Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

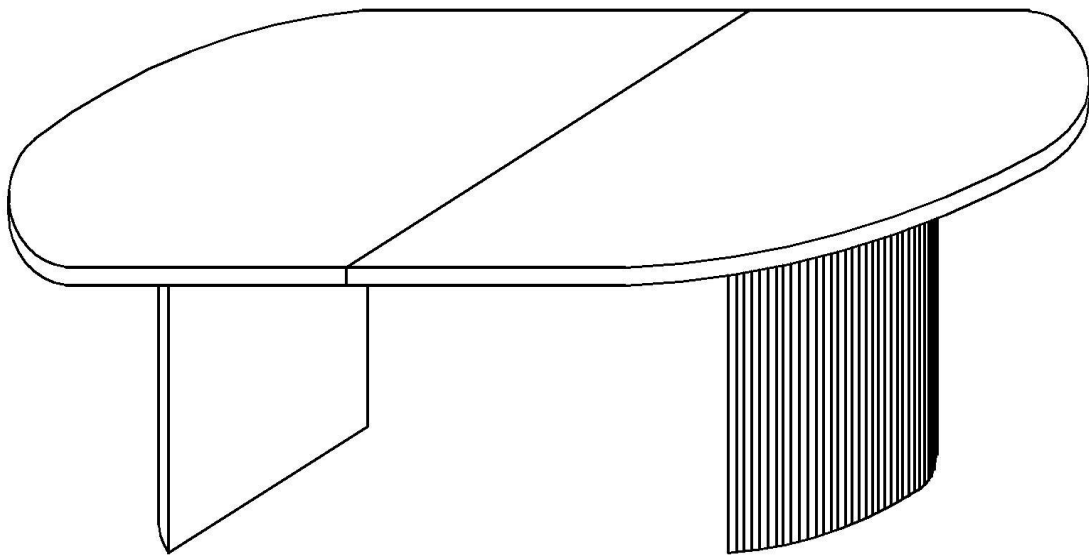


- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.

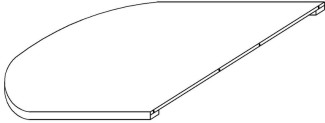
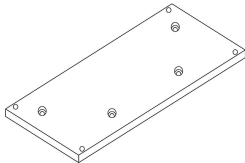
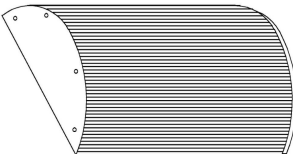


- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

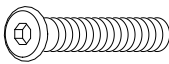
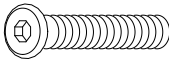

