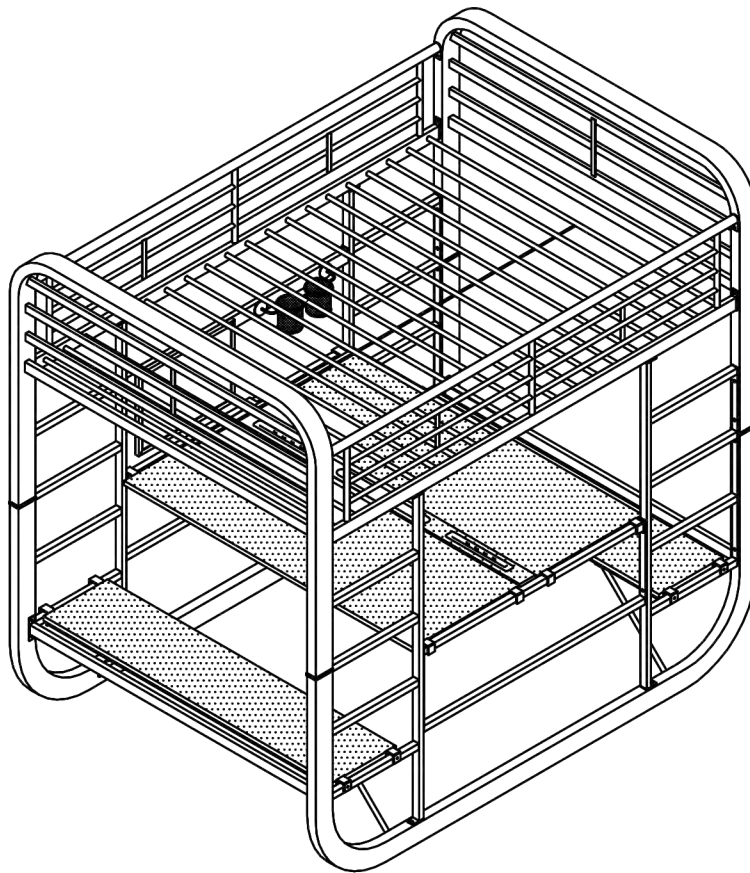


Assembly Instructions

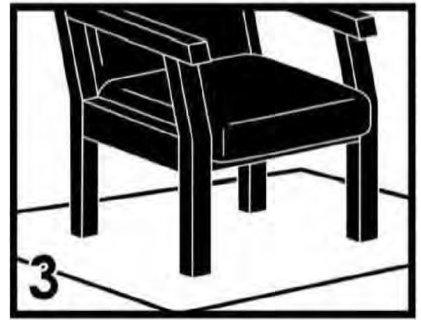
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



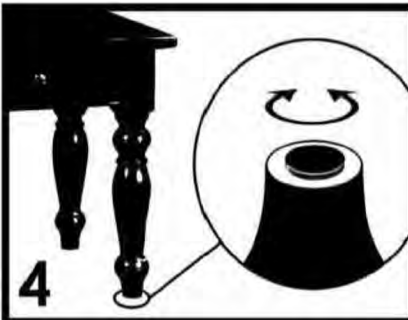
When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



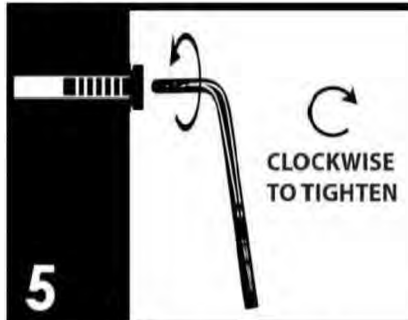
Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



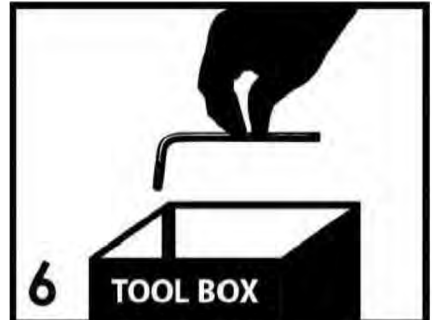
Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.

