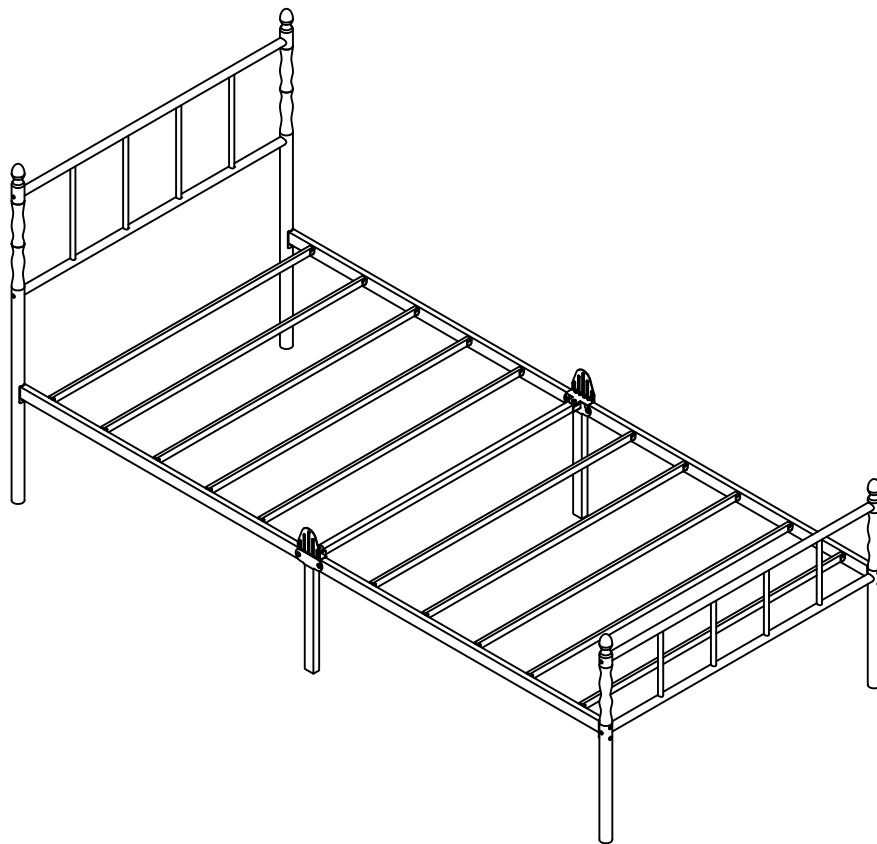


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

PLEASE READ BEFORE ASSEMBLY

Read Before Beginning Assembly

- 1. Clearing a area:** Please assemble in a spacious area near the product's final location, preferably on a carpet or protected surface to safeguard both your floor and the product.
- 2. Recommend team assembling:** It is recommended that at least 2 people assemble this product. Having an extra hand can make the process faster easier.
- 3. Check for all parts:** Most parts are labeled or stamped on the raw edge. Ensure all parts are included before starting.
- 4. Read each step carefully:** Follow the assembly steps in the correct order. Skipping steps or changing the sequence can lead to difficulties.
- 5. Tighten after complete:** Do not fully tighten any bolts before the entire assembly is completed. Final tightening all together ensures greater stability.
- 6. You can contact us:** If you encounter any questions or difficulties during installation, please contact us through marketplace.

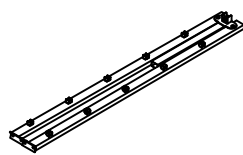
Caution

- 2. Use power tools with caution:** Overloading or improper operation of power tools can strip or damage parts and void the warranty.

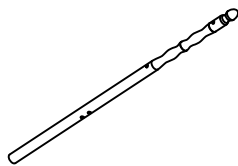
Warranty Information

- 3.** Not valid for misuse, improper assembly, alterations, or unauthorized repairs. No liability for consequential damages where permitted by law.

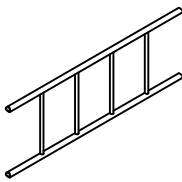

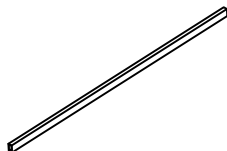

Step 1

Assemble the Headboard Bracket and the Headboard Posts

- Connect the Headboard brackets ⑤ and the Headboard posts ④ with bolts (I) washers (J).

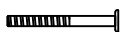
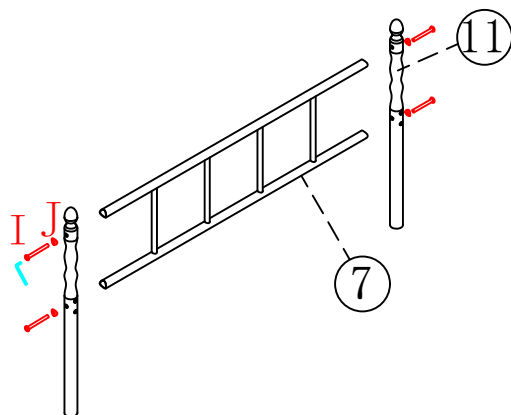

Assemble the Footboard Bracket and the Footboard Posts

- Connect the Footboard brackets ⑦ and the Footboard posts ⑪ with bolts (I) washers (J).

