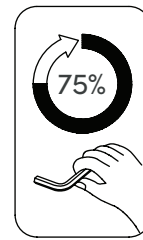


IMPORTANT

1. Do not tighten bolts / screws completely until all bolts / screws are lined up and inserted into holes.
2. Do not over tighten screws and bolts to avoid stripping.
3. Please use hand tools to assemble this product. Do not use power tools.

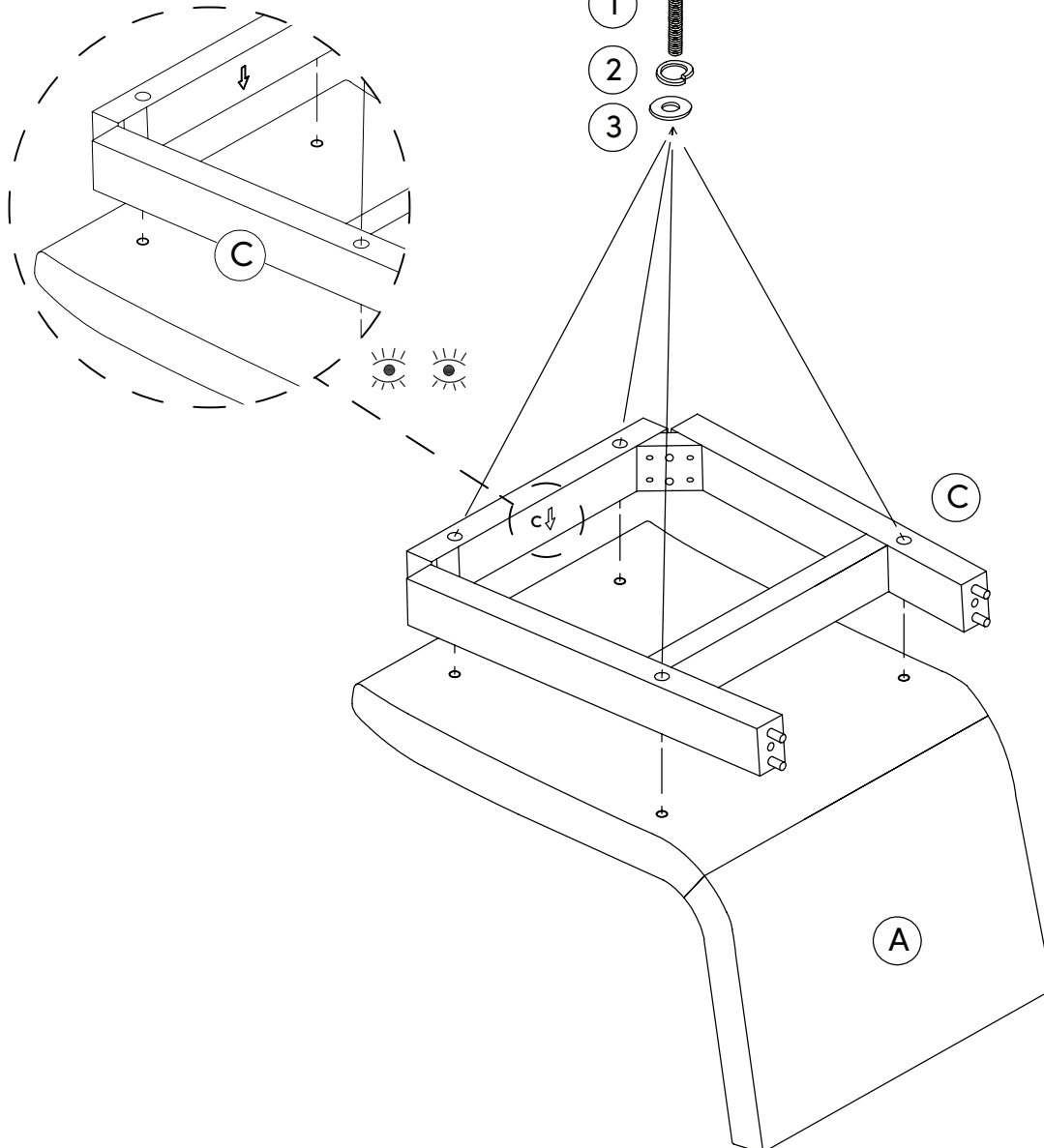
Step 1

It's as easy as it looks! Secure the Seat Cushion (A) to the Seat Frame (C) using the $\frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{8}$ inch Hex Button Head Bolts (1). Tighten using the provided Allen Key (4). We told you this was going to be easy!