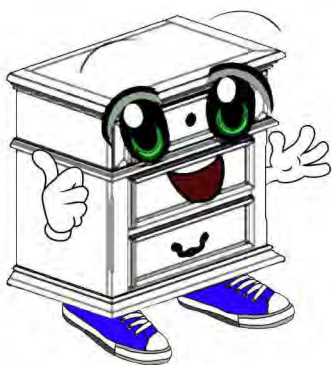


Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

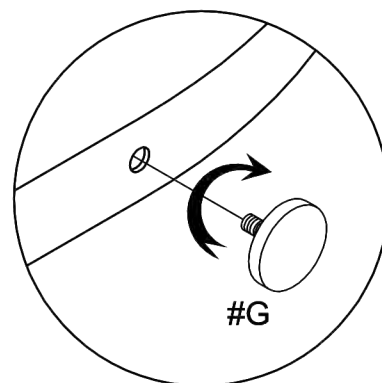
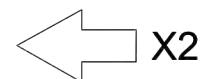
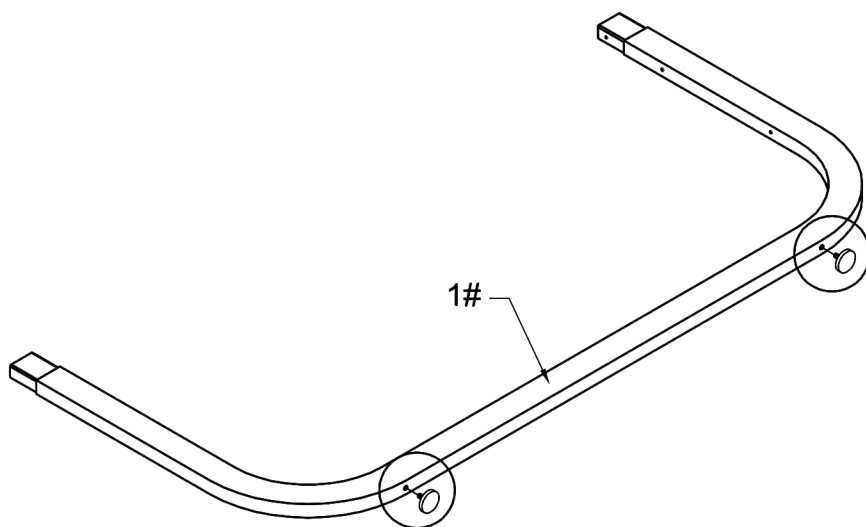
ASSEMBLY

Connect the upper panels to the bottom panels as shown in the picture.

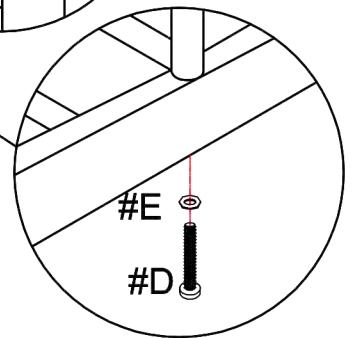
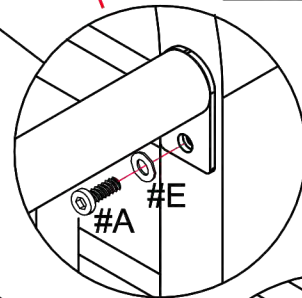

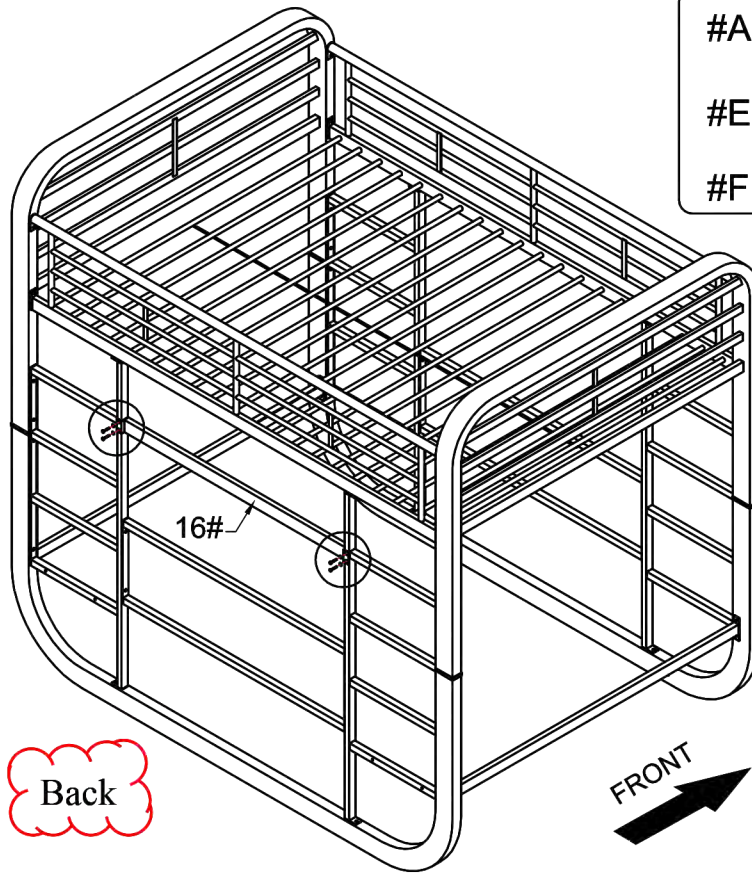
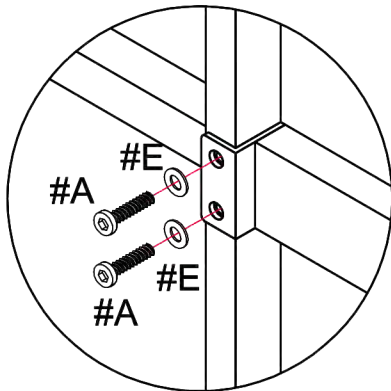
Prepare 10 bolts assembly by inserting flat washer (#E) onto bolts (#A). Align side frames (#12) in-between the ladders, then secure with bolts (#A).





