2. Safety Information

- Two people are recommended to install the shower wall.
- Read all installation instructions prior to starting the installation.
- We recommend allowing the shower walls to reach room temperature before starting the installation process.
- Prevent exposure to moisture during the installation process. Before installation, carefully examine the shower walls to ensure that they have not sustained any damage during shipping.
- The framing studs need to be vertically straight and at right angles to the subfloor.
- Make sure all wood studs and supports are properly installed.
- Always wear safety glasses and gloves to ensure proper protection while handling materials.
- Please note that the dimensions provided are for reference only. It is crucial to accurately measure the dimensions of the opening before beginning the installation process.
- These products must be installed by a fully insured and licensed plumber only. Before commencing the installation process, carefully inspect all boxes and packages for any shipping damages.
- These products must be installed by a fully insured and licensed plumber only. Before commencing the installation process, carefully inspect all boxes and packages for any shipping damages.
- Installation of any product by anyone other than a fully insured and licensed plumber shall void the limited warranty.

- Before starting the installation, ensure the water supply is turned off and remove any faucets, handles, or fixture trims that extend from the wall.

- Clean all wall surfaces by removing any soap residue and dirt with a standard household detergent, then dry thoroughly.
- This product is intended for installation over backer board, drywall, or tile and should not be installed directly onto studs.
- The step-by-step guide provided in the installation instructions is intended for general reference purposes only and may not cover specific scenarios or unique installation requirements.

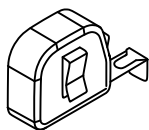

5. Installation Instructions

- Once you've opened all the boxes, read the instructions thoroughly and ensure all the necessary components are included in the package. If there is damage or missing components, **DO NOT INSTALL THE PRODUCT!** Contact customer service at 310-935-0028 or via email at support@streamlinebath.com.
- Ensure all rough plumbing and pipe fittings are fully installed and ready before starting the installation of the wall panels.
- Position each wall panel securely against the bathtub and the back corner. You may need to trim the vertical edge that aligns with the corner, the edge that sits on the base, or in some cases, both edges to ensure a proper fit.
- Walls should be solid, plumb, and square
- Panels can be resized using a circular saw. If a panel is too large for the wall space, start by measuring and marking the cutting lines accurately. Double-check all measurements before cutting and use the appropriate tools to ensure clean and straight edges.
- Wall panels should be installed in a temperature-controlled environment, ideally at a room temperature of around 16°C (60°F). Avoid installing panels in unheated spaces where the temperature might drop below 0°C (32°F).
- Refer to the instructions provided on your selected caulk tube for proper application. After completing the installation, carefully inspect all caulked areas and fill any gaps to ensure a thorough seal.
- Wall panels can be installed on a variety of surfaces, such as drywall, plaster, masonite, green board, cement board, water-resistant backers, painted surfaces, plywood, and ceramic tile.
- Ensure the installation surface is solid, clean, dry, and free from any imperfections.
- Remove any peeling paint, wallpaper, or plaster debris. For raw plaster or new wallboard, apply a primer or water sealant before beginning the installation.
- When installing over existing ceramic tile, if more than 30% of the tiles are removed during preparation, all remaining tiles must also be removed.
- For installations over intact tiles, lightly sand the surface to ensure proper adhesion.
- Mark vertical reference lines starting from the edges of the shower base/bathtub on both sides to maintain accurate alignment.
- Before starting the installation, turn off the water supply and ensure all required plumbing adjustments are completed.

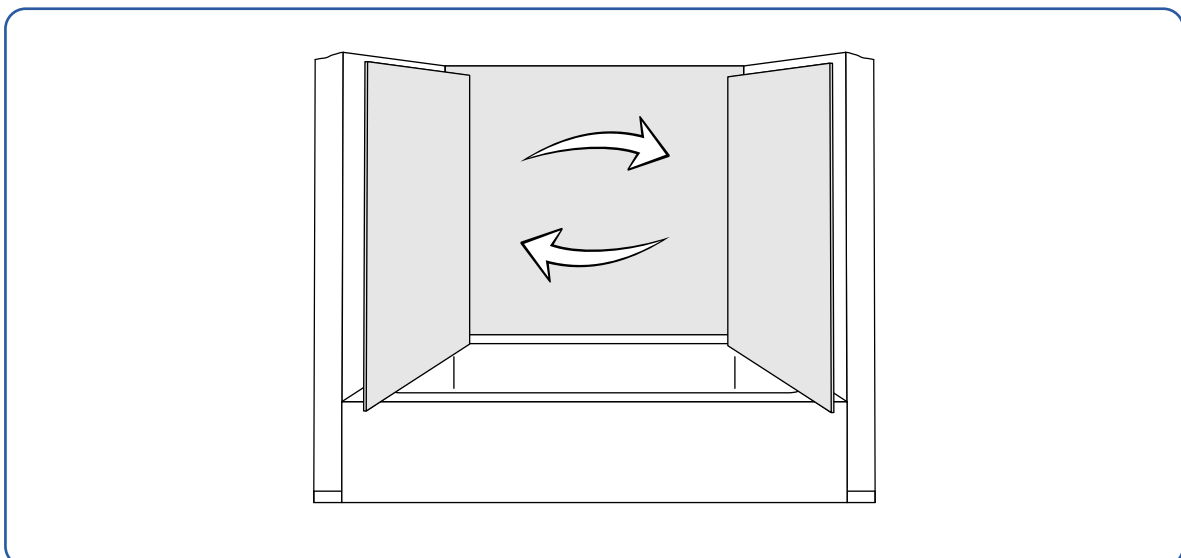
- Temporarily remove all plumbing handles and refrain from reinstalling them until the wall panel installation is finished.
- Position the showerhead so that it is either at least 2 inches below the top edge of the wall panels or mounted above the panels to ensure a proper water seal.



To properly install shower walls with an alcove bathtub, secure the bathtub flange directly to the wall studs. Mount the backer board above the flange, ensuring it is firmly attached to the studs. Align the bathtub walls on the backer board, allowing them to overlap the flange and rest on the bathtub. Failure to follow this method could lead to complications during installation.

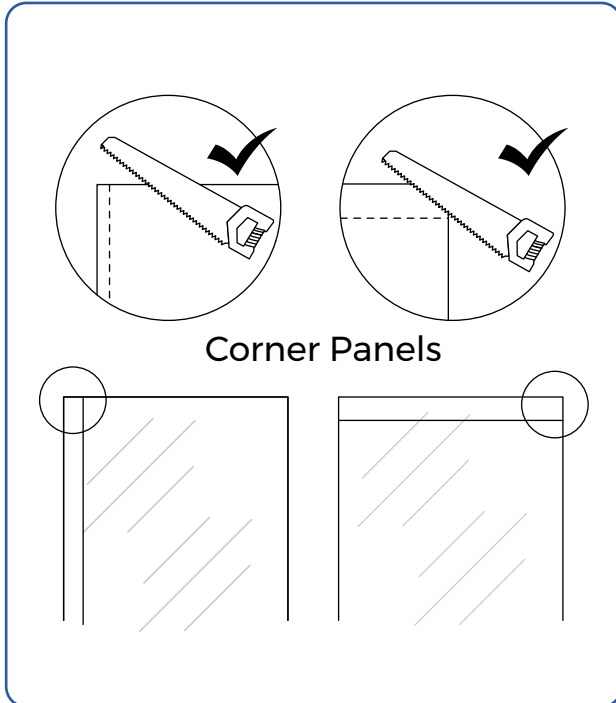
Important Installation Note

The side wall panel pattern is fully reversible, meaning there is no specific order for installation. The panels are interchangeable and can be placed on either side to suit your preference.