Do NOT overtighten hardware.
Tighten only to 75% for now.

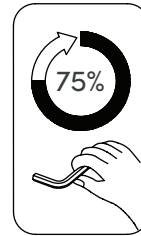
IMPORTANT NOTE:
Locate the arrow label on the Seat Frame (C) & be sure it is pointing towards the underside of the Seat Cushion (A).



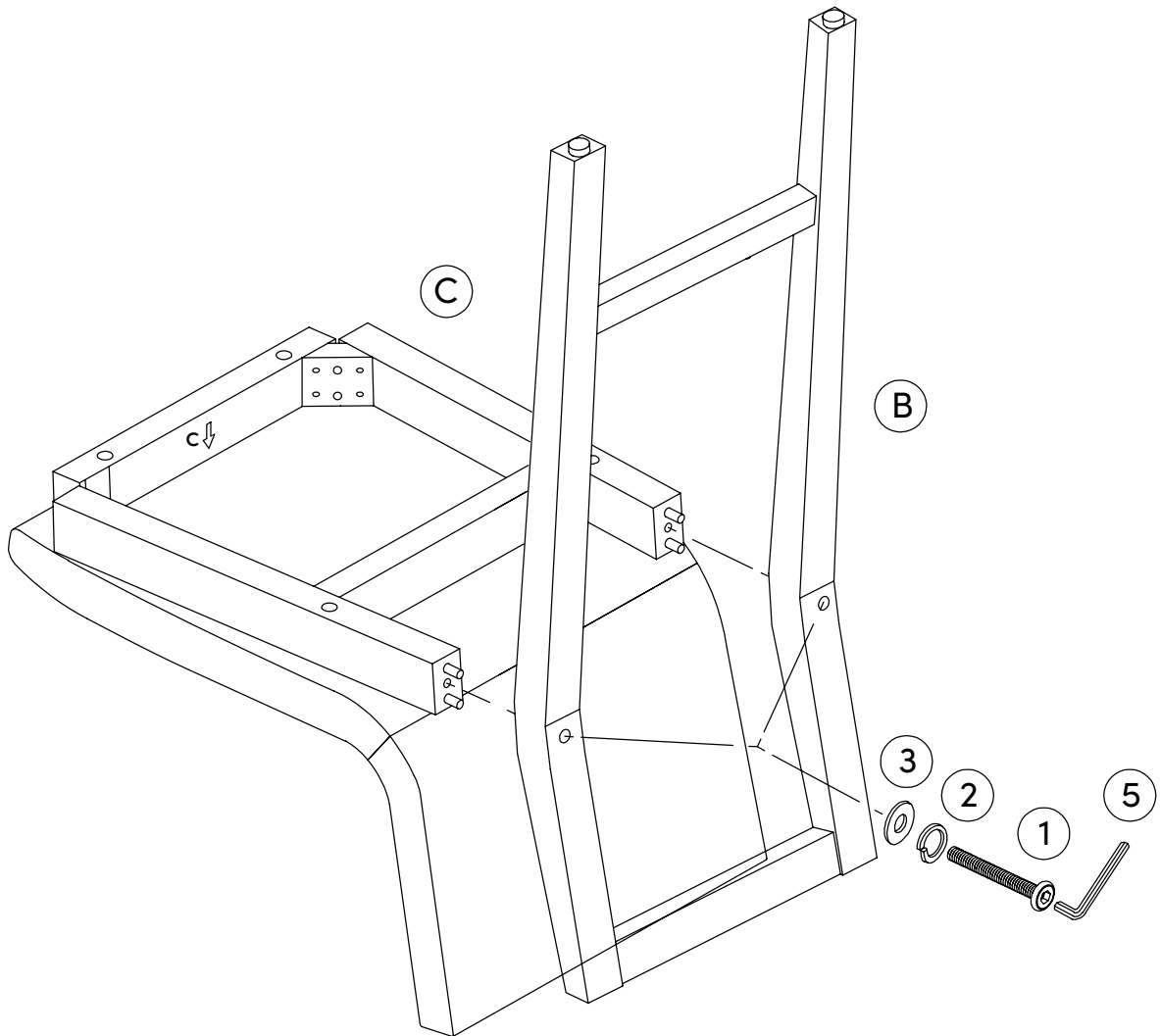
Step 2

Now take a moment to match the sticker on the bottom of the Chair Back (B) with the sticker on the corner block.

Attach the Chair Back (B) to the Frame Seat (C) using the $\frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{8}$ inch Hex Button Head Bolts (1). First place the $\frac{1}{4}$ inch Flat Washer (3), then the $\frac{1}{4}$ inch Lock Washer (2), then the $\frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{8}$ inch Hex Button Head Bolt (1). Tighten using the Allen Key (4).



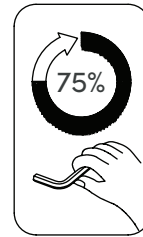
Do NOT overtighten hardware.
Tighten only to 75% for now.



