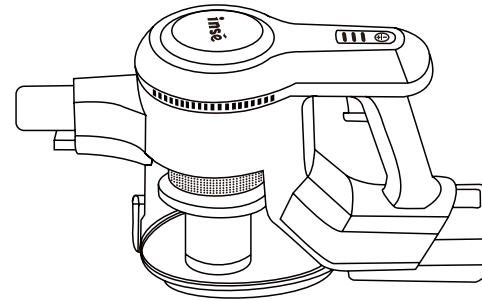

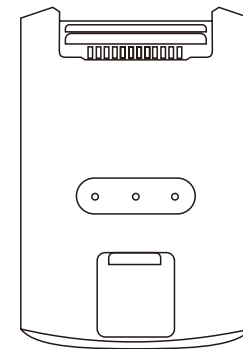
1.CHARGE

Method 1: Insert the battery pack into the main motor and then connect it with the power adapter

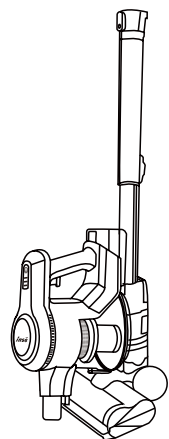
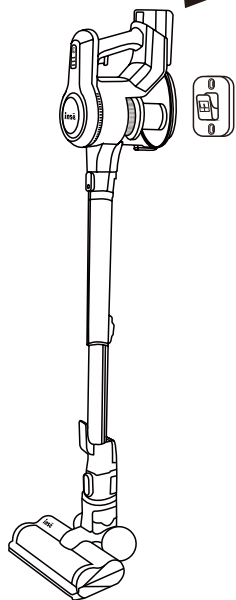
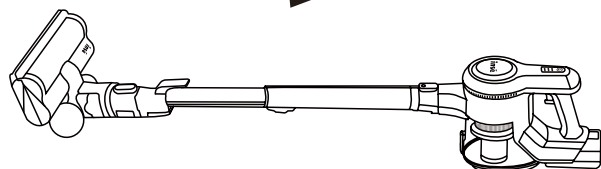
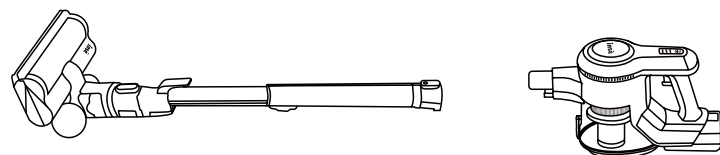
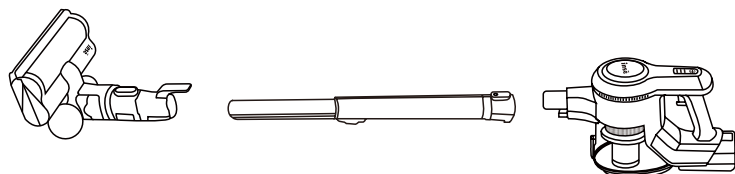


When the machine or battery is charged, there will be LED indicator.

Safety Warning

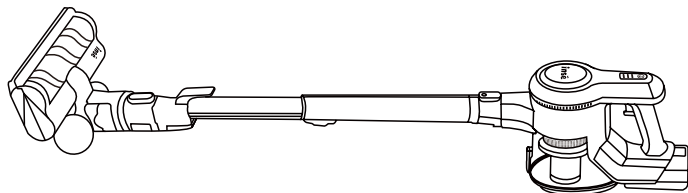
- The metal tube contains inner electric connections.

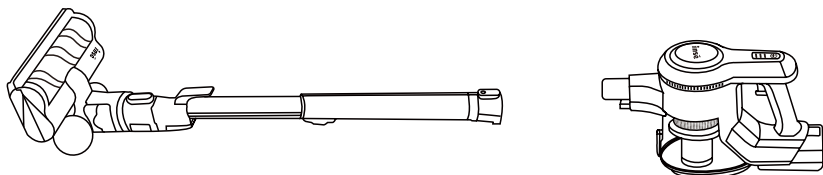
Product Introduction

Retractable Metal Tube Installation

Insert the metal tube end into the suction port of the main motor until you hear a click sound, make the connections is tight.



