

Stefani Ceramic Water Purifier Installation Guide

Stage 1

Pre-Assembly checks

- Check that all assembly components are in the box.
- Ensure that there are no damage to the included products.
- Fill Ceramic unit with water and ensure there are no cracks in the unit.
- Thorough wash all parts, the lid, tap and ceramic purifier.



Stage 2

Assembly Tap

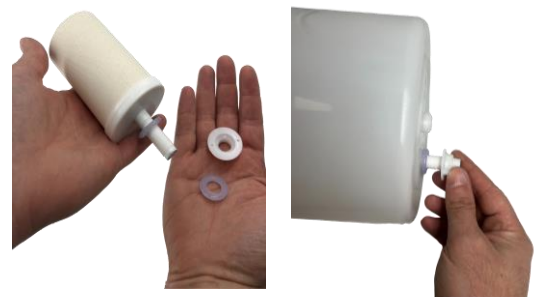
- Insert the tap through the hole in the side of the water purifier ensuring you have 1 x rubber washer on the outside & 1 x rubber washer inside to create the seal. Then tighten the plastic nut by hand on the inside. **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.**



Stage 3

Assembly Filters

- Insert the filters through the holes in the bottom of the white plastic bucket, ensuring you have 1 x rubber washer on either side to create the seal. Then tighten the plastic nut by hand on the inside. **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.**
- Once filters have been installed place the white plastic bucket into the ceramic purifier.



Stage 4

Prime and Flush your Cartridges

- Once your filter cartridges have been successfully installed into the purifier, it is recommended that you allow 2-4 litres of water to pass through the cartridge to remove any fine activated carbon particles from the ceramic cartridge. The fine particles are harmless and are a result of the activated carbon's manufacturing process.
