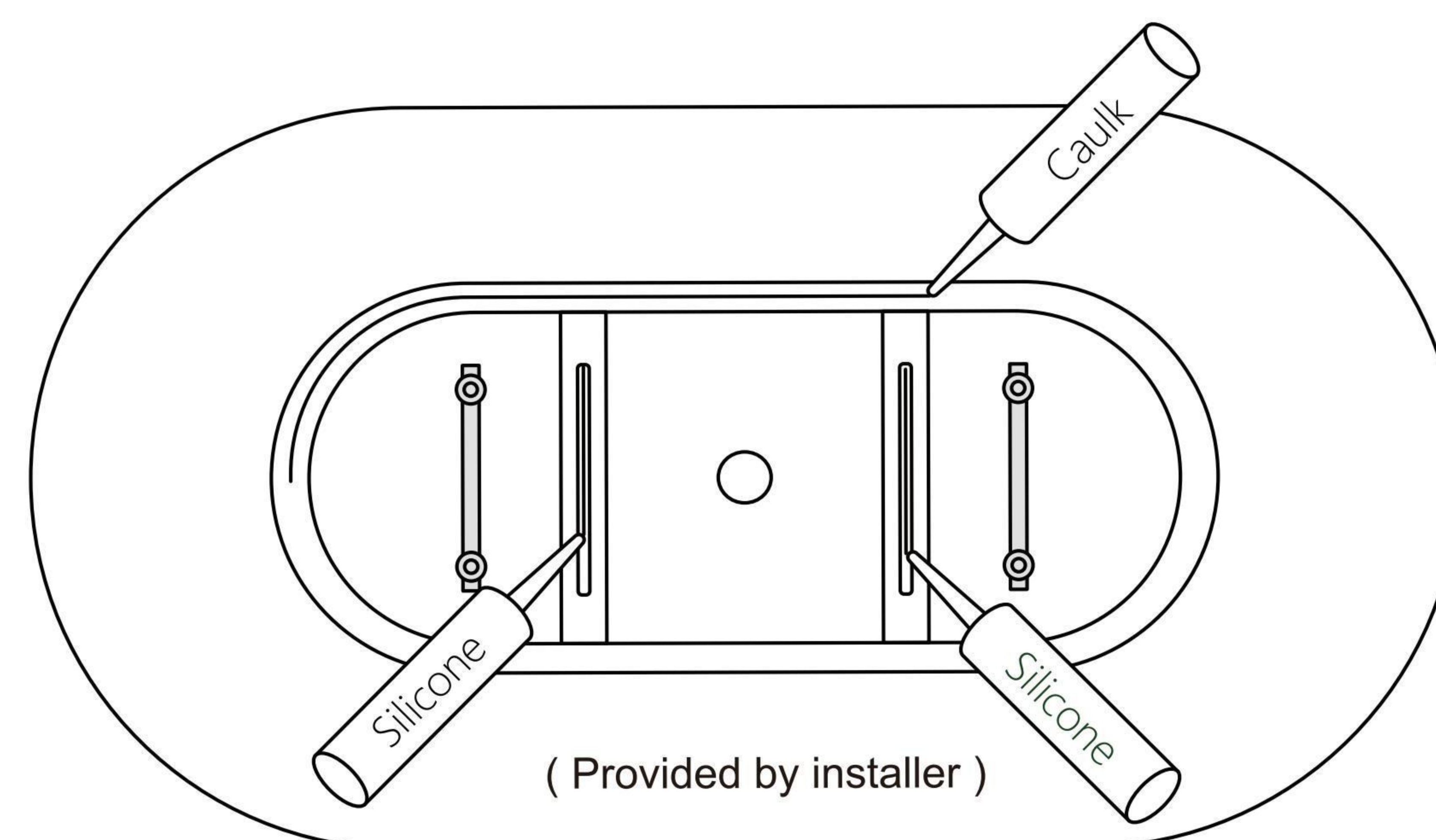
NOTE: Unscrew the pop up mechanism and drain cover to get a better view of the male PVC rough-in.



10. Fill the tub with water to check for any leaks from the connections. Verify that the drain is working properly



11. Finish your installation by running a bead of neutral cure silicone sealant around the base of the tub where it meets the floor. Wipe away any excess sealant with a damp cloth.



MAINTAIN YOUR BATHTUB

CLEANING

Clean your bathtub with a mild soap like dishwashing liquid mixed with warm water. Avoid abrasive cleaning pads; opt for a soft sponge or microfiber cloth instead. Use vinegar to tackle hard water stains and mildew. Rinse with warm water and dry with a soft cloth. For a glossy finish, buff your tub every three months using white polishing compound. Avoid harsh tools like metal scrapers or wire brushes.

REMOVE SCRATCHES

1. Dampen a sponge and cleanse the surface with warm water and dishwashing liquid, then rinse thoroughly.
2. Avoid abrasive cleaners or chemicals; ensure your chosen products are safe for acrylic tubs.
3. Gently sand the scratched area using 800 and 1200 grit sandpaper in circular motions.
4. Cleanse the sanded area with a damp sponge and rinse well.
5. Apply an acrylic polishing compound mixed with water using a soft cloth, buffing in circular motions for a smooth finish.
6. Wipe away any excess residue and rinse the tub with warm water, then dry with a soft cloth.

MAINTENANCE

We advise against using bath oils and bath salts as they pose challenges in cleaning the systems. Doing so will also nullify the consumer's warranty.

Maintaining your Whirlpool Tub or Air Bath:

To ensure your whirlpool tub or air bath remains in optimal condition, it's crucial to regularly flush out and clean its jets.

For an air bath, the process is straightforward. Simply activate the jets when the bath is empty, or utilize the bath's built-in drying cycle. This quick step effectively dries and flushes out the tub's jets within minutes.

However, cleaning a whirlpool tub requires a bit more effort:

1. Begin by filling the tub until the water level is a few inches above the jets.
2. Add a couple of cups of vinegar to the water or use a recommended cleaning product such as bleach or dishwashing detergent (refer to the manufacturer's instructions to ensure compatibility).
3. Turn off the air induction valves and switch on the jets. Allow them to run for approximately 15 minutes.
4. Drain the tub and repeat the process if necessary.

While cleaning the jets of a whirlpool tub may seem like a chore, it's essential for preventing the buildup of debris and mold, ultimately preserving the relaxation experience of your baths.

Keep in mind that if you frequently use your jetted tub (several times per week), you'll need to flush out its jets more regularly to maintain optimal performance.