For Panels with a Flat Design

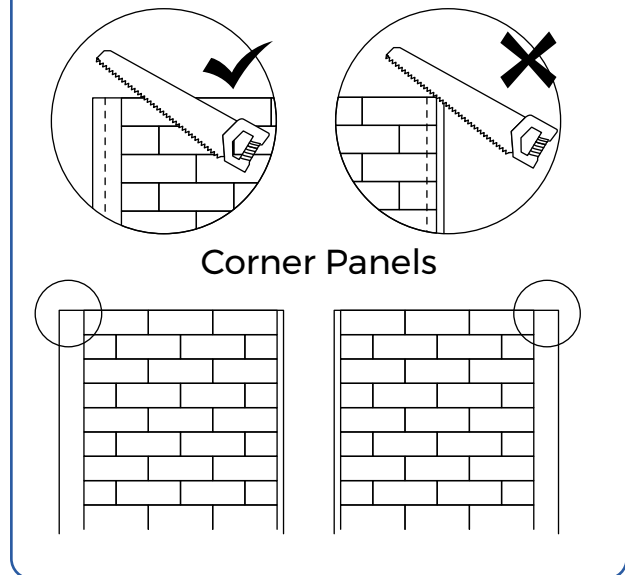
These panels can be trimmed both vertically and horizontally without restrictions.



For Panels with a Raised, Tiled Design

When cutting vertically, only trim along the wide, flat edge located on the outermost side of the panel.

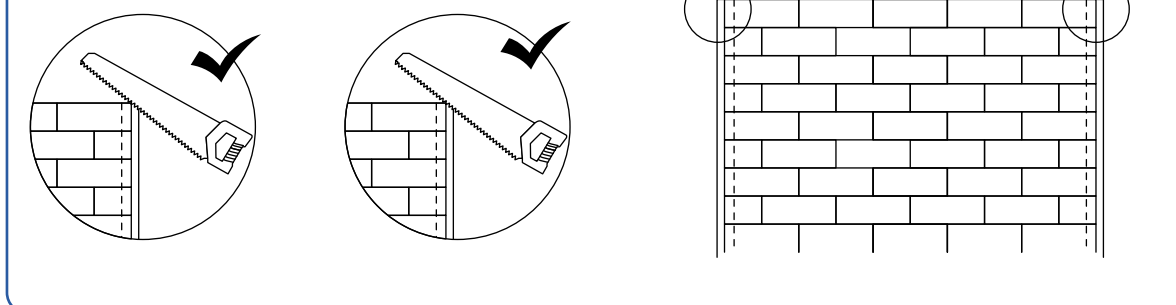
NOTE: Wide flat edge outward. Cut this edge if needed



For Back Panels with a Raised, Tiled Design

If vertical cuts are required, ensure that you cut equally from both sides of the panel to maintain a balanced appearance. Avoid trimming only one side, as this may affect the alignment and aesthetics of the design.

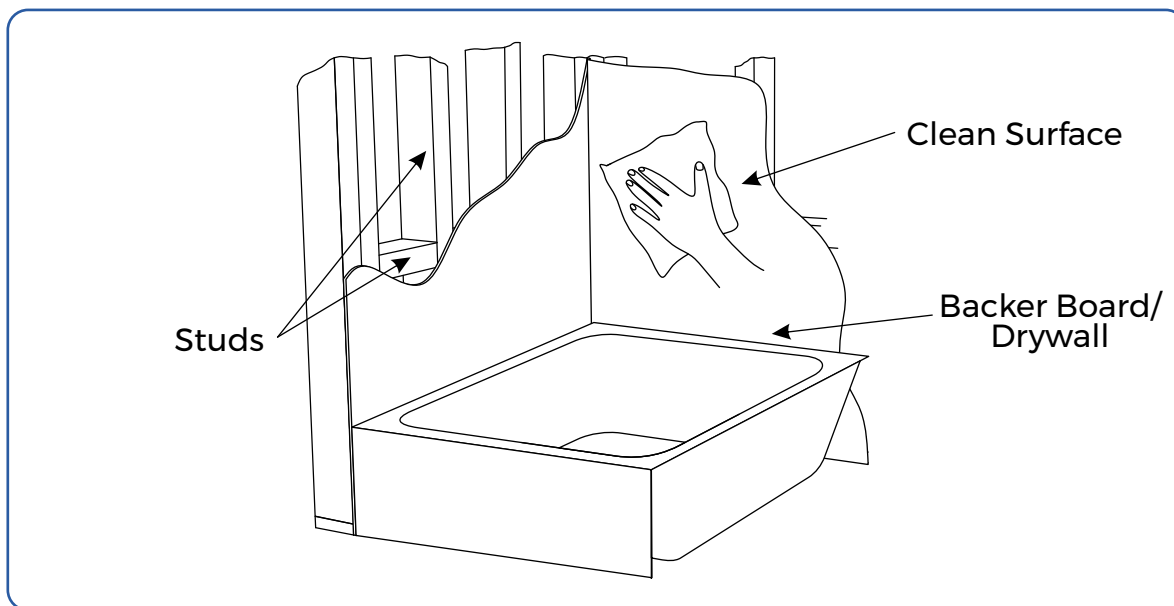
NOTE: Cut equally on both sides if needed. Do not jut cut one side



Horizontal cuts are not recommended, as they can compromise the design if not executed with precision. However, if horizontal cuts are necessary, ensure they follow the natural design lines of the tile pattern. This approach preserves the panel's aesthetics and allows for proper installation, maintaining the overall look and functionality. Take extra care to avoid damaging the raised or tiled design during the cutting process.

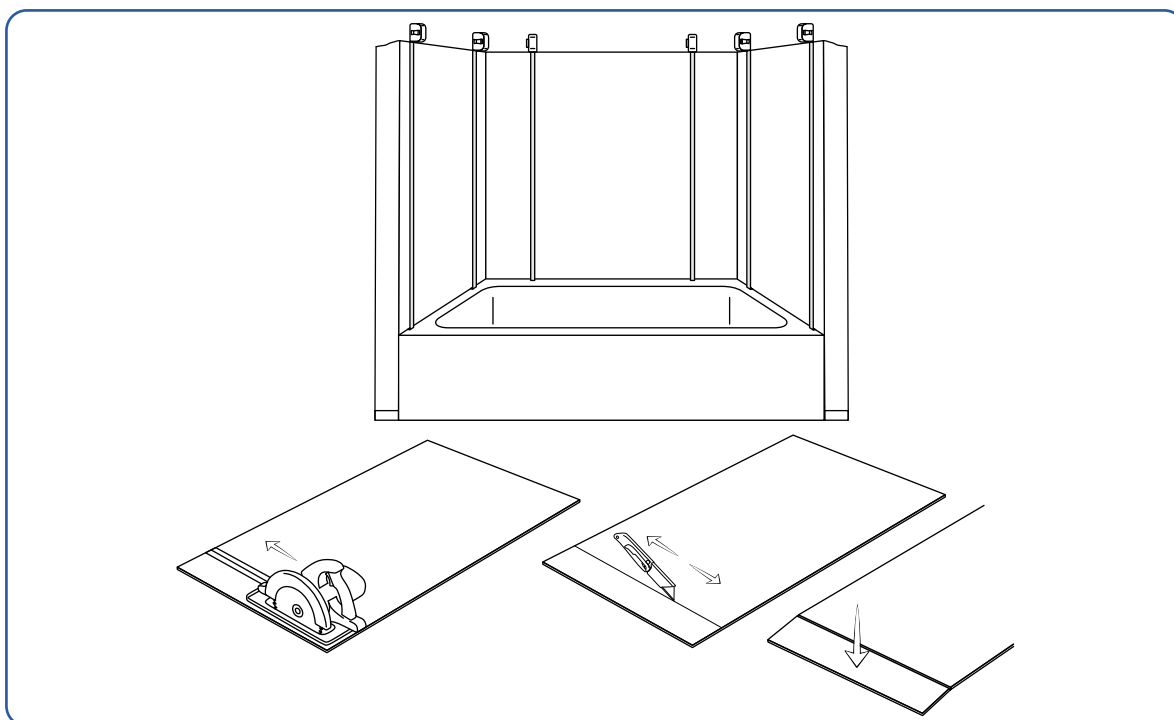
INSTALLATION

1. Ensure the wall surface is clean, dry, smooth, and free of dust, soap residue, mold, or any other contaminants. Wipe the wall with a damp cloth and let it fully dry before proceeding with panel installation.
 - a. **Note:** If you plan to install a shower door or any accessories such as grab bars, refer to the manufacturer's instructions and ensure the stud wall is prepared accordingly.

