


ASSEMBLY TIPS:


- 1. Remove hardware from box and sort by size.

- 3. Please follow attached instructions in the same sequence as numbered to assure fast & easy assembly.





SAFETY WARNING

Our bunk beds have been tested by an independent laboratory and are certified to be in compliance with ASTMF-1427, "Standard Consumer Safety Specification for Bunk beds" and U.S. Government specifications 16 Code of Federal Regulations. Parts 1213 and 1513.

- 1. Follow the information on the warnings attached to the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. Do not remove this label.
- 2. Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
- 3. Surface of mattress must be at least five inches(127mm) below the upper edge of guardrails.
- 4. Do not allow children less than six years of age to use the upper bunk..
- 5. Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
- 6. Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their roper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- 7. Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
- 8. Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
- 9. Do not use substitute parts. Contact manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- 10. Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
- 11. If the bunk bed will be placed next to a wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entapment between the bde and the wall. (This applies only to bunk beds without two full-length guardrails).
- 12. Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk.
- 13. The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.
- 14. Keep these instructions for future reference.

STRANGULATION HAZARD:

15. Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed for example, but not limited to hooks, and jump ropes.

SIZE OF MATTRESS AND FOUNDATION

Use only mattress which is $37\ 1/2$ " $-38\ 1/2$ " in width and 74 " -75 " in length . The total thickness of mattress Combined must not exceed 6 " .

Note: There must be at least 5" from mattress sleeping surface to top edge of guardrail.

REPLACEMENT PARTS

Replacement parts, including additional guardrails may be obrained

TO HRLP PRLVENT SERIOUS OR FATAL INJURIES FROM ENTRAPMENT OR FALLS:

- 1. Never allow a child under 6 years on upper bunk.
- 2. Use only mattress which is 37 1/2" -38 1/2" width and 74" -75" iong on upper bunk.(twin size)
- 3. Ensure thickness of mattress and foundation combinde does not exceed 6" and mattress surface is at lease 5" belo upper edges of guardrails.
- 4. Use guardrails on both sides of upper bunk.
- 5. Prohibit horseplay on or under bed(s).
- 6. Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
- 7. Use ladder for entering and leaving upper bunk.
- 8. If the bunk bed will be placed next to a wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent enttapment between the bde and the wall.

9. Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed for example, but not limited to hooks, and jump ropes.

- When using the beds as two (2) separate floor-standing beds, the ladder MUST be stored in a separate location where children cannot use the ladder in any manner.
- DO NOT use, nor permit children to use, the ladder in any manner whatsoever, other than to access the top unit when used as bunk beds, and only if the ladder is securely attached to the top bunk rail, as set forth in the instructions.