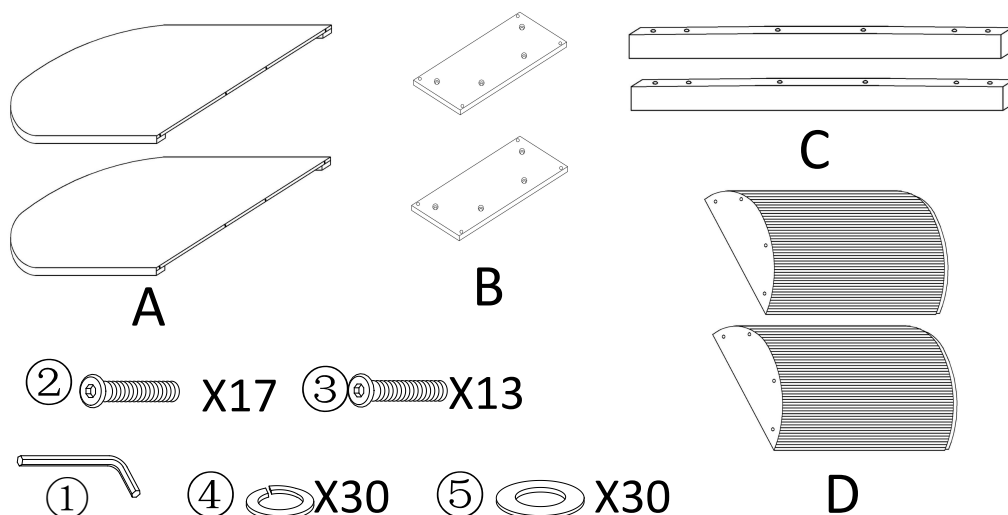

- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



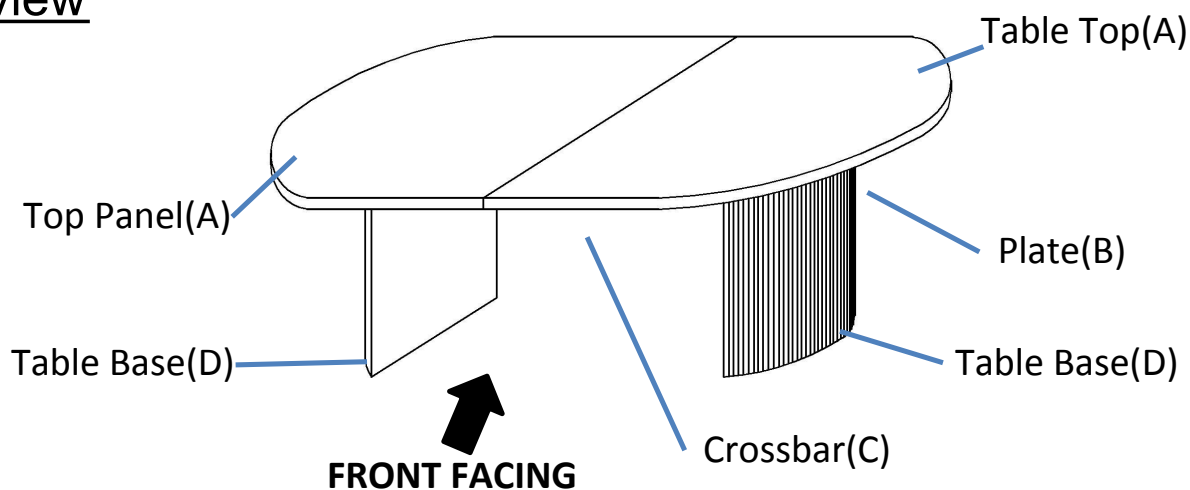
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

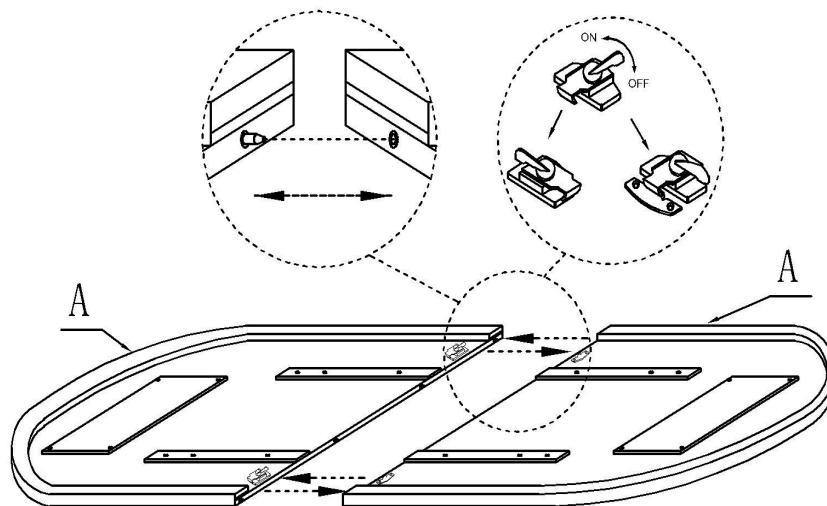
Assembly Steps

Overview



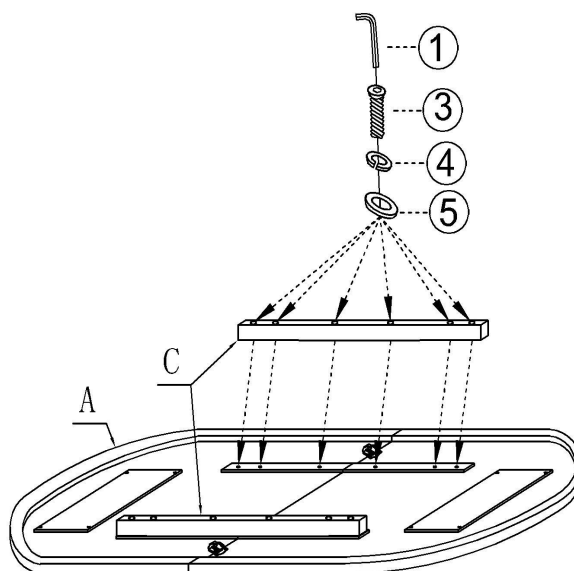
This Dining Table has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the **Dining Table** parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



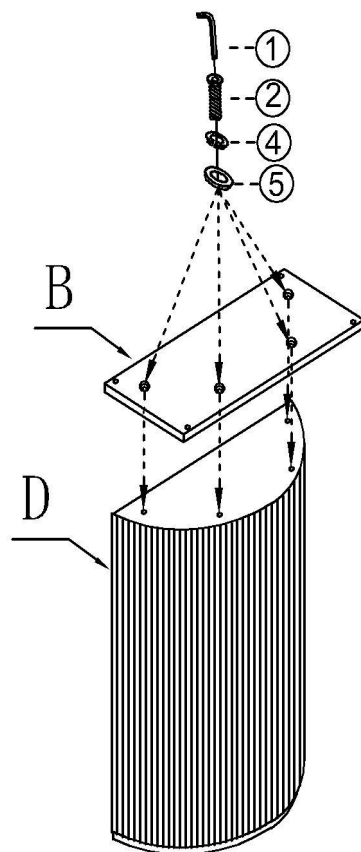
Please put the two Table Top (A) together as shown.
Place all parts on a clean, undamaged surface.

