WE RECOMMEND 2 PEOPLE TO ASSEMBLE THIS GAZEBO

Please check if you have all the parts as listed **Note:** The quantities below are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.

Assembly Instructions

Step 1 & 2

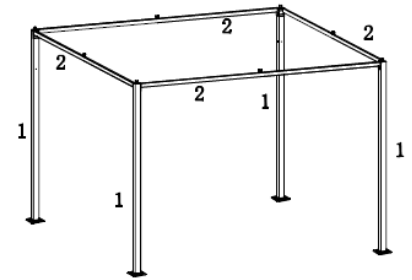
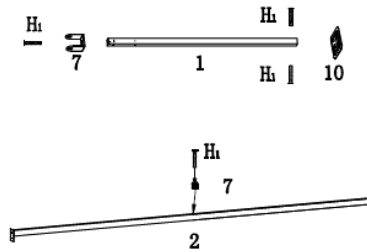
Connect the upright leg (1) to the foot plate part (10)

Add clip (7) to the top of the leg.

Add a further roof clip (7) to Top support beam (2)

Now connect the top beams part (2) to the leg uprights part (1) using the Bolts (H1)

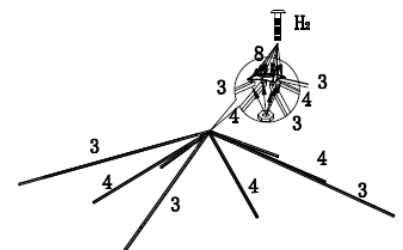
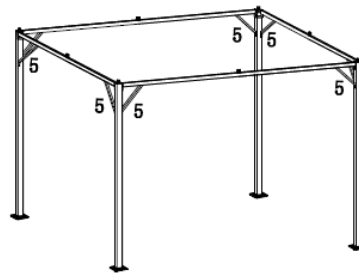
Do not over tighten the screws at this stage



Step 3 & 4

Add side supporting brackets part (5) to every corner.

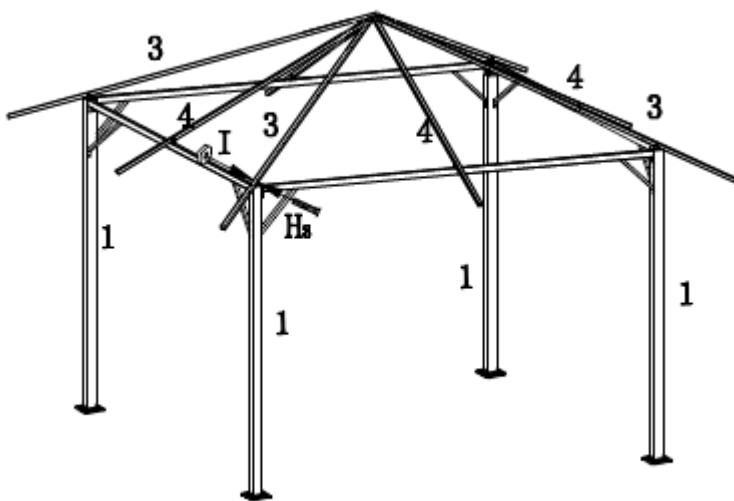
Create the roof section by assembling all roof bars to the spider part (8) ensuring the long sections part (3) are in the corner and the shorter supports part (4) are at the side



Step 5

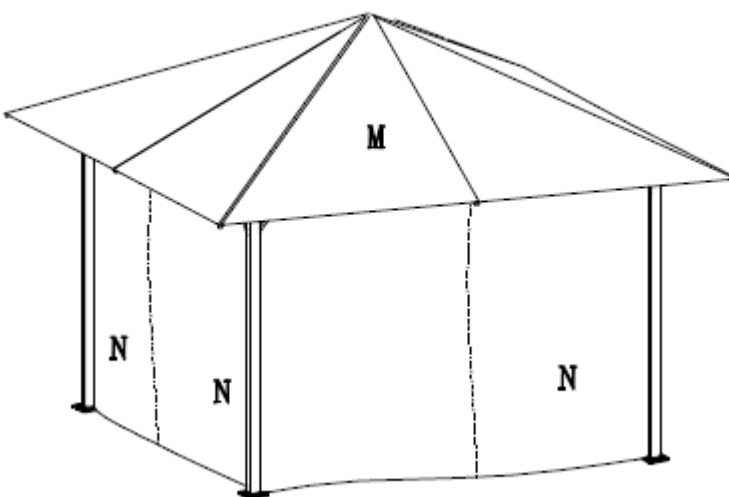
Lift up the roof section onto the frame and connect using Bolt (H3) & Nut (I)

Now ensure all the nuts & bolts are tight across all the gazebo.



Step 6

The gazebo is now ready to add the roof and curtains. First apply the roof canopy (M) simply apply the roof over the top section and spread it out so that all the corners are close to the roof bars. The easiest way to secure the roof is to pull the canopy over using the elasticated ends and secure the mid sections first, always making sure the canopy is even across the roof leaving the 4 corners until last. For the curtains undo each section (as they are all zipped together and from the internal (inside) Fit one curtain to every corner across one leg so when zipped it will all join up.



Safety and Care Advice

Your Gazebo frame can be left outside all year round but we advise the curtains & Canopy are taken off during the winter months and stored in a cool dry frost free place (do not store wet). This will prevent them from deteriorating. (To keep the canopy refreshed use a water proofing spray on the outside of the roof & curtains at least 3 times a year) Available at all good tent/camping shops.

***VERY IMPORTANT YOU MUST SECURE YOUR GAZEBO TO THE GROUND AS SOON AS IT IS BUILT – in heavy winds remove the canopy to avoid wind damage – Do Not BBQ under this gazebo**

To secure to grass use the tent pegs provided for hard surface patios fixing bolts must be used (not Supplied).