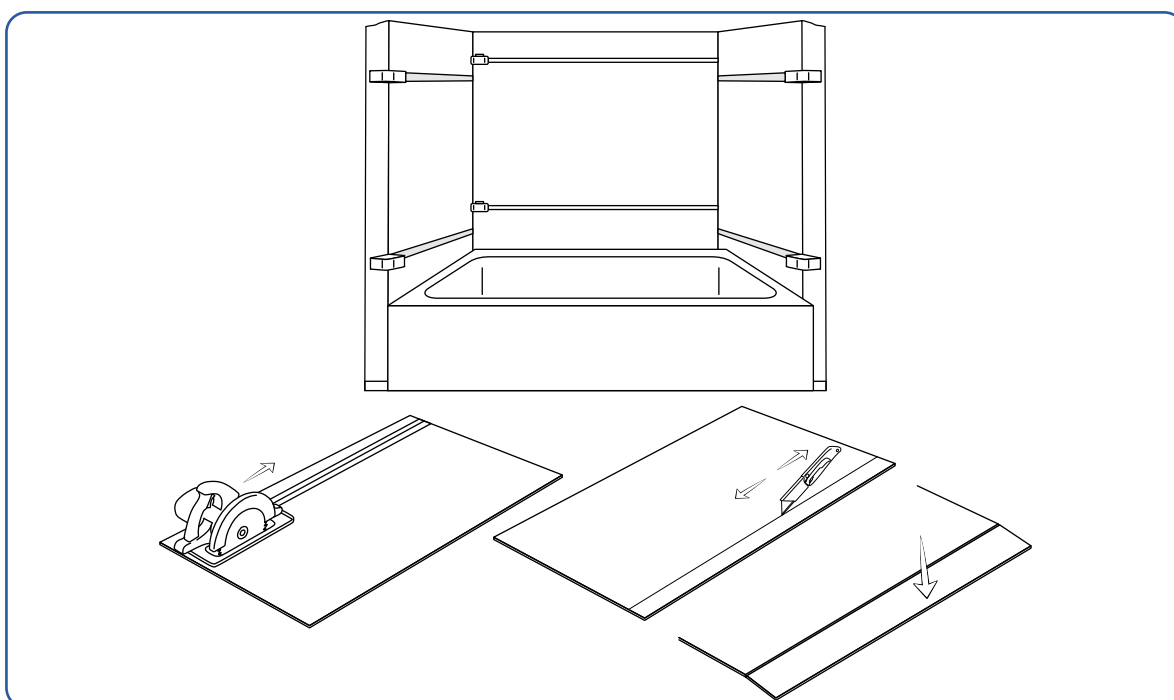


Note: Steps 2 and 3 may not apply to your specific installation setup. Please carefully review the previous installation notes for panels with a flat and raised design before continuing with steps 2 and 3 to ensure they are relevant to your installation.

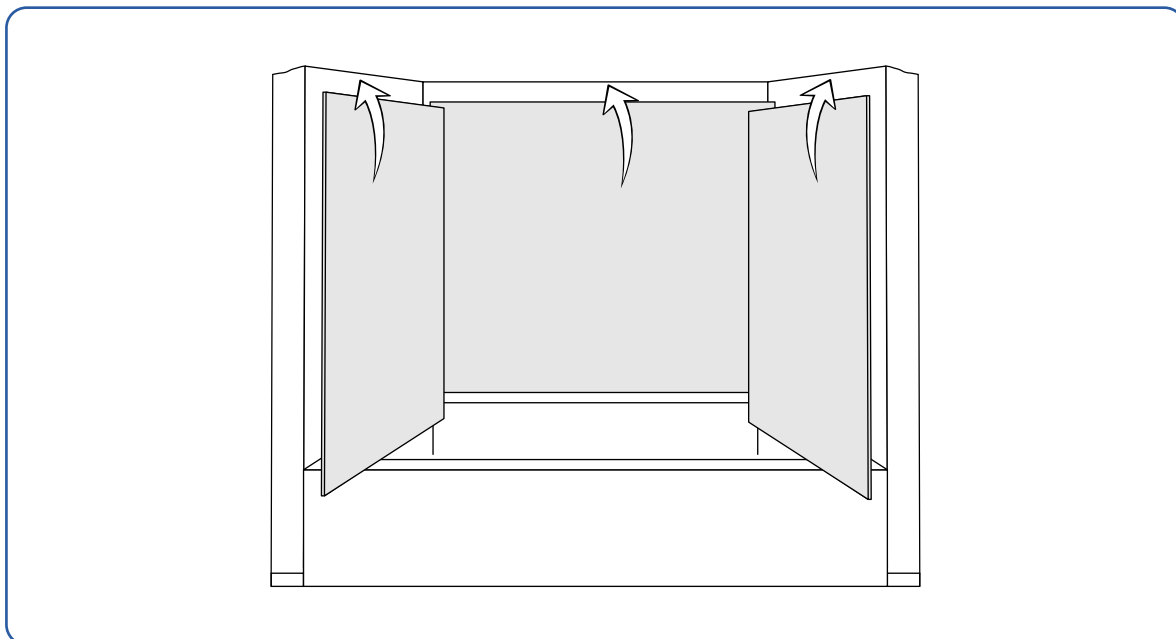
2. Measure the height of the installation area at both ends of each wall, starting from the top of the tub or shower base to the ceiling. If the ceiling height is less than the length of the panels included in your kit, trim the panels accordingly to ensure a proper fit.
 - a. A circular saw is recommended for making precise cuts. If using a utility knife, score the cutting line several times, then use locking pliers to snap off the excess material cleanly, as shown in the example. Important: When drilling, always drill from the finished side to prevent damage. Once cutting is complete, clean both the panels and the walls with a damp cloth to remove dust or debris and ensure everything is completely dry before continuing with installation.