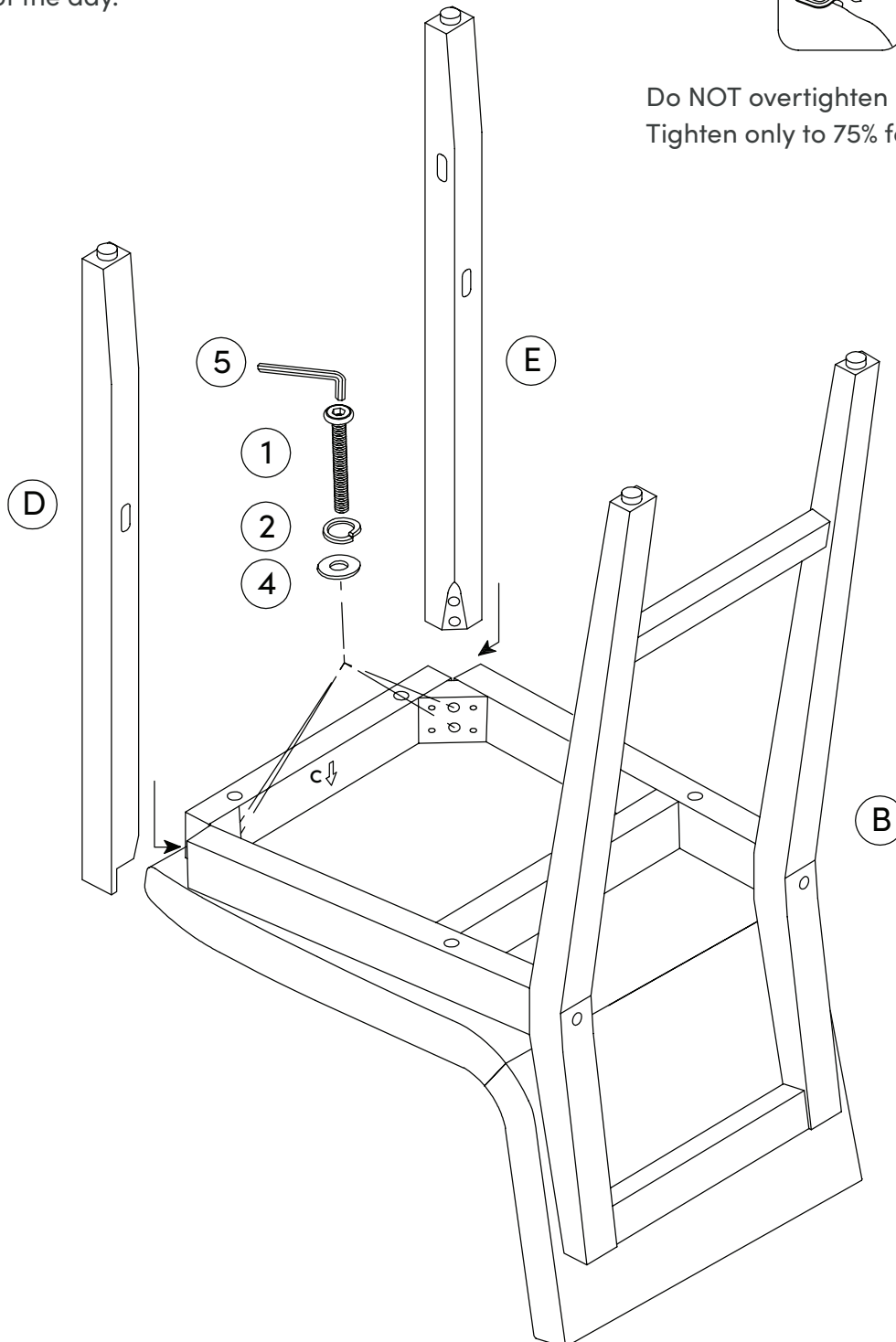
Step 3

Now let's secure those
Legs (D)(E) in place!

Tighten only to 75% for now.



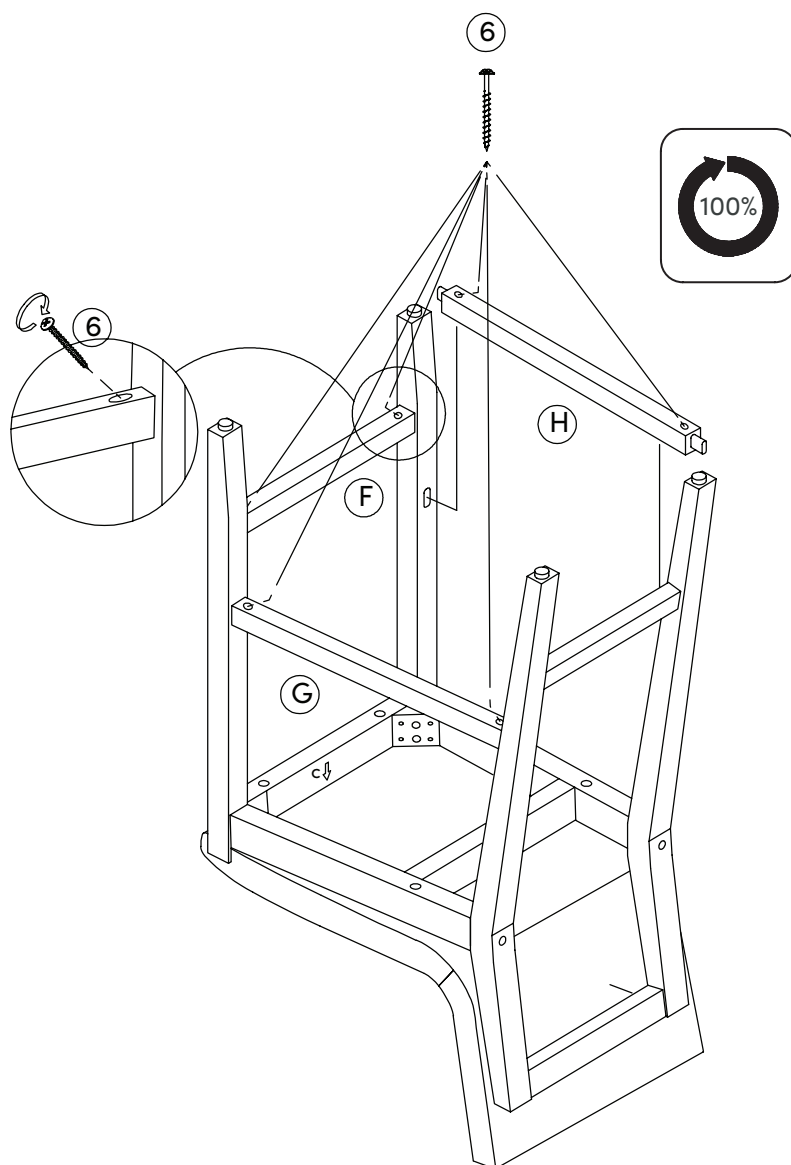
Step 4

Match the sticker on the bottom of the Front Chair Legs (D)(E) with the sticker on the corner blocks before tightening hardware.