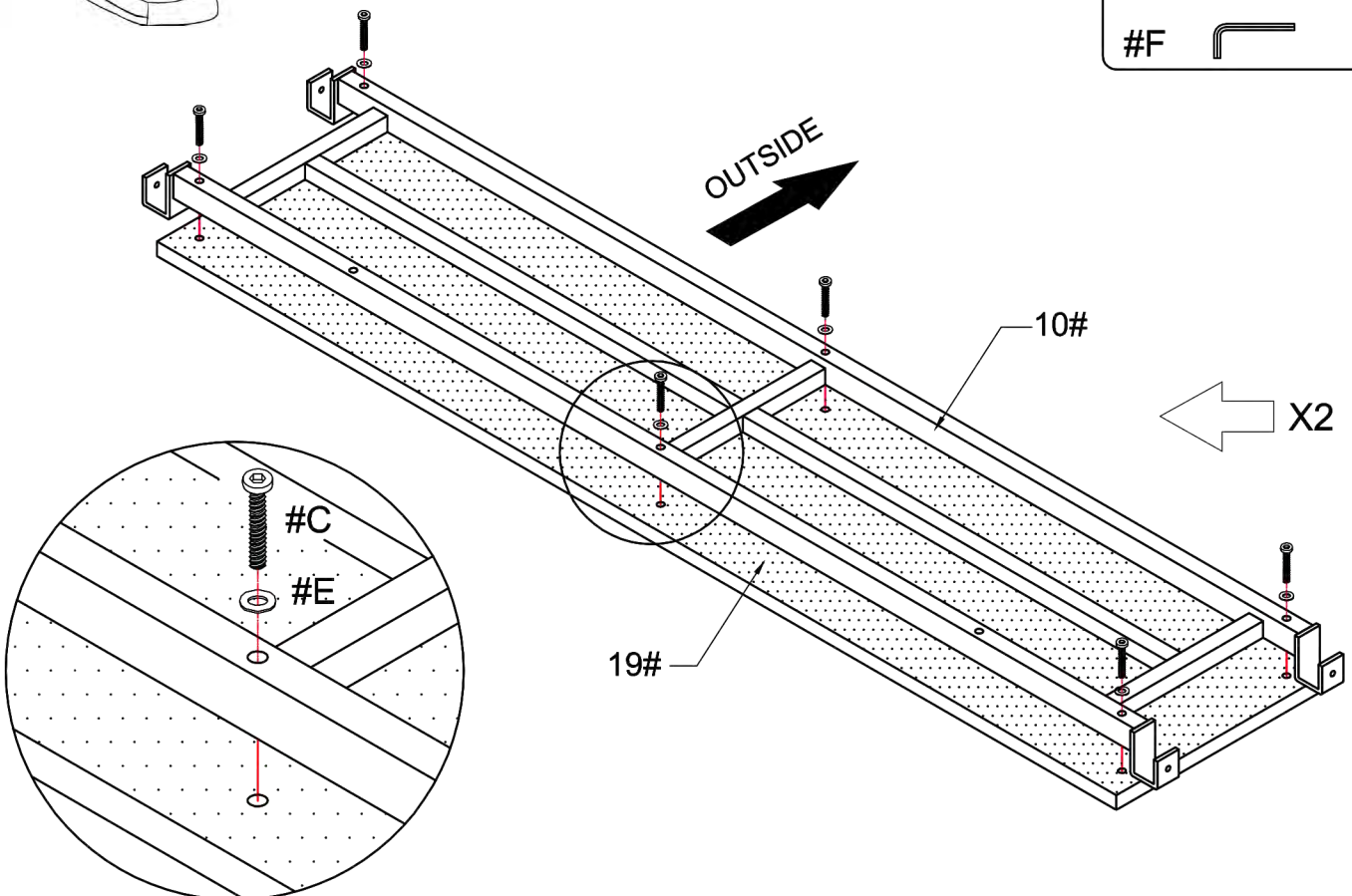

Prepare 4 bolts assembly by inserting flat washer (#E) onto bolts (#A). Align upper rails (#16) to the holes in-between the back ladders, then secure with bolts (#A).