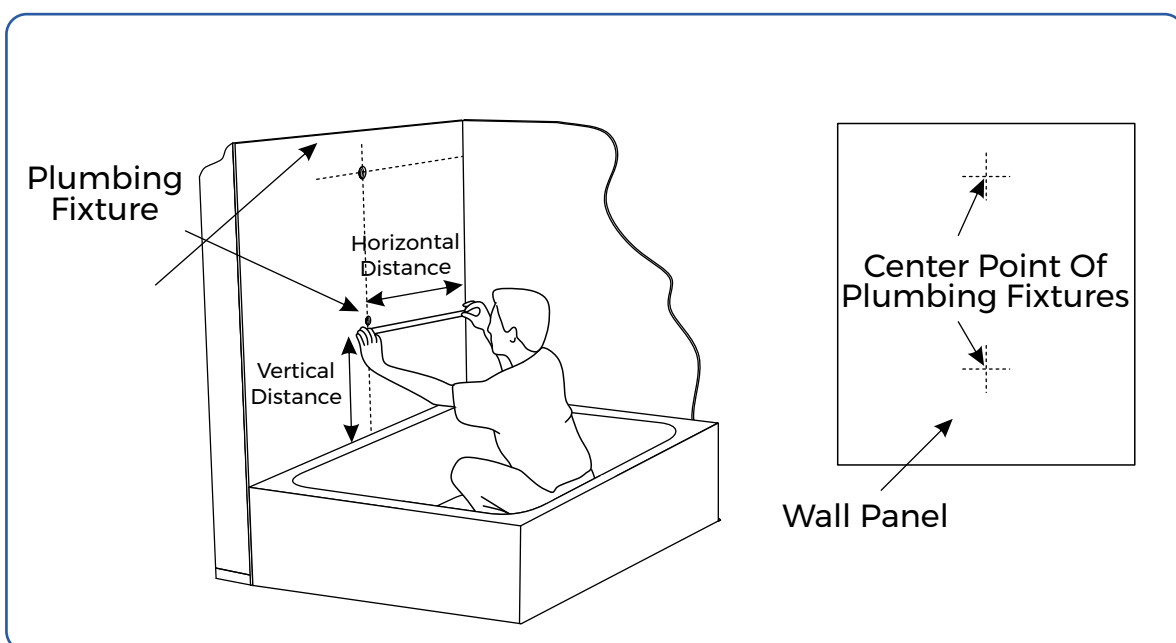
3. Measure the width of each wall at both the top and bottom of the installation area. Make sure the total width of the panels will fit within the space. If the space is narrower than the panels provided in your kit, the panels can be trimmed accordingly.
 - a. A circular saw is recommended for making precise cuts. If using a utility knife, score the cutting line several times, then use locking pliers to snap off the excess material cleanly, as shown in the example. Important: When drilling, always drill from the finished side to prevent damage. Once cutting is complete, clean both the panels and the walls with a damp cloth to remove dust or debris and ensure everything is completely dry before continuing with installation.



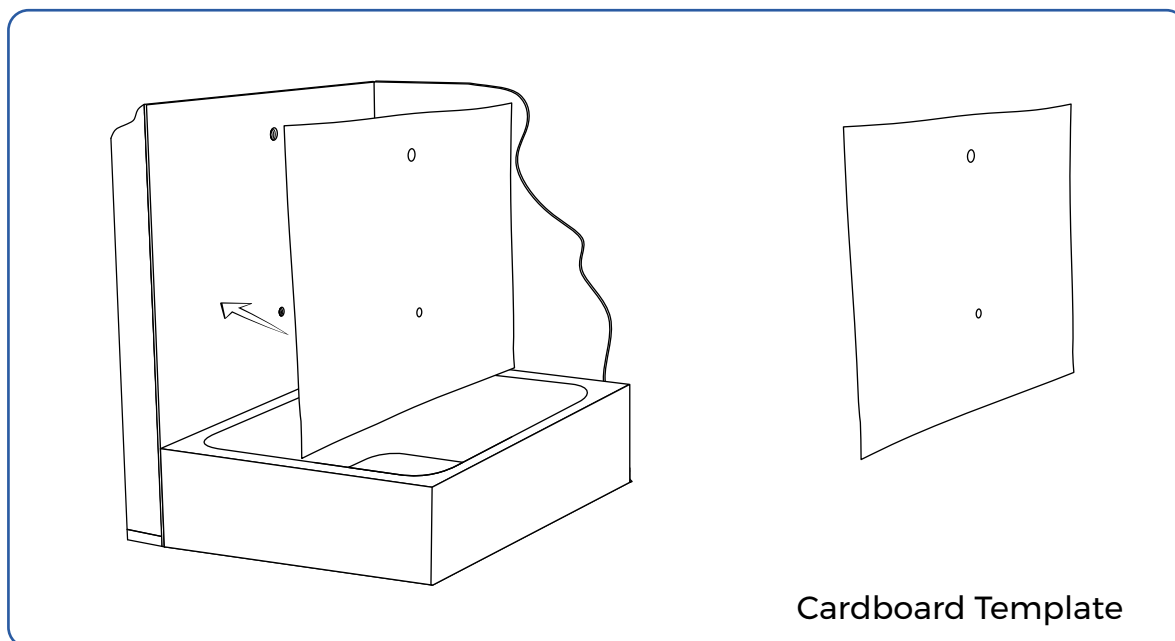
4. Dry-fit the back panels onto the shower's back wall to ensure they fit properly. If adjustments are required, follow the previous trimming steps to achieve the correct size.



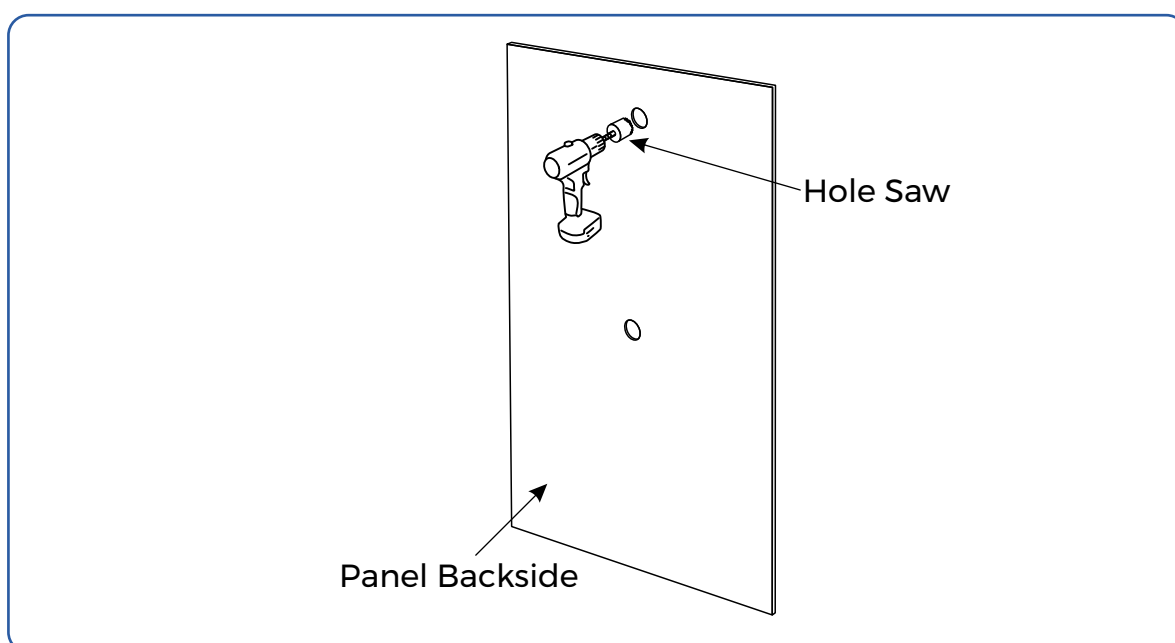
5. For precise alignment, begin by measuring the vertical distance from the center of each plumbing fixture to the bathtub. Next, measure the horizontal distance from the fixture's center to the back wall panel. Transfer these measurements to the front side of the panel, clearly marking the center points of each fixture.



6. To ensure your measurements are accurate, create a cardboard template matching the plumbing cutouts. Test the template on the wall to confirm the fit before cutting into the panel.