If you are having trouble getting the screws to catch, it is recommended to carefully use an electric screwdriver or drill with necessary bit for this step.



Do not over-tighten; holes may become stripped.

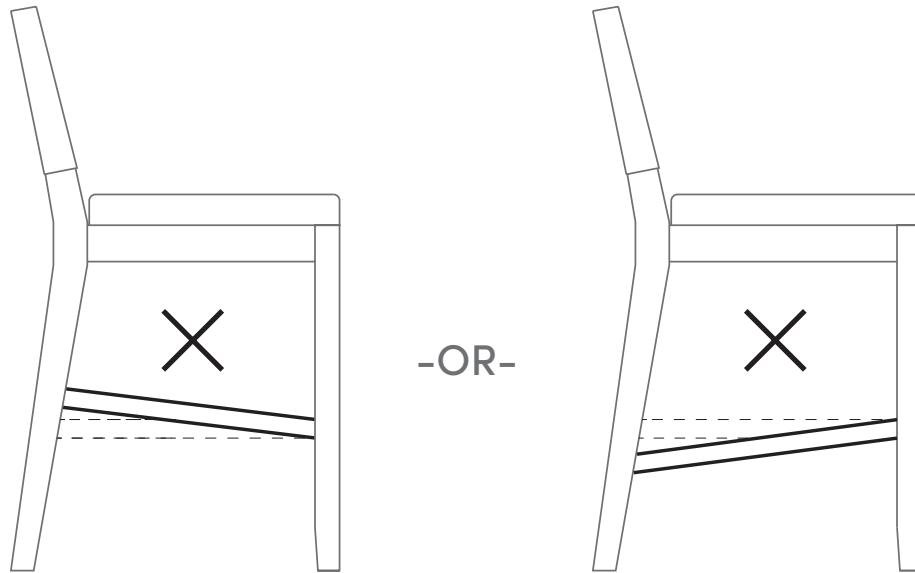


IMPORTANT NOTE:

Front Legs are not interchangeable.

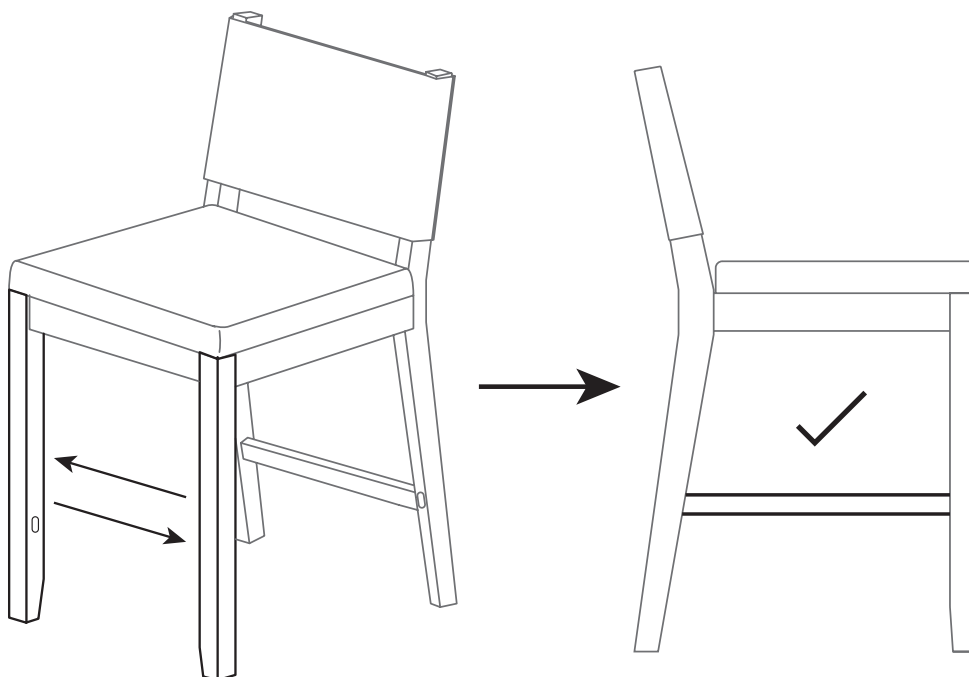
Issues with stretchers aligning at an angle?