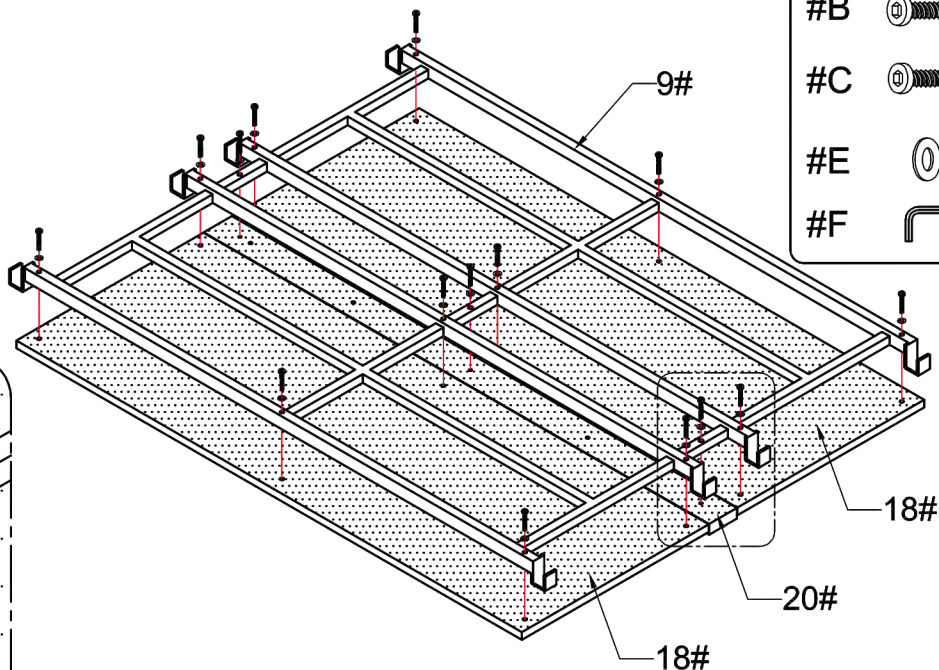
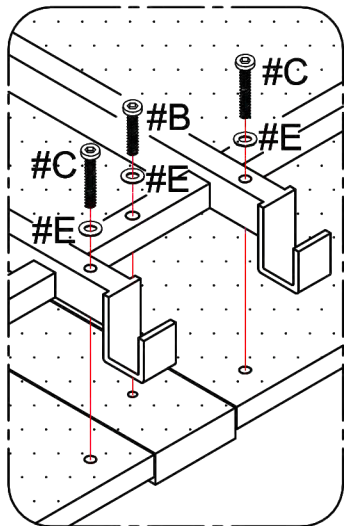

Prepare 12 bolts assembly by inserting flat washer (#E) onto boles (#C). Align board frame (#10) to the holes of the bottom board (#19). Secure with bolts (#C).

