
## **Pinch Pleat Curtain Installation Instructions**

**Getting Started:** Carefully remove your new draperies from packaging. Use caution, as drapery pins have been inserted into the pleats before shipment.

## Installing and Dressing Your Pleated Draperies (follow step by step below):

- 1. You will need a drapery rod installed, with curtain rings attached to the rod, before hanging the draperies.
- 2. Insert drapery pins through the eyelets of the rings (or just through the ring if there is no eyelets). Once you have inserted all the pins in the rings, let your drapery hang.



- **3. Important:** It's normal that you see creases/wrinkles on the draperies from folding/transit. Don't worry as this is only temporary. Once your draperies are installed, most wrinkles and folds will hang out on their own after a few days. For best and most immediate results, we also recommend that you use a garment/commercial steamer to help eliminate wrinkles by carefully using the steamer from the bottom to the top.
- **4. Adjustments:** Once your drapery is hung, if you need to adjust the length of the drapery, you can drop or raise the drapery pins to make the drapery longer or shorter. If further adjustment is required, you may need to adjust the rod height.
- **5. Caring and Cleaning:** If the drapery is dusty, simply vacuum over it using a clean upholstery attachment. For stubborn stains or overall deep cleaning, professional on-site service or dry cleaning is recommended.
