

Lamp Installation Steps

Step 1: Install the Ring Frame

Align the ring frame upwards with the mounting holes and tighten the decorative nut to secure it in place.

Step 2: Install the Connector Tube

Thread the power cord through the connector tube and tighten it downwards.

Step 3: Install the Fabric Shade and Lamp Pole

Thread the power cord through the lamp pole and fabric shade. Align the shade with the holes and tighten downwards.

Step 4: Install the Pendant Chain

Thread the power cord through the pendant chain and secure the chain in place.

Step 5: Fix the Mounting Bracket

Use mounting screws to secure the mounting bracket to the electrical junction box. Ensure the screws are tightened firmly so the bracket is securely fixed to the box.

Step 6: Connect the Wiring

Pull the power cord out from the junction box. Use wire connectors to make the following connections:

White Wire (Neutral): Connect the fixture's white wire to the supply white wire.

Black Wire (Live/Hot): Connect the fixture's black wire to the supply black wire.

Ground Wire: Connect the fixture's ground wire to the mounting bracket using the green ground screw, then connect it to the house ground wire with a wire connector.

Carefully tuck all wires back into the junction box. Ensure all wire connections are secure and no bare wire is exposed.

Step 7: Secure the Ceiling Canopy

Position the ceiling canopy over the mounting bracket. Tighten the decorative nut to secure the canopy. Ensure the canopy sits flat and is firmly fixed to prevent loosening.

Step 8: Install the Light Bulb

Install the light bulb (Note: Bulb not included). Select a suitable bulb and install it correctly. Ensure the bulb is firmly seated and makes good contact with the socket.

Step 9-12: Install Crystals

Align the central hole and snap the crystals onto the ring frame.

Important Notes

Ensure the power supply is switched OFF at the circuit breaker/fuse box before starting installation to avoid risk of electric shock.

Use a clean cloth or wear gloves when handling bulbs to prevent skin oils from contaminating the bulb surface.

If you are unsure about any steps, especially electrical connections, it is strongly recommended to seek assistance from a qualified electrician.
