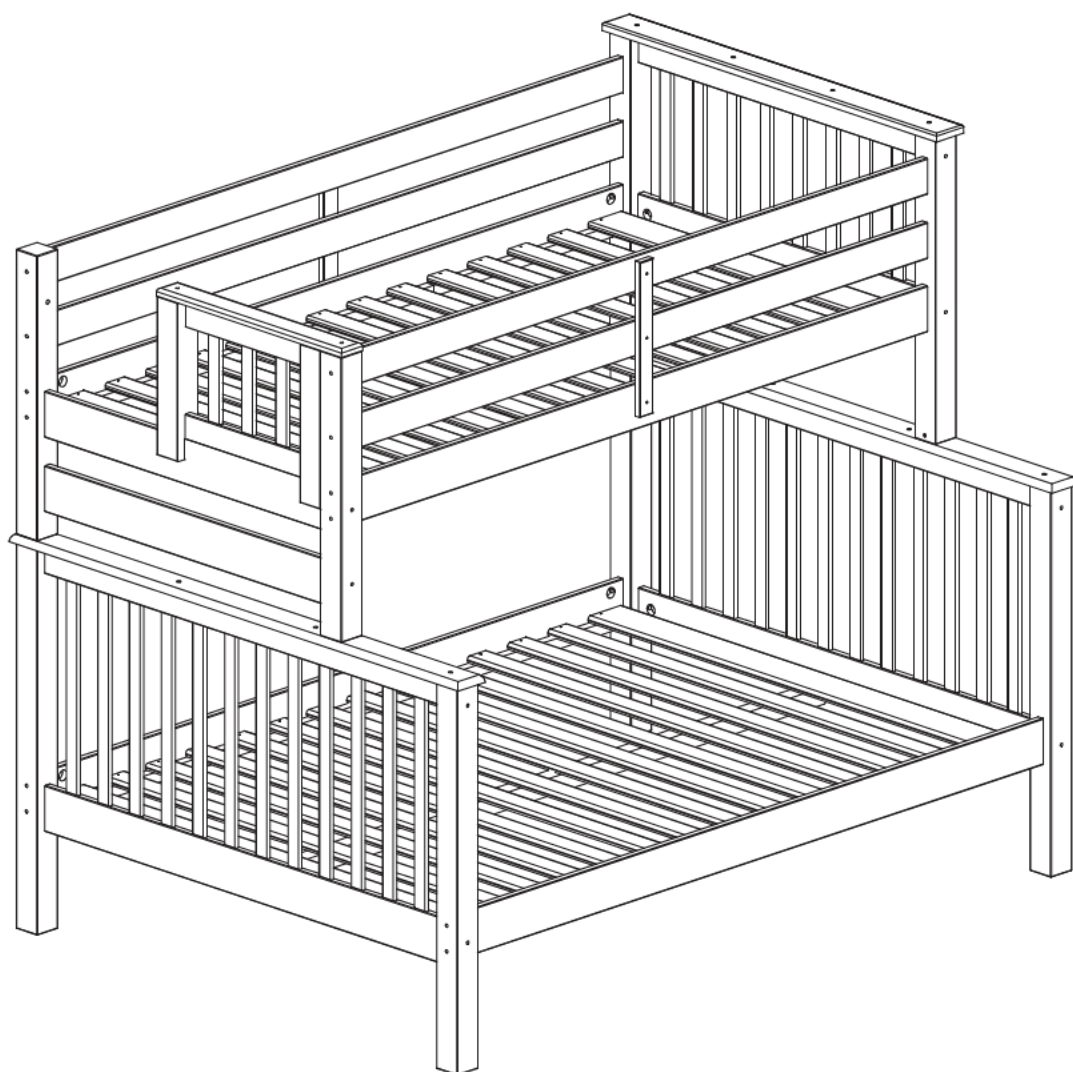


Twin over Full Solid Wood Standard Bunk Bed with Stairs, 4 Step Drawers and Trundle

Assembly Instructions



**READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE
ATTEMPTING TO ASSEMBLE THIS BED**

SAFETY WARNINGS AND GENERAL NOTES

- ✓ Follow the information on the warning labels on the upper bunk bed structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from the bed.
- ✓ Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
- ✓ The top surfaces of the mattress must be at least 5" below the upper edge of the guardrails.
- ✓ **Do not** allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
- ✓ **Prohibit** more than one person on the upper bunk.
- ✓ Periodically check and ensure that the guardrails, ladder and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- ✓ **Do not** allow horseplay on or under the bed. Always prohibit jumping on the bed.