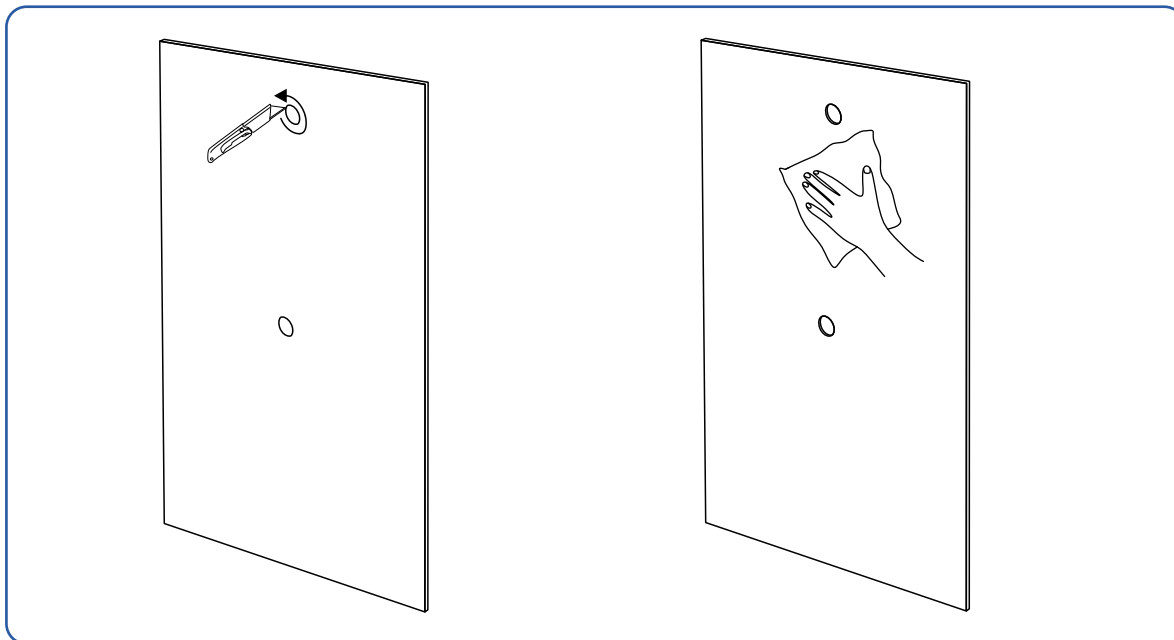


- a. To prevent scratching or damaging the panel's surface, drill holes from the backside of the panel, keeping the finished side protected.
- b. Use a hole saw sized appropriately for each plumbing fixture, such as the showerhead, filler spout, and faucet handles. Drill carefully to create clean cutouts for the installed fixtures.



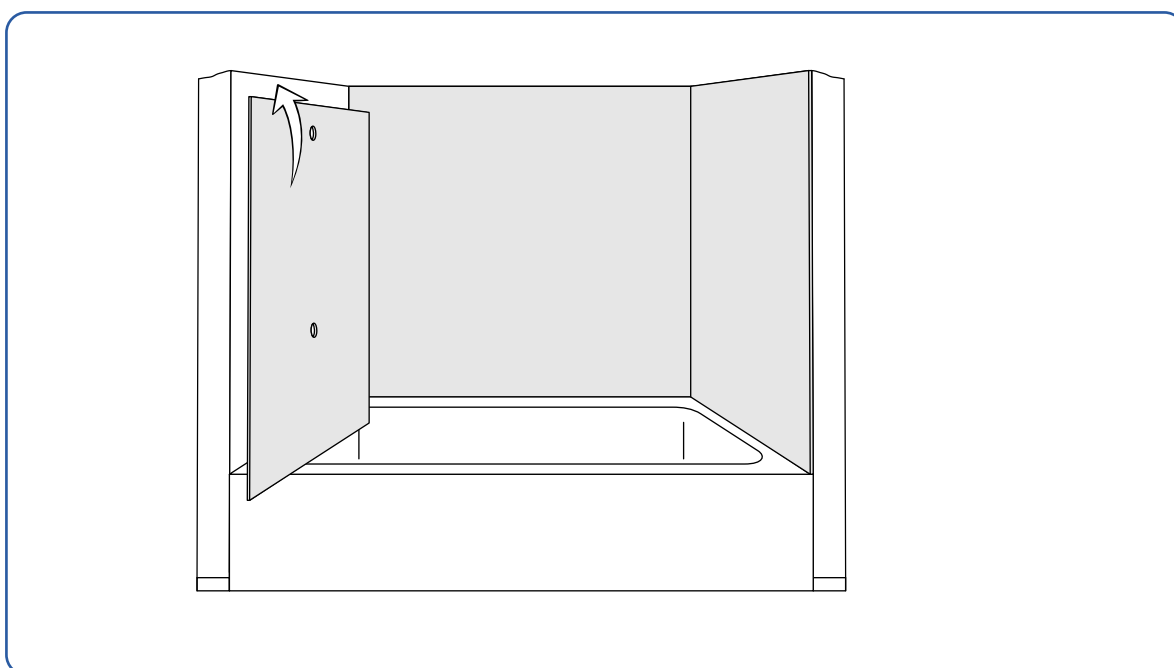
c. If using a utility knife, score the cutting line several times.

Important: When drilling, always drill from the finished side to prevent damage. Once cutting is complete, clean both the panels and the walls with a damp cloth to remove dust or debris and ensure everything is completely dry before continuing with installation.

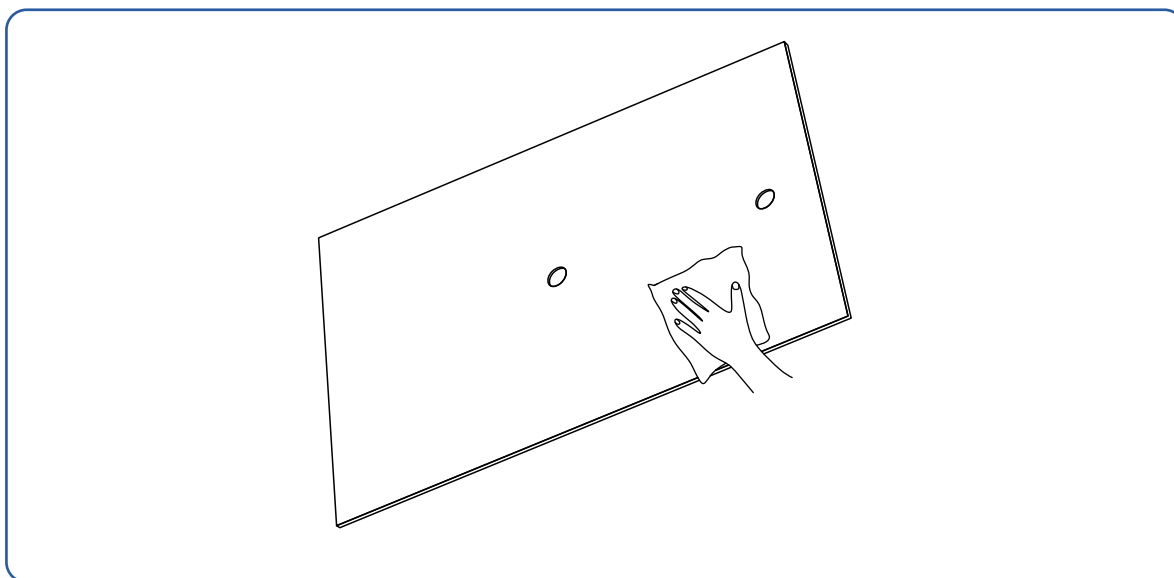


d. When installing a recessed accessory, ensure the panel is fully secured and adhered to the wall before making any cuts. Select the accessory's placement carefully, considering the location of wall studs to avoid interference.

