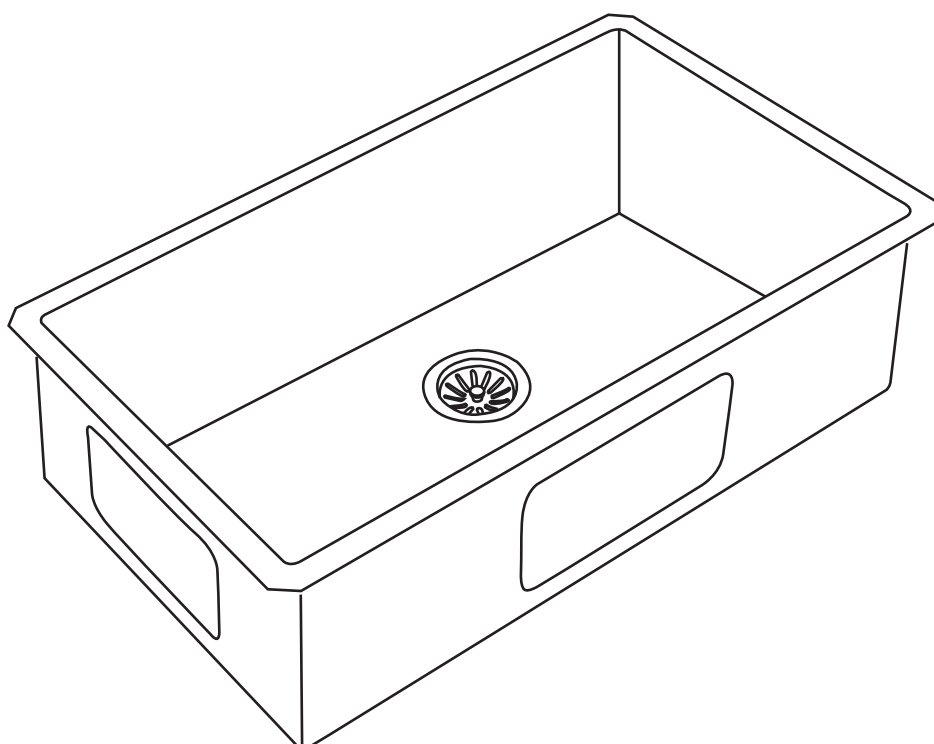

• Cleaning and care

- Clean your sink on a regular basis with warm soapy water. Rinse the sink after using cleaning products. Wipe the sink surface with a soft cloth to remove any liquid residue.
- Do not cut food directly on the surface of the sink. Do not leave sharp objects on the surface of the sink for an extended period of time.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning products, sanding tools, steel wool or bleaching products as use of such products may affect product performance or void the warranty.

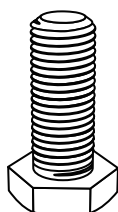
Cut-out Template

B Mounting Bracket

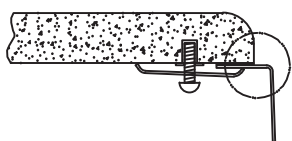

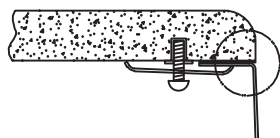
Step 1: Determine Reveal Type

- Use scissors to cut along the line of the paper template for your desired reveal type. (Positive or Flushed Reveal)