If the stretchers are set at an angle when you are aligning them with their respective holes on the front & back legs, **you have likely assembled the front legs incorrectly.**



Re-check to confirm that the proper legs are installed in their intended position on the proper side of the stool.

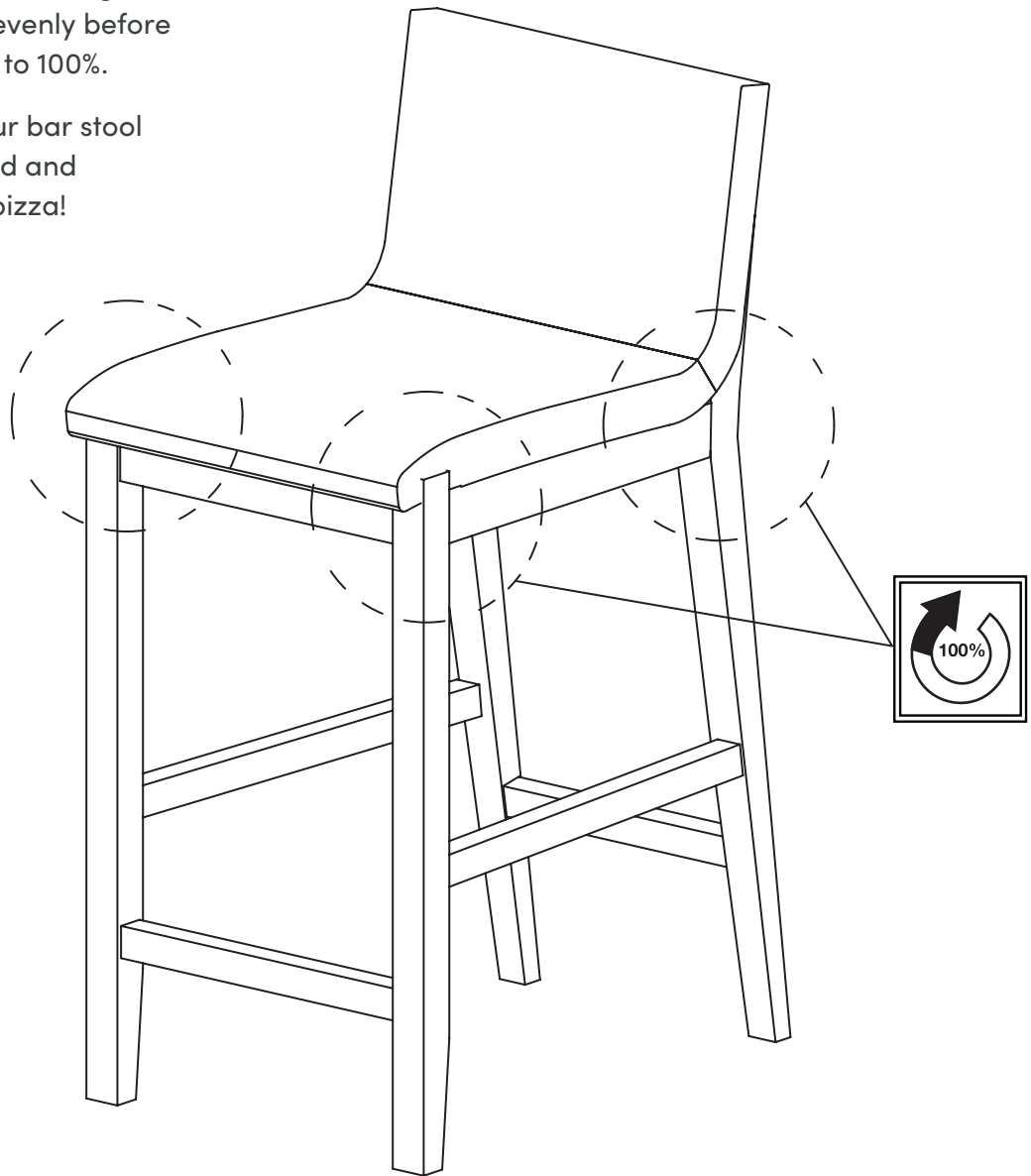
The front legs are not interchangeable; therefore they may need to be rotated and swapped to the opposite side.