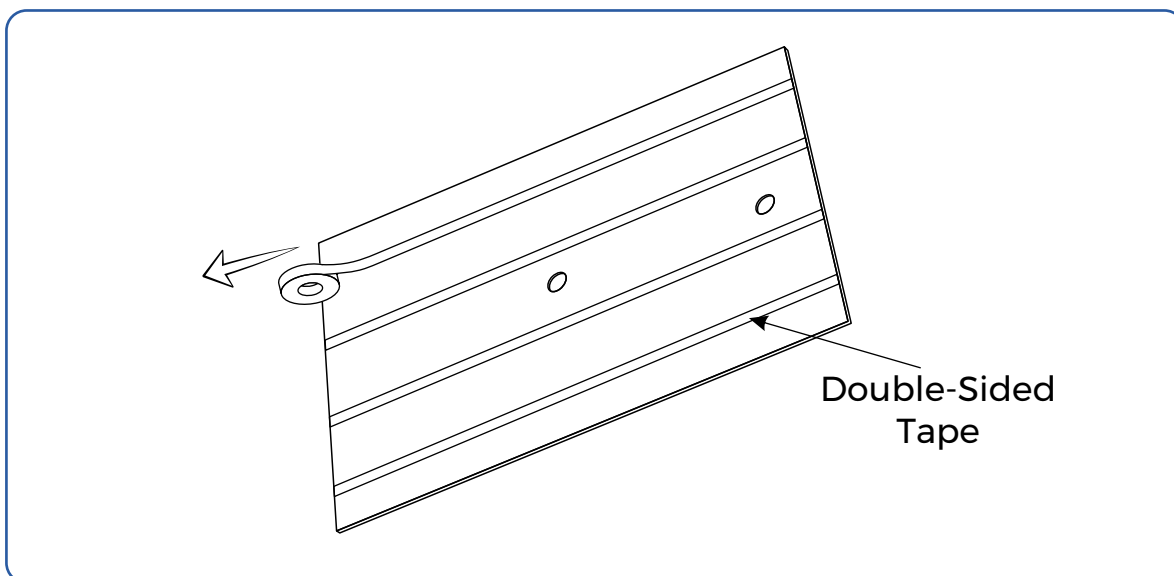
7. After drilling the holes, place the panel against the wall to verify that all openings align precisely with the plumbing fixtures.



8. Clean all panels and walls with a damp cloth to remove any dust or debris, then allow them to dry completely before proceeding.

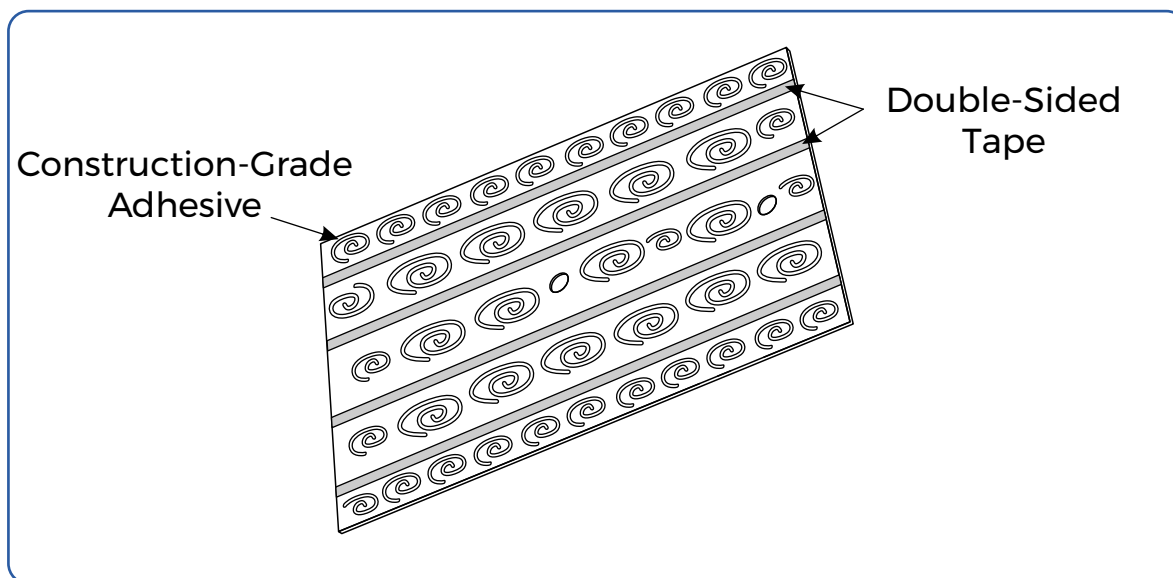


9. Apply the provided double-sided construction tape to the back of the panel in evenly spaced vertical strips, following the illustration for proper placement.

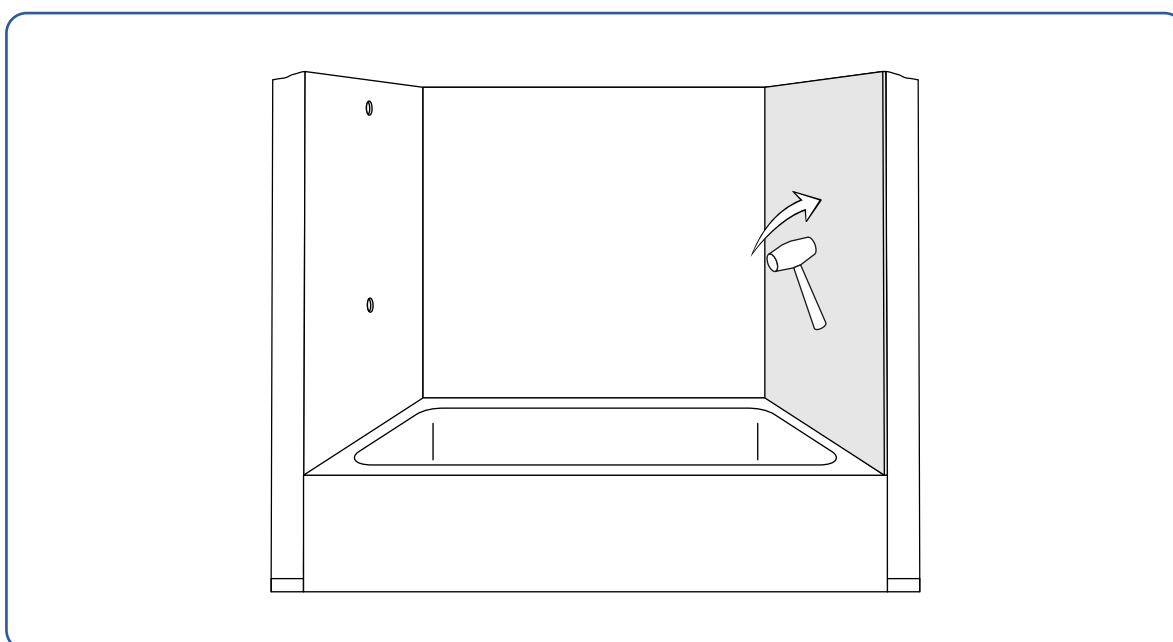


10. Apply a construction-grade adhesive between the taped areas in a circular pattern, ensuring the beads of adhesive are spaced 2 inches apart. Keep the adhesive up to, but no closer than, 1 inch from the panel edges.