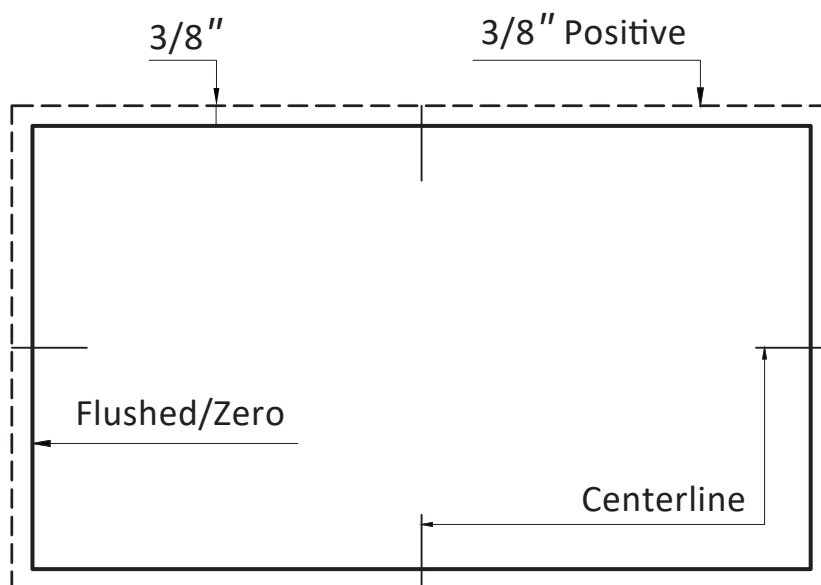
Recommended Installation Type



3/8" Positive Reveal



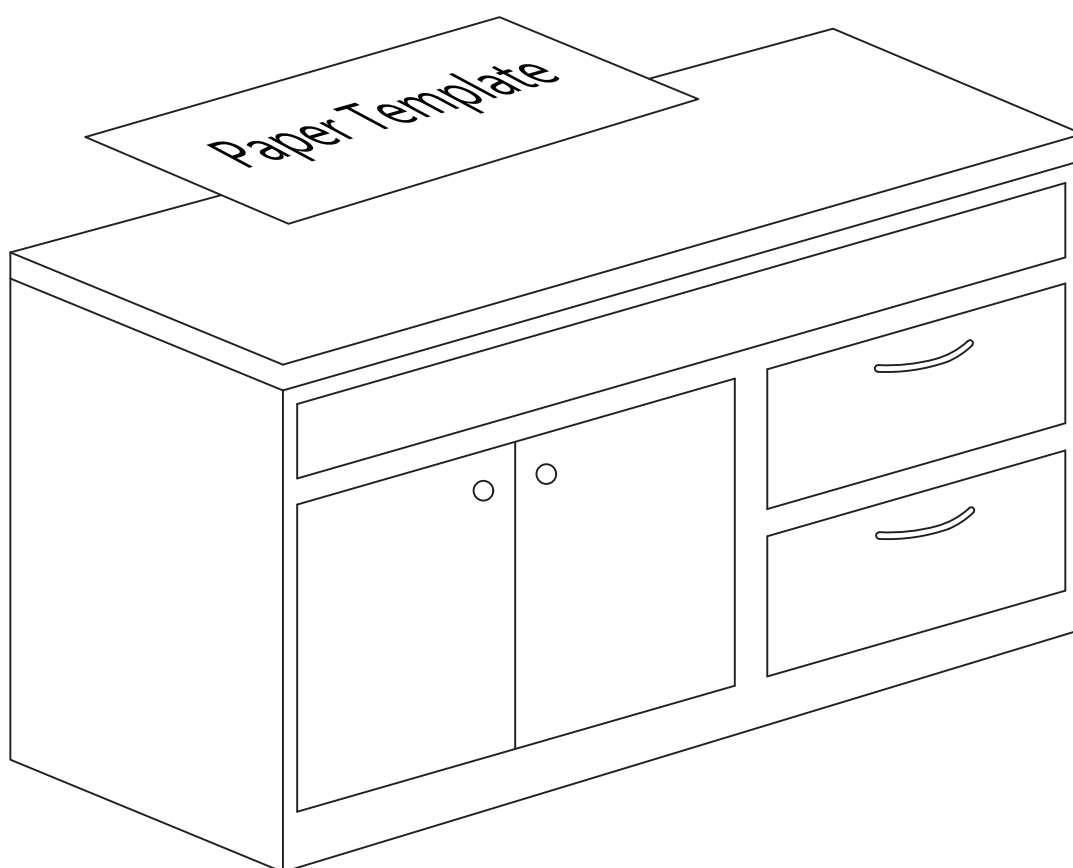
Flushed/Zero Reveal



NOTICE: It is strongly suggested that you contact a professional countertop fabricator when installing the sink as an undermount.

Step 2: *Position Template*

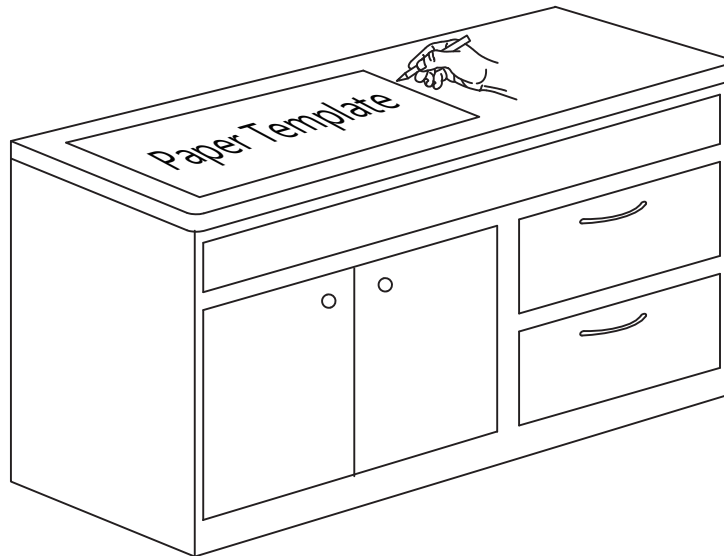
- *Check the cut-out template against the actual sink to ensure a proper sized cut-out.*
- *Place the cut-out template in the desired location on the countertop.*



NOTICE: Make sure clearance is suitable for backsplash, faucet and plumbing for the sink.

