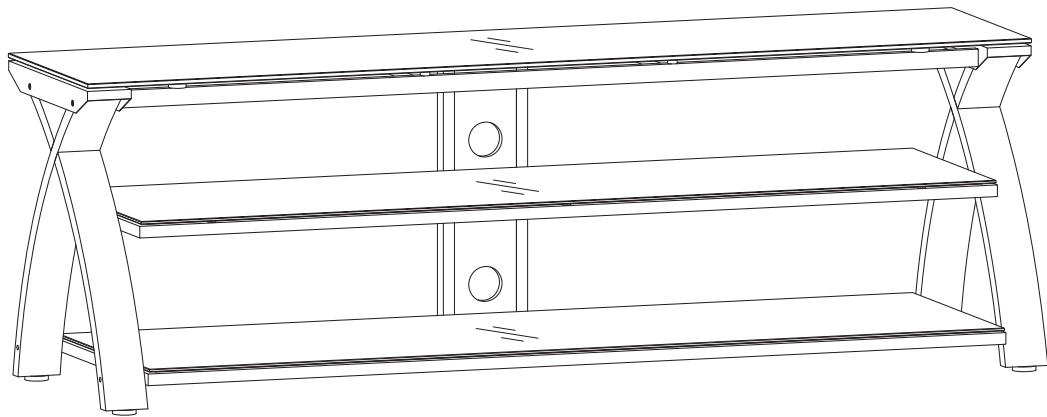
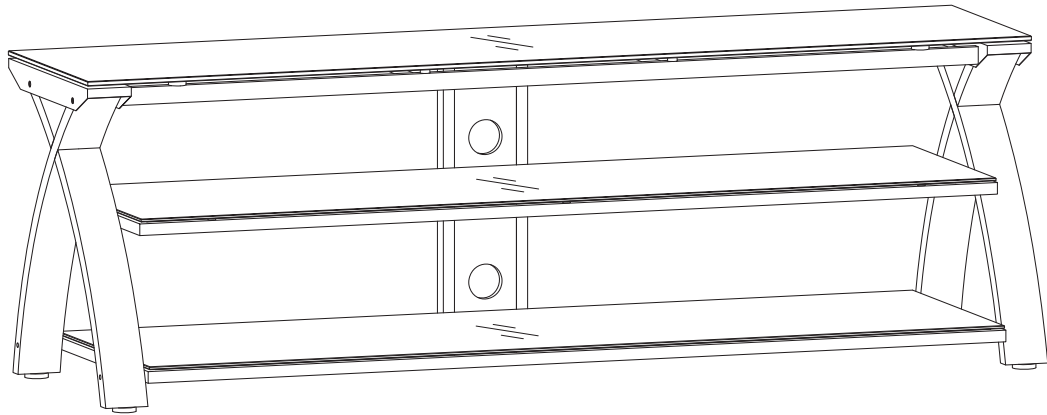

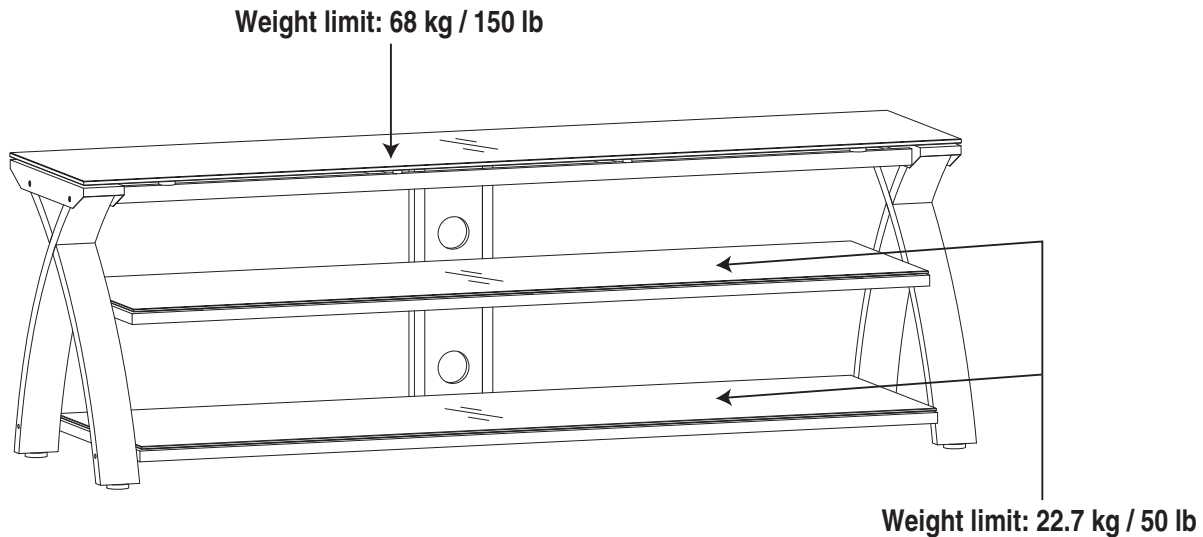


1. Do not use this product unless all screws and bolts are securely tightened.

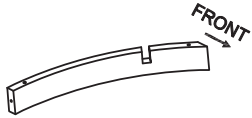

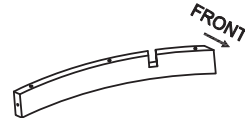
(A) Front Left Side Frame (1 PC)



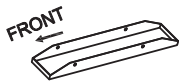
(B) Front Right Side Frame (1 PC)



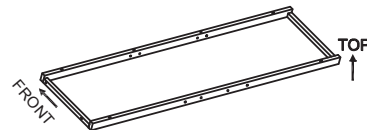
(C) Rear Left Side Frame (1 PC)



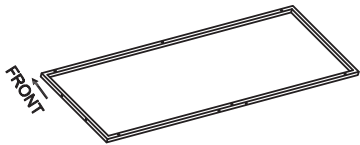

Place product in desired location

Step 1: Attach one Mounting Bracket (WD) to top rear corners of product using one Machine Screw (WA) for each Mounting Bracket (WD).

Step 2: Drill 2 (two) pilot holes approximately 2" below the corresponding positions of Mounting Brackets (WD). Insert one Wall Anchor (WC) into each pilot hole. **Note: You may need to gently tap anchors into pilot holes using a rubber mallet.**

Step 3: Attach Mounting Brackets (WD) to wall using one Wood Screw (WB) for each Mounting Bracket (WD).

Step 4: Connect corresponding Mounting Brackets (WD) using Mounting Straps (WE). Tighten as desired before locking into place.
