Caring for Leather furniture

- Weekly vacuum your leather upholstery to remove excess dust, concentrating on the seams in seats and backs
- · Clean with distilled water and a lint free rag once a month
- Blot spilled liquids immediately with a clean, absorbent cloth or sponge
- If necessary, use lukewarm water and a mild detergent like Ivory soap, to gently clean soiled areas. Dry with a clean white towel and allow to air dry.
- · Do not ever clean with harsh, strong cleaners, saddle soap or detergents
- Keep leather furniture a minimum of 24" from all heat sources
- Keep leather out of direct sunlight. The ultraviolet rays will eventually fade all leathers