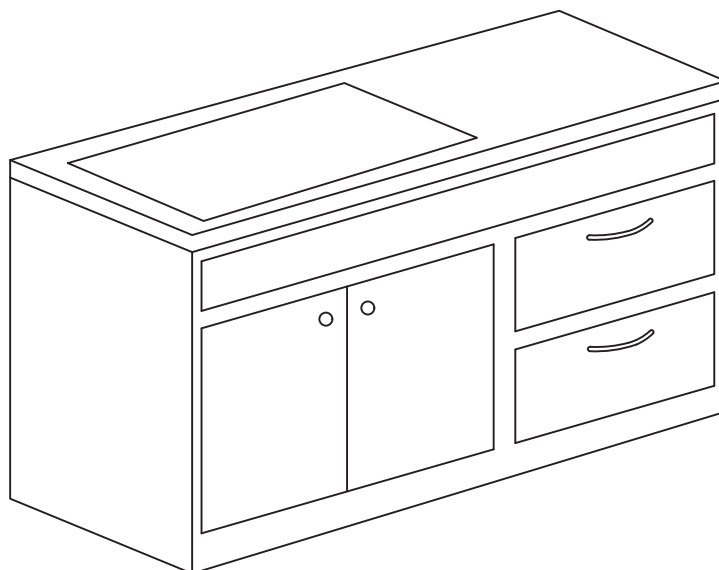
Step 3: Trace Template

- Trace template on countertop with a pencil.

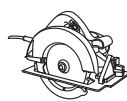
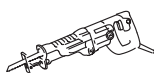


Step 4: Cut Countertop

- Cut the opening in the countertop by carefully following the traced line.



NOTICE: Please use the appropriate saw that best fits your countertop material.

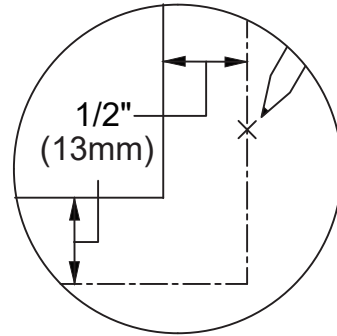
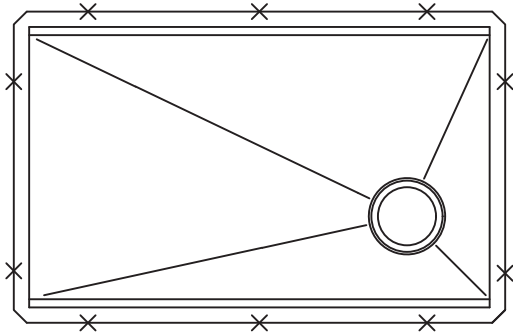

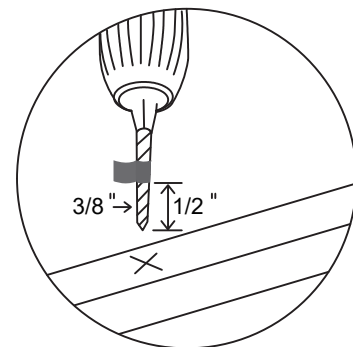
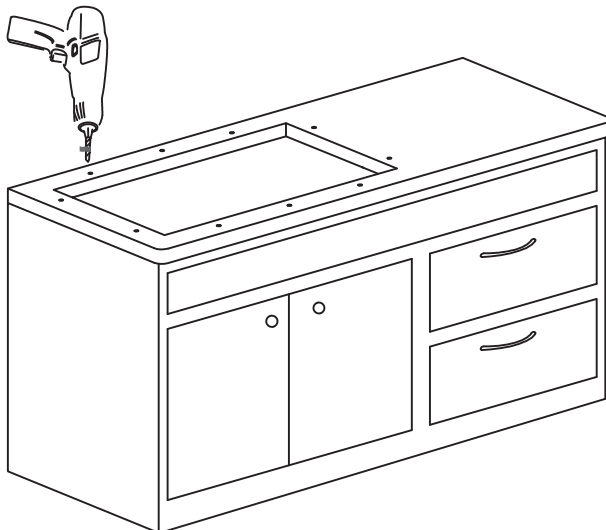
Step 5: Set up Mounting Brackets

- Turn countertop over and align sink with countertop. Decide location for mounting brackets.
- Mounting holes should be $\frac{1}{2}$ " from edge of sink.



Step 6: Drill Hole in Countertop

- Drill $\frac{3}{8}$ " diameter x $\frac{1}{2}$ " deep hole in the countertop.
- Mark $\frac{1}{2}$ " deep on your drill bit. And you can place a piece of tape above the mark, when the tape hits the surface of your countertop, you've drilled deep enough.

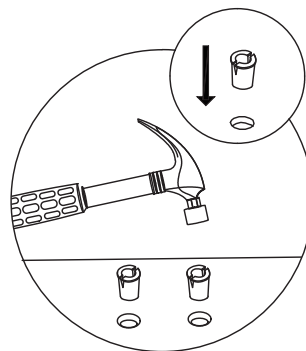
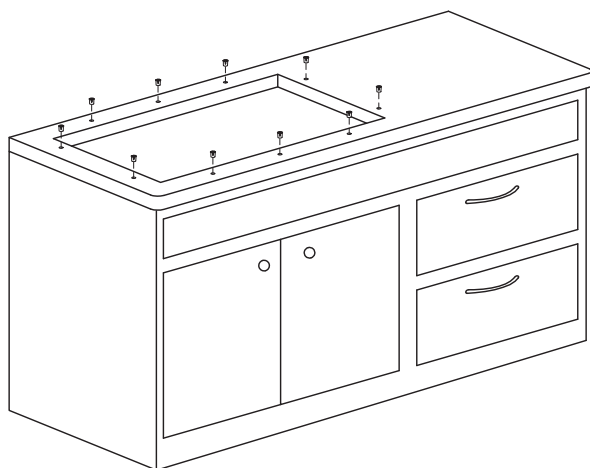