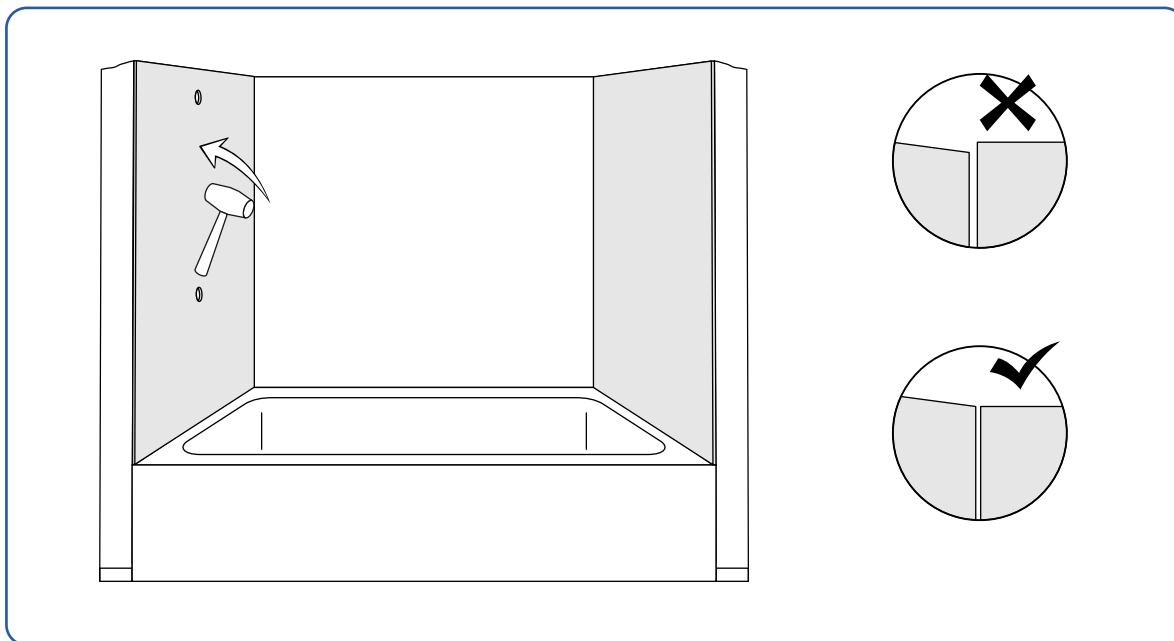
- a. Using a circular adhesive pattern is essential to achieve proper bonding and secure installation.



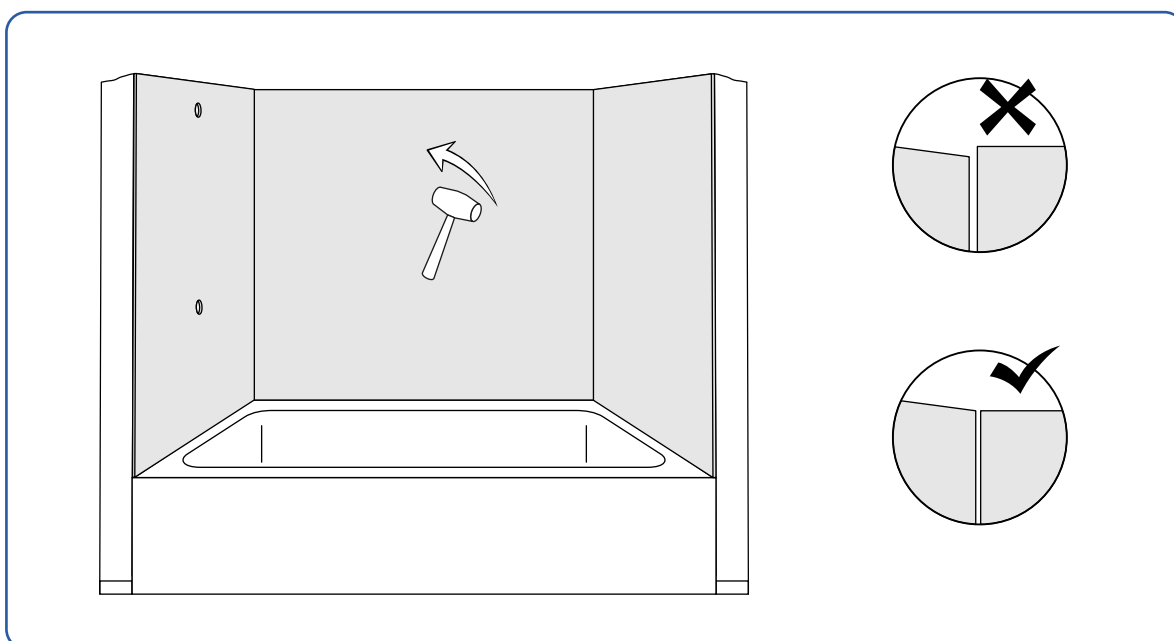
11. **Installing the Right-Side Wall Panel:** Press the panel firmly against the wall, smoothing out any air bubbles across its surface. Use a rubber mallet to gently tap the panel from top to bottom, ensuring it is securely adhered and tightly connected to the wall.



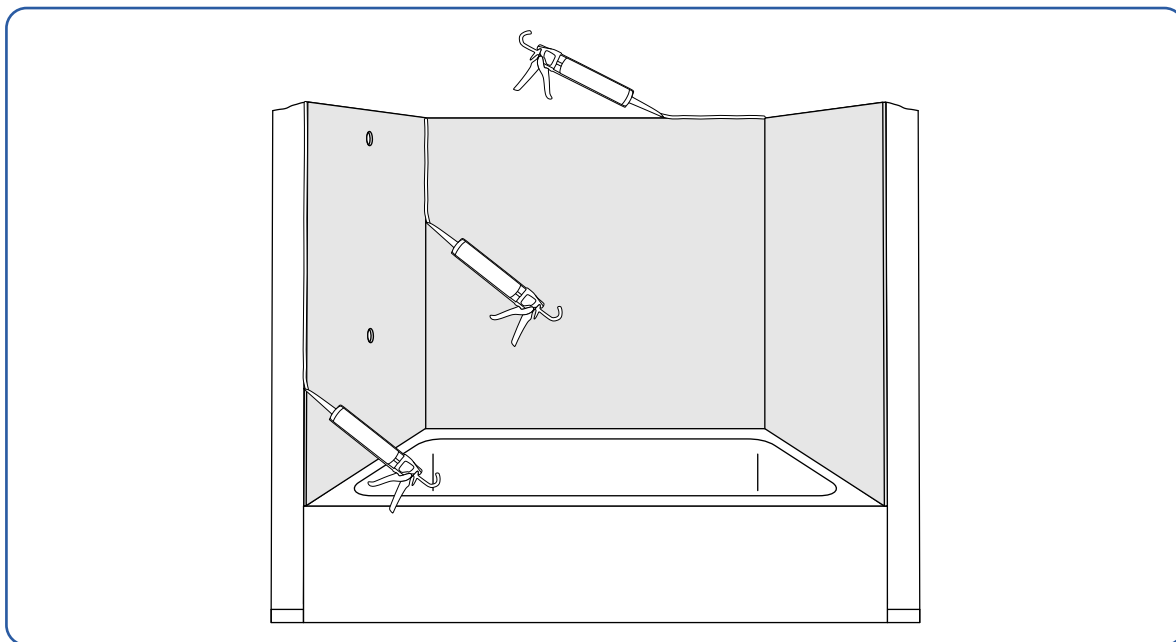
- 12. Installing the Left-Side Wall Panel:** Position the left-side wall panel so that it aligns perfectly with the installed right-side panel, ensuring the edges of both panels meet seamlessly. Press the panel firmly against the wall, smoothing out any air bubbles across the surface. Use a rubber mallet to gently tap from top to bottom, ensuring the panel is securely adhered and properly aligned with the adjacent panel.