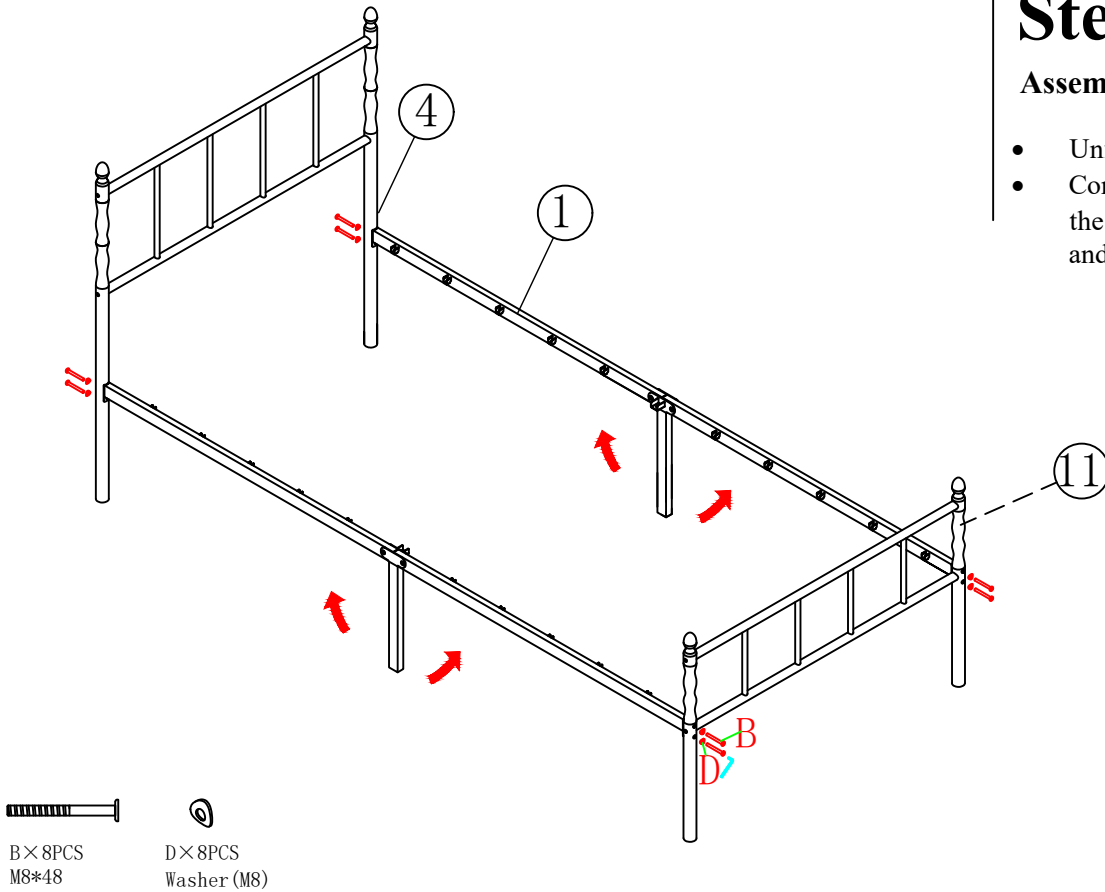

Step 3

Assemble the Side Brackets

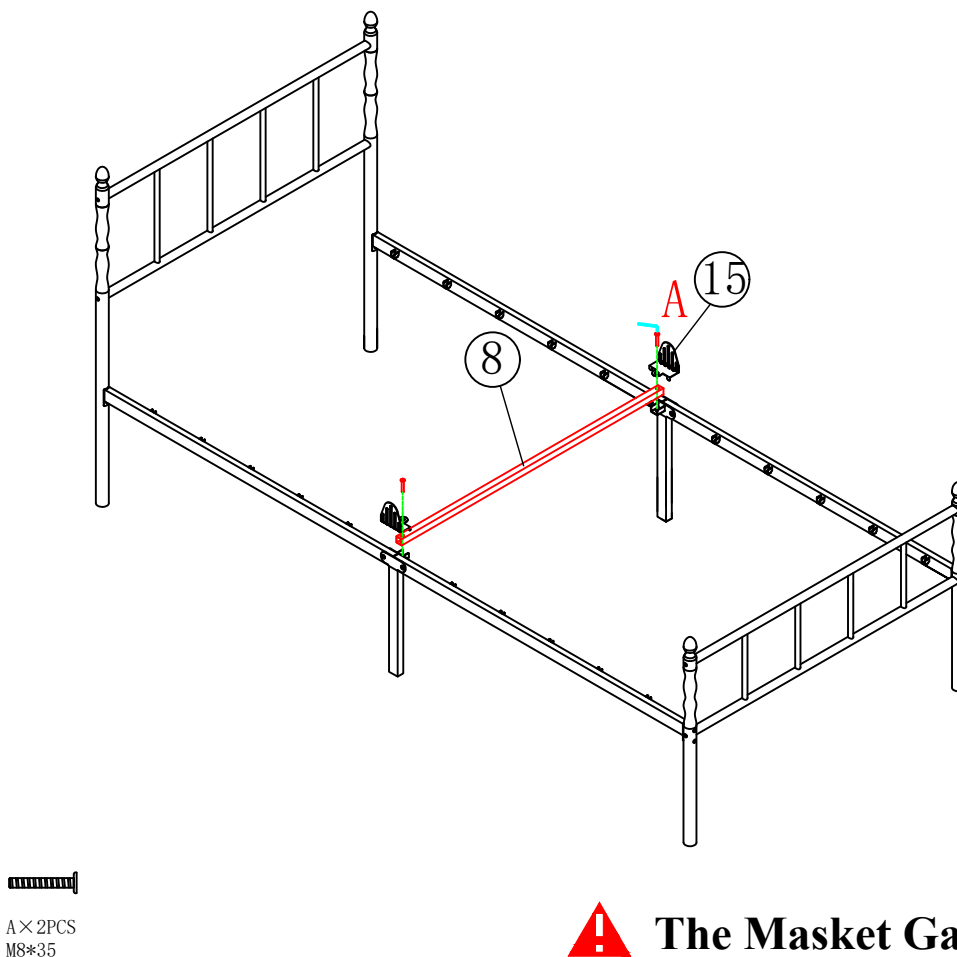
- Unfold the side brackets ①.
- Connect the side brackets ① and the bed posts ④&⑪ with bolts (B) and washers (D).