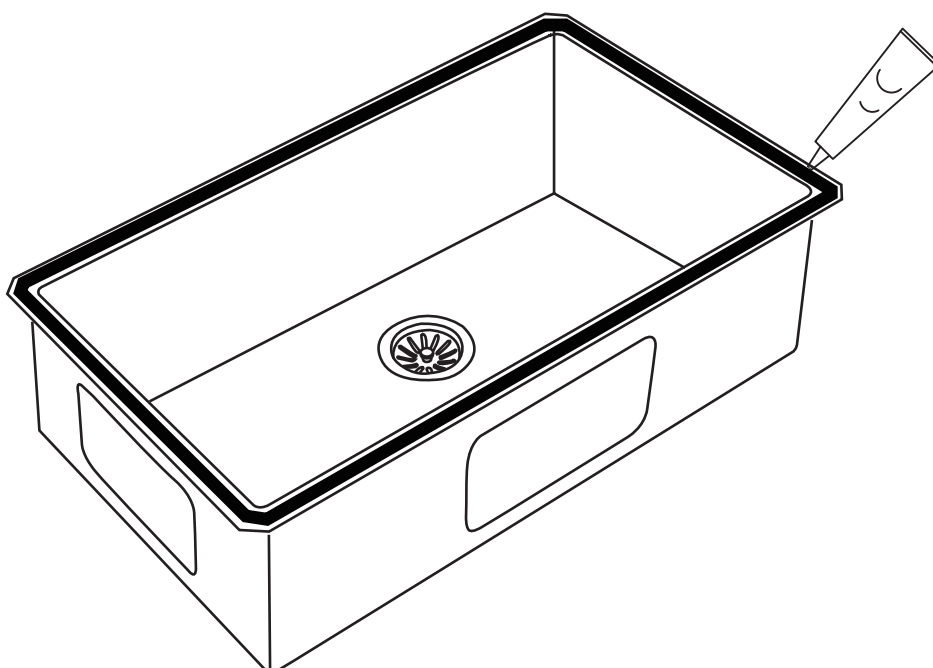
Step 7: *Install Anchors*

- *Insert anchors (A) into drilled holes and lightly tap with a hammer until flush.*



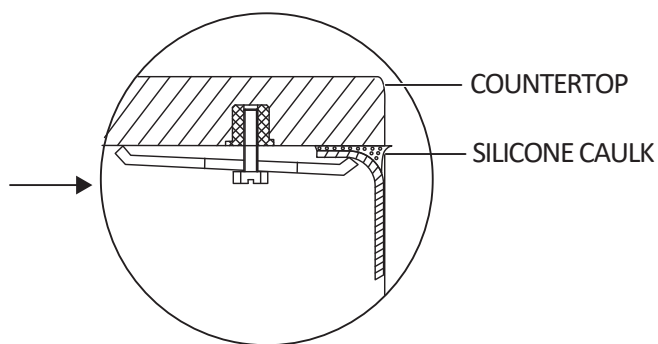
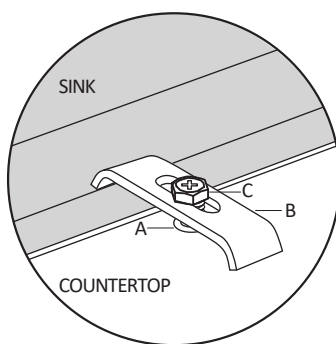
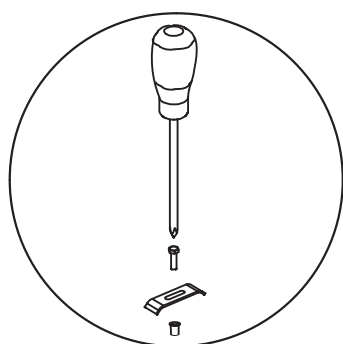
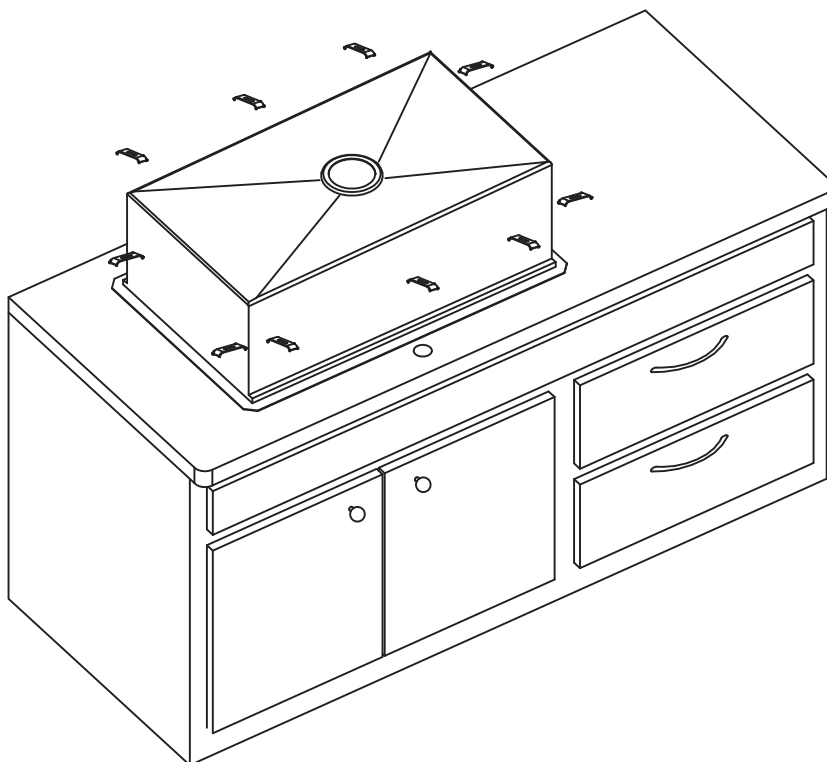
Step 8: *Secure Sink to Countertop*