Step 5

Carefully flip the stool over on a flat surface and make sure the legs are touching the ground evenly before tightening everything to 100%.

You did it! Go tuck your bar stool into your kitchen island and celebrate with some pizza!



If your stool feels a little wobbly or unstable,
re-address all fasteners to ensure they are 100% tightened.

If your stool STILL feels a little wobbly or unstable,
try loosening some of the fastener connections slightly in order to allow yourself to re-level all the legs on a flat surface before going back around & re-tightening everything back to 100%.

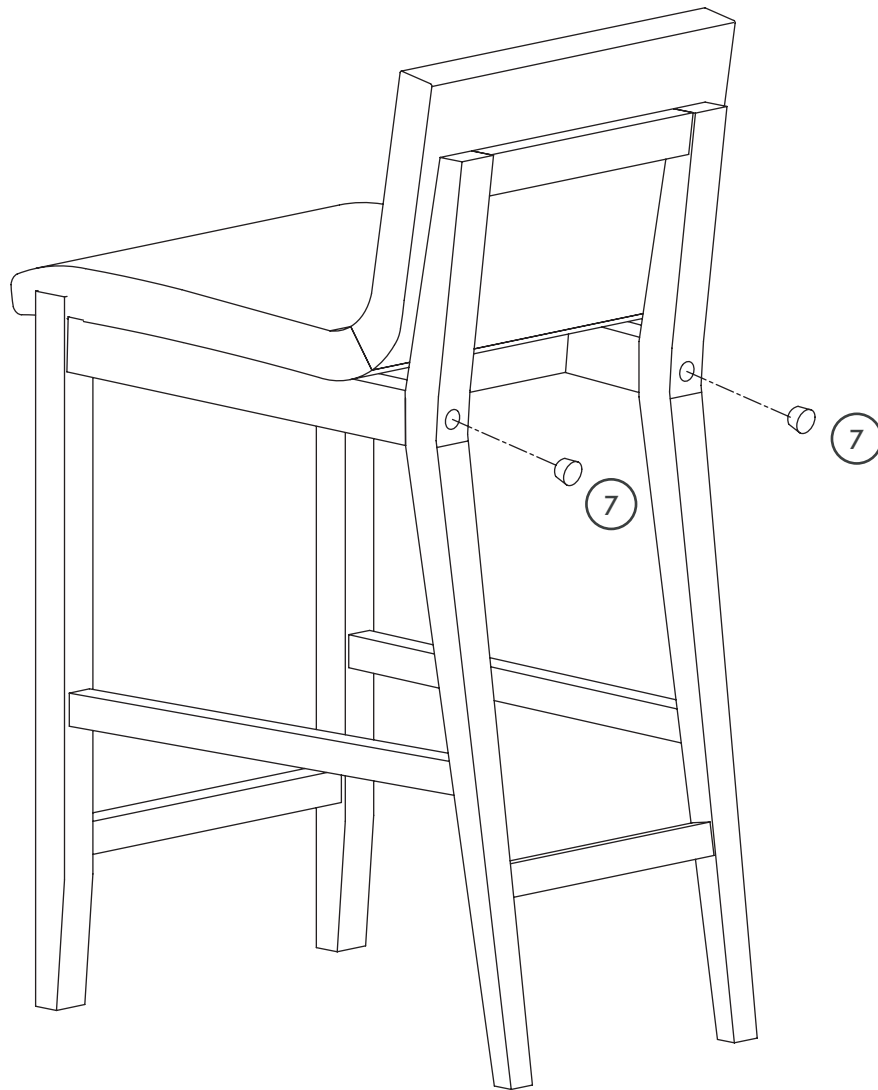


We want your bar stool to last as long as possible, so we recommend that you tighten the screws 2 weeks after assembly and for added safety check the tightness of all screws every 2 months.

Step 6

You made it to the last step! Now insert the Wood Plugs (6) into the holes in the back of the stool.