Step 4

Assemble the Center Support Bar

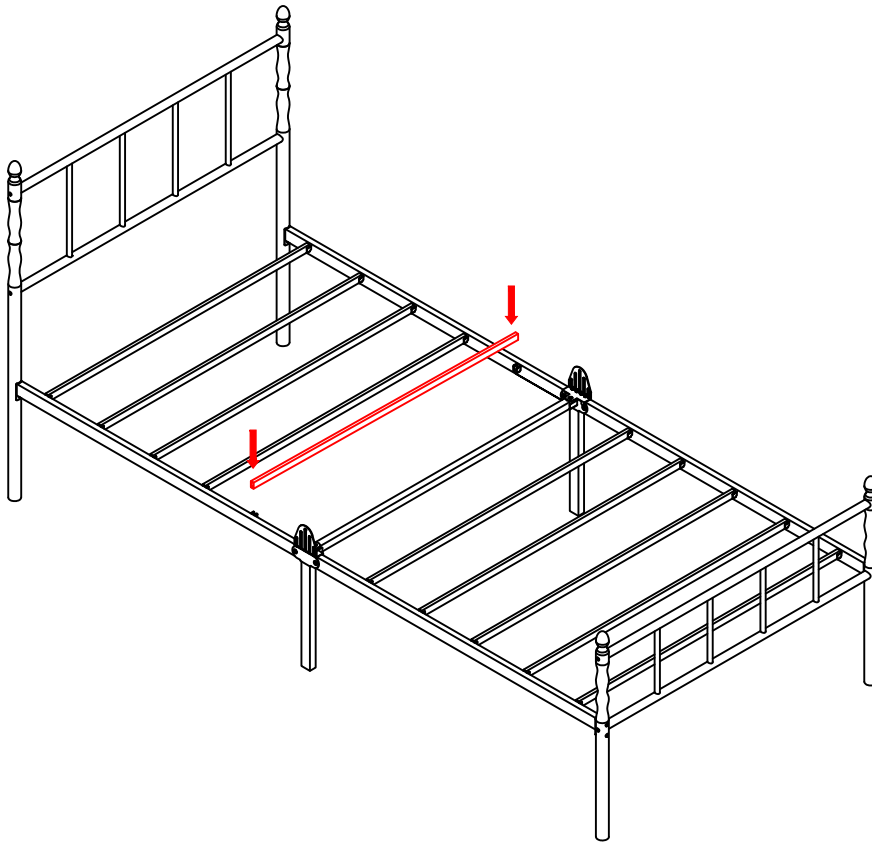
- Assemble the center support bar ⑧ and the mattress gaskets ⑮ with bolts (A) as shown in the figure.



The Masket Gaskets ⑮ are Optional.

Step 5

Install the Slats as shown.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Warning

- 1. Age Restriction:** The bed is not designed for children under 4 years old.
- 2. For your safety:** Jumping, rough play, or other vigorous activities on the bed are not recommended as they may cause injury or damage to the bed frame.
- 3. Weight Limit:** The maximum combined weight on the bed should not exceed 1000 lbs. This includes the weight of the bed itself, mattresses, bedding, and people.
- 4. Do not drag or push the bed frame:** Always use two people to lift and reposition the bed frame to avoid damage to the frame or the floor.

Cleaning & Care

- 1. Cleaning method:** Use a dry or slightly damp soft cloth for cleaning. Avoid abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- 2. Hardware maintenance:** Over time, hardware can loosen. Regularly check and tighten all connections to maintain the bed's stability and prevent damage.