- *Use a bead of silicone (or preferred adhesive) around the rim of the sink. Check the alignment of the sink to the cutout in the countertop. Place sink over cutout hole and press firmly.*



Step 9: *Attach Mounting Hardware*

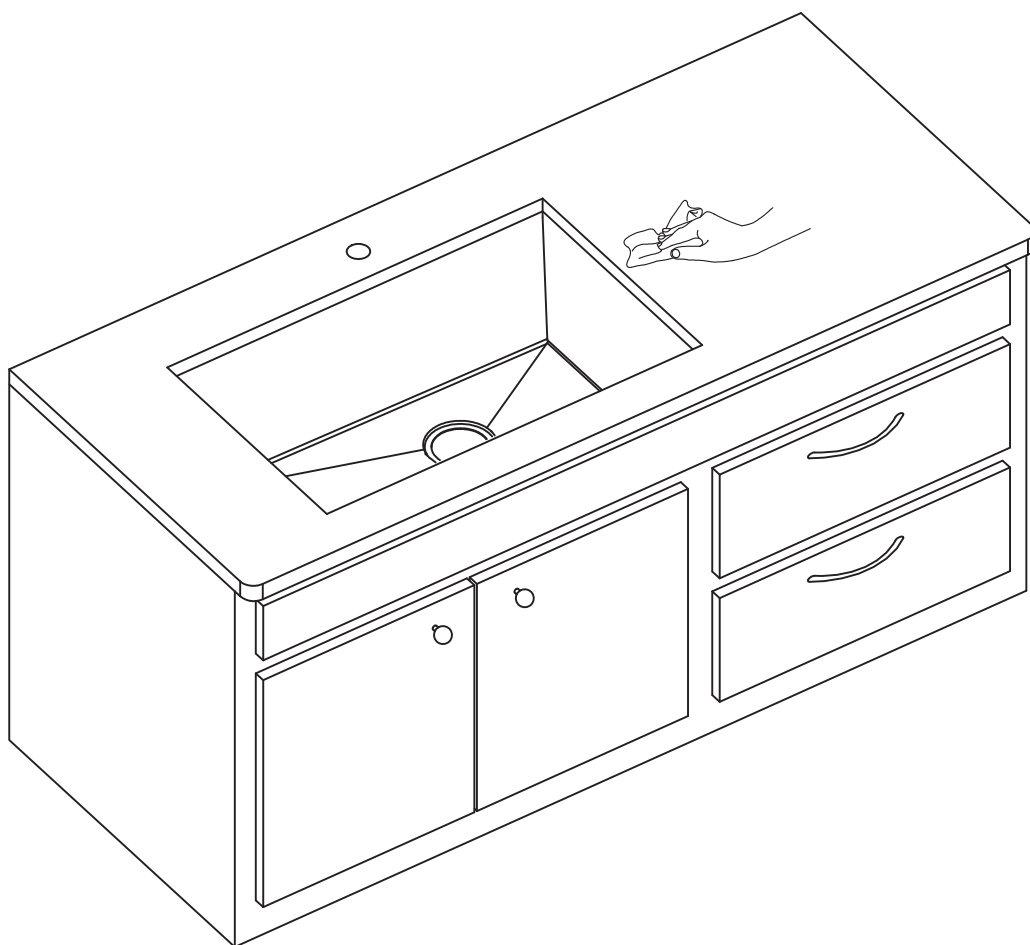
- *Attach mounting bracket (B) and screw (C) to secure sink. Remove excess sealant from inside lip.*
- *Allow sealant to set for 30 - 60 minutes.*



NOTICE: Use acetone or rubbing alcohol to remove any excess sealant.