Step 2



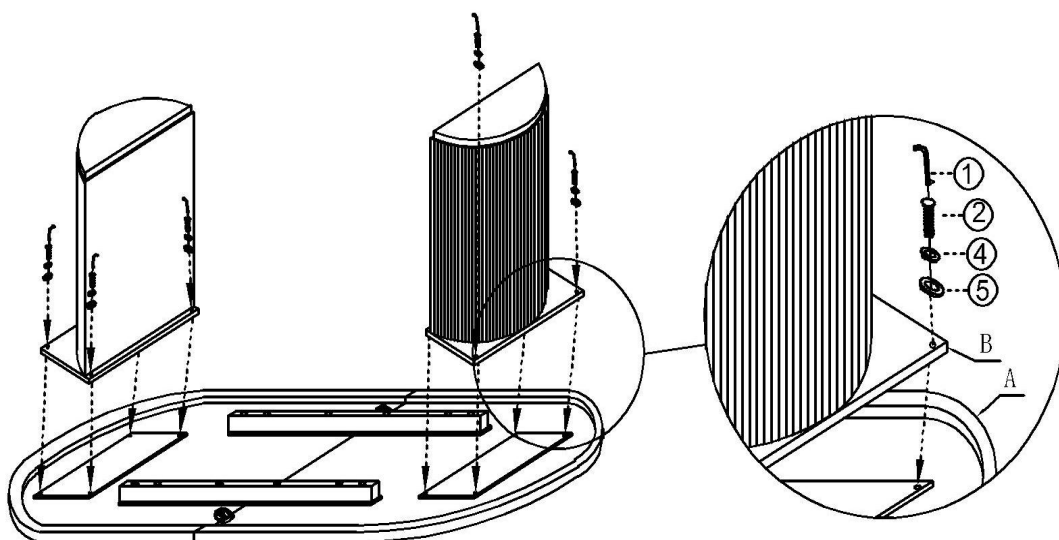
The bottom of the table top should be facing up as shown in the picture above. Use the Allen Wrench (①), Bolts (③), Spring Washers (④), and Flat Washers (⑤) to fix the Crossbar (C).

Step 3



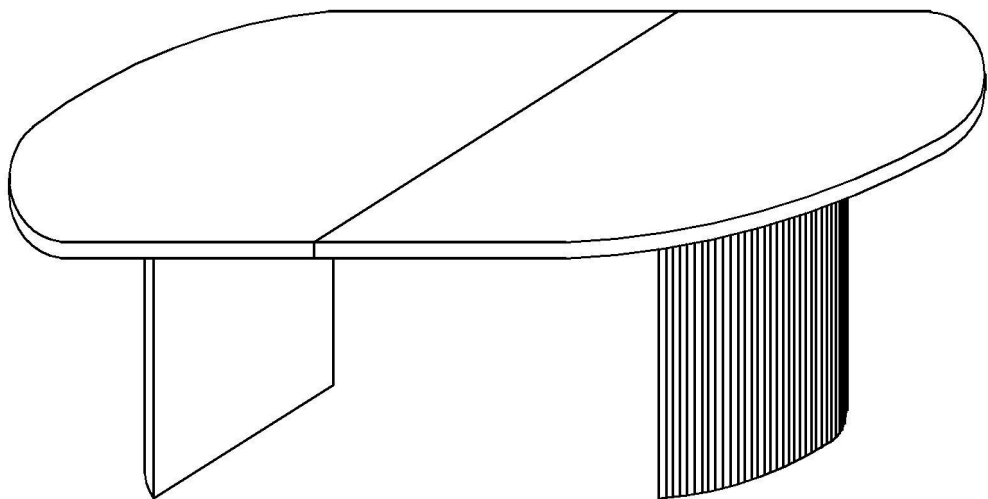
As shown in the picture: Please use the Allen Wrench (①) and Bolts (②), Spring Washers (④), Flat Washer (⑤) to fix the Plate (B) and the Table Base (D).

Step 4



As shown in the picture: Please use the hexagonal wrench (①), bolts (②), spring washers (④), and flat washers (⑤) to fix the Table Top (A) and Plate (B).

Step 5



Your Dining Table is ready for use.
This Dining Table should only be used on a flat, level surface.
