

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION console table

## Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

<ul> <li>Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.</li> <li>Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.</li> <li>Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.</li> <li>Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.</li> <li>Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.</li> <li>Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.</li> <li>Parts of the assembly will be easier with one person.</li> </ul>	• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torque setting.
Care and maintenance		
<ul> <li>Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>This product should not be discarded household waste.</li> <li>Take to your local authorily waste disposal centre</li> </ul>
Handy Hints		
<ul> <li>Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Regularly check and ensure That all bolts and fittings are tightend properly.</li> </ul>	
WARNING		
In order to help prevent overturning -		
please follow these intructions		
To help prevent product toppling over please follow the below steps :		
Use the anti tip stap wall fixing method provided (if applilcable) Do not allow children to climb or hang in the furniture Do not open more than one drawer at a time Do not place heavy items in the top drawers Do not place heavy items on top the furniture, unless the furniture has been designed for this purpose		
Please note that only the anti strap is provided You will need to provided wall plugs and screws applicable for your wall type		
Tools required		
Phillips screwdriver (medium & large )		
Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify screws		
The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown) Page 2/8