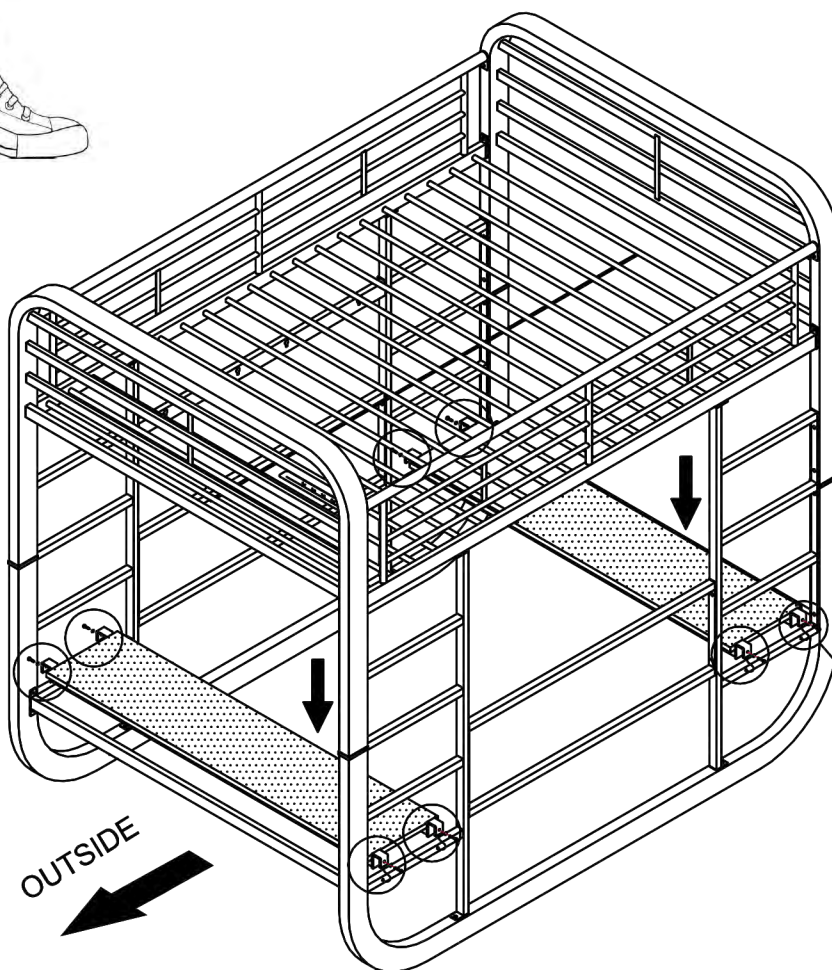

Prepare 15 bolts assembly by inserting flat washer (#E) onto bolts (#B,C). place middle board (#20) in-between table board (#18). Make sure finished side of table board (#18) is facing outwards. Align table frame (#9) to the holes of the boards (#18,20). Secure middle board (#20) with bolts (#B). Secure table board (#18) with bolts (#C).