WARNING

Use only mattresses which are 74" long and 37 1/2" x 53 1/2" wide on upper bunk. Use only mattresses which are 74" long and 53 1/2" x 53 1/2" wide on lower bunk. Ensure thickness of mattress and foundation combined does not exceed 9" and mattress is at least 9" below upper edge of guardrail. **DO NOT REMOVE THIS LABEL.**

Use guardrails on both sides of upper bunk. Push to forward on or under bed. Push to rear when one person on upper bunk. Use ladder for entering and leaving upper bunk. **STRANGULATION HAZARD** Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed. Not for use with the bed for example but not limited to: beds, ladders and jump ropes.

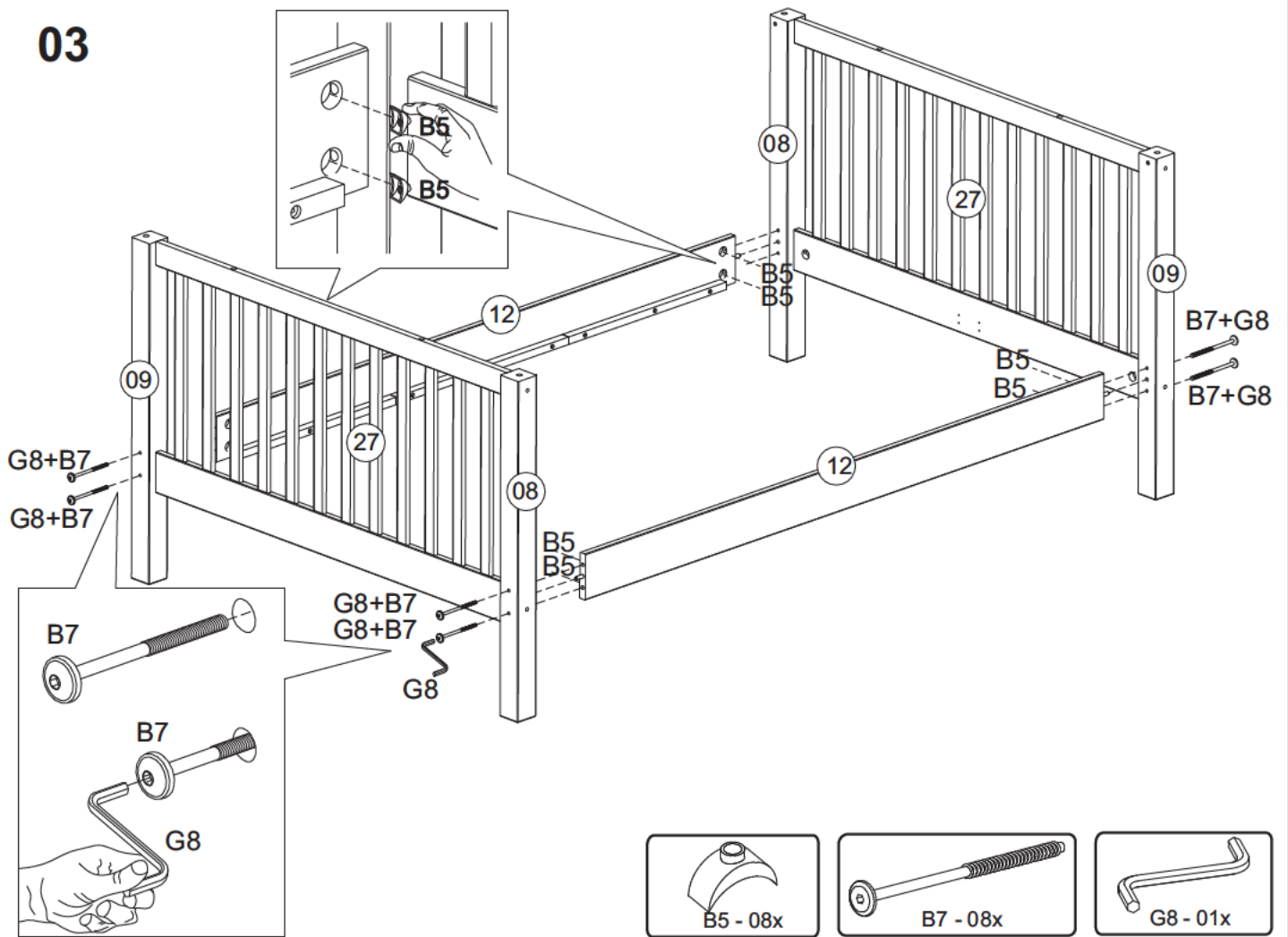