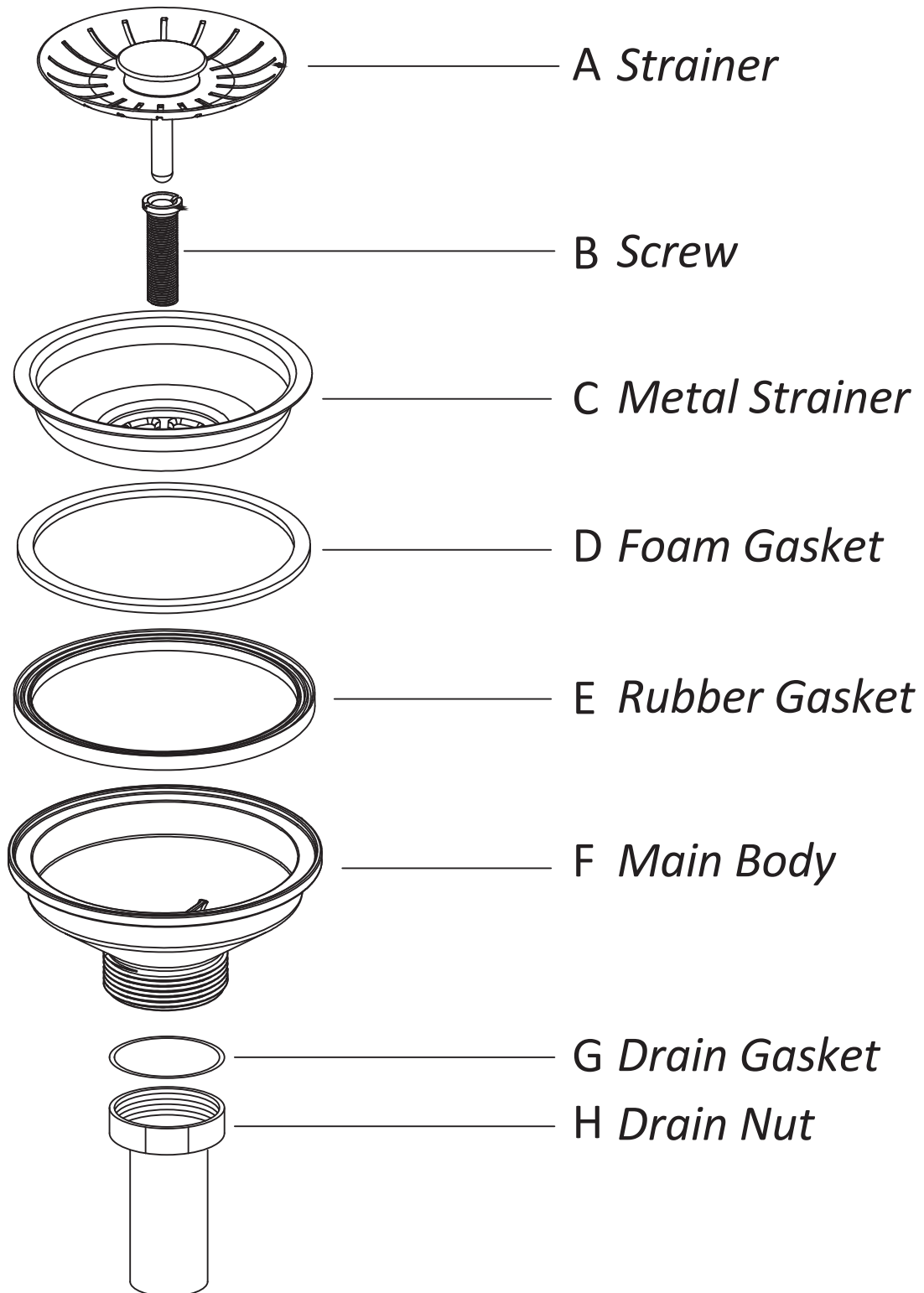
Step 10: *Install Plumbing Fixtures*

- *Connect drain to sink. Connect trap to drain. Connect water supply connections to faucet according to manufacturer's instructions.*
- *Run water into sink and check for leaks.*