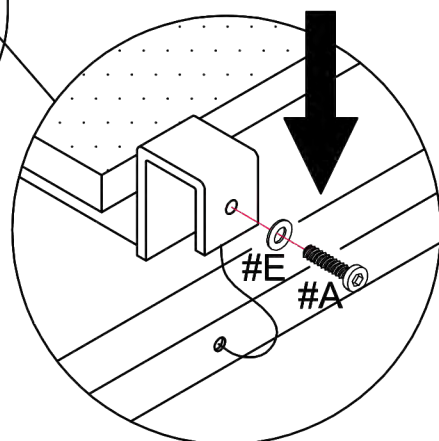

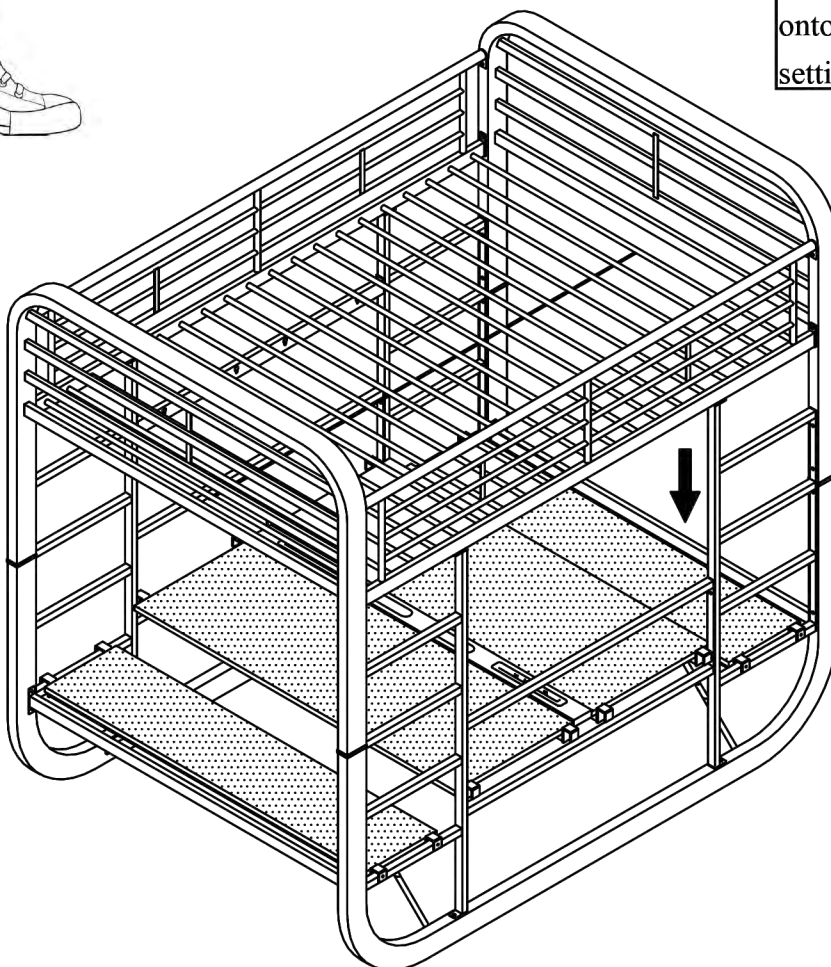


Carefully insert the table board within the bunk bed

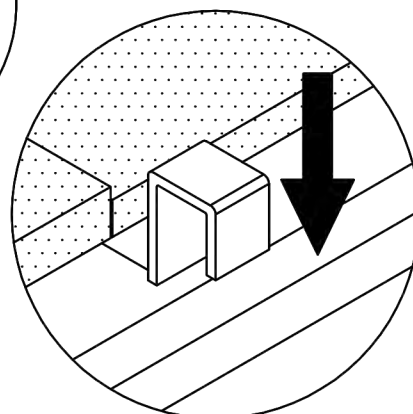




You can set the table board lower to be aligned with the bottom board.

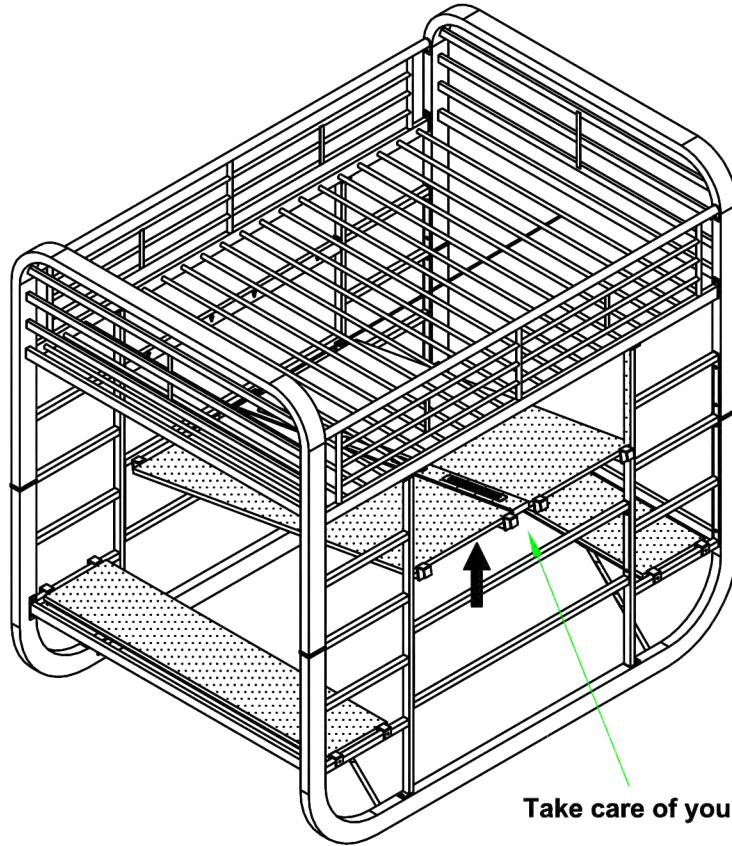


Carefully place and rest the table board onto the bar. Watch you fingers when setting the table down.