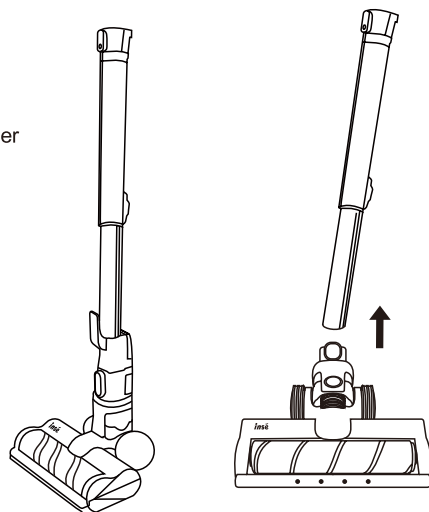
Press the metal tube release button with one hand, hold the main motor with another hand and then pull the handle to remove the metal tube.



Motorized Cleaner Head Installation

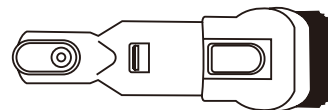
Inset the snap joint of the metal tube into the cleaner head until you hear a click sound, make sure the connection is tight.

Press the cleaner head release button with one hand, hold the metal tube with another hand and then pull it out to remove it.

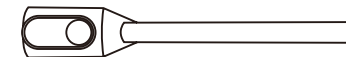


2 in 1 Brush and Long Crevice

Product Instruction

1. Preparation

Please check if the battery power is sufficient before using. It's suggested to charge over 5-6 hours before the first time of use to ensure utmost performance of the product. Choose the correct attachment according to the cleaning area.

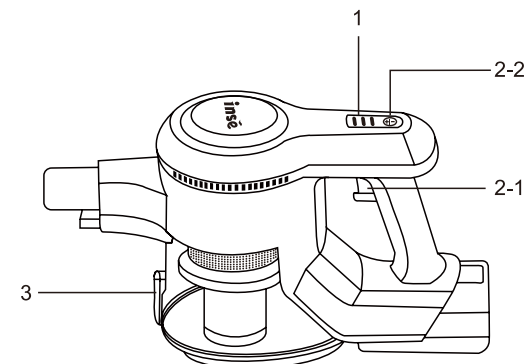
2. Start to Work

2-1 Press the power switch to turn on the vacuum, and then press it again to turn it off.

2-2 Press the +/- button to switch the speed level between low and high.

3. Dust Cup Cleaning

After turning off, press the dust cup release button and dump the dirt, and then close the bottom cover.



Daily Maintenance

In order to make ensure max performance of the vacuum, please regularly maintain its components.

Clean Handheld Part of the Main Motor

- ❗ Please turn off the vacuum before cleaning.
- ❗ Wipe the surface with a clean cloth; avoid the water gets into the inner part of the vacuum.
- ❗ Do not place the vacuum under direct sunlight or in wet places after cleaning.

Clean Stainless Steel Strainer

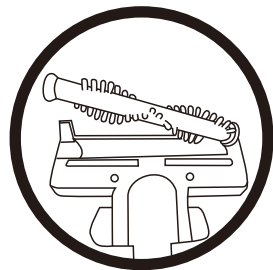
The dust cup is transparent so you can always check the dust condition of the strainer. If it is full of dust, please clean it in time.

Clean Dust Cup

The sign -MAX- means dust capacity limit. Once the dust approaches or arrives the sign, please empty the dust cup. To further clean the dust cup, you could remove the strainer and inner filter.