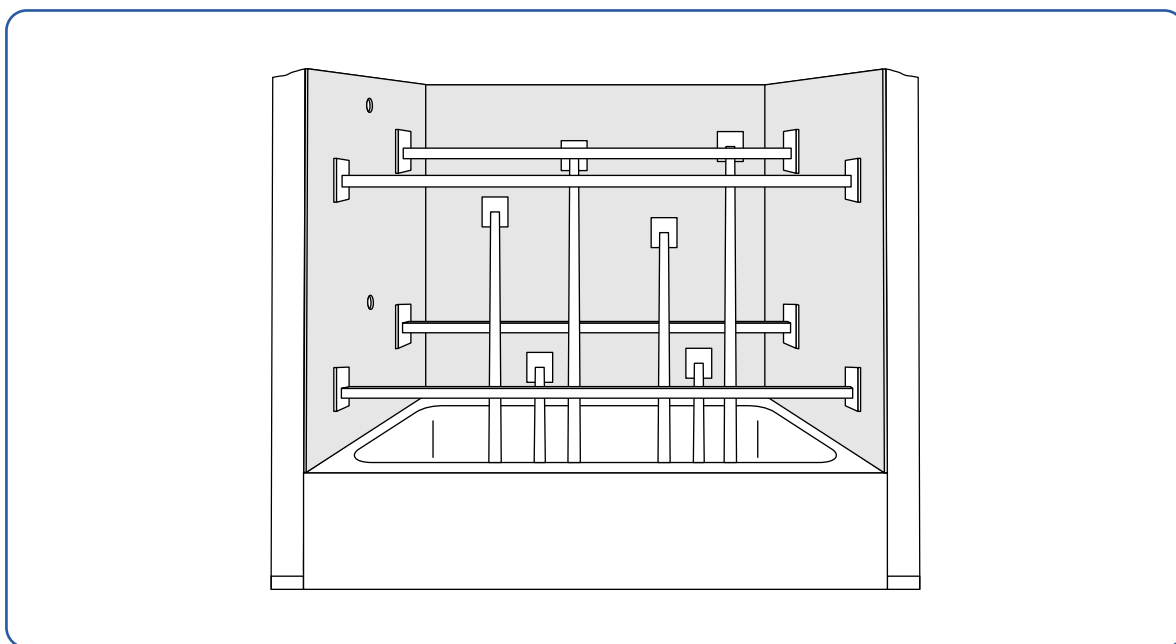
- 13. Installing the Back Wall Panel:** Position the back wall panel so that it aligns perfectly with the installed right-side panel and left-side panel, ensuring the edges of both panels meet seamlessly. Press the panel firmly against the wall, smoothing out any air bubbles across the surface. Use a rubber mallet to gently tap from top to bottom, ensuring the panel is securely adhered and properly aligned with the adjacent panels.



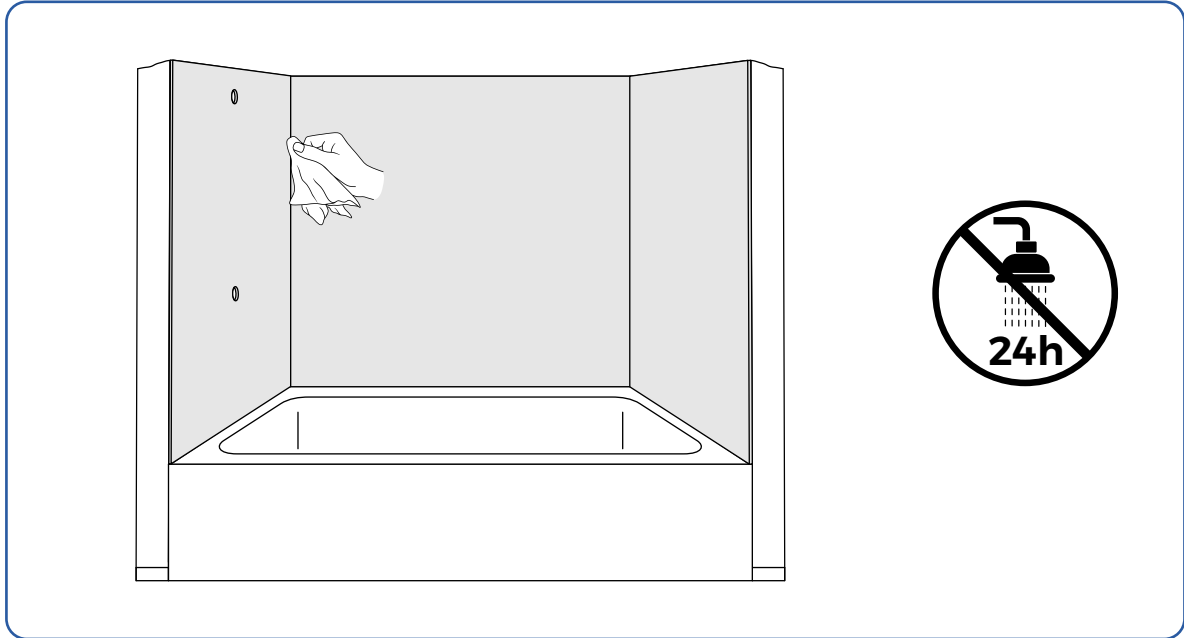
14. To ensure a secure and polished finish, properly apply caulk around the shower wall system. Focus on key areas such as the interior corners where the shower walls meet, the joints where the walls meet the base, and the outer edges of the side wall panels. Additionally, while optional, caulking along the top edge of the entire enclosure can contribute to a more refined and finished appearance. Apply the caulk evenly to achieve a clean, professional look.



15. For optimal adhesion of the wall panels, apply consistent pressure during the curing process using bars or wooden supports. Ensure the pressure is evenly distributed across each panel to achieve a secure bond.



16. Ensure the entire area remains dry for at least 24 hours to allow the caulk and construction adhesive to fully cure.
- a. After the caulk and adhesive have fully cured, use denatured alcohol and clean painter's rags to remove any residue left from the installation process.



6. Product Care Guide

Proper maintenance of your shower walls will ensure their durability, functionality, and aesthetic appeal for years to come. Follow these care instructions to keep your shower walls in excellent condition:

1. Cleaning Your Shower Walls



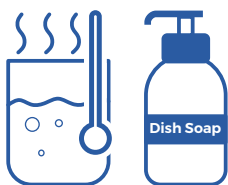
Regular Cleaning

Wipe down the walls after each use with a soft, damp cloth or sponge to remove soap scum, water spots, and grime.



Weekly Maintenance

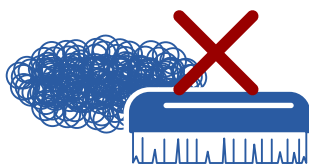
Use a mild, non-abrasive cleaner designed for bathroom surfaces. Avoid harsh chemicals such as bleach or ammonia, as they may damage the finish.



Stubborn Stains

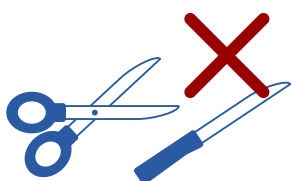
For tough spots, use a mixture of warm water and dish soap or a solution of white vinegar and water. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a microfiber cloth.

2. Preventing Damage



Avoid Scratches

Do not use abrasive pads, steel wool, or harsh scrub brushes on the surface, as they may cause scratches or dull the finish.



No Sharp Tools

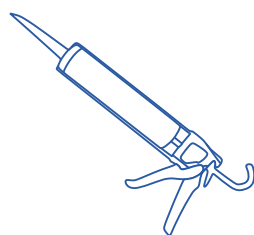
Never use sharp objects or tools to remove residue or buildup; instead, use a plastic scraper if necessary.

3. Maintaining Seals and Caulk



Inspect Regularly

Check the caulk and seals around the edges of your shower walls for cracks or gaps.



Reapply as Needed

Reapply silicone caulk every 12-18 months or as needed to maintain a watertight seal.

4. Managing Hard Water and Mold



Prevent Water Spots

Dry the walls after each use to reduce mineral buildup from hard water.



Control Mold and Mildew

Keep the bathroom well-ventilated by using an exhaust fan or opening a window. If mold appears, clean with a diluted vinegar solution and rinse thoroughly.
