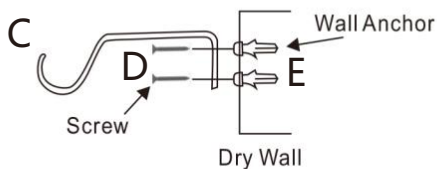


If installing into drywall, tap anchors into drilled holes with hammer until flush with wall.

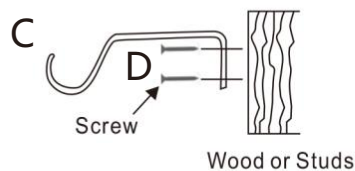

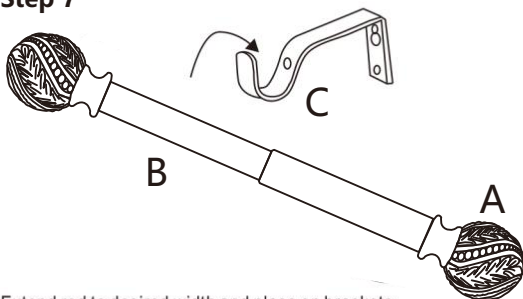

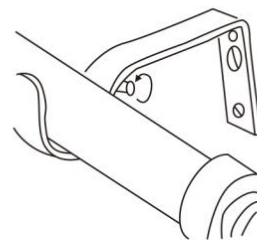

Hand-tighten set screw to secure rod.

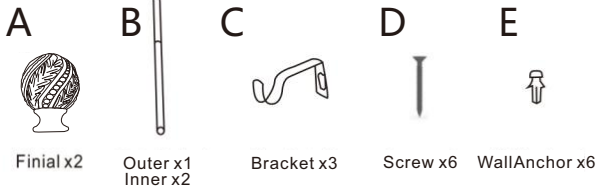

1 Step 1

Place mounting bracket at desired position on wall.
Mark holes with pencil

2 Step 2

28-48"

48-84"

Drill holes at the center of each marking.

5 Step 5

If installing into drywall, tap anchors into drilled holes with hammer until flush with wall.

Insert screws through mounting bracket.
