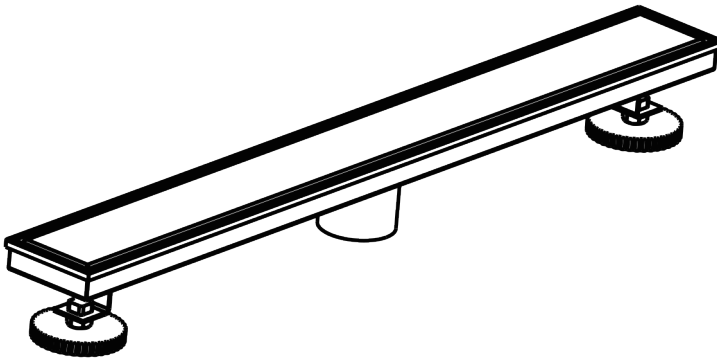

INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS

CRANACH recommends that this unit be installed by a licensed professional plumber.

Before starting the installation, please read these instructions carefully and make sure you have all the required tools and materials on hand.

To avoid the risk of scalding, ensure that the maximum output temperature of the shower mixing valve does not exceed 120°F (49°C).

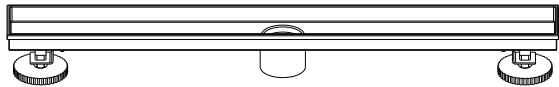

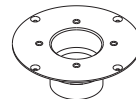

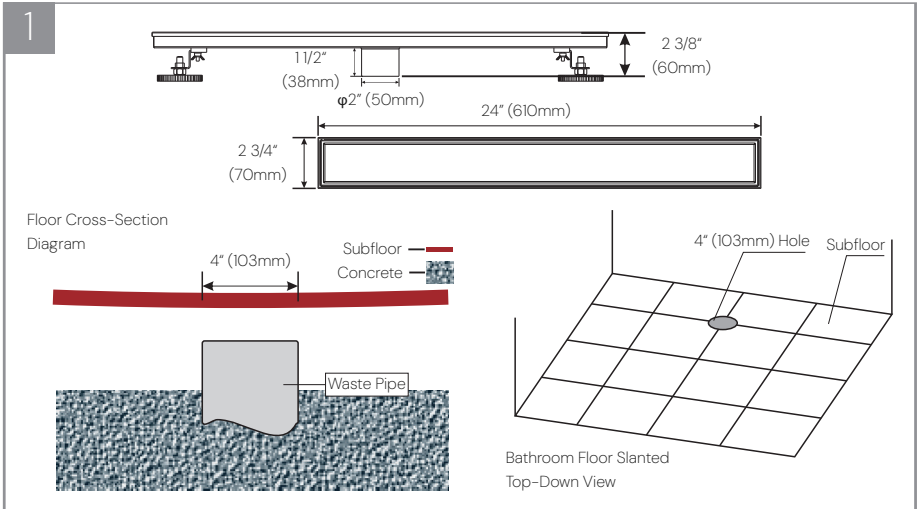


Upper Flange



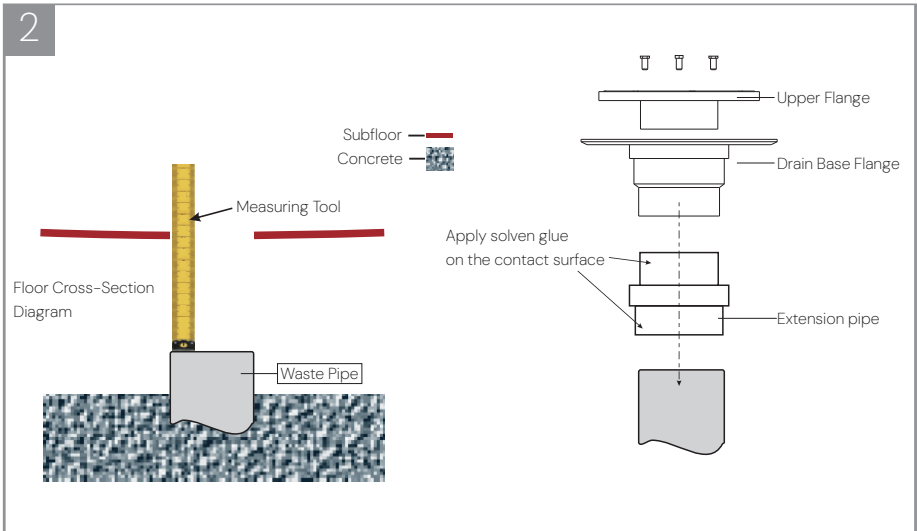
Drain Base Flange

INSTALLATION



1.1 Locate the position of the bathroom waste pipe, and use a tool to cut a hole with dimensions as shown in the diagram (4" 103mm).

1.2 Be careful not to let debris fall into the waste pipe to avoid damaging or clogging the drainage system.



2.1 Use a measuring tool to check if the depth of the waste pipe meets the required installation depth for the shower drain body. The top of the waste pipe must extend into the bottom of the shower drain body by 1" (25mm) - 1 1/8" (28mm).