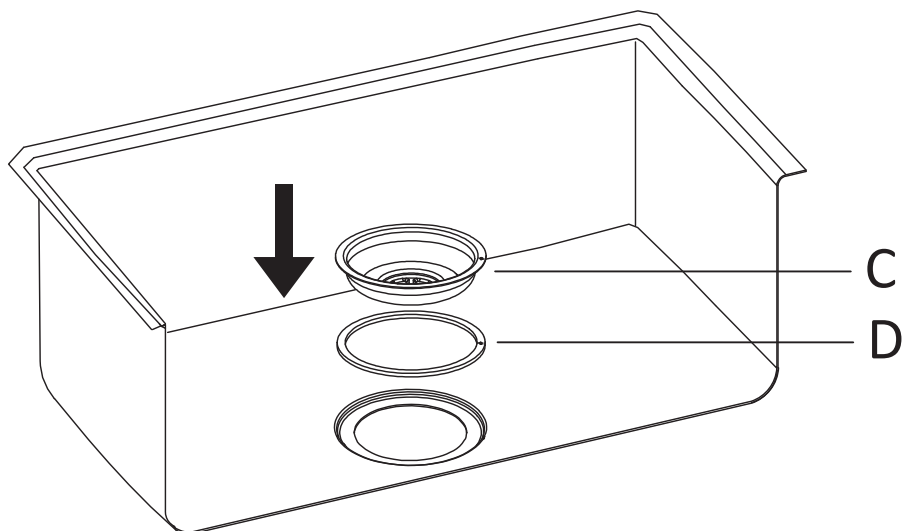
STRAINER INSTALLATION

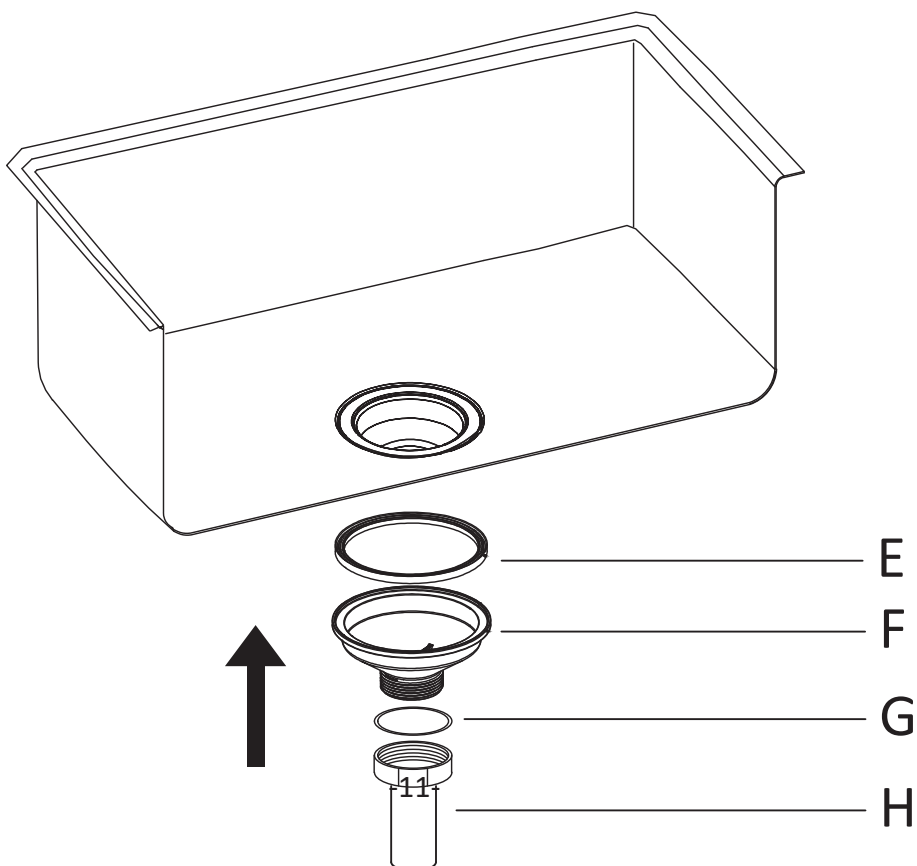
Step 1:

- Insert metal strainer (C) into drain hole with foam gasket (D) attached.



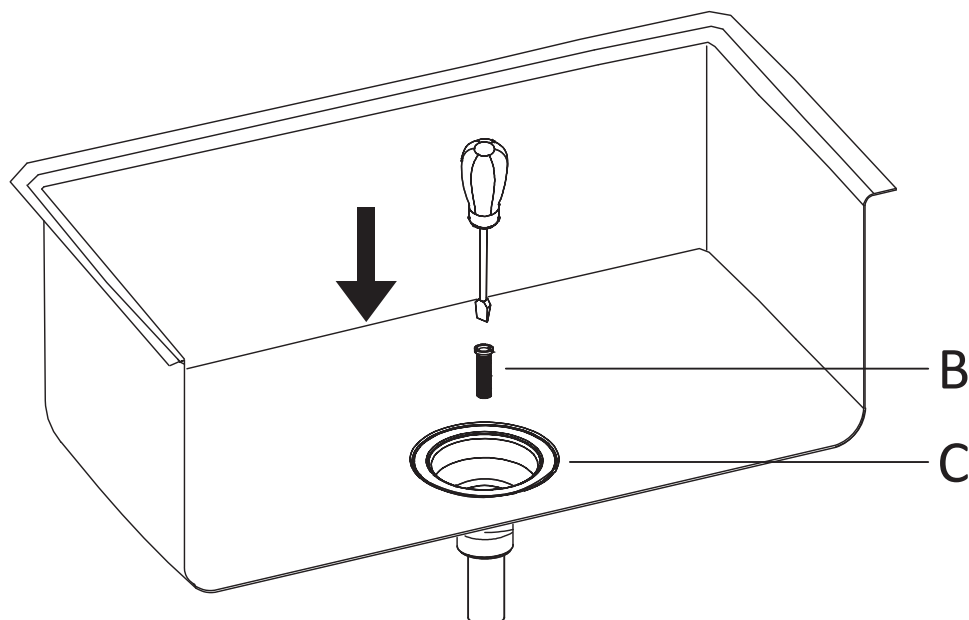
Step 2:

- Place the rubber gasket (E), main body (F), drain gasket (G), and drain nut (H) under the drain hole in the sink.