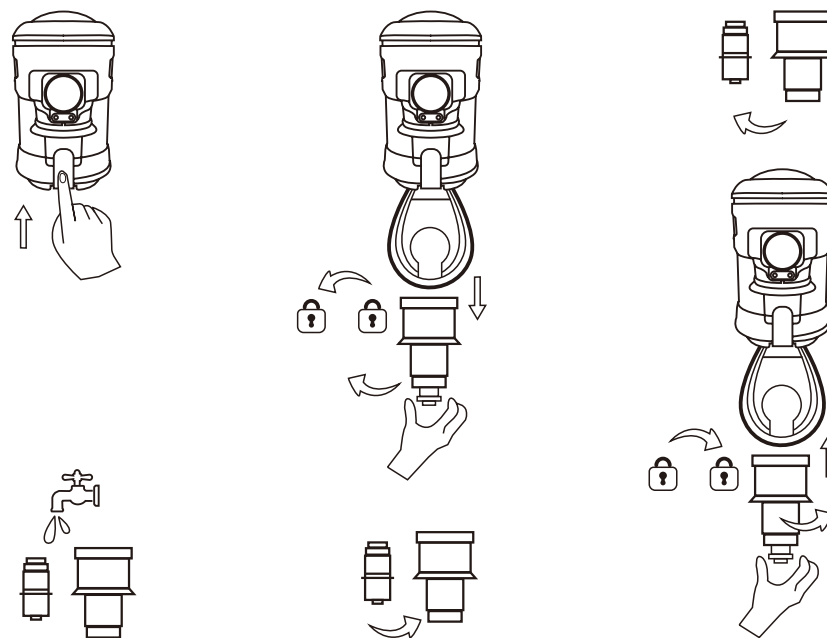
Clean Detachable Roller Brush

1. Unlock the side lock on the underside of cleaner head, remove the side cover and take out the roller brush.
2. Remove the side cover of the roller brush if necessary.
3. Use the 2-in-1 cleaning tool to cut and remove the tangled hair.



Clean High Efficiency Cotton Filter

1. Hold the main motor, press the dust cup release button to open the bottom cover of the dust cup, rotate the cotton filter and take it out, dump the dust. (see as picture below)



2. If there is too much dust, you can wash with water. Put it back after completely dry.

Battery Indicators

The product has three-block power indicator lights

- After correctly and firmly insert the battery pack into the main motor, press the power switch, the indicator lights would turn on to show the actual battery level.
- When the power is low than 5% of the total power, the indicator lights would flash; please charge the battery in time.
- When the battery is being charged, the indicator lights show the actual battery level in real time.
- Do not use the product while the battery is being charged.

Troubleshooting

Problems	Possible Causes	Solutions
Vacuum cleaner doesn't work	1. Low battery 2. Suction port is blocked	1-1. Charge the main motor with battery inserted 1-2. Take out the battery and charge it 2. Clean the blockage
Suction power is weaken	1. Dust cup and the inner cotton filter is full of dust 2. The cleaner head is blocked with hair, spitball or plastic bag, etc.	1. Clean the dust cup and filter 2. Clean the cleaner head
Motor has strange sound when working	Main suction port or metal tube are blocked	Clean the blockage
Roller brush stops spinning	Roller brush is tangled with hair	Clean all hair tangled with the brush, also remove the side cover of the brush to remove the hair and dust

Battery Safety

- If the battery pack becomes exhausted, it should be removed from the product to avoid leakage.
- In the event of the battery pack leaking, do not allow any liquid to come into contact with the skin or eyes.

- Keep the battery pack out of the reach of children.
- Secondary battery packs need to be charged before use. After extended periods of storage, it may be necessary to charge and discharge the batteries several times to obtain maximum performance.
- Do not leave battery packs on charge for prolonged periods of time.
- Do not use any charger other than that specifically provided for use with the product.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Do not store above 60°C. Avoid storing in direct sunlight.
- Do not use any battery packs that are not designed for use with the product.
- Do not dispose of the battery pack in a fire.
- Do not crush, puncture, dismantle or otherwise damage the battery pack.
- Do not dismantle, open or shred battery packs.
- Do not expose the battery pack to heat or fire as it may explode.
- Do not subject the battery pack to mechanical shock.

- This appliance is fitted with a 22.2V 2200mAh Li-ion rechargeable battery.

1. Prevent unintentional starting ensure the switch is in the off-position before connecting pack, picking up, or carrying the appliance.
Carrying the appliance with your finger on the switch or energizing appliance that have the switch on invites accidents.
2. Disconnect the battery pack from the appliance before making any adjustments changing accessories or storing appliance.
Such preventive safety measures reduce the risk of starting the appliance accidentally.
3. Recharge only with the charger specified by the manufacturer. A charger that is suitable for one type of battery pack may create a risk of fire when used with another battery pack.
4. Use appliances only with specifically designated battery packs.
Use of any other battery packs may create a risk of injury and fire.