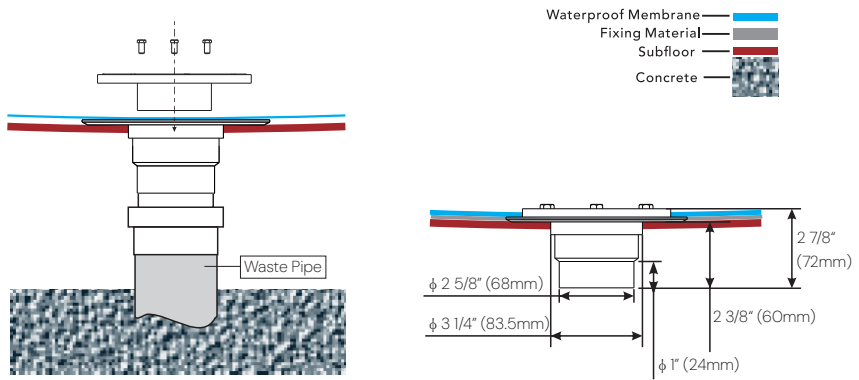
2.2 Cut a suitable extension pipe to connect the drain base flange and the waste pipe. Secure the drain base flange with 4 screws.

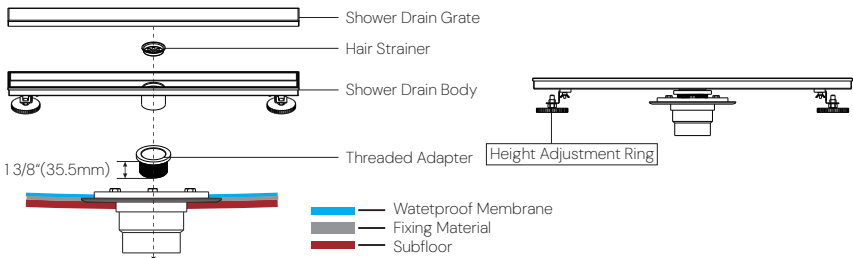

3. If there is a gap, mark the appropriate length on the extension pipe, cut it properly and use glue to connect it to the waste pipe. (The parts list does not include an extension pipe; it needs to be purchased separately.)

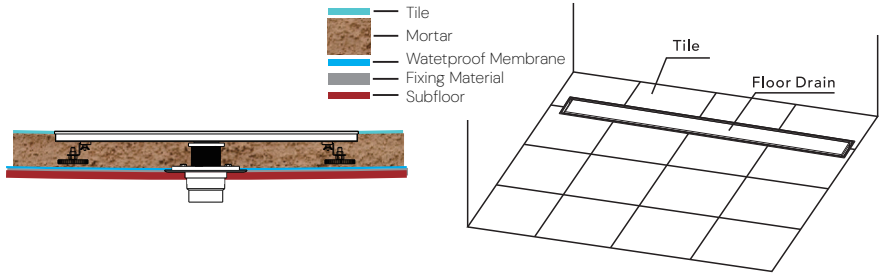
4. Install the floor drain and connecting flange from bottom to top according to the diagram. If the ground is uneven, adjust the height using the adjustment rings on both sides until level. (It is recommended to adjust the Threaded Adapter by no more than 1 1/8\"/>

5. First, measure the thickness of the floor surface materials such as tiles/wooden boards. Spread mortar onto the waterproof membrane, leaving space for the thickness of the tiles. Use a level to ensure it is even. Finally, lay the tiles to complete the floor drain installation.

WARRANTY

Parts and Finishes:

CRANACH warrants all parts (excluding electronic components and batteries) and finishes of this product, purchased from authorized CRANACH sellers, to be free from defects in material and workmanship.

Lifetime warranty, for as long as the original consumer purchaser owns the home in which the product is installed.
- Commercial or Multi-Family Use:
For a period of ten (10) years from the date the product is received by the original purchaser or their authorized representative.

Electronic Components:

If applicable, electronic components (excluding batteries) of CRANACH products purchased from cranachhome.com or authorized CRANACH sellers are warranted to the original consumer purchaser to be free from defects in material and workmanship.

- Residential Use:
For a period of five (5) years from the date the product is received.
- Commercial or Multi-Family Use:
For a period of one (1) year from the date the product is received.

What We Will Do:

During the applicable warranty period, if a defect is found in material or workmanship under normal installation, use, and service, CRANACH will provide replacement parts free of charge. Before returning your product to CRANACH, please visit our website or contact our customer service team (via phone or email) for troubleshooting assistance.

Exclusions & Limitations:

This warranty does not cover:

- Damage caused by abuse, misuse, improper care, lack of maintenance, or improper installation.
- Damage from freezing water or excessive water pressure.
- Damage from abrasive cleaning products or use in violation of applicable codes or regulations.
- Labor charges incurred during installation, removal, or repair of the product.
- Incidental or consequential damages.