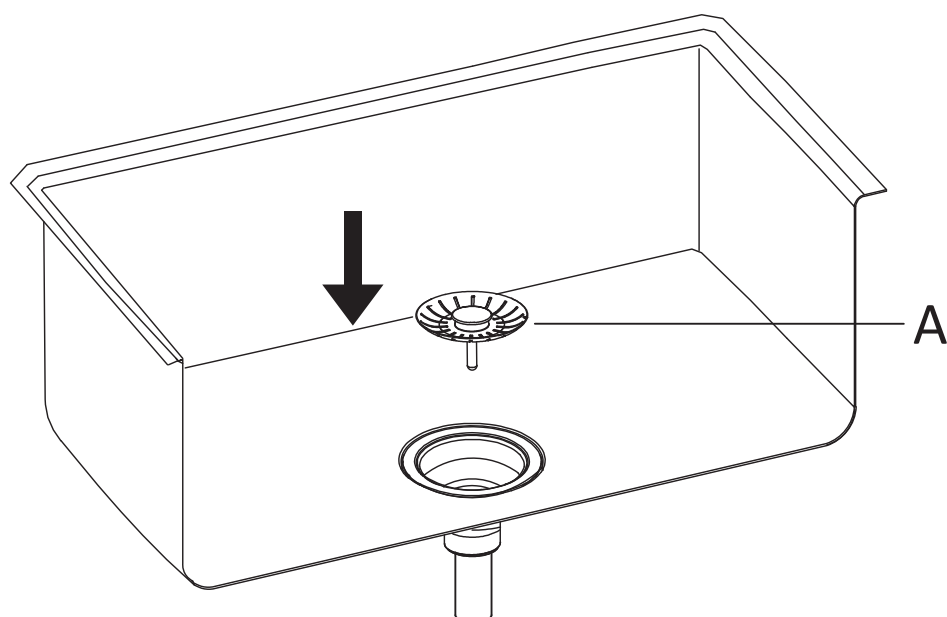
Step 3:

- Use a screwdriver to screw the screw (B) into the metal strainer (C), tighten the metal strainer (C) and main body (F) into place.



Step 4:

- Insert strainer (A) to seal water.



Limited Lifetime Warranty

•Parts and Finish

HomLux warrants to the original consumer purchaser all parts and finishes of its HomLux Kitchen Sink purchased from an authorized HomLux seller to be free from defects in material and workmanship for as long as the original consumer purchaser owns the home in which the sink was first installed. For commercial purchasers, the warranty period is five (5) years for multi-family residential applications and one (1) years for all other commercial applications, in each case from the date of original purchase. For purposes of this warranty, the term "multi-family residential applications" refers to the purchase of the sink from an authorized HomLux seller by a purchaser who owns but does not live in the residential dwelling in which the sink is initially installed, such as in a rented or leased single unit or multi-unit detached home (duplex or townhome), or a condominium, apartment building or community living center. The following installations are not considered multi-family residential applications, are excluded from the 5-year warranty and are subject to the 1-year warranty: industrial, institutional or other business premises, such as a dormitory, hospitality premises (hotel, motel or extended stay location), airport, educational facility, long-or short-term healthcare facility (hospital, rehabilitation center, nursing, assisted or staged-care living unit), public space or common area.

All parts and finishes of these HomLux Sink are warranted to the original consumer purchaser to be free from defects in material and workmanship for five (5) years from the date of original purchase, for commercial purchasers, the warranty period is one (1) year from the date of original purchase.

•What We Will Do

HomLux will repair or replace, free of charge, during the applicable warranty period (as described above), any part or finish that proves defective in material and/or workmanship under normal installation, use and service. If repair or replacement is not practical, HomLux may elect to refund the purchase price in exchange for the return of the product. These are your exclusive remedies.

•What Is Not Covered

Because HomLux is unable to control the quality of HomLux products sold by unauthorized sellers, unless otherwise prohibited by law, this warranty does not cover HomLux products purchased from unauthorized sellers.

This warranty does not cover instances of negligence, misuse, abuse, improper installation, carelessness, accident, hard water or mineral deposits, exposure to corrosive materials, misapplication, damages caused by improper maintenance, alteration of the product, or failure to follow care or installation instructions enclosed with your product. Avoid using abrasive cleaners such as powders, bleach, ammonia, alcohol, or chlorine. Avoid using abrasive pads, steel wool, or wire brushes, as these will damage and wear down the finish. Any labor charges incurred by the purchaser to repair, replace, install or remove this Product are not covered by this warranty. HomLux recommends using a professional plumber for all installation and repair. We also recommend that you use only genuine HomLux replacement parts.