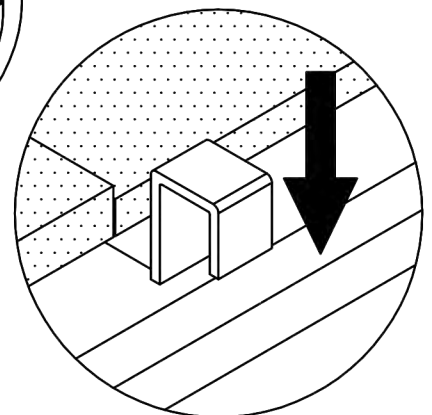
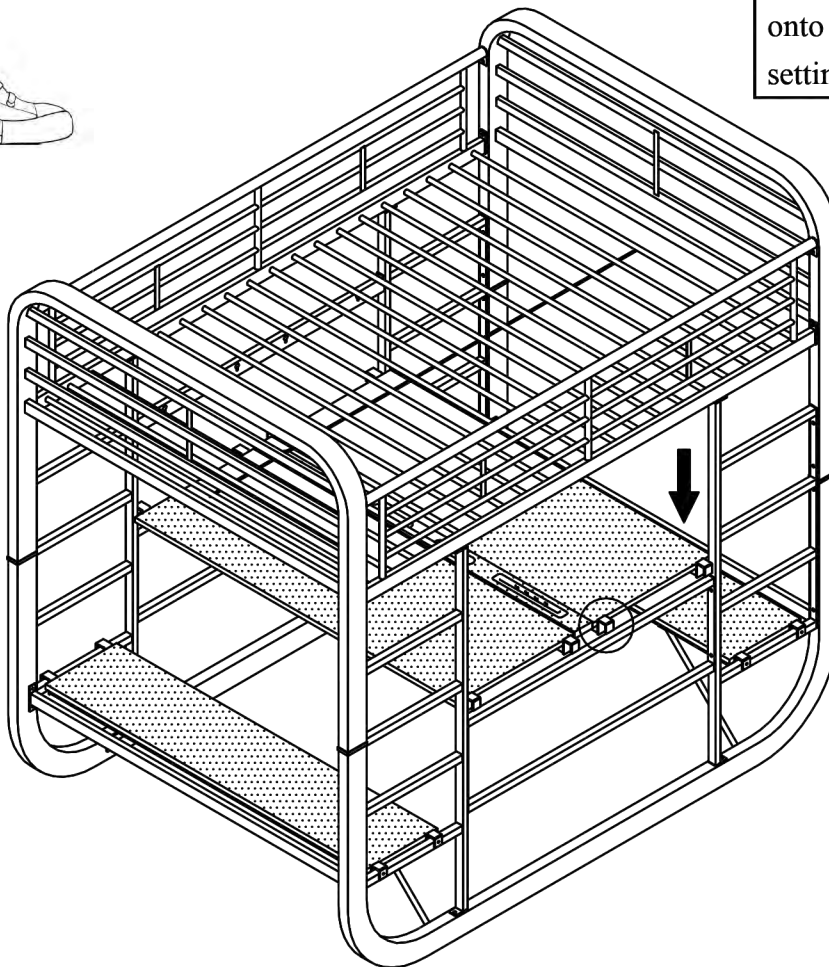
You can also place the table board onto the higher bars.

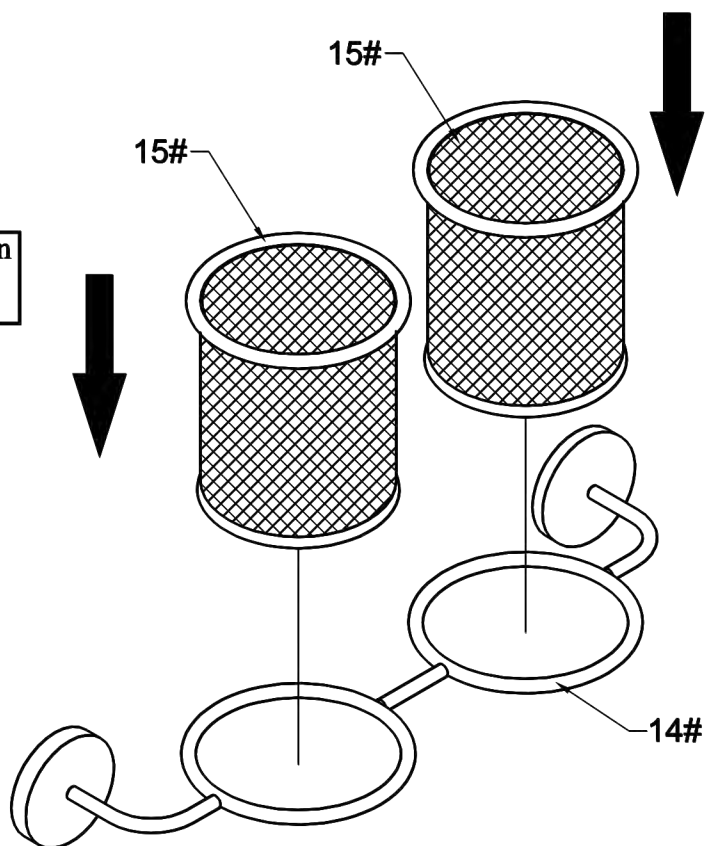

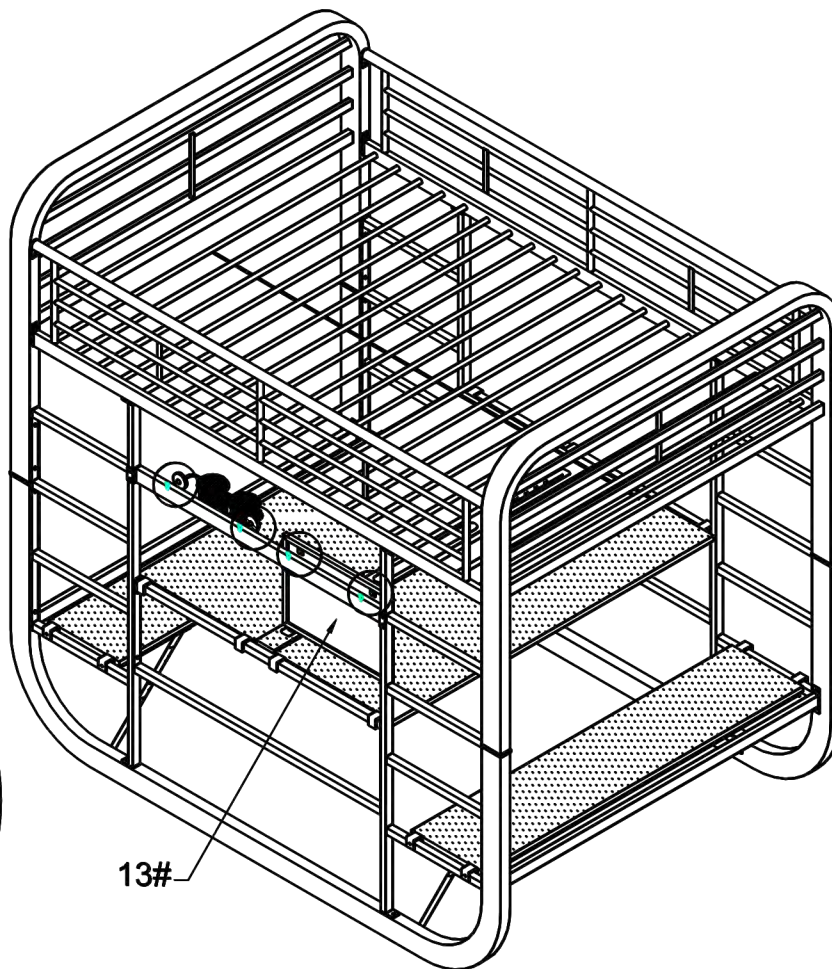
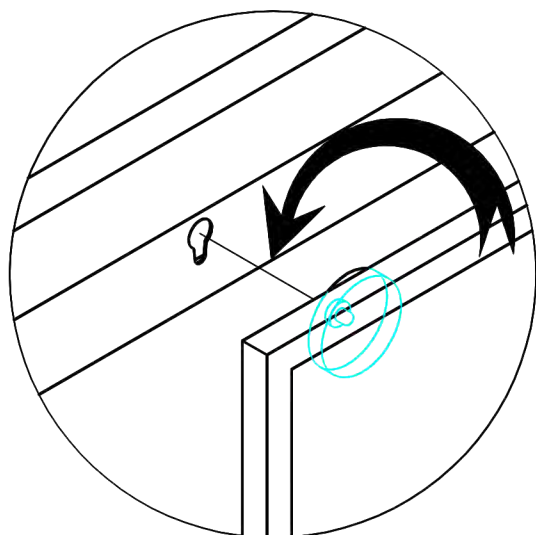




Attach pen container (#15) to pen holder (#14).

Safety Warnings

1. Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton . Do not remove warning label from bed.
2. Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
3. Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in(127mm). below the upper edge of guardrails .
4. Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
5. Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder ,and other components are in their proper position ,free from damage ,and that all connectors are tight .
6. Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
7. Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
8. Do not use substitute parts ,Contact manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
9. Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
10. Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk.
If the bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.
11. The use of water or sleep flotation mattress is prohibited .
12. Keep these instructions for future reference.
13. Use only mattress which is (74"-75")X(53"-54")X6" on upper bunk and for bottom bunk required (74"-75")X(53"-54")X8" mattress.
14. Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
15. Maximum total weight is not to exceed 400 lbs.on the upper bunk.

STRANGULATION HAZARD:

Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed, for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jump ropes.
